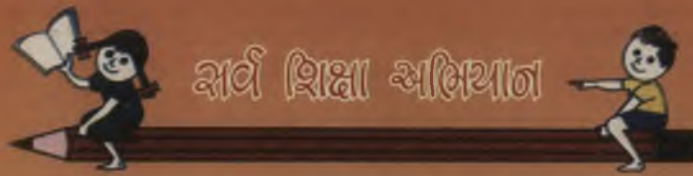

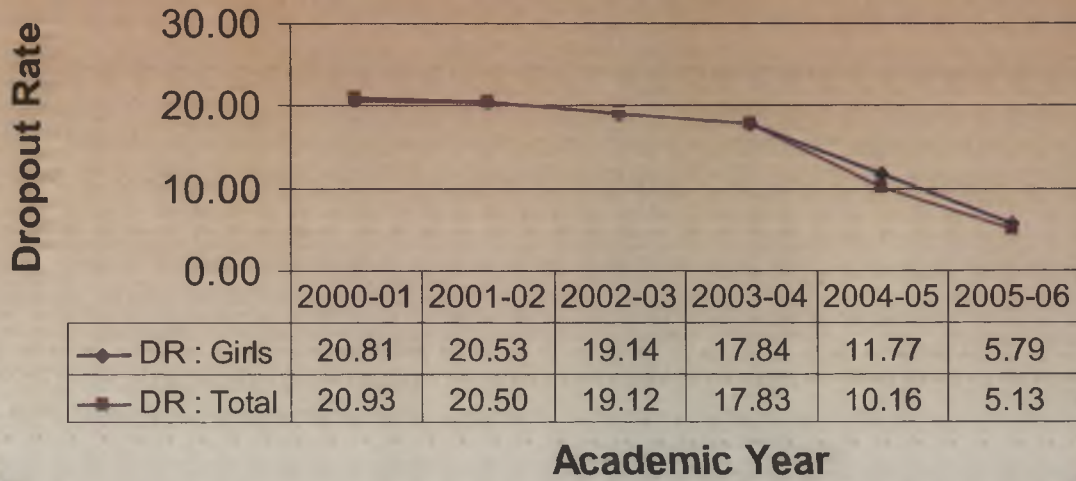

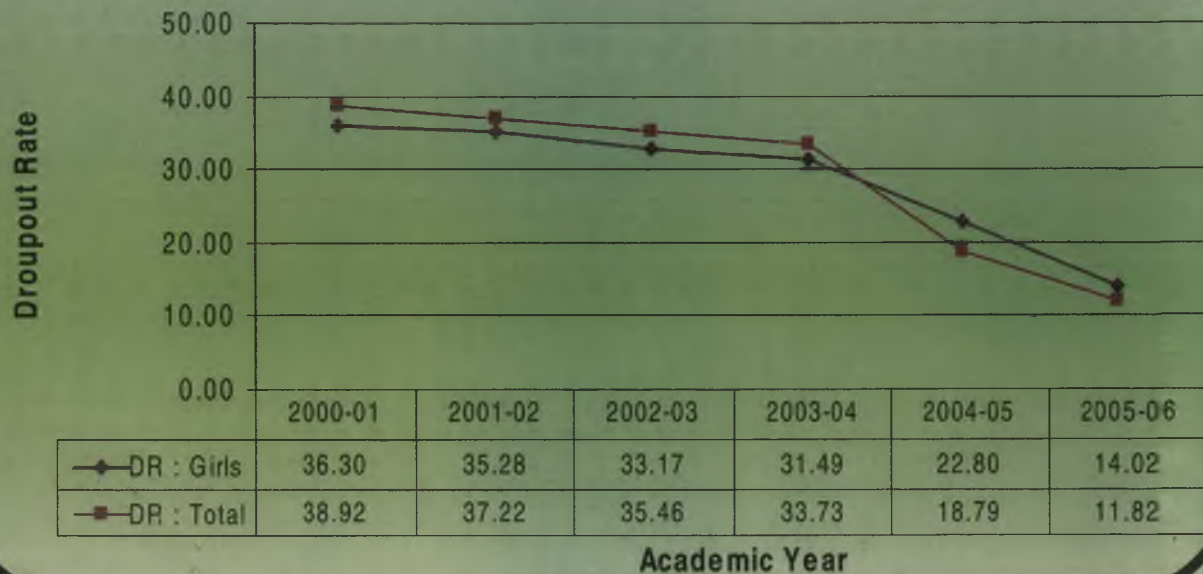


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### Dropout Rate : Std. 1 to 5



### Dropout Rate : Std. 1 to 7



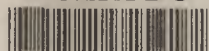

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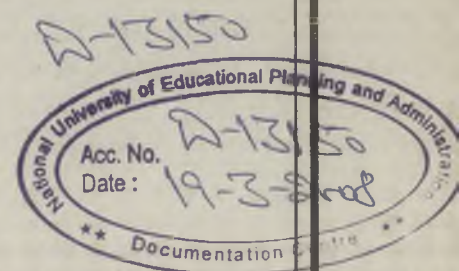

## PREFACE

Since the State, as an evolving society, has felt a need to settle the imbalance in male-female equality in all aspects, the girls' education has been kept in focus while preparing this booklet. 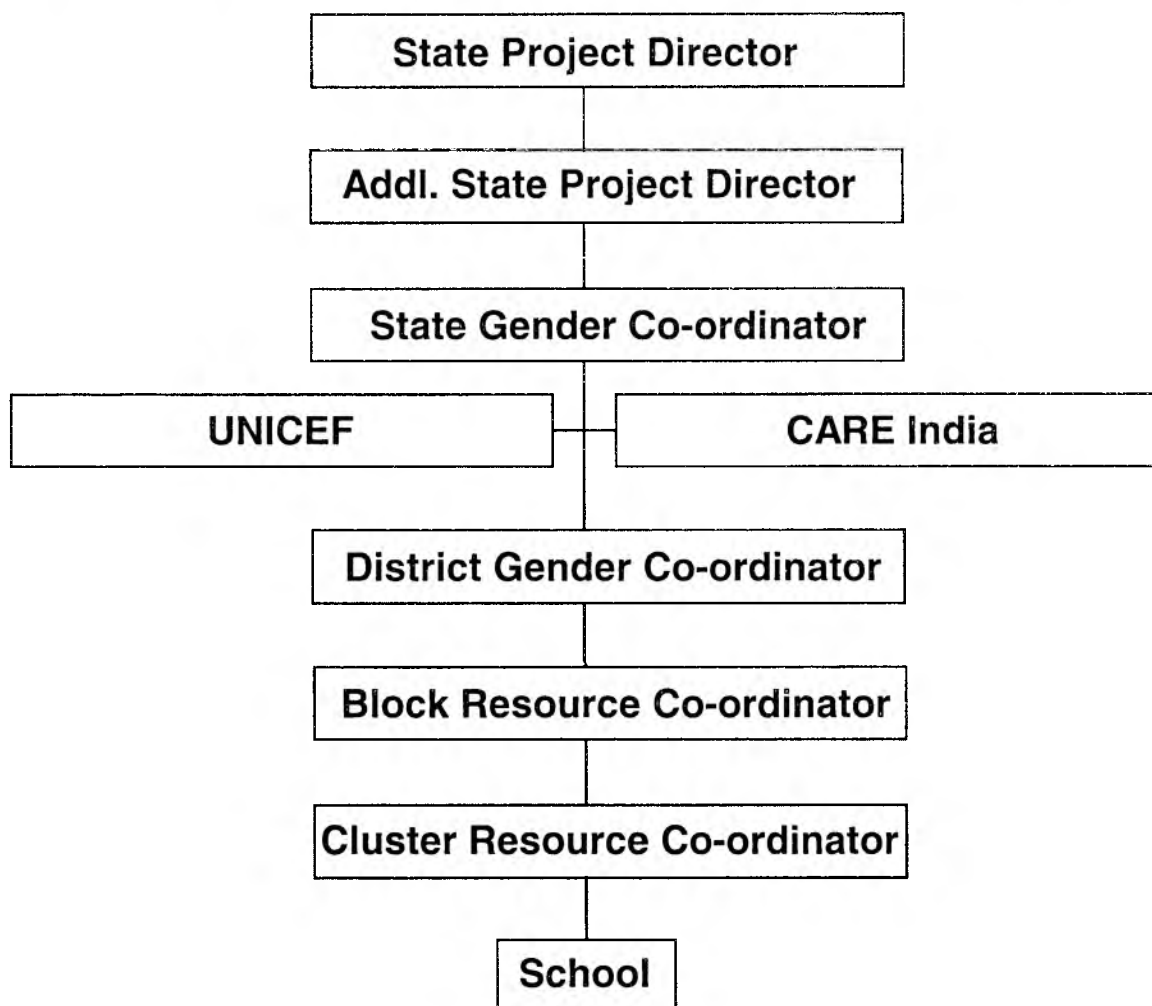

Training materials and modules play very important role to create healthier environment with respect to girl's education in Gujarat. Majority of the programs on the subject of girls education are implemented in the state by providing systematic training to concern functionary accordingly on developed module or materials by state gender unit. From planning to implementation and from supervision and monitoring to follow up, state gender unit works meticulously to spread out girl's education.

The objectives of developing material are as follows:

- ❖ To enhance the teaching skills of teachers
- ❖ To develop special understanding on gender education in teachers
- ❖ To create awareness among community members on girls education
- ❖ To improve the competence level of girl student in various subjects
- ❖ To build up self-confidence of girl students
- ❖ To empower girl student

**Implementation of the programmes**

1. State Gender Unit Gujarat, develops the Framework and main points of the programmes.
2. Selected district gender coordinators, Experts, Members of Educational Institutes, BRCs, teachers and CRCs are invited to discuss the developed framework and main facets of the programme. Based on the discussion, the module or material is developed.

3. First TOT is done in some selected clusters across the state to check the effectiveness of the developed materials. Based on the feedback, the module or material is revised. Revised copy of the module or material is used for the training.

4. Training

- In the first stage, training is imparted to District Gender Coordinators and some selected BRCs and CRCs.
- In the second stage, training is imparted to rest of the BRCs and CRCs.
- In the third stage, training is imparted to teachers or Balmitras.

- Vidhyalaxmi bond of Rs. 1000/- given to girls student who takes admission in 1<sup>st</sup> Std. The girl will receive the amount of bond with interest at the time of completion of Std. 7<sup>th</sup>.

## Chapter-7 : MAHILA SAMAKHYA

Mahila Samakhya Programme aiming at women's empowerment through education was initiated in Gujarat in 1989 in three districts i.e. Sabarkantha, Rajkot and Baroda. Mahila Samakhya Programme aims at empowering rural women, particularly from socially and economically marginalized groups, who are deprived of formal educational opportunities. Education for empowerment was broadly viewed as a process of building capabilities and confidence of women by imparting information and skills to take informed decisions on various matters affecting their lives at individual, community and societal level.

As of now, Mahila Samakhya Programme is operational in 7 districts of Gujarat i.e. Sabarkantha, Rajkot, Baroda, Surendranagar, Banaskantha, Panchamahar and Dangs.

Mahila Samakhya Programme is implemented in 38 blocks of 7 districts. The list is attached as under. Mahila Samakhya is working in 1903 villages of 38 blocks.

Mahila Samakhya runs literacy classes for illiterate women as well as Mahila Shikshan Kendra for girls.

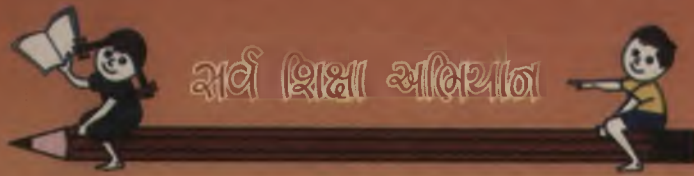

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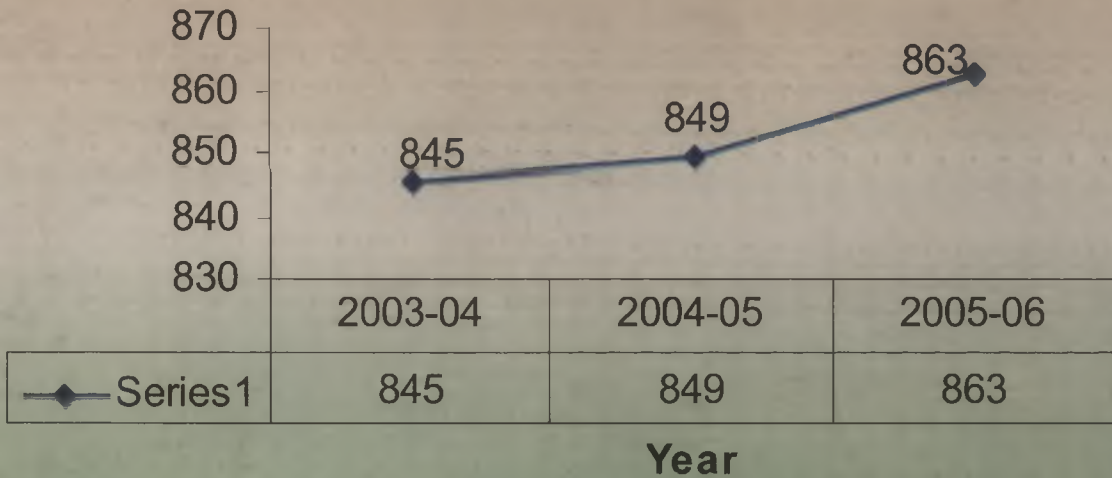
