Per Capita Income at Current and Constant Prices

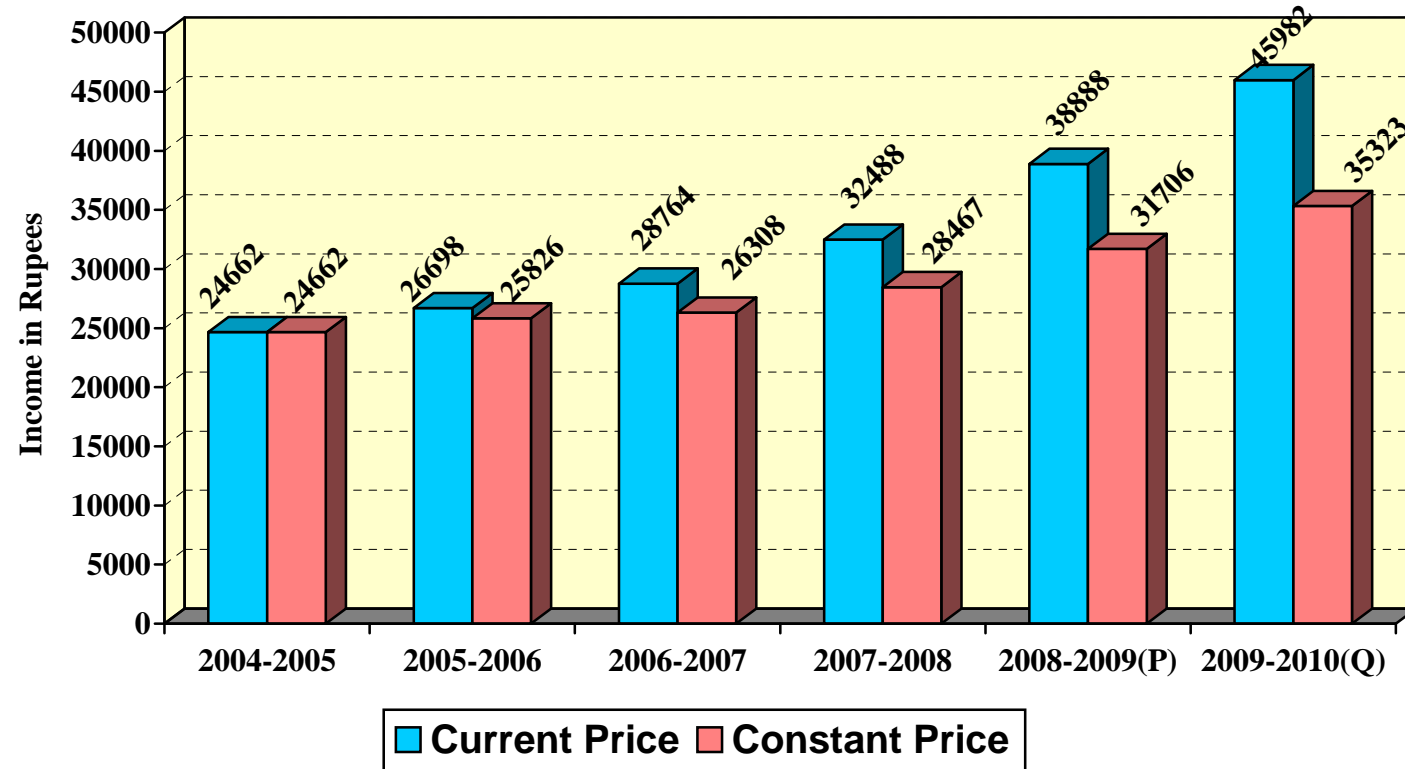

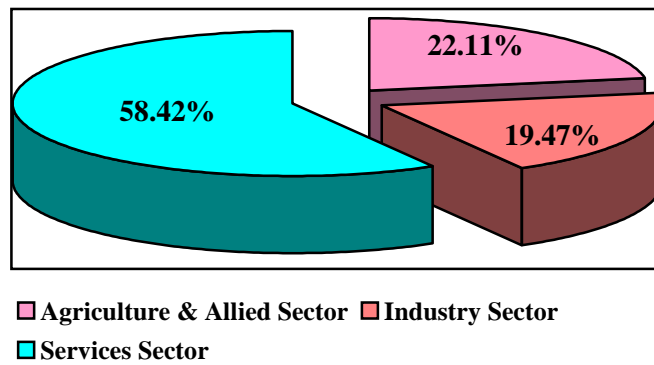

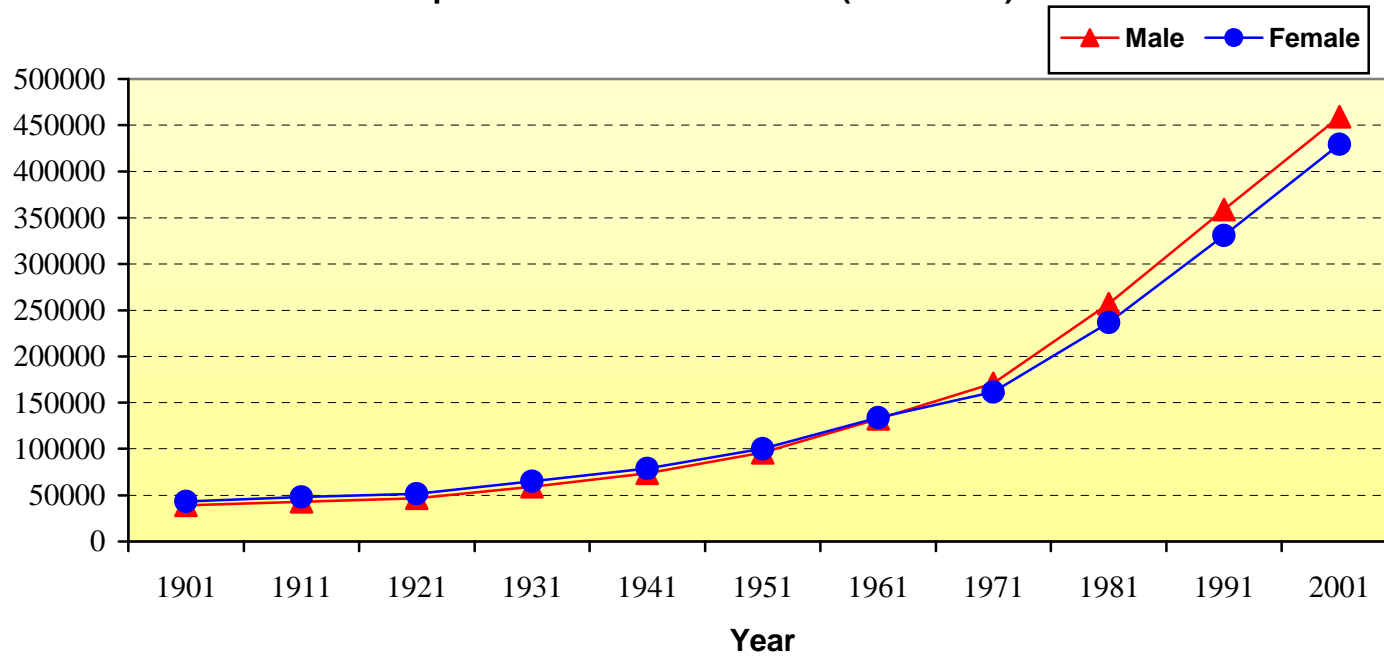

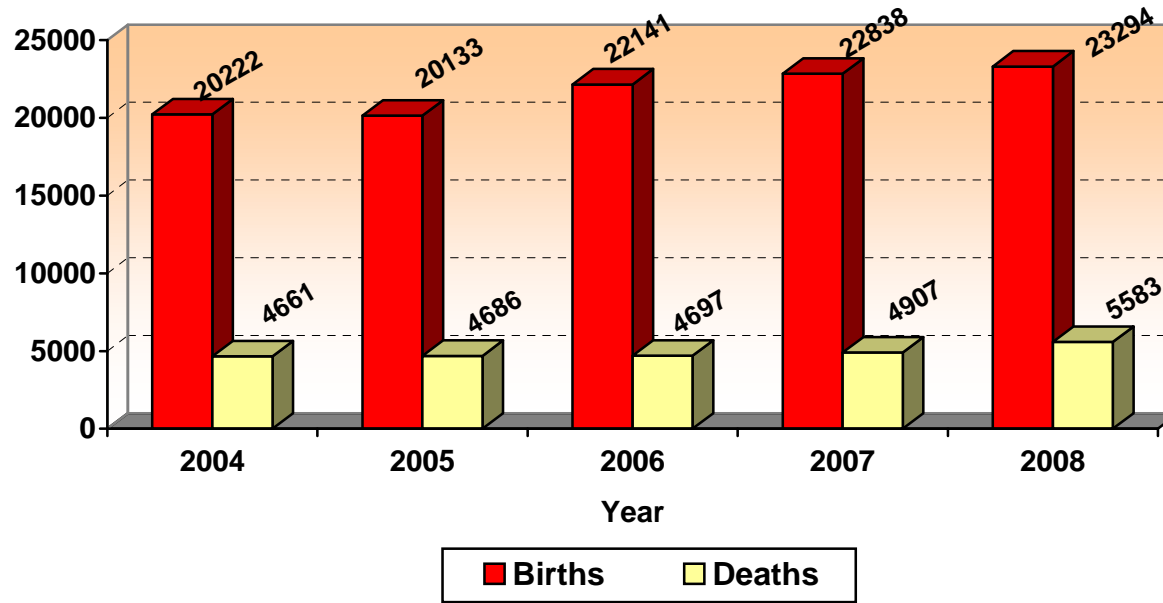
