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Foreword

The Third All-India Educational Survey was started at the beginning of 1974 with specific objectives to provide data on school education about availability of schooling facilities (particularly in the rural areas), enrolment, teachers, equipment, etc. The Second All-India Educational Survey was conducted in 1965, but compared to that the scope of the present survey was much larger in respect of items on which information was collected and the types and levels of education covered.

The survey has been conducted in collaboration with the Departments of Education in the States and the Union Territories. Because of the large scope and coverage of the present survey, two different strategies were adopted for processing and tabulation of data. While for some data it was decided to have manual tabulation first at the block level and further at the district and State levels, for the other set of data it was found more convenient to go in for computer processing.

All States have finalised the manually prepared State tables. The computerised tables are likely to take some more time. As there is demand from several quarters to provide data on selected important items as early as possible, it has been decided to compile and release some selected tables for each state separately out of the manually prepared tables received from the different States.

Keeping in view this specific objectives, the present set of "Selected Tables of Bihar" is being issued

to provide minimum essential data for the benefit of educational planners, administrators and other interested persons. The set includes ten tables, three relating to institutions by stage and type, four relating to availability of schooling facilities in rural areas and three relating to enrolment. The reference date for data contained in these tables is December 3, 1973.

Compilation of these tables has been possible largely due to the co-operation of the Department of Education of Bihar. I express my gratitude to the Director of Education and the State Survey Officer, who had the main responsibility for preparing the annual State tables, and to Shri S.M. Bhargava, Lecturer in our Unit, who compiled this set of selected tables in its present form out of the tables received from Bihar.

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Introduction

The State of Bihar is comprised of 31 districts having 67566 villages in 587 blocks and 193 urban areas. The number of habitations in rural areas as identified on 31.12.73 is 104326. As per 1971 Census the population in rural areas was 50719403 including 7436573(14.66%) scheduled castes and 4725693 (9.31%) scheduled tribes. In 1971 the urban population was 5533966 including 514079(9.12%) scheduled castes and 207074 (3.67%) scheduled tribes.

Amongst the rural habitations 3897 habitations are inhabited predominantly by scheduled castes. The estimated population in the rural areas as on 31.12.73 is 54074590 which includes 551 inhabitants who lived in 107 isolated houses.

1. 2 The Educational pattern of the State is
Primary Stage - Classes I-V
Middle Stage - Classes VI-VII

Secondary Stage - Classes VIII-XI

There are few Higher Secondary Schools. Their number being very small and insignificant /have been tabulated with the Secondary Schools/Sections.

1. 3 Schools (Tables 1,2,3)

There are 63308 educational institutions in the State of which 58521 (92.43%) are located in the rural areas.

There are 58669 primary sections in the State, of which 54798(93.40%) are in the rural areas. The number of middle sections is 9952, of which 8350(83.90%) are located in the rural areas. Out of the 2872 secondary sections 2218(77.22%) are in the rural areas. There are 21 Higher Secondary Sections/Junior Colleges etc, out of which 10(47.61%) are located in the rural areas.

1. 4 Educational facilities (Tables 4,5,6,7)

1. 4. 1 Primary Stage

48784 (46.76%) habitations have got the facility in the 'Habitation itself' and 38754 (37.11%) habitations have got the facility at a distance of 1km. Thus, in all, 87538 (83.90%) habitations have got the facility upto a distance of 1 km. In terms of population 76.40% of the rural population has got the facility in their own habitation and an other 17.48%

up to a distance of 1 km. Thus 93.88% of the total population is served by a primary section upto a distance of 1km.

1.4.2 Middle Stage

8215 (7.87%) habitations have got the facility in the habitation itself and another 67146 (64.36%) have got the facility upto a distance of 3 km. Thus, in all, 75361 (72.23%) habitations have got the facility upto a distance of 3 km. In terms of population, 22.06% of the rural population has the facility in their own habitation and another 61.03% upto a distance of 3 km. Thus, in all, 83.09% of the total rural population is being served by a middle section upto a distance of 3 km.

1.4.3 Secondary Stage

2172 (2.08%) habitations have got the facility in their own habitation and another 63821 (61.17%) have got the facility at a distance of 5 km. Thus, 65993 (63.25%) habitations have the facility upto a distance upto a distance of 5 km. In terms of population 7.86% of the rural population has got the facility in their own habitation and another 68.58% upto a distance of 5 km. Thus, 76.44% of the rural population is being served by a secondary section upto a distance of 5 km.

1.4.4 Higher Secondary/Junior College

45 (0.04%) habitations have got the facility in their own habitation and only 0.27% of the total rural population is being served by a Higher Secondary/Junior College in their own habitation.

1.5 Enrolment (Tables 8,9, 10)

The total enrolment in classes I to XI as on 31.12.73 is 5801831, of which 1406683 (24.25%) are girls. The number of pupils studying in schools in the rural areas is 4871762 (83.96%).

The number of students in the primary classes is 4353179, of which 1172898 (26.94%) are girl students. The number of students in the primary classes in the schools in the rural areas is 3824869 (87.86%).

The number of students in the middle stage classes is 735409 including 132650 (18.04%) girls students. The number of students in the middle stage classes in schools in rural areas is 567211 (77.12%).

The number of students in the secondary classes 713243 including
101135 (14.18%) girl students. The number of students in the secondary
classes in the schools in the rural areas is 479682 (67.25%).
