1. GEOGRAPHICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE FEATURES:-

The Lower Subansiri District covers approximately an Area of 13,010 Sq.Kms. The part of the District is mountaneous terrain with Hill Ranges. It lies in between Latitude-26°55' N and 28°21'N and Longitude 92°40'E and 94°21'E.

The District is bounded by China(Tibet) and some part of Upper Subansiri District to the North, West Siang and some part of Upper Subansiri District to the East, Assam State to the South and East Kameng District to the West.

Average Annual Rainfall of this District is 167 Centimetres.

It has 3 towns and 858 inhabited villages and it is divided into 4 Major Sub-Divisions and 17 Circles. The Deputy Commissioner is the Over-all Incharge of the District. Panchayat Raj system exists in the District. At present the District has 10 CD/IRD Blocks.

2. POPULATION AND SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONDITIONS:-

According to 1991 Census, total population of the District is 1,55,978 persons. Of this Male population is 82,277 persons and Female population is 73,701. Density of population is 11 persons per Sq.Km. The total literacy rate of this District is recorded as 32.74 %(Prov). 62.77%(Prov) of the total main working population are cultivators. Agriculture is the main occupation of the inhabitants of the District.

3. ROAD AND COMMUNICATION:- The District has 550.352 Km. surfaced and 888.587 Kms. length of unsurfaced roads. Most of the Administrative Head Quarters are connected by roads with the District Head Quarter. Regular Bus Service exists from Ziro to North Lakhimpur/Itanagar and some other Administrative Places/HQs.

There are 3 Nos. of post office with Telegraph facilities, 37 Nos. post offices without Telegraph facilities (PO=6+EDBPO=31) and 7 Nos. Telephone Exchanges(STD=4+others=3) are functioning in the District. Apart from this One Head Post office is functioning at Itanagar.

4. AGRICULTURE, VETERINARY, FISHERY & FORESTRY:-

The District has 39,356 Hects. of land available for cultivation. Of this, Net Area Sown is 28,788 Hects. 42,292.42 Metric Tonnes Cereal Crops (Paddy, Maize, Millet and wheat) produced during the year 1992-93.

It has 14 Nos. of Veterinary Dispensaries, 18 Nos. Veterinary Aid Centre at different Administrative places. It has 10 Nos. of Govt. Fish Farms, 127 Nos. of People Fish Farms, 726 Nos. of village Fish Ponds. 207 Metric Tonnes Fish and 20.00 lakh Nos. Fish Seeds produced during the reference year 1992-93.

The District has 1,36,300 Hects. Reserve Forest under different Forest Divisions and 176.83 lakh Rupees Revenue earned from the Forest Products grown in the District during the year 1992-93.

5. MINERALS AND INDUSTRIES:- There is no economic important Mineral Resources found in the District as yet.

There are 5 Nos. Training-Cum-Production Centre, 5 Nos. Weaving Units and 3 Nos. Sericulture Demonstration Farms are functioning in the District. 76 Nos. Trainees were trained in different Crafts during the year 1992-93.

6. MINOR IRRIGATION:- The District has 156 Nos. Minor Irrigation Channels and 4393.93 Hects. irrigated land Area.

An expenditure of Rs. 318.44 lakh were incurred as on 31.3.91 and Rs. 154.85 lakhs were incurred during 1992-93 for construction of Minor Irrigation Channel in the District.

7. SOCIAL SERVICES:- The District has 257 Nos. of Govt. and 14 Nos. of Private Educational Institutions with a total Enrolment of 40,054 students.

Besides, One District Hospital at Ziro, One General Hospital at Naharlagun, One R.V. Mission Hospital at Itanagar, One T.B. Centre at Ziro, 30 Nos. Health Units/Dispensaries were functioning in different Administrative Head quarters/places. 651 Nos. villages and 3 Towns have been provided with drinking water supply as on 31.3.93.

11. EMPLOYMENT:- There are 2 Nos. of Employment Exchange Cells, one each under Deputy Commissioner, Ziro and Deputy Commissioner, Papumpare functioning in the District. Total 1,804 Nos. Job Seekers Registered their name in these Employment Cells during the year 1992 as per report received from the Employment Exchange/Labour Officers.
