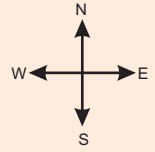

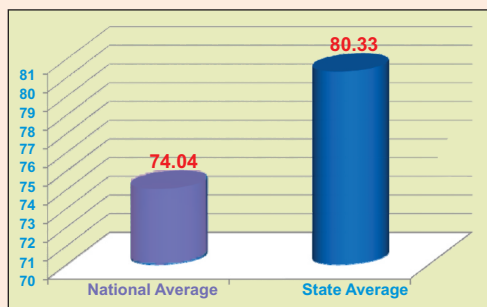

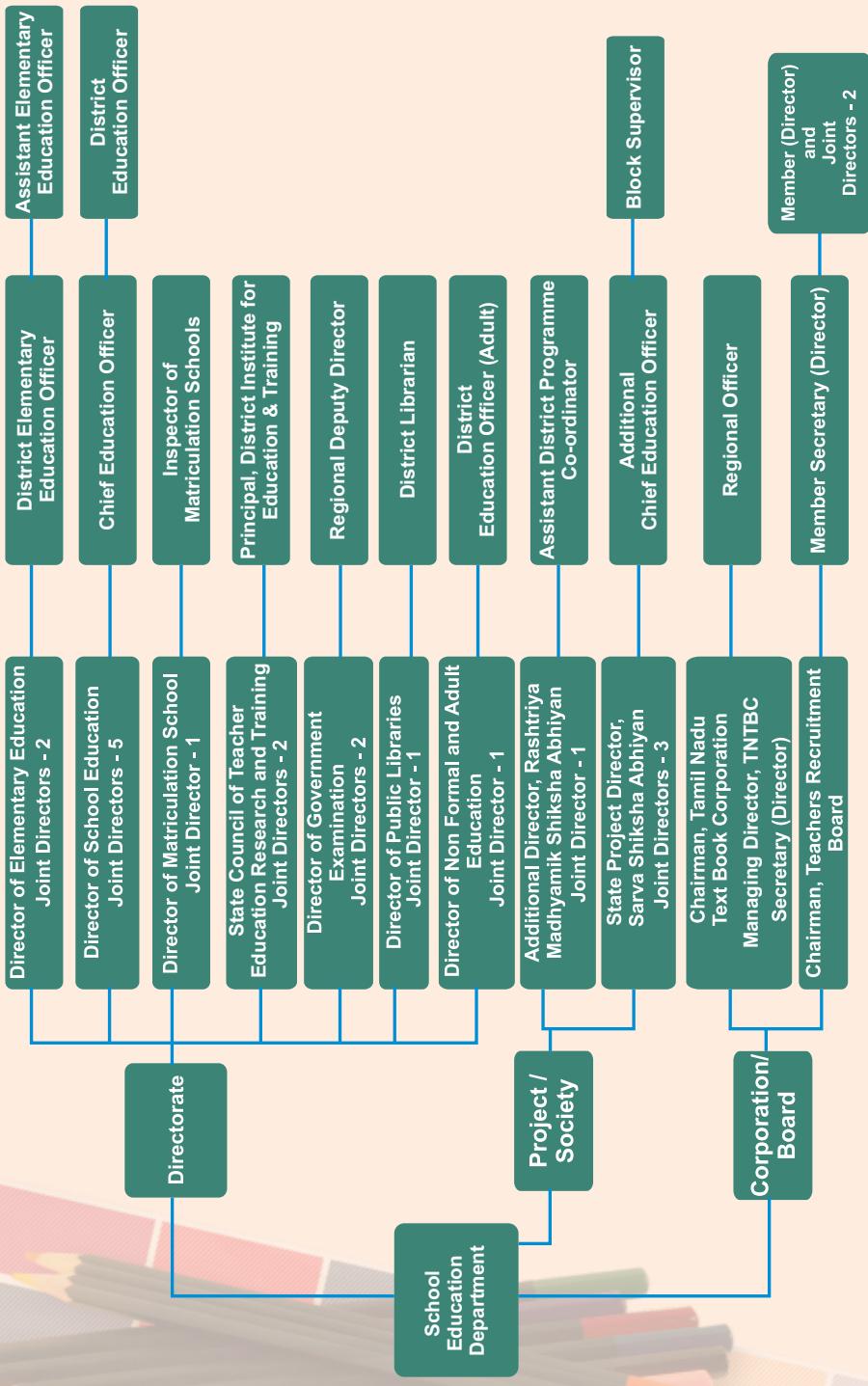

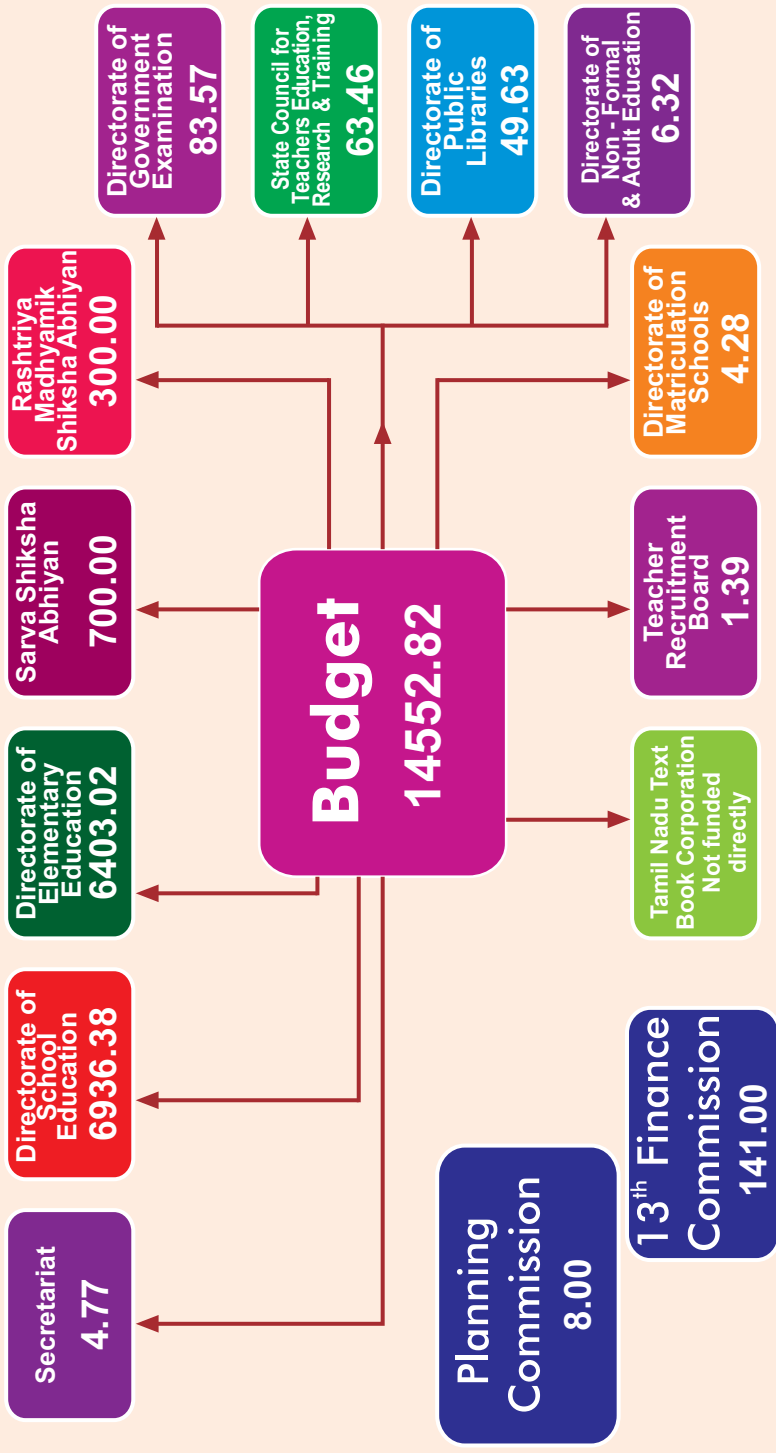

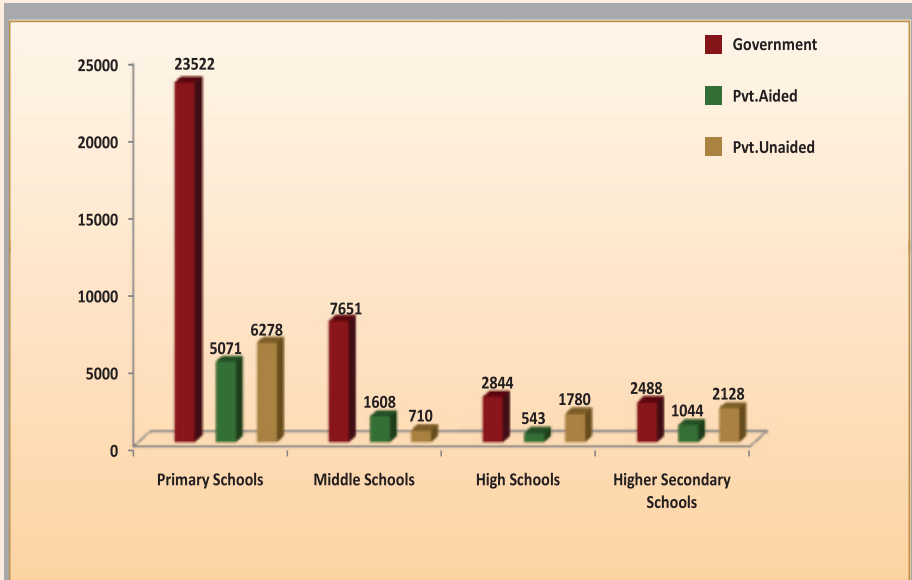

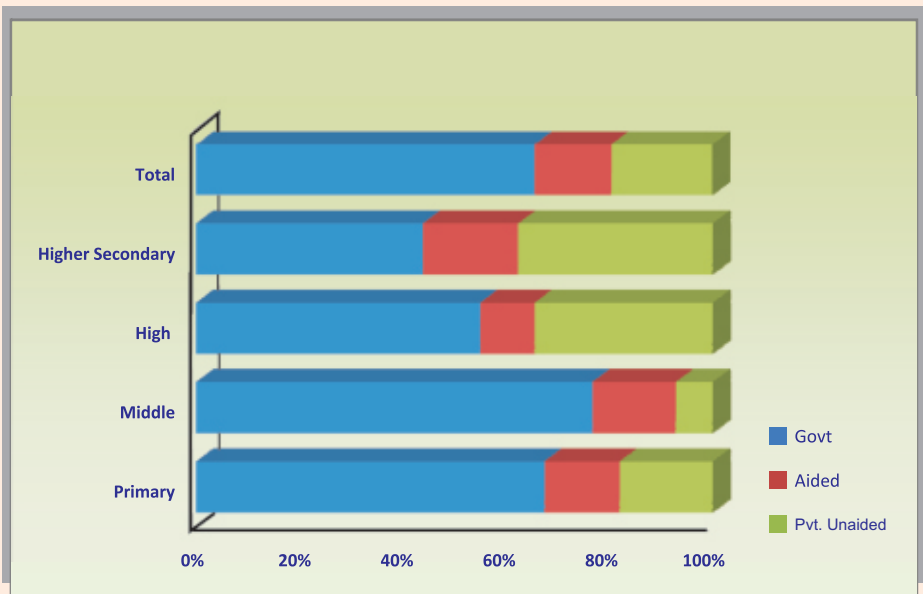

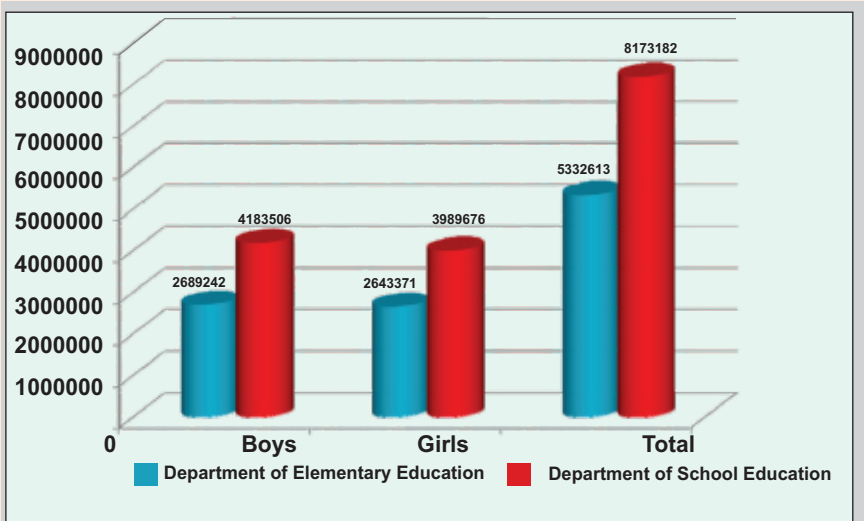

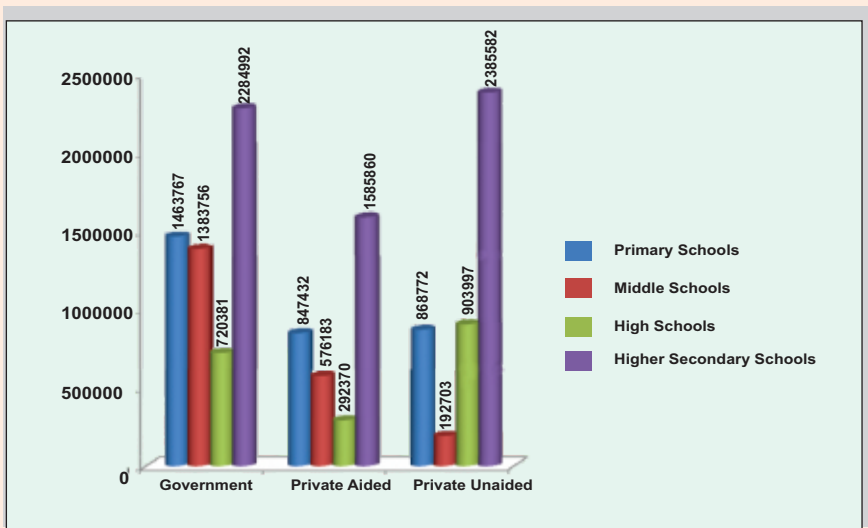

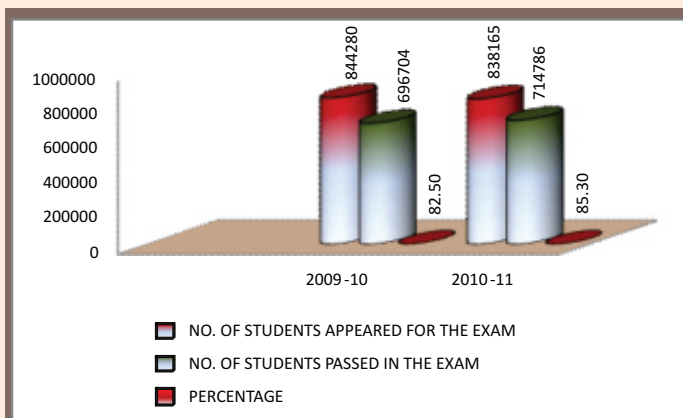

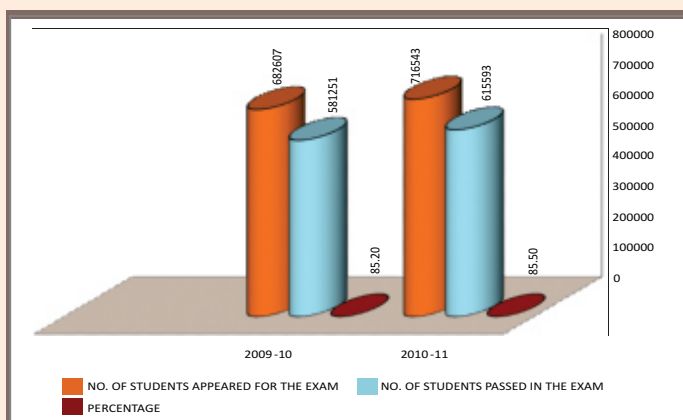

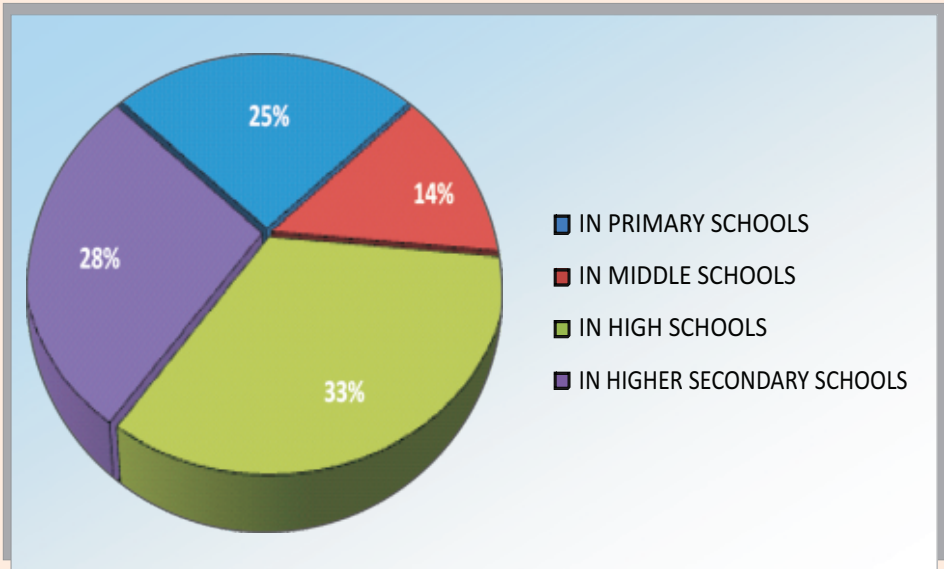

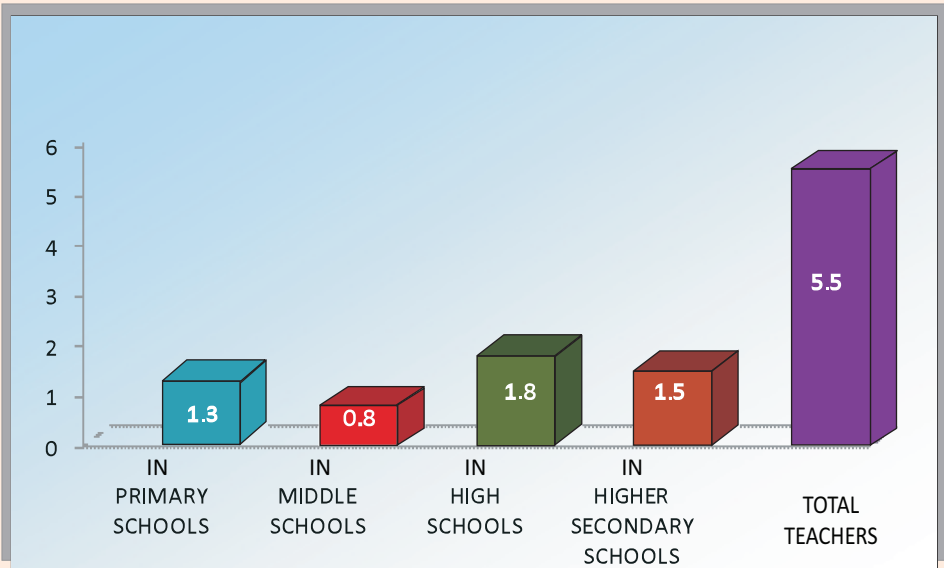

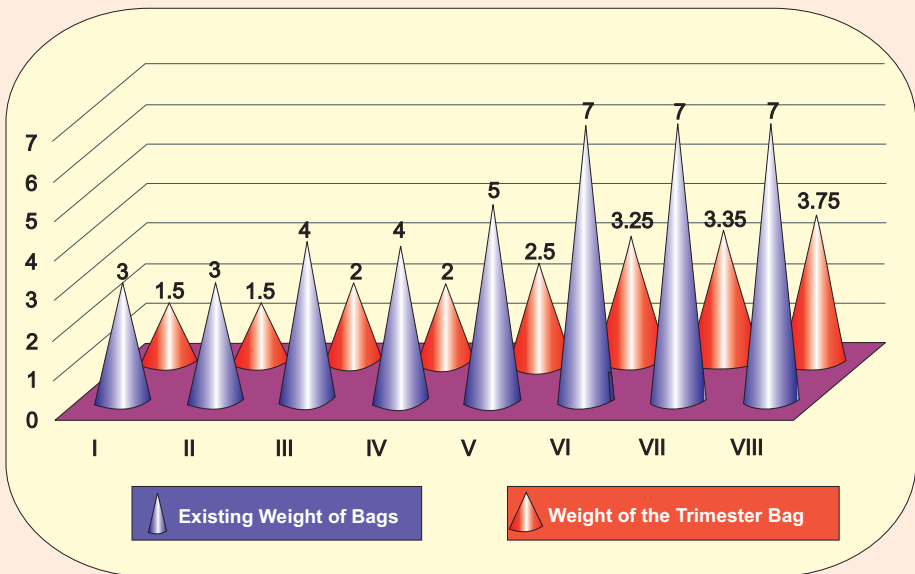
## Reduction of Book Load

- ▶ Trimester, Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation for I to VIII during 2012-13
- ▶ One set of books for each term
- ▶ Students will carry only 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the book load compared to the earlier system
  - Internationally recommended load of school bag is 10% of the body weight of the child
  - When the weight exceeds 15% of body weight musculoskeletal problems like kyphotic posture and scoliosis are caused

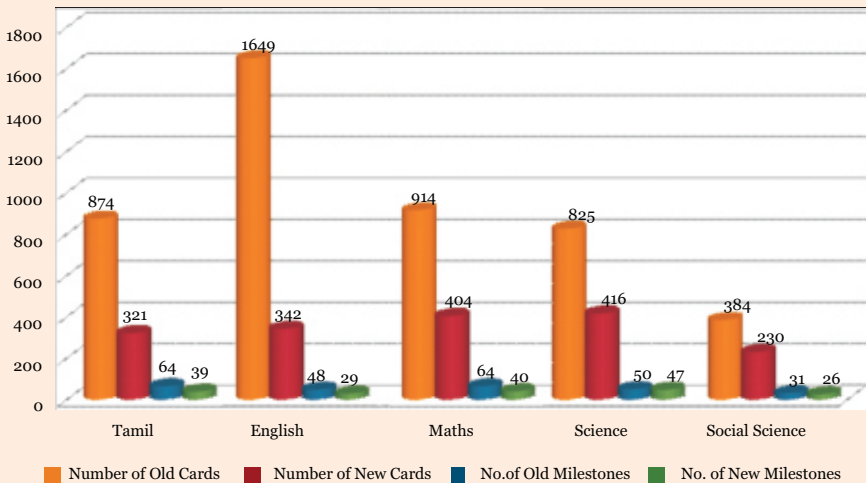

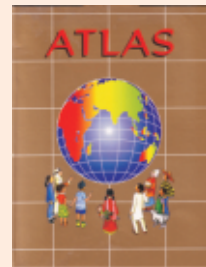
