SEVENTH FIVE YEAR PLAN OF TECHNICAL EDUCATION
TRIBAL SUB-PLAN (1985-90) & TRIBAL SUB-PLAN 1985-86:-

INTRODUCTION :

In the Sixth Five Year Plan of Technical Education there was a provision of Rs.6.15 crores now raised to Rs.13.02 crores. The Tribal Plan component out of this worked out to Rs.75 lakhs. As against this, a sum of Rs. 99.34 lakhs has already been spent upto 1984. There is a provision of Rs.1.15 crores (besides a sum of Rs.52 lakhs earmarked from the Additive Assistance) for the sub-plan of the current year. By the end of the Sixth Plan, a total sum of Rs.226.34 lakhs would have been available for the Tribal Sub-Plan of Technical Education.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PRESENT POSITION :-

2. The major achievements of the Tribal Sub-Plan, so far, are detailed hereunder :-
- (i) Out of the 2 new Engineering Colleges, one new Engineering College has been started in Jagdalpur. Similarly, out of the 4 new Polytechnics, 2 new Polytechnics have been started, one each at Jhabua and Ambikapur ;
 - (ii) To make Technical Education easily accessible to the Tribal boys, free supply of calculators, drawing equipment and stationery is made available to all tribal students studying in engineering colleges and polytechnics. The estimated cost of this facility works out to Rs.750/-per student.
 - (iii) With a view to facilitate the study and training of the tribal boys. Separate book banks have been started in all the Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics. The annual cost of this programme works out to Rs. 5.00 lakhs ;
 - (iv) To make up for the deficiency in the standard of attainment of the Tribal boys and also in view of the fact that they come from families having no educational back-ground/environment, special coaching classes have been started for them in all the engineering colleges and

Polytechnics of the State. Annual expenditure of this programme works out to Rs.15 lakhs;

- v) A special programme has been started to take care of the various problems which a tribal boy is likely to face in the course of his study programme. This scheme is called Teacher-Guardian Scheme which has been introduced in Engineering Colleges. One Teacher-Guardian is appointed for a group of 10 students. The teacher-guardian is paid remuneration.

3. Besides these special programme, provision has also been made and expenditure incurred on the accelerated development of Technical Institutions situated in the Tribal Sub-Plan areas/areas having sizeable population of tribals. Such institutions are: (i) Engineering College, Bilaspur; (ii) Polytechnics at Shahdol, Khirsadoh (Distt. Chhindwara), Raigarh and Dhamtari (Distt. Raipur); (iii) Government Higher Secondary Technical Schools at Dhar, Raigarh, Chhindwara and Shahdol.

4. In the foregoing paragraphs, the present position of the Tribal-Sub-Plan has been explained. This will determine the priorities and size of the Tribal Plan during the Seventh Five Year Plan.

PROPOSALS FOR SEVENTH PLAN:

5. The draft proposals of the various programmes of the Seventh Five Year Plan of Technical Education amount to Rs.22.33 crores. This provision is inclusive of the spill-over/consolidation programmes of the previous Five Year Plans. Schemewise distribution of the Tribal Sub-Plan is given hereunder:

TRIBAL SUB-PLAN VIS-A-VIS
STATE PLAN:

This roughly works out to 23 % of the State Plan outlay. In the Sixth Plan, this percentage was approximately 19 %. Out of the total provision of Rs. 5.10 crores proposed for the Sub-Plan, nearly 72.5% accounts for the Spill-Over programme which is made up mostly of the incomplete schemes of new engineering colleges and Polytechnics. As for the Quality Improvement Programme,

its percentage to the total Sub-Plan outlay works out to 19 %. For the expansion programme, the percentage to the total outlay roughly works out to 8 %.

PROGRAMME DETAILS:

6. This programme takes into account the development of existing engineering colleges (Bilaspur and Jagdalpu Polytechnics (Raigarh, Shahdol, Khirsadoh, Dhamtari, Jhabu Ambikapur) and Higher Secondary Technical Schools (Dhar, Shahdol, Raigarh, Chhindwara). Besides these old institutions, it is proposed that 2 out of the new Polytechnic to be opened during Seventh Five Year Plan should be started in Tribal Sub-Plan areas. It is further proposed to open new courses in emerging technologies in some of the Polytechnics and engineering colleges situated in the Tribal Sub-Plan areas. The selection of courses will depend on the needs/environment of the areas concerned.

7. There is need to popularise the use of computers in the institutions situated in Tribal areas also so that the Tribal students have proper benefit of the modern techniques. It is proposed that facility of computer may be extended to selected institutions of the Tribal Sub-Plan area. The break-up of proposed provision between recurring and non-recurring heads is given in the table in Para-5.

8. The programmes listed in para-2 (Free supply of stationery and drawing material, book banks, special coaching and teacher guardian programme) are of a continuing nature. They will, however, be provided in the plan budget of technical education from the year 1985-86 onwards, as per norms prescribed by the State Government.

SEVENTH FIVE YEAR PLAN 1985-90 AND ANNUAL SPECIAL COMPONENT PLAN 1985-86 IN RESPECT OF TECHNICAL EDUCATION :

During the Sixth Plan there was a provision of Rs. 16.39 lakhs for the Special Component Plan of Technical Education. The Special Component Plan provides for the following schemes/programmes :-

- (i) Free supply of calculator, drawing equipment and stationary at a cost of Rs.750/- per student ;
- (ii) Book Banks ;
- (iii) Teacher-Guardian Scheme ;
- (iv) Special Coaching Programme.

These four programmes are almost common between the student belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

As against the provision of Rs. 16.39 lakhs, a sum of Rs. 25.91 lakhs has already been spent whereas a provision of Rs. 12.00 lakhs is proposed for the current financial year, making a total provision of Rs. 37.91 lakhs.

All the above schemes provide direct benefit to the Harijan Boys. It is proposed that these schemes should be continued during the VII Plan.

It is proposed that a sum of Rs. 22.33 lakhs, instead of Rs. 100 lakhs ^{proposed earlier} should be provided for the Harijan Plan of Technical Education (1985-90) as per revised allocations.
