This volume on District Educational Statistics for the State of Gujarat is the 16th in the series of such volumes which are to be brought out for all the States and Union Territories of India. The main aim is to highlight the inter-district variations in a State by giving educational data at district level with the help of some important indices such as Enrolment Ratio, Percentage of Trained Teachers, per Capita Expenditure, Teacher-Pupil Ratio, etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have increased or decreased with time, the data for the year 1976-77 has been analysed and compared with that for the year 1970-71. Minor adjustments in district-wise data have been made wherever comparable data was not available.

I take this opportunity to express my appreciation of the co-operation received from the Directorate of Education, Gujarat and the project staff of the Planning, Monitoring & Statistics Division of the Ministry who have prepared this report.

I N T R O D U C T I O N

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of educational development just as in Urbanisation, Industrialisation, Distribution of Income and Wealth etc. With a view to high light the Regional imbalances in the educational ssector, the Ministry of Education & Culture brings out the publication "Educational Statistics - District-wise" quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. There after it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each State every five years by the Ministry of Education & Culture. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry.

3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as Enrolment Ratios, Percentage of Trained Teachers and Per Capita Expenditure on Education have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the Districts and hence the need for formulating educational plans at the District level.

II - AREA AND POPULATION

4. The area of Gujarat State was 1,95,984 Sq.Kms. and was comprised of 19 Districts. There was no change in Area, Number of District etc. in Gujarat State during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. However by 1976-77 the names of certain Districts listed below were changed/revised as under:-

The District-wise area in Gujarat varies from as large as 45,612 Sq. Kms. 23.37% in case of Kutch District to as small as 649 Sq. Kms. 0.33% in the case of Gandhinagar District.

5. The population of Gujarat was 266.39 Lakhs (137.72 Lakhs Males and 128.67 Lakhs Females) in 1971. By 1977 it is estimated to have increased to 304.15 Lakhs (157.23 Lakhs Males and 146.92 Lakhs Females). In 1971 the highest population was in Ahmedabad District 29.04 Lakhs (15.56 Lakhs Males and 13.48 Lakhs Females) and lowest in Dang District 0.74 Lakhs (0.48 Lakhs Males and 0.46 Lakh Females). In 1977 also the estimated population varied widely among these Districts from 33.16 Lakhs (17.77 Lakhs Males and 15.39 Lakhs Females) in case of Ahmedabad to 1.07 Lakhs (0.55 Lakhs Males and 0.52 Lakhs Females) in case of Dang District.

6. The over-all density of population per Sq. Km. in 1971 was 136 which is estimated to have increased to 155 by 1977. The density of population in 1977 varied widely among Districts viz. from 388 the highest in Kaira District to only 21 the lowest in Kutch District. The area, total population and density of population for different District for the years 1971 & 1977 are given in Statement No.(2). Table No.(1) below gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and the density of population 1977.

7. The Total Population of the State as well as Population of different Age-Groups for the year 1971 & 1977 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 11st March of the year) available from the office of the Registrar General of India - District-wise. Population in the Age-Groups 6-11, 11-14 & 14-17 are based on the following formula:-

We assume that

$$\frac{P_{6-11}}{P} = \frac{P_1}{P_1} = K$$

$$\therefore \frac{p_i}{6-11} = K p_i$$

Where K is estimated from the equation

$$K = \frac{P_{6-11}}{P}$$

P_{6-11} = Denotes 6-11 Age-Group Population of the State

P = Total Population of the State

p_i = Total 6-11 Age-Group Population of the ith District.

p_i = Total Population of the ith District.

To get the sex-wise break-up of Total Population in the various Age-Groups of the District first of all Girls Population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in the above formula Total Population is replaced by the Girls Population. The Boys Population is obtained by the residual method i.e.

Boys Population in the Age-Group 6-11 = Total Population in the Age-Group 6-11 - Girls Population in Age-Group 6-11.

Similarly Population in the Age-Groups 11-14 & 14-17 are estimated District-wise.

8. The Total Population of Children in the Age-Group 6-11 was 37.99 Lakhs (19.56 Lakhs Boys and 18.43 Lakhs Girls) in 1971 which is estimated to have increased to 39.64 Lakhs (20.39 Lakhs Boys and 19.25 Lakhs Girls) by 1977. In 1977, 6-11 Age-Group Population formed 13.03% of the Total Population.

9. The Total Population of Children in the Age-Groups 11-14 was 19.98 Lakhs (10.49 Lakhs Boys and 9.49 Lakhs Girls) in 1971 which is estimated to have increased to 23.14 (11.89 Lakhs Boys and 11.25 Lakhs Girls) by 1977. The Percentage of Population in the Age-Group 11-14 to Total Population in 1977 was 7.61%.

10. Similarly the Population in the Age-Group 14-17 in 1971 was 17.74 Lakhs (9.39 Lakhs Boys and 8.35 Lakhs Girls) which is estimated to have increased to 21.58 Lakhs (11.19 Lakhs Boys and 10.39 Lakhs Girls) by 1977. Population in the Age-Group 14-17 formed 7.10% of the Total Population in 1977.

11. Out of the Total Population of 304.15 Lakhs in 1977 of the State, the School going population in the Age-Group 6-17 years was 84.37 Lakhs consisting of 43.48 Lakhs Boys and 40.89 Lakhs Girls. The Population in the Age-Group 6-17 years constituted 27.74% of the Total Population. The Percentage for Boys was 27.65, while for Girls it was 27.83.

III - LITERACY

12. According to the 1971 Census the effective Literacy rate i.e. the number of literates per hundred of the Population (excluding 0-4 Age-Group) in Gujarat was 41.84. The Literacy Rates for Males & Females separately were 53.78 and 29.0 respectively indicating a wide gap between the two sexes. The highest literacy was in Ahmedabad (56.66) and lowest in Dang 16.89. Details are given in Statement No.(7).

IV - GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS

13. The Total number of Educational Institutions in Gujarat was 26,220 in 1970-71 which increased to 27,794 by 1976-77 showing an increase of 6.00% during the period of 6 years. Ahmedabad District had the largest share of Institutions 9.5% whereas Gandhinagar had the lowest 0.7% in 1976-77. The District-wise position of Institution is given in Statement No.(1).

(b) ENROLMENT

14. The Total Enrolment in all recognised educational Institutions in the State increased from 44.97 Lakhs in 1970-71 to 55.79 Lakhs in 1976-77. The increase in Enrolment was observed in all the Districts during this period. The Enrolment increased with an average annual growth rate of 4.00%. Ahmedabad had the largest share in Enrolment i.e. 13.5% whereas Dang had the lowest share of Enrolment i.e. only 0.5% in 1976-77.

15. The Percentage of Girls' Enrolment to Total Enrolment was 36.1 in 1970-71 which increased to 37.5 by 1976-77. Among the Districts Surat had the maximum Percentage of Girls Enrolment to Total Enrolment 43.8 whereas Banaskantha had the minimum 26.0 in 1976-77.

16. The Total Enrolment in all recognised educational Institutions as a Percentage of Total Population increased from 16.9 in 1970-71 to 18.3 by 1976-77 at the State level. The increase in Percentage during the period of 6 years was observed in almost all the Districts. In 1976-77 the Percentage was highest in Dangs 23.2% and lowest in Banaskantha 11.9%.

(c) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

17. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes or the Co-efficient of equality is defined as

$$I = \frac{\text{Percentage of Enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to Total Enrolment}}{\text{Percentage of Population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to Total Population}} \times 100$$

In Gujarat in 1976-77 the Percentage of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students to Total number of students was 8.6% (9.2% for Boys and 7.5% for Girls) and 9.7% (10.2% for Boys and 8.8% for Girls) respectively. The Percentage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes' population to Total Population is estimated to be 6.8% and 14.0% respectively. Therefore the extent of coverage or co-efficient of equality in the case of Gujarat works out to be 126.5% & 69.3% respectively. Details may be seen in Statements No. (8 & 9).

(a) TEACHERS

18. The Total number of Teachers in the State in all Educational Institutions increased from 1,34,486 in 1970-71 to 1,59,082 in 1976-77, showing an average Annual Rate of increase of 3.05% during this period. Increase in number of Teachers was observed in all District. In 1976-77 Ahmedabad had the largest share of Teachers 13.9 whereas Dangs has the smallest i.e. 0.4% only.

In 1976-77 total number of Teachers upto School level were 1,46,155 (96,953 Males and 49,202 Females) out of which 1,39,632 (93,896 Males and 45,736 Females) were Trained Teachers, whereas the rest of the Teachers were Un-Trained. The Percentage of Trained Teachers to the number of Male, Female and Total number of Teachers in School Education was 96.8%, 93.0% and 95.5% respectively. As many as 13 Districts had more Percentage of Trained Teachers than the State's Percentage.

(c) EXPENDITURE

19. The Total Expenditure (excluding Expenditure on Directorate & Inspectorate) of all recognised Educational Institutions in the State, was Rs.57.79 Crores in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.151.06 Crores by 1976-77 showing an average Annual Increase of 26.91% during the period of 6 years. Ahmedabad's share was the maximum of the Total Expenditure i.e. 19.4% whereas Dang's share was the minimum i.e. only 0.5%.

20. The Expenditure on Education per-head of Population in the State increased from Rs.21.7 in 1970-71 to Rs.49.3 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 Per Capita Expenditure was more than the States Per Capita Expenditure in as many as 6 District. It was maximum in Gandhinagar District Rs.104.5 and minimum in Banaskantha Rs.21.0. Expenditure per Institution in Gujarat also increased from

Rs.22,039 in 1970-71 to Rs.53,899 in 1976-77. The maximum being in Gandhinagar i.e. Rs.1,27,620 and minimum in Dang i.e. Rs.14,312 only. The District-wise details are given in Statement No.(5).

V - PRE-PRIMARY

21. Number of Pre-Primary Schools in Gujarat increased from 839 in 1970-71 to 1,067 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 27.18% during the period of 6 years. The increase in Pre-Primary Schools was observed in all Districts except 3 District viz. Banaskantha, Bhavnagar and Junagadh where the number decreased marginally. Dang had no Primary School in 1970-71 and 1976-77.

The number of Teachers in Pre-Primary Schools also increased from 1,366 in 1970-71 to 1,673 in 1976-77.

22. Enrolment in Pre-Primary Schools as also the Enrolment in Pre-Primary & Nursery Classes increased from 57,279 (30,562 Boys and 26,717 Girls) in 1970-71 to 76,221 (40,277 Boys and 35,944 Girls) by 1976-77. In 1970-71 out of 57,279, 2,491 students (1,338 Boys and 1,153 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, whereas in 1976-77 out of 76,221, 2,920 (1,582 Boys and 1,338 Girls) and 1,219 (670 Boys and 549 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes respectively.

23. The Expenditure on Pre-Primary Schools increased from Rs.36.71 Lakhs to 79.93 Lakhs during the period of 6 years.

VI - PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS & TEACHERS

24. The Total number of Primary Schools in Gujarat decreased from 10,810 in 1970-71 to 10,338 in 1976-77. This was due to upgradation of some Schools in the State. The highest Percentage of Primary Schools was in Panchmahals i.e. 12.5% and the lowest in Gandhinagar only 0.29%.

25. On an average, in 1970-71, a Primary School was serving an area of 18.1 Sq. Kms., whereas in 1976-77 a Primary School was available per 18.9 Sq. Kms. In 1976-77, the average Area served by a Primary School was minimum in the case of Dang (6.6 Sq. Kms.) and maximum in Kutch District (183.1 Sq. Kms.).

26. The Population served by a Primary School in the State registered an increase from 2,464 in 1970-71 to 2,928 in 1976-77. Among the Districts the Population served by a Primary School was maximum in Gandhinagar 7,617 and minimum in Dang 419. Details are given in Statement No.(11).

27. The Total number of Teachers in Primary Schools in Gujarat increased from 20,717 in 1970-71 to 21,698 in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase rate of 0.95% during the period of 6 years. In 1976-77 the highest share percentage of Teachers was in Ahmedabad District 16.26% and the lowest in Gandhinagar District 0.22%. Women Teachers formed 32.56% of Total Teachers in Primary Schools in 1976-77.

b) ENROLMENT

28. In 1970-71, the Total Enrolment in Primary Schools in Gujarat increased from 7,61,744 in 1970-71 to 8,78,651 in 1976-77. In Classes I-V, the Enrolment increased from 30,87,501 (19,28,101 Boys and 11,58,400 Girls) to 37,77,997 (22,97,485 Boys and 14,80,512 Girls) during this period, with an average annual growth rate of 3.73%. The Annual Enrolment Growth Rate separately for Boys and Girls was 3.19% and 4.61% respectively, showing that Girls Education has been progressing in Primary School level in the State.

29. The Percentage of Enrolment in Classes I-V to the Corresponding Population in the Age-Group 6-11 (also called the Enrolment Ratio) gives an index of the facilities created at the Primary stages of Education. In Gujarat this Percentage increased from 77.6 to 95.3 during this period of 6 years. In the case of Boys the Enrolment Ratio increased from 92.7 to 112.7 and for Girls the increase was from 61.0 to 76.9. In 1976-77 the Enrolment Ratio was maximum in Dang District for Boys, Girls and Total viz. 144.9%, 121.4% and 133.5% respectively and was minimum in Panchmahals for Boys and Total 98.3% and 72.7%, whereas the Enrolment Ratio for Girls in Banaskantha was minimum 4.4%. Details are given in Statement No.(12).

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

30. Of the Total Enrolment of 30.88 Lakhs in Classes I-V in 1970-71 5.14 Lakhs belonged to the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes forming 16.6% of the Total Enrolment in these Classes. In 1976-77, out of 37.38 Lakhs in Classes I-V, 3.53 Lakhs and 4.45 Lakhs belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes respectively. The Percentage of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes Enrolment to Total Enrolment thus works out to be 9.3 and 11.8 respectively. Hence the co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes in these Classes works out to 136.76% and 84.29% respectively. The District-wise details on Enrolment of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes and their Percentages etc. are given in Statement No.(13).

(d) EXPENDITURE

31. The Total Expenditure on Primary Schools in Gujarat increased from Rs.528.77 Lakhs in 1970-71 to 1468.94 Lakhs in 1976-77, giving an average annual increase of 29.63% during the period under consideration.

32. The Per-Capita Expenditure on Primary Schools in the State increased from Rs.2.0 in 1970-71 to Rs.4.8 by 1976-77. The Per-Capita Expenditure in 1976-77 was maximum in Durg Rs.27.0 and minimum in Gandhinagar Rs.1.1.

33. The cost per student in Primary School increased from Rs.69.4 in 1970-71 to Rs.167.2 by 1976-77. Among the Districts the cost per student was highest in Dang District Rs.303.6 and lowest in Kutch District Rs.95.8. The Percentage of Expenditure on Primary Schools to Total Expenditure on Education at the State level increased from 9.2 to 9.8 in a period of 6 years. This Percentage in 1976-77 was the highest in Dang District 40.8% and lowest in Gandhinagar District 1.0. The Teacher Pupil Ratio was 37 in 1970-71 which increased to 40 in 1976-77. The Teacher-Pupil-Ratio in 1970-71 was the lowest in Rajkot 31 and the highest in Amroli 49. Details can be seen from Statement No.(14).

VII - MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

34. The Total number of Middle Schools in the State increased from 10,545 in 1970-71 to 12,178 in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of 2.58% during the period of 6 years. In 1976-77 the largest number of Middle Schools was recorded in Ahmedabad 8.2% and lowest in Gandhinagar 0.7%.

35. On an average in 1970-71, a Middle-School served an area of 18.6 Sq. Kms. The position was then available every 16.1 Sq. Kms. In 1976-77 the area served by a Middle School was less than the State average in as many as 14 District. The area served by a School was the smallest in Kaira 7.4 Sq. Kms. and largest in Kutch 78.1 Sq. Kms. Improved in 1976-77, a Middle School

36. The population served by a Middle School in the State decreased from 2,526 in 1970-71 to 2,480 in 1976-77. Among the Districts, the population served by a Middle School in 1976-77 varied from 1,170 in Dang to 3,293 in Ahmedabad. Details are given in Statement No.(15). The number of Teachers in Middle School also increased from 72,084 in 1970-71 to 89,292 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 23.87% during the period i.e. an annual increase of 3.98%.

(b) ENROLMENT

37. The Total Enrolment in Middle Schools was 26.77 Lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 34.34 Lakhs in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 4.71%. The Enrolment at Middle stage i.e. in Classes VI-VIII increased from 7,21,024 (4,79,423 Boys and 2,41,596 Girls) in 1970-71 to 9,50,355 (6,17,287 Boys and 3,33,068 Girls) in 1976-77. This shows an average annual growth rate of 5.30%. The average annual Enrolment Growth Rate separately for Boys and Girls comes out to 4.79% and 6.31% respectively.

38.-The Percentage of Enrolment in Classes VI-VIII to Corresponding Population in the Age-Group 11-14 i.e. Enrolment Ratio gives an index of facilities available at the Middle stage of Education. In Gujarat this Percentage was 33.9 (42.3 for Boys and 24.3 for Girls) which increased to 41.4 (51.9 for Boys and 29.6 for Girls) by 1976-77. In 1976-77, taking Boys and Girls together, the Percentage Enrolment was higher than the State's Percentage Enrolment in as many as 10 Districts. In 1976-77 the Enrolment Ratio was maximum in Ahmedabad District for Total and Girls (54.8, 46.5 respectively) whereas the Enrolment Ratio for Boys only was highest in Rajkot District 63.8%. The Enrolment Ratio was minimum in Banskantha 32.0, 8.0 and 20.3 for Boys, Girls and Total respectively.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

39. Of the Total Enrolment of 7,21,024 in Classes VI-VIII 86,158 (61,233 Boys and 24,925 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes in 1970-71 forming 11.9% of Total Enrolment. In 1975-77 out of Total Enrolment of 9,50,355 in these Classes, 70,694 (51,838 Boys and 18,855 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 59,524 (42,609 Boys and 16,915 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes, forming 7.4% and 6.3% respectively of Total Enrolment in these Classes. Hence the co-efficient of equality for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes works out to 108.8% and 45.0% respectively.

(d) EXPENDITURE

40. The Total Expenditure on Middle Schools increased from 1875.86 Lakhs in 1970-71 to 5789.53 Lakhs in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of @ 34.77% per annum during the period under consideration.

41. The Per-Capita Expenditure on Middle School in the State was Rs.13.6 in 1970-71. In 1976-77 it increased to Rs.19.0. The range of variation in Per-Capita Expenditure among the Districts varied from Rs.35.1 in Dang District to Rs.9.5 in Banaskantha.

42. The Total Expenditure on Middle Schools in 1970-71 formed 32.7% of the Total Expenditure on Education. This Percentage increased to 38.6% by 1976-77. The range of variations in this Percentage in 1976-77 was 65.5% in the case of Amreli and 22.2% in case of Ahmedabad.

43. The average cost per student in Middle Schools which was Rs.70.1 in 1970-71 increased to Rs.168.6 in 1976-77, at the State level. Among the Districts cost per student ranged from Rs.334.00 in Dang District to Rs.120.1 in Sundernagar District in 1976-77. In 1970-71 Teacher-Pupil-Ratio was 37 which increased to 38 by 1976-77. In 1976-77 Teacher-Pupil-Ratio varied from 33 to 44 in Dang District and Junagadh District respectively. Further details are given in Statement No.(18).

VIII - HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

44. It is significant to note that the system of High/Higher Secondary School changed during the period between 1970-71 and 1976-77. Previously in the State, the duration of Higher Secondary Course was 3 years. In 1976-77, with the introduction of 10+2 Pattern, the duration of the Higher Secondary Course became 4 years. In 1970-77 there were 2,263 High/Higher Secondary Schools, which increased to 2,753 by 1976-77 showing an increase of 21.65% during the period of 6 years. The increase in number of High/Higher Secondary Schools was observed in all Districts except Bhavnagar. Among the Districts in 1976-77 the largest number share of High/Higher Secondary Schools was observed in Ahmedabad 13.3% and smallest number shared by Dang District 0.29%.

45. On an average, there was a High/Higher Secondary School for every 86.6 Sq. Kms. in 1970-71. By 1976-77 the position improved considerably and then a High/Higher Secondary School was available for every 71.2 Sq. Kms. In 1976-77 in Gandhinagar District a High/Higher Secondary School was available at every 20.3 Sq. Kms., whereas in Kutch District a High/Higher Secondary School was available at every 642.4 Sq. Kms.

46. On an average, at the State level there was a High/Higher Secondary School for every 6086 persons. By 1976-77, a High/Higher Secondary School was available for every 11,048 persons. Among the Districts the average population served by a High/Higher Secondary School varied from as high as 23,251 in the case of Banaskantha District to as low as 7,140 in Gandhinagar District.

47. The Total number of Teachers in High/Higher Secondary Schools in Gujarat increased from 29,229 in 1970-71 to 33,292 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 13.9% during the period of 6 years. The increase in Teachers was observed in all the Districts. Women Teachers formed 20.27% of Total Teachers in 1976-77.

(b) ENROLMENT

48. The Total Enrolment in High/Higher Secondary Schools of the State was 7,85,865 in 1970-71, which increased to 8,72,365 by 1976-77, showing an average annual growth rate of 1.8%. The Enrolment in Classes IX-XI in 1970-71 was 4,16,361 (2,81,655 Boys and 1,34,706 Girls). In 1976-77 with the introduction of 10+2 system in the State Enrolment in Classes IX-XII increased to 4,56,257 (3,05,077 Boys and 1,51,180 Girls) showing an average annual growth rate 1.60%. The growth rate for Boys and Girls separately works out to be 1.39 and 2.04 respectively.

49. The Enrolment Ratio for Gujarat State at the High/Higher Secondary stage i.e. in Classes IX-XI/XII decreased from 24.2 (30.7 for Boys and 16.7 for Girls) in 1970-71 to 21.1 (27.3 for Boys and 14.5 for Girls) in 1976-77. Among the Districts in 1976-77, the Enrolment Ratio varied from 32.5 in Ahmedabad to 5.1 in case of Dang District. The Enrolment Ratio for Boys was maximum in Gandhinagar 39.1 and for Girls in Ahmedabad 26.3. Details are given in Statement No.(20).

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

50. Of the Total Enrolment of 4,16,361 in Classes IX to XI, 35,282 (27,335 Boys and 7,947 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes in 1970-71 forming 8.5% of the Total Enrolment in these Classes. In 1976-77 out of 4,56,257 enrolled in Classes IX-XII, 29,911 (23,455 Boys and 6,456 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 22,084 (16,527 Boys and 5,557 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 7.5% and 5.5% respectively to the Total Enrolment in these Classes. Thus the co-efficient of equality for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes works out to be 110.29% and 39.28% respectively. The details of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes Enrolment and their Corresponding Percentages are given in Statement No.(21).

(d) EXPENDITURE

51. The Total Expenditure on High/Higher Secondary Schools in the State increased from Rs.1557.69 Lakhs 1970-71 to 4057.87 Lakhs in 1976-77. The Expenditure increased with an annual growth rate of 26.75% during the period under consideration.

52. The Per-Capita Expenditure on High/Higher Schools at the State level was Rs.11.3 in 1970-71, which increased to Rs.13.4 by 1976-77. Among the Districts the Per-Capita Expenditure was maximum in Ahmedabad Rs.20.5 and minimum in Dang Rs.4.2.

53. The Total Expenditure on High/Higher Secondary Schools in 1970-71 formed 27.2% of the Total Expenditure on Education in Gujarat. This Percentage remained almost same 27.1% in 1976-77. The Expenditure on High/Higher Secondary Schools as Percentage to Total Expenditure was highest in Mehsana District 47.1% and lowest in Dang District 6.4%.

54. The Cost Per student in High/Higher Secondary Schools in Gujarat increased from Rs.198.2 in 1970-71 to Rs.465.2 in 1976-77. It was highest in Mehsana District Rs.627.3 and lowest in Rajkot Rs.372.9 in 1976-77. The Pupil-Teacher-Ratio was 27 in 1970-71, which improved to some extent by 1976-77, when there were 26 students per Teacher. In 1976-77 Pupil-Teacher-Ratio was lowest in Kaira 22 and highest in Junagadh 32. Details are given in Statement No.(22).

IX - PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL & OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

55. The number of Schools for Professional, Vocational, Special & Other (School) Education in 1970-71 were 1,442. In 1976-77 the number of Schools declined to 1,023.

56. The Total Enrolment in Professional, Vocational, Special & Other (School) Education in 1970-77 also declined from 50,016 (26,023 Boys and 23,993 Girls) in 1970-71 to 47,685 (25,141 Boys and 22,544 Girls) in 1976-77. Out of 50,016 students in these Classes in 1970-71, 9,610 Boys and 3,400 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes forming 19.21% to Total Enrolment in these Classes. In 1976-77 out of 47,685 students in these Courses, 4,369 (2,224 Boys and 2,140 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 2,284 (1,328 Boys and 956 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 9.16% and 4.79% respectively to Total number of students in these courses. Number of Teachers in Professional, Vocational, Special and Other Education increased from 1970 in 1970-71 to 2,002 in 1976-77.

57. The Total Expenditure on these Institutions increased from Rs.121.71 Lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.245.58 Lakhs in 1976-77.

X - HIGHER EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

58. Number of Institutions for Higher Education increased from 322 in 1970-71 to 385 in 1976-77, showing an increase of 19.57% during the period of 6 years. In 1976-77, there were 20 Universities, deemed to be Universities, Institutions of National Importance & Research Institutions, out of which 10 were located in Ahmedabad; 3 in Jamnagar; 2 in Surat and one each in Banaskantha, Baroda, Bhavnagar, Kaira and Rajkot. In all there were 303 Affiliated Institutions (Degree Level and above), maximum in Ahmedabad 67. The Dang District had no facility for Higher Education. Out of 303 Affiliated Institutions of Degree Level and above 202 Institutions were for Arts, Science & Commerce; 4 for Agriculture and Forestry; 1 for Business Management; There were 35 Institutions for Education; 7 for Engineering, Technology and Architecture; 23 for Law; 20 for Medicine and the rest of 11 Institutions were for teaching other subjects. There were 3 Non-Affiliated Institutions of Degree Level and 58 for below Degree Level Education. There was one Board of Secondary Education in Gandhinagar District. District-wise details are given in Statement No.(24).

59. Statement No.(24) also gives District-wise statistics of Teachers in the Institutions of Higher Education in Gujarat. Total number of Teachers in Higher Educational Institutions increased from 9,120 in 1970-71 to 10,925 in 1976-77, showing an average annual increase of 3.3% during the period. Amongst Districts the number of Teachers in Higher Education was maximum in Ahmedabad 3,011 and minimum in Banaskantha 77.

(b) ENROLMENT

60. The Total Enrolment in all Institutions of Higher Education increased from 1,65,429 in 1970-71 to 2,70,720 in 1976-77, showing an average annual growth rate of 10.6% of the Total Enrolment in 1976-77. 5,802 students were studying in Universities, deemed to be Universities, Institutions of National Importance & Research Institutions; 2,44,545 were studying in Affiliated

Colleges of Degree Level and above; 268 in Non-Affiliated Degree Level and 20105 in below Degree Level Institutions of the 2,44,545 students in Affiliated Institutions of Degree Level and above; 2,07,829 were studying in Arts, Science & Commerce Colleges; 1,490 in Agriculture & Forestry; 354 in Business Management; 4,526 in Education; 9,159 in Engineering, Technology and Architecture; 11,992 in Law; 7,073 in Medicine and rest of the 2,122 were studying in Institutions of other subjects. The highest number of students in Higher Education were in Ahmedabad District 77,291 and lowest in Gandhinagar District 1,201. District-wise distribution of Enrolment in different type of Institutions is given in Statement No.(25).

61. Statement No.(26) gives the Enrolment in Higher Education by type of Education. The Total Enrolment in Higher Education increased from 1,64,569 (1,26,209 Boys and 38,360 Girls) in 1970-71 to 1,89,468 (1,40,299 Boys and 49,169 Girls) in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 2.52%. Out of Total Enrolment in Higher Education, 1,32,733 (90,455 Boys and 42,278 Girls) were studying General Education and the rest viz. 56,735 (49,844 Boys and 6,891 Girls) were in Professional courses during 1976-77.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

62. There were 9,133 students (8,251 Boys and 882 Girls) belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in 1970-71 forming 5.5% of the Total Enrolment in Higher Education. In 1976-77, the number of students belonging to Scheduled Castes were 17,106 (14,891 Boys and 2,215 Girls) forming 6.3% to Total Enrolment in Classes of Higher Education and 8,316 (6,808 Boys and 1,508 Girls) students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 3.1% to Enrolment in these Classes. The co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes at the Higher Education stage were 92.65% and 22.14% respectively.

(d) EXPENDITURE

63. The Total Expenditure on Higher Education in Gujarat increased from Rs.1657.63 Lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.3462.71 Lakhs in 1976-77, showing an average Annual Growth Rate of 18.15% during the period under review. Among the Districts in 1976-77 the highest Expenditure on Higher Education was incurred by Ahmedabad District 37.16% whereas Kutch spent the lowest i.e. 0.90% only. Subject-wise and District-wise details are given in Statement No.(28).
