AREA AND POPULATION

POPULATION OF DELHI

After independence Sixth Population Census was undertaken in the entire area of NCT of Delhi between 9th February to 28th February 2001 with a revisional round from 1st to 5th March, 2001. As such, the population of Delhi, as on 1st March, 2001, has been worked out at 13.85 millions as against 9.42 millions as on 1st March, 1991. This reflects decennial growth of 47.02% of population after 1991 census. The corresponding percentage at All-India level has been worked out at 21.34%. The total population of Delhi is 1.34% of the All-India Population. Figures at a glance – Population Characteristics 2001 are given in Table 1.1. Decennial Population Growth Rate in Delhi is given in Table 1.2.

AREA OF NCT OF DELHI

The total area of NCT of Delhi is 1483 Sq. Kms. As per Population Census 1991, its rural and urban composition is given below:

During Population Census 2001, the area of NCT of Delhi has remained the same at 1483 Sq. Kms. However, its rural-urban composition has undergone change due to urbanisation of villages. According to the estimates of Directorate of Census Operations, Delhi, its rural-urban break-up of NCT of Delhi is given below:

ANNUAL AVERAGE GROWTH RATE OF POPULATION IN DELHI

The annual average exponential growth rate of population of Delhi was the highest (6.42%) during 1941-1951 due to large scale migration from Pakistan to India after partition in 1947. Since then the annual growth has been recorded 4.22 % during 1951-1961, 4.25% during 1961-1971, 4.25% during 1971-1981 and 4.15% during 1981-1991. The annual growth rate of population of Delhi during 1991-2001 has been recorded as 3.85% and it is almost double the national average.





PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF POPULATION IN LOCAL BODIES



Distribution of Population (2001) By Selected Languages







PRICE & PRICE INDICES

PRICE & PRICE INDICES

WHOLE SALE PRICES (WPI)

It is a general purpose index to measure the variations in the whole sale price levels in the state with base year 1999-2000=100. It covers 19 commodities for which prices are collected from different markets of Delhi. Table no. 4.1 presents average wholesale prices of the commodities from 1980 to 2008; while Index numbers of wholesale prices in India present in Table no. 4.5.

The Wholesale prices are collected by the Directorate of Economics & Statistics Delhi, while index no. is prepared by Ministry of Commerce Industry.

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI)

The Labour Bureau Shimla has been compiling and releasing regularly the monthly Consumer Price Index Number for Industrial Workers which is one of the important economic indicators of inflationary measures in the country. The index measures the overall changes in the level of average retail price of a fixed set of goods and services consumed by the target population. The base year of the current CPI for industrial workers is 2001=100. The source of weights for this index is a family living survey, which includes the whole centre of Delhi.

The Index Number is compiled for following major groups:-

- (1) Food
- (2) Pan, Supari, Tobacco and Intoxicants
- (3) Fuel and Light
- (4) Housing
- (5) Clothing, Bedding & Footwear and
- (6) Miscellaneous

Table 4.2 contains Group-wise CPI for Industry Workers in Delhi from 1980 to 2009 while table 4.3 presents Group/Sub-group wise CPI for Industrial workers in ratio of All India & 4 metro cities. Table 4.4 contains Annual average CPI for some selected centers of India. Table of 4.6 contains Consumer price index for Urban Non- Manual Employees in Delhi.





JOINT STOCK COMPANIES

Of Company Affairs, Govt. Of India.

INDUSTRIES & TAX

The data regarding No. of registered factories, their Productive Capital (Fixed and Working), total No. of Employee and their emolument is present in table 6.2.1 while table 6.2.2 includes Index number of industrial Production (General Index, Manufacturing and Electricity). Data is provided by DES relates to the period 1980-81 to 2009-10.

Information regarding total number of Registered dealers under Local and Central Act, Receipts of Local sales tax and Central sales Tax is given in Table No. 6.3 and the source of information is Trade & Taxes Deptt. Of GNCTD.

ECONOMIC CENSUS

The Fifth Economic Census in respect of NCT of Delhi was conducted under the aegis of Directorate of Economics & Statistics. Economic Census is the complete enumeration of entrepreneurial activities operating in the geographical boundaries of State/ Country at a given point of time to come out with the official count of establishments and their characteristics. Fifth Economic Census briefly includes all types of entrepreneurial activities in the field of agriculture (except crop production and plantation) as well as non- agriculture. Entrepreneurial activities mean, all those economic activities dealing with the production or distribution of goods/services not solely for the purpose of own consumption. The result of 5th Economic Census are shown in table 6.4 while table 6.5 presents the NSS 62nd & 67th Survey Results of un-organized Manufacturing service sectors. This data is provided by Directorate of Economics & Statistics, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.



ECONOMIC INDICATORS

This section deals with information pertaining to State Income by Industry at current prices and at constant (1999-2000) Prices.

Broad Economic Activities are divided into three sectors namely.

- I. The Primary sector includes Agriculture and allied activities, Mining & quarrying.
- II. The Secondary sector includes Manufacturing, Electricity, Gas, Water, Supply and Construction Sector.
- III. The tertiary sector includes Trade, Hotel and Restaurants, Transport storage & Communications, Finance, Insurance, Real Estate/ Business services, Community, Social & Personal Services.

Table 8.1 to 8.5 presents GSDP/NSDP by Broad Economic Activity at current and constant prices while table 8.6 presents monthly per capita expenditure in Delhi with comparison to other states and table 8.7 presents the population below poverty line. Data is compiled and provided by DES.





Distribution of M C C D Deaths 2009




