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HISTORY OF CHITTOOR DISTRICT : AT A GLANCE

CHITTOOR DISTRICT that forms part of ancient DRAVINDANADU has a long history enjoying or suffering of the VICISSITUDAS that cast the sunshine or shadows on the region right from the times earlier to PALLAVA DYNASTY. Places like Narayanavanam, Karvetinagar, Chandragiri, Karakambadi, Venkatagiri kota and Tirupathi were in prominence either as capitals of kingdoms or forts in the territories of PALLAVAS, CHOLAS, BALLAL DYNASTY, VIJAYANAGAR KINGS, BAHMANI CHIEFS AND the ZAMINDARS or POLIGARS as kingdoms rose and fell with the marching of times. When the Vijayanagar kingdom was routed as a sequel of war of TALIKOTA and torn apart into fragments, there arose the ZAMINDARS and POLIGARS who ruled over tiny bits of land and one of the nearest relative of the deceased RAJAH removed himself from PENUKONDA (Ananthapur District) to Chandragiri. Here at the court of Chandragiri the East India company was granted a small strip of land on the coast -- the first ever possessed by the British in India. Port. St. George came up on this piece of land and made the beginning of the founding of the mighty British Rule over the vast BHARAT.

Around 1760 Tirupathi had been the scene of several struggles for the possession of income derived from the offerings made at its celebrated shrine. In 1757, the brother of NAWAB OF CARNATIC by name NAZEEBULLAH set his eyes on the sacred temple, but was already stoutly rebuffed by a detachment from MADRAS. Abdul wahab allied himself with the French with fond expectations of TIRUPATHI revenues but was sorely disappointed. Again in 1759, the MAHARATTAS bid to possess the sacred Tirupathi shrine on the hills was initially thwarted. With the assistance of POLIGAR OF KARAKAMBADI there was a second attempt by the MAHARATTAS under Narayana sastry. The POLIGAR was killed and Narayana sastry retreated.

The national movement was spear headed by notable personalities of the District. PANAPAKKAM ANANTHARAYUDU ENTERED politics as secretary of the Madras Native Association in 1880. He founded the Madras Advocates Association in 1889. In 1891 at the NAGPUR he was selected as the president of the Congress. He was the FIRST ANDHRA and SOUTH INDIAN to receive such high honour.

PANUGANTI RAMARAYANAM known as RAJA OF PANAGAL evinced interest in politics even in his student days. In 1912 he was elected to the Imperial legislative council at the age of 26. Five years later he joined the justice party. In the composite MADRAS STATE he served as Minister and later the Chief Minister when the justice party formed the Ministry in 1920. He was knighted in 1926.

MOLLINI MUNASWAMY NAIDU was another man of eminence. He rose from the seat of chairman of the CHITTOOR municipality and the president of the District Board to the post of chief Minister of MADRAS from 1930 to 1934.

KATTAMANCHI RMMALINGA REDDY had his early education in Chittoor and Madras and moved to Cambridge for higher Education. In different capacities like Vice principal of Baroda, Assistant Inspector General of Education, Professor, principal and Inspector General of Education he served in MYSORE. He became the first VICE-CHANCELLOR of Andhra University in 1936 and shaped its destinies till his death in 1951.

Dr. SARVEPALLI RADHAKRISHNAN hailed from Tiruttani which was part of CHITTOOR DISTRICT till 1961. In him we have a world reputed philosopher who by virtue of his wisdom and knowledge acquitted himself creditably as the 1st VICE PRESIDENT and 2nd PRESIDENT OF INDIA. The list of eminent personalities of the District is incomplete without the mention of Late ~~xxx~~ sir M. ANANTHASAYANAM AYYANGAR and late Sri R. B. RAMAKRISHNAM RAJU. The former worked as Deputy speaker and speaker of Lok Sabha and also GOVERNOR OF BIHAR. The latter was the chairman of the MADRAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

MADANAPALLE which is a seat of Theosophical Institutions is proud of its association with world renowned personalities like ANNIE BESANT, JAMES COUSINS and philosopher late JIDDU KRISHNAMOORTHY.

PHYSICAL ASPECTS

The District derives its name from Chittoor, the District Head Quarters town. The District lies between 12°-37" to 14°-08" North Latitude and 78°-03" to 79°-55" East longitude. On its East and South, there is Tamilnadu, on the west Karnataka State and on the Northern boundaries i.e., Nellore, Cuddapah and Anantha Pur Districts of Andhra Pradesh. The District covers an area of 15,152 Sq. kms., and a population of 2,737,316 according to the 1981 census.

HILLS: The District is a sweet blend of hills with uplands and plains to present a picture-scenery, that is unique. The general elevation of the district is 2500ft. The Eastern ghats that enter the south west part of the district run westward, South and North, in set order leaving valley like plains fertile and graceful. The prominent cliff known as Nagari nose is conspicuous for long miles around. The Seshachalam Hills over which the famous pilgrim centre of TIRUPATHI is located and Horsely Hills which has been developed into a hill station stand as unique spots of beauty for the ardent lovers of Nature.

RIVERS: There are not any perennial rivers in the District. Some minor rivers like Swarnamukhi, Kalyani, Kusasthali, Bahuda, Arani, Ponne, Palar, Koundinya, Papagiri and pincha have the flow when it rains in their catchment area and remain dry for most of the year. The irrigation is mostly by wells and tankfed whereas the hill slopes are rainfed. Visitation of famine is not uncommon as in the case of other Rayalaseema Districts.

CLIMATE AND RAINFALL: The annual rainfall according to the statistical supplement part II of Andhra Pradesh Gazette, Hyderabad Dated 15-1-1981 is 82.74 cms spread through three spells (1) between June and September (2) May and (3) Post Monsoon season.

SOILS: The soils of the district are broadly divided into red, black and mixed. On the clay and loamy black soil fields are raised paddy, sugarcane and other irrigated crops. Groundnut is also grown on the mixed soils. Mango is the Chief fruit that is exported from the District.

CHANGES IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE SET UP : Chittoor was once a part of North Arcot District and was constituted as a separate District on 1st April, 1911 with Headquarters at Chittoor. Consequent on the implementation of Pataskar Award Chittoor District lost to Tamilnadu, a major chunk of Tiruttani Taluk, getting in return a few insignificant villages of Chengalpat District giving rise to a new taluk with Head quarters at Satyavedu. In a bid to make the Taluks co-terminous with Assembly constituencies 14 villages of Srikalahasti Taluk were transferred to Nellore District. Subsequent to the advent of Telugu Desam Government in the state in 1983, the 15 Taluks were further bifurcated into 66 Revenue Mandals with avowed promise and pledge to take the Government to the door-step of the common man under the three Revenue divisions of Chittoor, Madanapalle and Tirupathi.

V ALL INDIA EDUCATIONAL SURVEY

In the post independence era and with the ushering in of state planning for development in general and educational development in particular ever increasing emphasis was laid on universalisation of elementary education in order to fulfil the constitutional obligation. As a consequence thereof considerable expansion in schooling facilities has taken place, to some extent, at the cost of relegation of qualitative improvement to a back seat. The All India Educational Surveys, four so far, were conducted with the main objectives of identification of rural habitations and the provision of Educational facilities for them at a different stage. These surveys also attempted to collect information on physical and other facilities available in the schools which might directly or indirectly help the qualitative improvement and provide a basis for educational policy makers, planners and administrators. This is clearly brought out in the National Policy on Education 1986.

"Programme of action" has spelled out the implications of "Operation Black Board" in clear terms and stipulated minimum requirements of a school for an effective working. As a first step it has recommended that All India Educational Survey be conducted thus enabling a complete stock taking of the conditions obtaining in schools as on 30.9.1986. The V All India Educational Survey will provide the starting point for the planners.

The objectives of this survey are to assess the present position of educational facilities at various school stages and to assess the availability of physical facilities like school Buildings, Play grounds, furniture, drinking water etc., and also to assess the position of inputs like Black board, Library, Laboratory, and to know about the academic and professional qualifications of working teachers.

The date of reference of this survey is 30.9.1986. Information regarding each Revenue Village is collected in "Village information form (V.I.F.). Data regarding Urban areas is collected in Urban information form (U.I.F.). Particulars in respect of schools are collected in school information form (S.I.F). The village information form (V.I.F.) seeks information relating to population, schooling and other facilities in the village. The urban information form (U.I.F) seeks information relating to population, schooling and other educational facilities in the Urban area. The School information form (S.I.F) seeks the information in respect of recognised schools, the location, the management, the Media of Instruction, the type of building, the physical facilities, the teachers working with their qualifications and the enrolment in the schools etc.,.

For the conduct of this survey a post of District Survey Officer was sanctioned to each district. District Survey Officers were in position by 1-6-1987 and they were given training from 18.6.1987 to 26.6.1987 in the office of the Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad. In turn the District survey officers have conducted survey training for all the Mandal Educational Officers at the District level from 10.7.1987 to 12.7.1987. The Mandal Educational Officers were requested to administer the similar training at Mandal level for all the Heads of Institutions within their respective jurisdictions and collect the information in the forms prescribed. The Mandal Educational Officers were requested to scrutinise the forms and send them to the District Head Quarters in a phased manner for scrutiny by the District Survey Officer from 19.9.87 to 30.9.87. After scrutiny, by the District Survey Officer, the Mandal Educational Officers were requested to tabulate the survey data in the tables supplied to them at the Mandal level.

The District level tabulation was in ~~xxxxxx~~ progress in the month of January 1988. In the meanwhile the Director of School-Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has taken a decision the consolidation of survey be conducted at state level by computerisation.

The important concepts and definitions are given here under:-

1. HABITATION: "A habitation" is a centre, where people live in compact and contiguous manner. The habitations with population below 25 in plain areas may not be given a separate status of habitation and its population is included in the nearest habitation.

2. VILLAGE: "A Village" is used in the same way as in census., it is a parcel of land, the boundaries of which are defined and settled for revenue purposes.

3. SCHOOL STAGES:

A: Primary stage :- (I to V classes).

B: Upper Primary stage:- (VI and VII classes) (but for (NCERT) survey purposes VI, VII & VIII)

C: Secondary stage:- (VIII ~~xxx~~ to X classes) (but for (NCERT) survey purposes IX and X)

D: Higher Secondary stage :- (XI and XII classes).

4. URBAN AREA: All areas which were identified as "URBAN" at the time of 1981 census.

5. RURAL AREA: Areas which are not urban shall be treated as Rural.

There are 1391 Revenue villages in the district of which 39 are un-inhabited and 1352 are inhabited. Further there are 13 urban areas including 5 Municipal Towns in the District. The Habitations in the District are 7690 and the estimated population of the District as per V All India Educational Survey is 30,78,991 of which the Rural population is 25,63,706 and Urban population is 5,15,285.

The District is divided into 66 Mandals including Tirupathi Urban Mandal which has no Mandal Praja Parishad. There are 3528 primary schools, 261 ~~xxx~~ upper primary schools, 255 secondary schools and 31 (Higher secondary schools) Junior colleges in the District.

CHAPTER-II
PRIMARY EDUCATION

1:1. REVENUE VILLAGES AND HABITATIONS:

There are 1391 Revenue villages in Chittoor District. Of which 1352 are inhabited and 39 are uninhabited. The 1352 Revenue villages contain 7690 habitations. The Ratio between Revenue villages and Habitations is 1:5 which is very high when compared to other districts in the State and also National Level. Where the Ratio is only 1:4, there are number of revenue villages in the District which contain more than 50(fifty) habitations. The biggest Revenue village in the District is vempalle of Madanapalle Mandal having 57 habitations at its credit.

1:2. POPULATION (RURAL AND URBAN):

The total population of the District is 30,78,991, of which the Rural population is 25,63,706 and the Urban population is 5,15,285.

1:3. HABITATIONS: INSTITUTIONS AND SERVED POPULATION:

3544 habitations in the District are having primary schools within them and they serve 18,92,689 population.

3209 Habitations are having primary schools within distance of 1.00 K.M. and they serve the population 5,24,563.

937 habitations with population of 1,46,454 are not served with a primary school within a walking distance of 1.00 K.M.. It is proposed to start 222 new primary schools to serve the population of 88,465.

The population served within the habitation is upto 1.00K.M. after existing and proposed primary school is 25,05,717.

In the following Mandals 90 and above percentage of population is being served with primary schools.

1. Bairreddipalle 2. Buchinaidukandriga 3. Nagalapuram 4. Nindra and Narayanavanam, where as the following Mandals are only less than 50% of the population is served with primary schools in them.

1. Yerravaripalem 2. Chinnagottigallu 3. K.V. Palle 4. Thamballapalle.

1:4. REVENUE VILLAGES ACCORDING TO S.C. AND ST. POPULATIONS:

All the Revenue villages having a scheduled Tribe population upto 25% are served with primary schools and only 913 villages with the same percentage of S.C. Populations are served with primary schools.

1:5. INSTITUTIONS IN RURAL AND URBAN AREA:

The management-wise distribution of primary schools in Rural areas is as follows:

1. Government:34, 2. Local Bodies:3303, 3. Private Aided:29, 4. Private Un-aided:01 = Total:3367.

In urban areas the primary schools are distributed according to management-wise as furnished hereunder:

1. Government:01, 2. Local Bodies:129, 3. Private Aided:10, 4. Private Un-aided:21 = Total:161.

1:6. PRIMARY SCHOOLS ACCORDING TO TYPE OF BUILDINGS:

In Rural areas there are 3367 primary schools. Of which 2022 are housed in pucca buildings, 495 in partly pucca, 333 in Kucha, 336 in thatched huts and 161 in open spaces.

In Urban areas out of 161 primary schools, 110 are housed in pucca buildings and 42 are in partly pucca. This shows that Urban area schools are comparatively having better accommodation.

CHAPTER-III
UPPER PRIMARY EDUCATION

3:1. INSTITUTIONS.

543 Habitations in the District are having Upper primary schools within them and they serve 5,55,668 population.

5519 Habitations are having Upper Primary schools within walkable distance of 3.00 K.ms. and they serve the population of 20,04,550.

2171 Habitations with the population of 5,59,156 are not served with an Upper primary schools within a walking distance of 3.00 K.ms.

It is proposed to start 135 New upper primary schools to serve the population of 3,09,579.

The population to be served upto a distance of 3.00 K.m. after the proposed upper primary schools are opened is 23,14,129 (including existing).

3:2. REVENUE VILLAGES ACCORDING TO S.C. AND S.T. POPULATION:

The villages in the population of scheduled castes and scheduled Tribes upto 25% are served with upper primary sections are 188 and 194 respectively (for S.Cs and S.Ts).

3:3. INSTITUTIONS IN RURAL AND URBAN AREA:

Number of Upper Primary schools existing in Rural areas along with their management-wise distribution is as follows:

1.Government..Nil, 2.Local Bodies..220, 3.Private aided..01, 4.Private Un-aided..Nil. = Total:221.

In Urban areas, the Upper primary schools are distributed according to Management-wise as follows:-

1.Government..01, 2.Local Bodies..28, 3.Private aided..06 4.Private Unaided..05. = Total:40.

3:4. UPPER PRIMARY SCHOOLS ACCORDING TO TYPE OF BUILDINGS.

In Rural areas, there are 221 Upper primary schools. Of which 164 are having pucca Buildings, 41 semi-pucca, 11 Acha-Buildings, 03 Thatched huts and 02 are working in open space.

In Urban areas, out of 40 schools, 30 are having pucca buildings, 08 semi-pucca 02 schools are functioning in thatched-huts. This shows that urban area schools are comparatively having better accommodation.

3:5. LIBRARY FACILITIES.

Out of 261 Upper Primary schools, 174 are having small Libraries and in those libraries 94 have only below 100 books in each.

3:6. ANCILLIARY FACILITIES:

Out of 261 Upper primary schools, 120 are having Drinking water facilities, 15 have urinals and no separate Urinals and Lavatories are available for Girls. The Urban schools are having better ancilliary facilities.

3:7. TEACHERS:

RURAL: There are 1103 Teachers working in U.P. Schools, of which 799 are Male and 304 are Female. All are trained.

URBAN: There are 418 Teachers, of which 172 are Male and 246 are Female Teachers. All are Trained.

In Rural areas, Male Teachers are more whereas in Urban areas Female Teachers are more.

27 Habitations in the District are having Higher secondary stage facilities within them and they serve 1,30,993 population.
6,246 Habitations with a population of 16,78,605 are served by Higher Secondary stage facilities within a distance of 8 Kms. and 1444 Habitations with a population of 8,85,101 are served by the facilities existing at a distance of beyond 8 Kms.

URBAN: There are 842 Teachers working in Secondary schools. Of which 126 are post Graduates, 339 are Graduates, 63 are Higher Secondary, 135 are Matriculate, 124 are Language Pandits and 55 are others.

4:7. HIGHER SECONDARY:

RURAL: 388 teachers are working in Higher Secondary schools. Of which post-graduates are 183, Graduates are 91, Higher Secondary 18, Matriculate 56 and others are 19.

URBAN: 331 teachers are working in Higher secondary schools. Of which post-graduates are 94, Graduates are 91, Higher Secondary are 34 and Matriculates are 39 and others are 36.

4:8. SCIENCE LABORATORIES (SECONDARY SCHOOLS)

RURAL: out of 215, 145 are having Laboratories. URBAN: out of 40, 32 are having science laboratories. There is improvement in science laboratories in Urban area, particularly in Government institutions.

4:9. HIGHER SECONDARY:

RURAL: 20 Higher secondary schools in Rural Area. URBAN: 11 Higher secondary schools in urban area. All are having laboratories. All are having Laboratories.

4:10. TEACHERS (SECONDARY STAGE)

1239 teachers are teaching science in secondary schools. Out of which 116 are post-graduates, 660 are Graduates, 299 are Inter science and 164 are Matriculation.

(HIGHER SECONDARY STAGE)

109 teachers are teaching science in Higher secondary schools. Out of which 02 are Phd and 107 are Post-Graduates.

All the 31 Higher Secondary schools are having science, Arts and commerce Groups.

CHAPTER-V

OTHER EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES

5:1. NON FORMAL EDUCATION:

In the District there are 486 Non-Formal Education centres in Rural areas. Of which 441 are run by the Government, 43 by private Agencies receiving Aid from the Government and 02 are run by the private agencies without Aid. In the Urban area, there are 40 centres of which 19 are managed by the State Government and 21 by private agencies. These centres belong to Primary stage. Under Middle stage, there are No centres in Rural area.

ENROLMENT IN NON-FORMAL EDUCATION:

There are 32,211 children in primary stage in Rural areas. Of which 12,485 are Boys and 9,276 are Girls. In Urban area, there are 3,226 children. Of which 1798 are Boys and 1428 are Girls.

5:2. ADULT EDUCATION:

There are 461 Adult literacy centres in the District in Rural areas. Of which 167 are for Men and 147 for women and 147 for Both.

In Urban area, there are only 15 centres. Of which 3 are meant for men and 11 are for women and 01 for Both. In the above centres, 16,805 people are studying. Of them 8,659 are men and 8,146 are women.

5:3. EDUCATION FOR THE DISABLED:

There is only one school in the District, which is meant for Orthopaedically Handi-capped children. It is run by the Tirumala Tirupathi Devasthanams by name SRI VENKATESWARA SCHOOL FOR DEAF, TIRUPATHI.

5:4. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION:

In the District, 348 centres are having preprimary education facilities in Rural areas and 178 centres in Urban areas. There are 82 Independent pre-primary schools and 35 pre primary classes attached schools in the District. There are 409 Balwadi/Anganwadi centres in the District.


