CHAPTER : I

INTRODUCTION :

The Fifth All India Educational Survey was conducted in 1987. The reference date for the survey was decided to be 30th September, 1986. The objectives of the survey were as follow :

Objectives

(i) To assess the present position of educational facilities at various school stages, in respect of coverage of school going population, the distance to be covered by a child to reach the school, enrolment in general and of scheduled caste and scheduled tribe children and girls in particular.

(ii) To assess the availability of physical facilities like school buildings, play-grounds, drinking water within the school, furniture, medical check-up, other equipment, incentive schemes and the number of beneficiaries.

(iii) To assess the position of inputs like black-board and chalk, library, laboratory, book banks etc.

(iv) To know about the academic and professional qualifications of working teachers with special reference to teaching of science and mathematics and to determine attrition rate in teaching profession.

(v) To prepare block maps, showing habitations, existing educational facilities and proposed provision of facilities in a planned manner over a period of time.

2. The Tools

Three forms viz. village information form, Urban Information form and School Information form were developed keeping in view the objectives of the survey.

Village Information Form : The items of the VIF were 1. Male/Female population in 1981, SC and ST population 2. Actual/Estimated population of the village. 3. Actual/Estimated child population in various age groups. 4. Schools available in various habitations of the village and classes taught in these. 5. Estimated population in various habitations of the villages. 6. Distance at which schooling facilities for Primary, Middle, Secondary and Higher Secondary stages are available for each habitation. 7. Habitations predominantly populated by SC and ST 8. Centres for non-formal education, their number and enrolment. 9. Centres for adult education, their number and enrolment. 10. Institutions for disabled (handicapped). 11. Institutions for pre-school education.

Urban Information Form : The above written items no. 2-3-8-9-10-11 were almost common. These items were to collect the data of urban and slum areas in particular. Some items were added to collect the number of institutions of different types.

School Information Form : The main items of information in this form were 1. Management, 2. Type of school : boys, girls, co-educational, 3. Classes taught 4. Types of school buildings, 5. Total covered area and number of class rooms including subject room, 6. Possibility of fur-

ther expansion of school building and number of additional rooms required for instructional purposes. 7. Use of school building for other purposes. 8. Availability of various facilities e.g. play grounds, furniture, text book bank, library, black boards, games and sports material etc. 9. Arrangements of medical check up of students. 10. Availability of drinking water and urinals etc. 11. Incentives to students. 12. Number of teachers working at various stages along with their qualification and corresponding details for further belonging to SC and ST. 13. Enrolment in classes I to XII and corresponding enrolment of SC/ST students. 14. Attrition of teachers. 15. Qualification of teachers teaching Science/Mathematics at secondary stages and utilisation of teachers with science qualification. 16. Vocational courses and guidance facility in secondary, higher secondary schools.

17. Vocationalisation at + 2 stage, courses offered, availability of workshop facility, trained teacher, enrolment, on the job training, follow up etc.

1.3 Organisation of Survey

The administrative set up for the survey work at the state level was of the state survey officer, 2 Assistant State Survey Officers, 2 Statistical Assistants, Steno cum typist and a junior clerk. The set up at the district level was of a district survey officers to be assisted by A.E.I. and a clerk. To carry on the survey work at the district level, DEOs and DPEOs were requested to co-operate. In April '87, the district survey officers were called at Ahmedabad for the short-term training programme. The experts from the NCERT, Delhi helped in training and guiding the DSOs. Adequate number of different forms, as per the need of different districts were distributed. In the next phase, training courses were conducted at various district headquarters to train up the assisting team at the district level. The second phase of the training of D.S.Os. was during the month of August.

How to collect the data with due care, check up of the collected data, scrutinise analyse and how to tabulise the collected information, how to prepare the block tables and block maps along with final report etc. were discussed during the several monthly meetings at head quarters and also at district places.

For accuracy, quality check and guiding and solving various problems and confusions the state unit frequently visited the district units.

At the district level, the district survey officer prepared two sets of the district tables based on the block tables. One copy of the district tables was to be submitted to the state survey officer and the second copy was to be kept at the office of the D.E.O. The survey report of the district as well as block was to be prepared as per the guideline given. The Final district survey report and district tables along with the district map were submitted to the state survey officer in the second week of December, 1987.

At the state level, the state unit started its work of preparing the state tables after due checking of the district tables from 1st January '88 onwards. To assist the state unit, some experienced and efficient persons from districts were called. The NCERT officers Dr. I. K. Bansal and Dr. Mohamed Yunus were with the state unit from 10-1-88 to 13-1-88 for the scrutiny and reconciliation of the state tables. They again visited in the second week of February '88. As per their guideline the final touch was given.

It was a heavy task to prepare the state tables, with due accuracy, constantly keeping an eye on the time-schedule. Because of the whole hearted co-operation of the primary teachers, educational supervisors of Panchayats and assistant educational inspectors, the state educational survey work was nicely completed. Finally the state tables along with the report were prepared and submitted to N.C.E.R.T. in the last week of February '88.

The detailed findings are included in the main report. Here are some outstanding findings given in the next chapter on 'main findings'.

CHAPTER : II MAIN FINDINGS :

2.1 EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES IN RURAL AREAS

2.1.1. Habitations and Estimated Population

As per the details given in Table No. 1 The Gujarat State comprises of 19 districts. The total number of inhabited villages is 18,094. The total number of habitations is 24,390. The number of the urban areas is 203. The rural population as per the census 1981 is 2,34,65,000. The estimated population of the rural area is 2,70,07,998 and the total estimated population of the state on 30th September, 1986 is 3,95,89,150.

2.1.2. (i) Habitations Served by Primary Stage

As per the details of table no. 5, the total no. of habitations served for the primary stage within the habitations of residence is 22,068 (i.e. 90.48% of the total habitations) and up to the distance of 1 km. is 1,602 (i.e. 6.57% of the total) habitations.

Thus the total number of habitations having the facilities of primary stage within the habitations or up to the distance of 1 km. is 23,670 which is 97.05% of the total habitations.

2.1.2. (ii) Habitations served by Upper Primary Stage.

As per the table no. 8, the total number of habitations served by the Upper Primary Stage within the habitations of residence is 11,333 (i.e. 46.47% of the total).

10315 habitations (42.29%) get the facilities of upper primary stage up to the distance of 3 kms.

Thus the total 21,648 (i.e. 88.76% of the total habitation) get the facilities of upper primary stage either within the habitations or up to the distance of 3 kms.

(i) Population Served by Upper Primary Stage

As per the contents of table 5 and 6 2,64,21,326 (i.e. 97.83% of the total) population is served by the educational facilities of primary stage within the habitation of residence, 4,38,096 (i.e. 1.62% of the total) population get this above mentioned facilities up to the distance of 1 km.

Totally 2,68,59,422 (i.e. 99.45% of the total) population get the primary staged schooling facilities either within the habitations of residence or up to the distance of 1 km.

3 (ii) Population Served by Upper Primary Stage.

As per the details given in table 8 and 9, 74.91 percent (i.e. 2,02,30,429) population get the facilities of upper primary stage within the habitations.

19.53% (i.e. 52,72,205) of the total population get the said facilities up to the distance of 3 kms.

Totally 2,55,02,634 (i.e. 94.44% of the total) population get the facilities of upper primary stage either within the habitations or up to the distance of 3 kms.

2.1.4 Habitations with population 300 or more unserved by Primary Stage

As per the table no. 7, there are 19798 habitations with 300 or more population of which 99.23% of the habitations get the facilities of primary stage within the habitations and up to the distance of 1 km i.e. 19,645 habitations are served by the facilities of primary stage.

Thus 153 (i.e. 0.77%) having population of 300 or more are not yet served by primary stage as per the norms laid down.

2.1.5 Habitations with population 500 or more unserved by Upper Primary Stage.

As per the table no. 10 There are 15,869 habitations with 500 or more population of which 91.09% of the total habitations get the facilities of upper primary stage within and up to the distance of 3 kms. That is 14455 habitations are served by the facilities of upper primary stage.

Thus 1414 (i.e. 8.91%) habitations having population of 500 or more are not yet served by the upper primary stage as per the set norms.

2.2 SCHOOLS :

2.2.1 No. of P/UP/S/HS Schools.

As per the details given in the table no. 3 & 4.

There are 12709 primary 16,192 upper primary and 3302 secondary and 1242 Higher (Secondary) schools in the state.

For the Primary schools in the state the overall percentage increase during 1978-86 is 15.9%. Similarly the increase during the same period in upper primary is 29.5, in secondary schools it is 54.2 and in the higher secondary schools is 61%. So there is remarkable increase in Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.

2.2.2 No. & % of Schools in Rural Areas

The table 2 gives the details of the schools of the rural areas. There are 11,422 Primary Schools 12,959 Upper Primary Schools, 2,602 Secondary Schools and 495 Higher Secondary Schools in the rural areas of the state, the total number of schools in rural areas is 27,478.

Thus the percentage of Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools of the rural areas is 41.57%, 47.16%, 9.47% and 1.20% respectively.

2.2.3 No. of Sections P/UP/S/HS Rural & Urban Areas

Information about the sections of the Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary as per their areas is shown in table no. 2 which is as under :

Out of total 28,037 Primary Sections 23,996 Primary Sections are in rural areas and 404 sections are in urban areas, similarly 16,197 sections are there in Upper Primary level. Out of this 12960 are in rural and 3237 in urban areas. In Secondary totally there are 4540 sections out of this 3097 are in the rural areas and 1443 in urban areas.

In Higher Secondary there are 1242 sections in total, of which 495 are of rural and 747 urban areas.

2.3 ENROLMENT :

2.3.1 Enrolment in Classes I to V

As per the details of table no. 11 and 12, the total enrolment in classes I to V in the state 46,44,846. The enrolment in the rural areas in the same classes is 34,23,843.

As per the table no 17, the SC enrolment is 4,61,923 that is 9.34% of the total enrolment. Out of this 2,62,770 that is 9.35% of the total are boys and 1,99,153 (9.33%) are the girls.

As table 18 provides details. The ST enrolment in total is 7,15,672 that is 14.47% of the total.

As per the table no. 12 informs about the enrolment, against the total enrolment of 49,44,846 in classes I to V 21,35,413 (which is almost 43.18% of the total) is the enrolment of girls.

In the rural areas enrolment of girls in I to V classes is 14,41,763 as against the total enrolment of 34,23,843. Thus 42% proportion is that of girls.

The estimated population (in thousands) in the 6 to 11 year age group in the rural area is 3118 and the total is 4684. GER (a) for classes I to V is 109.80 and the total is 107.86. This details are available in Table no. 19.

3.2 Enrolment In classes VI to VIII :

Table 13 and 14 gives us the number of enrolment in classes VI to VIII.

As against the total enrolment in classes VI to VIII in the state (14,97,506 students), in the rural areas the number is 8,53,730.

The total SC enrolment in VI to VIII classes is 1,43,860 that is 9.61% of the total.

The total ST enrolment in the above said classes is 1,65,534 that is 11.05% of the total.

The total enrolment of the girls in classes VI to VIII is 5,81,278 that is 38.81% of the total, in the rural areas it is 309590 (53.26% of total girls enrolment).

The estimated population (in thousands) in the 11 to 14 year age group is received from table 19 is 1853 in the rural areas and in total it is 2734 G.E.R. (b) for classes VI to VIII is 46.08 in the rural areas and in total it 54.77.

3.3 Enrolment in Classes IX to XII

As per the table 15 and 16 the total enrolment in classes IX to XII is 825414 in total.

The enrolment in rural areas it is 348396.

SC enrolment in total is 82753 that is 10.03% of the total.

ST enrolment in total is 76993 that is 9.32% of the total.

The enrolment of the girls in classes IX to XII is 301687 in total out of this total the enrolment of girls in the rural areas is 112146; that is 37.17% of the total of the girls enrolment.

2.4 TEACHERS :

2.4.1 Teachers in P/UP/S/HS Schools

There are totally 2,01,738 teachers in different schools of the state.

The total no. of the Primary teachers as per the table no. 27, is 32069, in Upper Primary Schools is 1,22,327, in the secondary schools 22,325 and in the Higher Secondary School is 25,017.

2.4.2 Percentage of the Female Teachers

As the table 27 gives the information the total no. of the female teachers serving at the Primary level is 12,515, at Upper Primary level is 53,556, at the secondary level is 4266 and at the Higher Secondary level is 6009. The total of all of these is 76,346.

The percentage of female teachers at Primary level is 44.89, Upper Primary level is 40.99, at Secondary level is 21.25 and at the Higher Secondary level is 22.50. This details are based on table no. 32-33.

As per the table no. 28 the percentage of SC and ST teachers at Primary level is 12.90% & 15.28%, at Upper Primary level is 10.43% & 8.22%, at the Secondary level is 3.93% & 5.02% and at the Higher Secondary level is 3.83% and 3.93% respectively.

2.4.3. Single Teacher Schools

As per the table no. 34, there are 4784 single teacher schools out of this total 12,709 are primary schools that is 37.64% of the total.

Out of 4784 single teacher schools 4671 are in the rural areas and 113 are in the urban areas.

The total no. of Primary Schools in the rural areas is 11422, of which 4671 schools are single teacher schools that is 40.89% of the total rural Primary Schools.

As the table 27 provides information the total number of the urban Primary Schools is 113 of which 113 are single teacher schools that is 8.78% of the total.

2.5 BUILDINGS

2.5.1 Primary School Buildings

As per the details given in table 35 and 36 the physical facilities of the schools are as follows:

Out of 12709 Primary schools of the state, 12,415 schools have buildings. Out of the 11,422 Primary schools in the rural areas 11,146 schools have buildings. Thus, 97.69% of the urban and 97.58% of the rural areas schools have buildings.

2.5.2 Types of the Buildings

As per the table no. 36, out of total 1287 schools in the urban areas 1206 (93.70% of the total) schools have partly pucca buildings.

Out of the total 11422 Primary Schools situated in the rural areas, 10,005 schools (i.e. 87.6% of the total) have pucca buildings and 325 schools (2.84% of the total) have partly pucca buildings.

Out of the total 12709 Primary Schools in the state, 11211 schools have pucca and 377 schools have partly pucca buildings. Thus 11,588 schools in total have either pucca or partly pucca buildings. i.e. 91.18% of the total which is a quite good proportion.

2.5.3 Schools with no room

The information based on table no. 36 indicates that the out of the total 12709 schools in the state, 303 (i.e. 2.36%) schools have no room at all. Of which 290 out of the total 11422 rural schools are without room that is 2.53% of the total. In 1287 total urban Primary Schools 13 schools have no room at all. That is 1.01% of the total.

2.5.4 Primary Schools with one room

As table 36 provides details, out of total 12,709 Primary Schools of the state 7739 (60.89%) schools have one room, 7580 (66.36%) schools of the rural areas and 159 (12.35%) schools of the urban areas have one room only.

2.5.5 Primary Schools with two rooms

2666 schools (20.97%) have two rooms. Out of these 2666 schools, 2474 (21.65%) schools are of rural areas and 192 (14.91%) are of urban areas.

2.6 NON FORMAL EDUCATION :

2.6.1. (i) No. of Centres (Primary)

As per the table no. 37 the total number of the centres of non formal education situated in the the urban areas is 20 and in the rural areas 509.

2.6.1. (ii) Enrolment (Primary)

The enrolment in the centres of urban areas is 746 out of this 286 are boys and 460 are girls. While the enrolment in the rural areas is 10021 boys, 5617 girls that makes the total 15638.

2.6.2 No. & Enrolment in Upper Primary Centres

There is no Upper Primary non formal education centre in the state.
