SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONDITION OF SIRMAUR DISTRICT
DURING 1981-82

1. GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURES

1. Sirmaur District is bounded on the north by Shimla District, on the south and west by Ambala District of Haryana on the east by Dehradun District of Uttar Pradesh. It has six tehsils viz. Nahan, Paonta, Renuka, Rajgarh and Shikhar. According to census of India-1981, the district has three towns and 2965 inhabited villages with a total geographical area of 2825 Square Kilometers.

2. The elevation of the district varies virtually from plains to high hills and ranges between 1,500 feet to 12,000 feet above mean sea level. The climate also change with the altitude and varies from exceedingly hot in southern part to the snowy heights of the northern hills. River Giri, a tributary of the Yamuna divides the district into two parts viz. Trans-Giri and Cis-Giri. The valleys area lie mainly in the Cis-Giri, which have many characteristics of the plains. The Trans-Giri, area is mainly characterised by the features of a backward hilly region and has been identified as backward area for giving more emphasis on its development. The population of the district according to census-1981, is 3,06,952 of which 92% is rural. It is widely scattered and the density of population per square kilometers is 109 persons. The population of Scheduled Caste is 92,155 and the Scheduled Tribes is 4,943 and aggregatively constitute 31.02 percent of the population of the district.

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2--AGRICULTURE

2.1 The economy of the district is predominantly agricultural based with 92% of its population in rural areas. The workers constitute 42.6% of the total population, out of which 71% are cultivators, 6% agricultural labourers and the remaining 23% belong to other categories. This 77% of the working force has to depend directly on agriculture and allied occupations for its subsistence.

2.2 The area of the district according to village papers is 2,24,774 hectares (1981-82). Of this 43,732 hectares is net area sown and 3,859 hectares is fallow land. The gross irrigated area for 1981-82 was 21,821 hectares of which 11,861 hectares was net area irrigated. Thus net area irrigated constitutes 27.12% of the net area sown. In order to make agriculture a lucrative profession, capable of providing sufficient means of livelihood to a large population, intensive agricultural practices are being adopted. The programme of S.F.D.A.-cum-M.F.A.L. in the district constituted an important step in this direction.

2.3 The agroclimatic condition of the district are suitable for the cultivation of cash crops like potato, ginger and sugarcane. Renuka Tehsil is the largest producer of ginger. 9 seed multiplication farms 14 progeny orchards and 3 bee keeping stations continued functioning during the year 1981-82.

HORTICULTURE

The area under various kinds of fruits continued to show an increasing trend and was 8800 hectares in 1981-82. The production of fruits was 9570 tonnes in 1981-82.

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LIVESTOCK AND ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

Total livestock population of the district was 4,12,841 according to livestock census-1977 and the number of poultry birds was of the order of 22,172 during the year 1981-82. There were 62 veterinary institutions (18 Hospitals, 31 Dispensaries and 13 artificial insemination centres) functioning in the district.

3- MEDICAL AND PUBLIC HEALTH

3.1 The number of medical institutions functioning during 1981-82 was 61 comprising of 4 Hospitals, 5 Primary Health Centres, 18 Allopathic Dispensaries and 34 Ayurvedic Dispensaries. The total number of beds available in this district was 438. Thus, bed available per lakh of population are 143. Under the family welfare programme sterilisation operations performed during 1981-82 were 2289 against the target of 2090. During 1981-82, 524 IUD insertions were made and 33843 Nirodhs were distributed.

4- EDUCATION

4.1- There were 535 primary schools, 99 middle schools and 40 high/higher secondary schools, 2 degree colleges/basic training centres and 2 professional institutions functioning during 1981-82. During 1981-82, the number of scholars in the primary, middle and high/higher secondary schools was 14140, 8620 and 7410 respectively. Two degree colleges continued functioning in the district during 1981-82 (One Govt. College at Nahan and One Private College at Paonta Sahib).

5- CO-OPERATION

5.1 The co-operative movement continued to gain momentum in the district. During the year under review 200 co-operative societies were functioning with a total membership of 44,954 persons. Share capital of the societies stood at Rs.46.19 lakhs whereas the working capital was of the order Rs.185.42 lakhs.

6- INDUSTRIES

6.1 The number of registered factories in Sirmaur District during the year 1981-82 was 29 the details of which are given in table 12.1 during 1981-82 the industrial loan worth Rs.1,20,300 was advanced to 11 parties. A sum of Rs.1,49,396.23 (Principal Rs.1,04,079.49 and interest 45,316.74) were recovered. One Industrial Training Institute at Nahan and the second Rural Industrial Training Institute at Paonta-Sahib continued functioning and imparting training.

7- POWER

7.1 Under various electrification programme being executed in the district the total number of electrified villages on 31st March, 1981 stood at 744 thus covering 78% of the number of villages.

8- EMPLOYMENT SITUATION

8.1 The number of employment exchanges functioning in the district is three only. The number of registration on live register as on 31st March, 1982 stood at 2153 vacancies were notified and 196 were filled in during the same period.

9- OTHERS

9.1 Banks :- There are 34 banks functioning in the district of which 8 are in Nahan Tehsil, 12 in Paonta Tehsil, 8 in Pachhad Tehsil, 3 in Shillai Tehsil and 3 in Renuka Tehsil.
