I N T R O D U C T I O N

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of educational development just as in urbanisation, industrialisation, distribution of income and wealth. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector, the Ministry of Human Resource Development brings out the publication "Educational Statistics - District-wise", quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research & Training in 1960-61. There after, it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state, every five years by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out for all the States and Union Territories with legislature.

3. For making inter-district comparison possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratios for different age groups, percentage of trained teachers and teacher pupil ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show a wide range of variations between the districts and are much needed for formulating educational plans at the district-level.

II. AREA AND POPULATION

4. The area of the Gujarat State was reported as 1,96,024 Sq.Kms. as per 1981 census. Among the districts, the area varies from as high as 45,652 Sq.Kms.(23.29 %) in the case of Kutch to as low as 649 Sq.Kms.(0.33 %) in the case of Gandhinagar. The area of the State was 5.96 % of the total area of the country as per 1981 census.

5. The estimated total population of Gujarat was 304.15 lakhs (157.23 lakhs males and 146.92 lakhs females) in 1977. The same is estimated to have been increased to 348.05 lakhs (179.07 lakhs males and 168.98 lakhs females) in 1982. The annual growth of the population worked out to 2.9 % during the period under consideration. The estimated population of the State in 1982 was 4.8 % of the estimated population of the country in 1982.

6. The overall density of population per Sq.Kms. was 155 in 1977 which is estimated to have increased to 178 in 1982. The density of population per Sq.Kms. also varies widely among the districts. It is found to be the highest (455) in Gandhinagar and the lowest (23) in Kutch during 1982. The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the years 1976-77 and 1981-82 are given in Appendix No. 2. Table No. 1 gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and density of population in 1982.

7. The total population of the State as well as population of different districts in different age-groups for the year 1977 and 1982 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of the Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-group 6-11, 11-14 & 14-17 are based on the following formula :

8. To get the Sex-wise break-up of total population in the various age-groups of the district, first of all the girls population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in the above formulae, total population is replaced by the Girls' population. The boys population is obtained simply by subtraction of girls population from the total population.
9. Similar formulae are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age group 11-14 and 14-17 years.
10. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 44.05 lakhs in 1982 (22.75 lakhs boys and 21.30 lakhs girls) which constituted 12.65 % of the total Population.
11. The population in the age-group 11-14 years in 1982 was 25.50 lakhs (13.22 lakhs boys and 12.28 lakhs girls). This formed 7.32 % of the total population of the State.
12. Similarly, the estimated population in the age-group 14-17 years was 31.63 lakhs (16.25 lakhs boys and 15.38 lakhs girls) in 1982. This formed 9.02 % of the total population.
13. Out of the total population of 348.05 lakhs of the state, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 100.94 lakhs (52.22 lakhs boys and 48.72 lakhs girls). The total population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 29.0 % of the total population. These percentages separately for boys and girls were 29.16 % and 28.84 % respectively. The district-wise details may be seen in Appendix No. 3.

III. LITERACY

14. According to the 1981 census, the effective literacy rate viz., total no. of literates per hundred of population including 0-4 age group was 43.70 for the state as a whole. The literacy rate for males was 54.44 whereas for females it was much lower (32.30 %) for the State as a whole. The highest literacy was in Ahmedabad (56.08) and the lowest was in Banaskantha (23.04). Number of literates per hundred in case of SC & ST were 39.7 and 21.14 respectively. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No. 6.

IV. GENERAL VIEW

a) INSTITUTIONS

15. The total number of educational institutions at school level in Gujarat was 27,794 in 1976-77 which increased to 37,309 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 34.23 % during the period under review. In 1981-82, Kheda had the highest share of institutions (9.1 %) and Gandhinagar had the smallest share (0.9 %). The district-wise position of educational institutions is given in Appendix No. 1.

b) ENROLMENT

16. Total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions (School Level) in the State was 55.79 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 66.79 lakhs in 1981-82, showing an annual growth rate in enrolment of 3.91 % during the period under review. Ahmedabad had the largest share of enrolment i.e. 12.8 % whereas Dangs had the lowest share i.e. 0.4 % during 1981-82. The percentage share of enrolment (School) was 5.89 % of total enrolment in the country.

17. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was 37.5 % in 1976-77 which showed a slight increase to 39.5 % in 1981-82. This is higher than the corresponding percentage for the country as a whole (36.6 %). Percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was higher in 9 district than that of State percentage. Sexwise breakup of enrolment figures for different districts in Appendix No. 4.

c) TEACHERS

18. Total number of teachers in schools increased from 1,46,155 in 1976-77 to 1,74,855 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 19.6 % during the period under review. The increase has been observed in all the districts. In 1981-82, of the total of 1,74,855, 63,676 were female teachers in the State. The total number of trained teachers were 1,69,213 forming 96.8 % of the total number of teachers. The percentages of trained teachers were 98.0 % & 94.6 % for males & females respectively, during 1981-82. Taking male & female teachers together, this percentage was the highest in Banaskantha (98.9) and the lowest in Kachchh (71.6 %). The percentage was higher in 14 districts as compared to the state average and even higher than the corresponding figure for India (85.9 %). District-wise details are given in Appendix No.5.

d) Extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes

Extent of coverage is defined as :

$$I = \frac{\text{Percentage of enrolment of SC/ST to total enrolment}}{\text{Percentage of population of SC/ST to total population}} \times 100$$

19. Of the total enrolment in school education 6,20,254 belonged to Scheduled Caste which comes out to be 9.3 % of the total enrolment in the State. Among the districts the percentage of Scheduled Caste varies from 14.7 % in Ahmedabad to 1.6 % in Dangs. Percentage of SC population to total population is 7.0 % in 1981-82 for the state as a whole. The extent of coverage for Scheduled Castes in School education comes to 132.9 % at state level. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 7.

20. Enrolment percentage of Scheduled Tribes in school education is 12.6 % (13.2 % for boys and 11.7 % for girls) in 1981-82. The enrolment percentage is the highest in Dangs (94.2 %) and the lowest in Amreli (0.1 %). Percentage population of ST to the total population is 13.9 % for the state as a whole. Extent of coverage for this community is therefore worked out to be 90.6 % at the state level. District-wise details can be seen from Appendix No. 8.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

a) PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOLS

21. The number of pre-primary schools in Gujarat increased from 1067 in 1976-77 to 1632 in 1981-82, showing an annual increase rate of 52.9 % during the period under review.

b) TEACHERS

22. Number of teachers also increased from 1673 in 1976-77 to 2366 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 41.42 %. There were 2271 female teachers in Pre-Primary schools in 1981-82.

c) ENROLMENT

23. Enrolment in Pre-Primary schools which was 76,221 in 1976-77 increased to 1,00,446 in 1981-82. Enrolment in Pre-Primary classes was 7,26,221 in 1976-77 and it increased to 1,00,527 (53,012 boys and 47,515 girls) by 1981-82. In 1976-77 there were 2,902 students (1582 boys and 1336 girls) belonging to Scheduled Castes and 1291 students (670 boys and 549 girls) belonging to Scheduled Tribes studying in these classes. In 1981-82, there were 8881 students (4757 boys and 4124 girls) belonging to Scheduled Castes and 5945 students (3155 boys and 2790 girls) belonging to Scheduled Tribes studying in pre-primary classes forming 8.8 % and 5.9 % respectively to the total enrolment. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 9.

d) EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

24. In 1981-82, of the total 1632 pre-primary schools in the state, 915 were lowest in Rural Areas having an enrolment of 79020 (78.6 %).

VI. PRIMARY EDUCATION

a) INSTITUTIONS

25. The total number of primary schools in Gujarat increased from 10,388 in 1976-77 to 11,396 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 9.7 % over the period of 5 years.

26. In 1976-77 a primary school in the state was serving an area of 18.9 Sq.Kms. in five years, the position improved and a primary school was available for every 17.2 Sq.Kms. in 1981-82. In 1981-82 the average area served by a primary school was minimum in case of Panchmahal (5.7 Sq.Kms.), where as maximum area served by a primary school was in Kutch (160.2 Sq. Kms.).

27. The average population served by a primary school in the state was 2928 in 1976-77 but the position changed marginally in 1981-82 and a school was then available for a population of 3054 persons. The district-wise details may be seen in Appendix No. 11.

b) TEACHERS

28. Total number of teachers in Primary school education in the state increased from 21,898 in 1976-77 to 23,937 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 1.9 per annum. In 1981-82, primary teachers in different districts varied from the highest in Ahmedabad (16.7 %) and the lowest in Gandhinagar district (0.42 %). Pupil teacher ratio in Primary schools in 1976-77 was 40 which increased to 41 in 1981-82. The ratio was higher in 6 districts than the State's ratio and in 16 districts it was higher than that of India's viz. 39 during 1981-82. In 1981-82, the percentage of trained teachers in primary schools was 96.8 (98.3 for males and 93.9 % for females). The percentage for males and females together was the highest in Dangs (100.0 %) and the lowest in Junagarh (81.5 %). Percentage of trained teachers was higher in 13 districts than the state's percentage and was higher in 17 districts than that of India's percentage which being 86.6 %. District-wise details can be seen from Appendix No. 13.

c) ENROLMENT

29. The total enrolment in primary schools in Gujarat during 1976-77 was 8,78,651 which increased to 9,91,265 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 12.8 % during the period under review. In classes I-V, the total enrolment increased from 37,77,997 to 44,07,692 during 1976-77 to 1981-82 showing an annual growth rate of 3.3 % during the said period.

30. The enrolment ratio in classes I-V is defined as the percentage of enrolment in classes I-V to the corresponding population in the age-group 6-11. This ratio gives an index of facilities created at primary stage of education. For Gujarat, this ratio increased from 95.3 % to 100 % during the period 1976-77 to 1981-82. The corresponding enrolment ratio for boys increased from 112.7 % to 114.5 % and for girls from 76.9 % to 84.7 % during the said period. Taking both boys and girls together, the enrolment ratio at the primary stage varied widely among the districts. It worked out to be the highest of 157.7 % in Dangs and lowest of 8.0 % in Panch Mahal district during 1981-82. In 8 districts, the enrolment ratios are found to be higher than that for the state as a whole and all the districts had higher percentage than that of India i.e. 83.1 % for the year 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 12.

d) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

31. Of the total enrolment of 37.79 lakhs in classes I-V in 1976-77, 3.52 lakhs students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 4.45 lakhs belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 9.3 % and 11.8 % respectively of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82, out of the total enrolment of 44.08 lakhs in classes I-V, 4.13 lakhs students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 6.26 lakh students belonged to Scheduled Tribes. Thus the percentage of enrolment of Schedule Caste and Schedule Tribe students to total enrolment works out to be 9.16 % and 14.2 % respectively. This implies that the educational progress among SC communities has almost remained static although ST communities have made better progress. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No. 14 & 15.

e) EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

32. In 1981-82, of the total number of primary schools viz. 11,396 in the state, 10,462 (91.3 %) were located in Rural Areas. The enrolment in Primary classes I-V in Rural Areas was 31.26 lakhs. District-wise details of primary schools and their enrolment are given in Appendix No. 16.

f) HABITATIONS WITH OR WITHOUT PRIMARY SCHOOLS

VII. MIDDLE EDUCATION 33. In all there were 23983 habitations in the state out of which 19494 had a Primary School with in them where as 22906 had a Primary School with in a distance of 2 Km. District-wise (a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS details are given in Appendix No. 17.

34. The total number of middle schools in the state increased from 12,178 in 1976-77 to 14,099 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 3.2 % during the period of five years. In 1981-82 the highest percentage of Middle schools was observed in Ahmedabad (8.7 %) and the lowest in Dange (0.6 %).

35. On an average in 1976-77, a Middle school served an area of 16.1 Sq.Kms. In 1981-82, the position improved slightly and a Middle school was available for an area of 13.9 Sq.Kms. The area served by a Middle school was less than the state's average in as many as 11 districts in 1981-82. The area served by a middle school was the minimum in Gandhinagar (6.1 Sq.Kms.) and maximum in Kutch (64.8 Sq.Kms.) in 1981-82.

36. The average population served by a Middle school in 1976-77 in Gujarat was 2480 which decreased marginally in 1981-82 to 2469. Among the districts, the population served by a middle school varied from as low as Dangs (1304) to as high as 7843 in Banskantha district in 1981-82. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No. 18.

37. The total number of teachers in Middle school was 89,292 in 1976-77 which increased to 1,08,185 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 21.27 % during the period under review. Teacher pupil ratio in 1976-77 was 38 which was slightly decreased to 39 in 1981-82. The ratio was higher in 10 districts than the state's ratio and almost in all districts except that of Dangs in which case it was higher than the India's ratio of 34. Percentage of trained teachers to total no. of teachers was 97.0 (98.2 for males and 95.3 for females). All districts had higher percentage of trained teacher than that for the country as a whole i.e. 89.8. District-wise details can be seen from Appendix No. 20.

b) ENROLMENT

38. Total enrolment in Middle schools was 34.34 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 42.33 lakhs by the year 1981-82 at the State level showing an average annual increase of 4.65 %. Total enrolment in Middle classes for the state as a whole was 9.50 lakhs (6.17 lakhs boys 3.33 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 which increased to 11.45 lakhs (7.19 lakhs boys and 4.26 lakhs girls) by 1981-82 showing an annual growth rate of 4.09 % during the period under review.

39. The enrolment ratio at the middle stage which is defined as the percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age-group 11-14 years gives an index of facilities created at the Middle stage education. For the state as a whole, the enrolment ratio was 41.4 % (51.9 % for boys and 29.6 % for girls) in 1976-77. In 1981-82 the enrolment ratio increased to 44.9 % (54.4 % for boys and 34.7 % for girls). Among the districts, the percentage of enrolment was the highest in case of Valsad (54.2) and the

lowest of 23.8 % in Banaskantha. In 1981-82, the enrolment ratio was higher for boys and girls combined in 9 districts than that of state's ratio and higher in 11 districts than that of India's ratio of 43.3. District-wise details of enrolment in middle education are given in Appendix No. 19.

c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTE AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

40. Of the total enrolment of 9,50,355 in classes VI-VIII, there were 76,694 and 59,524 students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes forming 8.1 % and 6.3 % respectively in 1976-77. In 1981-82 out of 11,44,996 enrolment in classes VI-VIII, there were 98,743 and 97,968 students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes respectively. The percentage of SC/ST enrolment to total enrolment in these classes works out to be 8.6 % and 8.5 % respectively. District-wise details may be seen in Appendix No. 21 & 22.

d) MIDDLE EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

41. Out of 14,099 middle schools in the state, 11,407 were located in Rural Areas in 1981-82 and their total enrolment was 29.37 lakhs. All the district had pucca school buildings. District-wise position is given in Appendix No. 23.

f) HABITATION WITH OR WITHOUT MIDDLE SCHOOLS

42. Appendix No. 24 depicts the position of middle schools in habitations of the state. Out of the total number of 23,983 habitations in Gujarat in 1981-82, 10,632 (41.8 %) habitations were having a Middle school with in them and 17,525 habitations were having a middle school up to a distance of 2 Kms. The remaining 22,017 habitations were having a middle schools up to a distance of 5 Kms.

VII. ENROLMENT BY STANDARD

43. Appendix No. 25 depicts class-wise enrolment from class I to VIII. At the State level the percentage of enrolment of class V to that of class I is worked out to be 46.8 % and of class VIII to class I as 26.5 % showing a rough picture of the dropouts children.

VIII. HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION

a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

44. There were 2753 High/Higher Secondary schools in Gujarat during 1976-77 which increased to 3352 by 1981-82 showing an increase of 21.7 % during the period of 5 years. Of the total number of these schools in 1981-82, there were 2241 High Schools and 1111 Higher Secondary Schools (10+2 Pattern). The largest share of High/Higer Secondary schools was in Ahmedabad district (431) and the lowest was in Dangs district (10).

45. On an average, there was a High/Higher Secondary school for every 71.28 Sq.Kms. of area in 1976-77. The position improved considerably by 1981-82 as a High/Higer Secondary school was then available for every 58.5 Sq.Kms. at the state level. In 1981-82, among the districts, the average area varied from as High as 585.3 Sq.Kms. in case of Kachchh to as low as 16.6 Sq.Kms. in case of Gandhinagar.

46. On an average, at the state level, a High/Higer Secondary school was available for every 11,048 persons during 1976-77. The position considerably improved during the period under review in 1981-82 as a High/Higer Secondary School was available for every 10,384 persons. Among the districts, the average population served by a High/Higer Secondary school varied from 6031 in Sabarkantha to 18,631 in case of Bhavnagar di trict.

47. The total number of teachers in High/Higer Secondary schools in 1976-77 was 33,292 which increased to 40,367 in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 21.3 % during the period under review. Women teachers formed 20.2 % of the total teachers against the All India's average of 27.7 % in 1981-82 which calls for need to recruit more number of female teachers in these schools by the state Govt. Pupil teacher ratio in High/Higer Secondary schools in 1976-77 was 26 which increased to 27 in 1981-82. Comparing with the Pupil teacher ratio for All India for the state as a whole in these schools which was 27 during 1981-82, there were 6 districts having higher teacher pupil ratio than the All India teacher pupil ratio. Percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers in these schools was 97.4 (97.5 for males and 96.7 for females). The district-wise statistics of High/Higer Secondary schools, teachers, area and population served by a High/Higer Secondary school are given in Appendix No. 26 & 28.

b) ENROLMENT

48. The total enrolment in High/Higer Secondary Schools in the state in 1976-77 was 8.72 lakhs which increased to 11.01 lakhs in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 5.24 %. In 1976-77, the total enrolment in classes IX-XI/XII was 4.56 lakhs (3.05 lakhs boys and 1.51 lakhs girls) and the same increased to 7.72 lakhs (5.08 lakhs boys and 2.64 lakhs girls) by 1981-82. This shows an impressive annual growth rate of 13.84 % (13.33 % for boys and 14.86 % for girls) during the period under review.

49. The enrolment ratio in classes IX to XII in Gujarat State was 21.1 % (27.3 % for boys, 14.5 % for girls) in 1976-77 which increased to 24.6 % (31.3 % for boys and 17.4 % for girls) in 1981-82. Among the districts the enrolment ratio ranged from the highest of 34.9 %

in Ahmedabad to the lowest of 10.1 % in Banaskantha district during 1981-82. The enrolment ratio was higher in 9 districts than the state's ratio and was higher in 13 districts than that of India's (18.0). District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 27.

c) ENROLMENT OF SC & ST

50. In 1976-77, the percentage of SC & ST students to total enrolment in classes IX-XII was 6.6 % and 4.8 % respectively. In 1981-82, out of 7,71,959 students in these classes, there were 61,279 students belonging to Scheduled Caste and 49,641 students belonging to Scheduled Tribes forming 7.9 % and 6.4 % respectively of the total enrolment in classes IX-XII.

d) HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS :

51. Out of 3352 High/Higher Secondary schools in the state, 2168 were located in Rural Areas. Among the Rural Areas of different districts, the largest number (317) was in Rural Areas of Kachchh. There were 90 % pucca schools in Rural Areas. The enrolment in High/Higher Secondary schools in the state was 4,47,333 or 40.6 % in Rural Areas. The enrolment in classes IX-XI/XII in Rural Areas is reported to be 2,99,620 during 1981-82 forming 38.8 % of the total enrolment in these classes. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No. 31.

IX.

PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION :

a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

52. The number of schools for professional, vocational, special and other (school) education in the state increased from 1023 in 1976-77 to 6830 in 1981-82, showing an increase of 667.6 % during the period under review. This abnormal increase is because of opening of large number of Adult Education Schools included under this category. The number of teachers in these schools also increased from 2002 in 1976-77 to 8315 in 1981-82.

b) ENROLMENT

53. Total enrolment in professional, vocational, special and other (school) education also increased from 47,685 in 1976-77 to 2,44,664 (1,51,441 boys and 93,223 girls) in 1981-82. In 1976-77 out of the total enrolment 4369 belonged to Scheduled Castes and 2284 belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 9.2 % and 4.8 % respectively of the total enrolment in the state. In 1981-82, out of the total enrolment of 2,44,664 students in these schools, 38,799 (25,227 boys and 13,572 girls) students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 61,936 (41,392 boys and 20,544 girls) students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 15.9 % and 25.5 % respectively of the total enrolment in these courses. Large share of SC/ST enrolment under this category of institution seems to be an account of large number of SC/ST enrolled in Adult Education centres. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 33.
