PREFACE

As a State grows over years, importance of statistical data pertaining to past year also increases. In order to meet the demand of various users of old statistical data, the first issue of this publication was brought out in the year 1983 depicting data from the year 1950-51. The present publication is the sixth issue in the series and like previous publication, has been divided into two parts. Part-I contains absolute information, while Part-II contains some important indicators which may help the users to develop some relations and offer comparison of data over years.

I am thankful to all the Heads of Departments who have helped us in giving shape to this publication by providing very old statistical data. Comments of the users are welcome.

This booklet has been compiled in the official statistics section of this department and I commend the hard work done by the staff of the section.

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INTRODUCTION

Himachal Pradesh came into being on April 15, 1948 as a centrally administered territory by the integration of 30 erstwhile princely hill States. At that time, the State had four districts viz., Chamba, Mandi, Mahasu and Sirmaur and its area was 25,839 square kms.

Later in 1951, it became a part 'C' State under a Governor with a 36 Member legislative Assembly and a three member Cabinet. In 1954, Bilaspur another part 'C' State was merged with Himachal Pradesh there by adding one more district with an area of 1,168 sq. kms. and the strength of its Assembly was raised to 41. On November, 1, 1956, it again became a Union Territory under an Administrator designated as lieutenant Governor and its Assembly was abolished. In 1960, a new border district of Kinnaur was carved out of Mahasu district. Again in 1963, the Assembly was revived and a popular ministry was formed. Till October, 1966, the old Himachal Pradesh comprised the six hill districts of Bilaspur, Chamba, Kinnaur, Mahasu, Mandi and Sirmaur with an area of 27,007 sq. kms. having a population of 13,51,144.

On 1st November, 1966 it was enlarged by merging the districts of Kangra, Shimla, Kullu, Lahaul-Spiti, Nalagarh tehsil of Ambala district, some parts of Una tehsil of Hoshiarpur district and Dalhousie of Gurdaspur district of the then Punjab State. With this merger the total area of Himachal Pradesh increased to 55,673 sq. kms. and its population rose to 21,12,463 (1961 Census). It comprised the Districts of Bilaspur, Chamba, Kangra, Kinnaur, Kullu, Lahaul-Spiti, Mahasu, Mandi, Shimla and Sirmaur. Later on 25th January, 1971 Himachal Pradesh attained Statehood.

Reorganisation of the districts took place on 1st September, 1972. As a consequence two more new districts namely Una and Hamirpur were created as a result of trifurcation of the erstwhile Kangra district. Also from the then existing districts of Mahasu and Shimla, new districts of Shimla and Solan were formed by reorganising the boundaries of old districts.

Presently, Himachal Pradesh comprises 12 districts having an area of 55,673 sq. kms. and a population of 51,70,877 according to 1991 Census. Decennial population growth rate during 1981-91 is 20.79 per cent and sex ratio is 976. Literacy rate has increased to 63.86 per cent in 1991 from 42.48 percent in 1981.
