\* The overall percent increase in enrolment shows an increased of 7.18%. This in case of girls is higher then that of boys with 9.88% & 4.98% respectively. This shows a positive trend in case of increase in girls enrolment and reducing the gender disparity.

\* When details of blockwise figures are seen, six out of ten block show that percent increase in enrolment of girls is more then that of boys. These blocks are Amla, Athner, Betul, Bhimpur, Chicholi & Ghoradongri.

\* In all the blocks, Bhimpur is ahead in recording higher enrolment, the percent increase in girls being more then that of boys.

\* Amla, Prabhatpattan & Betul blocks need to be given special focus on overall enrolment with concentrated efforts on boys in Amla & Betul on girls in Prabhatpattan, which has shown decline in the enrolment figures.

\*In Amla block, last year the percentage of result of boys in comparison to girls was very good hence a good number of of boys passed out after passing V class, while that of girls was good in Prabhat pattan block thus affecting overall enrolment.

\* The SC enrolment in Betul indicates a fall in enrolment since 95-96 which is reflected more in case of SC Boys. However the enrolment of SC girls though marginally increased shows a positive trend.

\* The increase in enrolment is higher in girls in fifty percent of blocks.

\* The focus areas of enrolment of SC children are Bhainsdehi & Ghoradongari block. Multai Block also needs to focus on SC girls enrolment which also happens to have gender disparity by 44.72 points.

\* In Athner block percentage of ST enrolment 11%. They usually go in search of work to Maharashtra province hence the percentage falls.

\* In Ghoradongari Block ST's usually migrate to Hohangabad district hence the percentage falls.

\* In rest of the block there is increase in the percentage of enrolment.

## **Action Points :**

- \* The enrolment of SC children needs to be addressed with specific efforts.
- \* The gender disparities needs to decrease. For this ongoing efforts for girls education needs to be specifically targetted towards enrolment.

\* In Raisen district, the overall enrolment has shown an increasing trend, the %increase being 22.54 for boys & 25.56 for girls. There is not much gender differential in enrolment increase. This clearly indicates that girls enrolment has shown considerable increase.

\* In Badi, Gairatganj, Obedullahganj, Sanchi & Udaipur % increase in enrolment is more in girls as compared to boys.

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\* Sanchi & Badi block shows higher enrolment the increase being 50.48 & 59.94 percent respectively.

\* Udaipur block needs to be given special attention for enrolment as the boys enrolment has shown decline by 1.53%.

\* Udaipura shows marginal increase in SC girls enrolment.

\* In Gairatganj, Silwani and Udaipura block where increase in enrolment is more then girls, the disparity ranges between 3 to 7 points of percent increase in enrolments.

\* The enrolment increase in Obaedullahganj block is not very encouraging & special focus needs to be given to enrolment of SC boys, which has shown a decline in enrolment figures.

\* In Shahdol district, the overall enrolment has shown an increase by 9.32%, which is more in case of boys (10.07%) as compared to girls (8.37).

\* In Beohari block. the difference between enrolment of boys & girls is the highest. In case of boys % increase in enrolment is 23.29. whereas in girls it has gone down by 2.41%.

\* In Burhar, Gohparu, Jaisinghnagar, Jaithari, Manpur & Pushparajgarh, the % increase in enrolment of girls is more then the boys.

\* Gender disparity in enrolments is high in Beohari, Karkeli & Kotma block where as moderate in Annuppur, Pali and Sohagpur block.

\* In Beohari & Sohagpur block, the enrolment of girls has gone down.

\* Pushparajgarh block shows a phenomenal increase in enrolment. The girls enrolment leads the way with 30.61% increase

- \* District need to make efforts to make electricity available to the schools.

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

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
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### DISTRICT PRIMARY EDUCATION PROGRAMME, M.P. EXPENDITURE DETAILS as on 30.06.97





RECURRING & NON-RECURRING DETAILS EXPENDITURE against BUDGET RECEIVED as on 30.06.97




DPEP, M.P. as on (30.06.97) DETAILS OF PFE BUDGET RECEIVED v/s EXPENDITURE

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#### DISTRICT PRIMARY EDUCATION PROGRAMME, MADHYA PRADESH 4 CATEGORIES OF EXPENDITURE



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
