DRAFT ANNUAL PLAN 1979-80 - TECH. EDUCATION ASSAM.
GENERAL AREA

The Fifth Plan ended in the year 1977-78 by curtailing one year from the original plan period and the Sixth Plan has been stepped in the year 1978-79. The emphasis has been given to consolidate the continuing schemes and expansion of Technical Education by introducing some new schemes to cater the requirement of Technical manpower in the country in general and North-Eastern Region in particular. To achieve this end in view it has been proposed to strengthen the existing institutions /by providing more physical facilities like Institutional Buildings, Workshops, Laboratories, Staff Quarters, students Hostels, Equipments and other facilities. It has also been included the diversification of Diploma Courses in the Textile Technology, Agricultural Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Architectural Assistantship etc., besides some other new courses like Fisheries Technology, short term management course, introduction of Timber Technology, introduction of Commercial Practice included in the Sixth Plan as well as for the annual-Plan 1978-79.

Apart from physical facilities, proposed in the Plan, the stress has also been laid for qualitative improvement under different quality improvement programmes. The provisions have also been made for awarding scholarships to the students under specialised subjects. The provision has also been made for the programme "Do-it-Yourself" by the students. Proposed outlay for 1979-80 is Rs. 150.00 Lakhs of which Rs. 103.53 Lakhs for constructional works, Rs. 13.16 Lakhs for Tools & equipments and the rest Rs. 35.31 Lakhs for recurring and other contingency expenditure.

REVIEW OF THE ANNUAL PLAN 1978-79

In the annual Plan 1978-79 the emphasis has been given mainly to increase the tempo of progress of the schemes which are in continuing from the previous plan programme. The schemes included construction of essential buildings of the institutions as well as for workshop and Laboratories, procurement ~~markxh~~ of equipments and construction of staff quarters and other students aminities with a view to improve the facilities of the institutions. The diversification of the diploma courses in Textile Technology, Agricultural Engineering Automobile Engineering and A rchitectural Assistantship were included. The other facilities like award of scholarship for study of specialised courses, improvement of Library facilities, organisation of "DO-IT-YOURSELF" exhibition and training of teachers under Quality Improvement Programme were inculded.

The total approved outlay for 1978-79 is of the order of rs. 92.00 Lakhs, out of which rs. 36.66 Lakhs ~~xx~~ has been earmarked for constructional work, rs. 17.00 Lakhs for procurement of equipments and rs. 38.34 Lakhs to meet the recurring and other contingency expenditures for different schemes. So far about 40 P.C. of the sanctioned outlay for the year 1978-79 has been spent. It is expected that the remaining portion of the allocation can be utilised within the financial year.

(1) Engineering College ~~3~~ There are two Engg. Colleges in the state functioning at present. Both the colleges facing difficulties due to inadequacy of building facilities particularly the hostel buildings. Moreover during the

current academic session of 1978-79 sixty additional seats (M.E. 30 and E.E. 30) have been provided at Jorhat Engg. College Jorhat. The provisions have however been made in the annual plan to cope with the situation.

A third College namely Regional Engg. College has been established during the academic session, 1977-78 at Silchar under centrally sponsored scheme. The State Govt. has to bear some expenditure on it. The pattern of assistance to be borne by the State is 50% of recurring expenditure and 40 percent for development of land construction of internal road, water supply and providing fencing around the College campus. A provision of Rs. 31.67 Lakhs has been made in the annual plan.

(2) Polytechnics - At present there are seven polytechnics including one for Girls in the state. All of these polytechnics facing difficulties for shortage of physical facilities like building and equipment. Provisions have however been made in the proposed annual plan for providing necessary physical facilities as far as practicable. Recently M.E. & E.E. courses of 30 intake each have been introduced in Dibrugarh Polytechnic to meet the increased demand. These two courses were sanctioned along with the original sanctioned scheme but kept in abeyance for shortage of physical facilities and steep fall in employment facilities.

Besides some diversification of diploma courses in the existing polytechnic have also been taken up. A four-year sandwich-Cum-Semester pattern Diploma course in Textile Technology have been introduced in Assam Textile Institute, Gauhati and a 3 yrs Diploma course in Agri. Engg. at Dibrugarh Polytechnic which has however been temporarily shifted to Prince of Wales Institute, Jorhat. A post Diploma Course in Automobile Engg. at P.O.W.I., Jorhat have also been introduced.

Further a 3 yr. Diploma course in Architectural Assistantship has been sanctioned recently at Girl's Polytechnic, Gauhati in replacement of the Old Diploma course in Civil Draftmanship. Moreover a number of new Diploma Courses like Fisheries Tech., Timber Tech., Shortterm management course, commercial practice course have been proposed in the both sixth plan and annual plan for 1979-80. It has also been proposed to establish three new polytechnics in the North Bank of Brahmaputra. For all these necessary provision for physical and financial facilities have been made.

(3) Junior Tech. Schools - There are two Junior Technical schools under general plan exists in Assam, one at Golaghat the other at Sibsagar. The physical facilities like institutional and workshop ~~work~~ buildings etc. are still lacking at Junior Technical School Sibsagar. The land for this school has recently been acquired. Necessary action for construction of building is being taken up shortly for which provision has been mad in the plan. A third Junior Technical School is being started at Goalpara from the next academic session in its own building constructed earlier. Provision for Physical and financial facilities for the same has been made in the plan.

(4) State Directorate of Tech. Education :-

The Directorate of Technical Education needs to be strengthened for conducting diploma examinations, to look after the students after passing out and taking up to other development activities. For these purpose an examination cell has been recently created and provision has been made for (1) formation of training -cum-placement and manpower cell (2) Curriculum development and research problem, (3) Co-ordination and strengthening of existing evaluation (4) Adoption of polytechnic by industry and (5) construction

(5) Quality Improvement Programme:

A provision has also been made to train up teachers under different Quality Programme like Q.I.P., T.T.T.I. and C.T.I. provision has also been made for "DO-IT-YOURSELF" Exhibition Programme.

(6) Students Amenities.

Provision has been made for providing amenities to the students like facility for games and sports, development of play ground, expansion of Book Bank, establishment of supply centres for the benefit of the students.

(7) Staff Quarter.

A provision has been made for construction of staff quarters as are required to be provided to the staff of the institutes for deriving full utilisation of their services.

(8) Introduction of Post-Graduate Course.

The Post-Graduate Course in water-shed management including flood control has been introduced in Assam Engg. College, Gauhati. Necessary provision has been made for maintenance of the scheme. A similar course in M.E. has also been proposed at Jorhat Engg. College, Jorhat under the centrally sponsored scheme.
