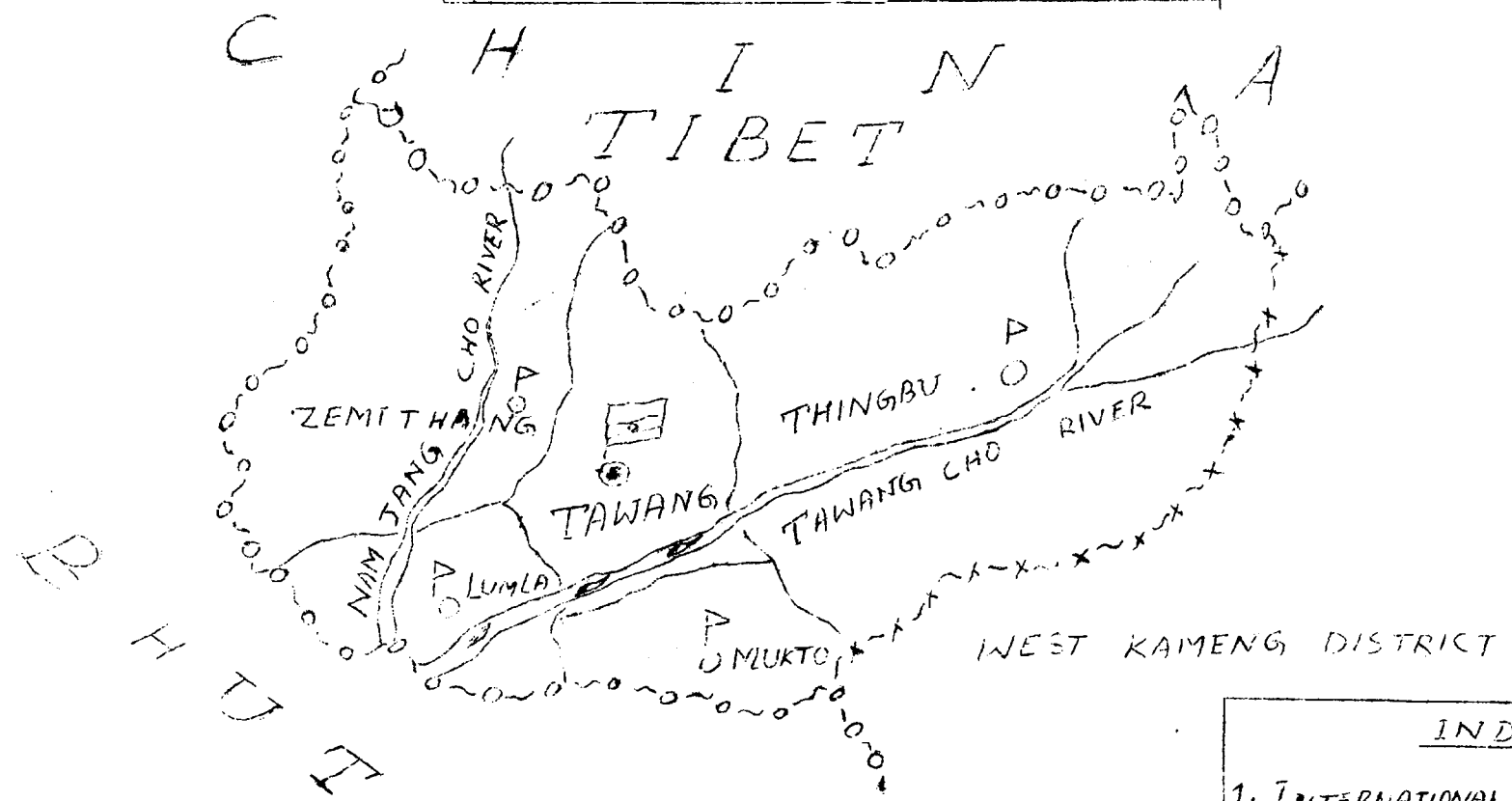

** A SYNOPSIS OF TAWANG DISTRICT **
** **

Tawang district once a Sub-Division of West Kameng district in the early parts of 1984, is situated in the North-Western part of Arunachal Pradesh. This Sub-Division came to be a full-fledged district, carved out from the west Kameng district of Arunachal Pradesh, on 6th October 1984. The area of the district is approximately 2085 sq. Km. bordered by Tibet in the North, Bhutan in the south-west and the sela ranges separates west kameng district in the East.

HISTORICAL GENESIS.

The name of "TAWANG" derives from some bearings on the surroundings. The popular interpretation is that the name "TAWANG" was given by the Mera Lama in the seventeenth century as we found that it was the place where horse "TA" was in excellent "WANG" (Blessings) condition. The other interpretation is that the "TA" horse and "WANG" means pits, a place where horse is kept.

ADMINISTRATION.

The first administrative centre at Tawang was set-up by Maj. J.R. Khating as Ist Assistant Political Officer on 6th February 1951. Previous to this, administration of this area was run by the locals. This area is divided into certain units. This practice of local administration is still invogue among the locals.

PHYSIOGRAPHY.

Two-third of the entire area of the district is approximately of high mountairous region, The highest mountain peak in the district is known as the "GAURICHAN" which is approximately 22,500 ft. from the main sea level. There are two main rivers namely, Tawang-Chu and Nyamjang-Chu. Most of the villages of the district are concentrated on the basins of these two river valleys.

CLIMATE.

The climate of this district during the summer is moderatty cold and **extremely Cold** during the winter. The district has land configuration, the altitude varying from 3,500 ft. to 22,500 ft. With such varying altitudes the flora and fauna of the region are of wide variety mostly of Fire species with blue-pines and a variety of Snow-leopards, Musk-Deer, Talken-Deer, Bears, Barking-Deer, Leopards etc. are found in both mountainous and lower region.

POPULATION.

The population of the district according to census 1981 is 21,735 with an average density of 10.30 persons per sq.Km. The scheduled Tribe and Scheduled cast population is 18,862 and 13 respectively with literacy percentage rate of 14.62 as recorded in 1981 census. The sex ratio indicates 941 females per 1000 males.

INHABITANTS.

The inhabitants of the district are all of Monpa Tribe. The Monpas belong to the Mongoloid stock. They are well built, fair in complexion and medium to tall in structure. They are hospitable, gentle and unassuming in temperament. Their houses are built with stones, timbers and bamboos etc. Popularly known as monpa structure.

OCCUPATION.

Agriculture and animal husbandry are the fundamental means of the Monpas occupation. In addition to these, the Monpas go-in for weaving Bamboo works, Wood carving and work under various departments for earning their livelihood as and when get freed from agriculture works. Some of them have good business acumen, too.

RELIGION AND CULTURE.

The Tawang Monastery known as "GALDEN NAMGYEL LHATSE" in local, is one of the largest Lamaseries in Asia and is one of the most important elements in the social and religious life of the Monpas, believed to have been constructed by Mera Lama Lodre Gyamtso in mid-seventeenth century was said to have been a disciple of an Indian teacher, visited Tibet during the later part of Sixteenth century. The Lamaserie comprise of several sections ranging near-about four hundred years, devoted to love, learning and purity of life.

The Tawang district occupies a unique status amongst the Mahayana sect of Buddhism because of the fact that His Holiness the 6th Dalai Lama was born at Urgelling village near Tawang HQ.

There are two major religious festivals of the Monpas namely "LOSAR" and "TORGYA". Both the festivals are celebrated once annually. The "LOSAR" is celebrated to commemorate the New Year. Every third year of Torgya, the festival of Dugyur is celebrated. Both "Dugyur" and "Torgya" festivals are celebrated at the premises of the Tawang Monastery with traditional gaiety and enthusiasm.
