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P R E F A C E

This volume on District Educational Statistics for the State of Himachal Pradesh is the third in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the States and Union Territories. The main aim is to highlight the inter-district variations in a State by giving educational data at district levels with the help of some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentages of trained teachers, per capita expenditure, teacher pupil ratio etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have widened or narrowed down with time the data for the year 1976-77 has been analysed and compared with that for the year 1970-71.

I take this opportunity to express my appreciation of the co-operation received from the Director of Education, Himachal Pradesh and the Project Staff of the Planning, Monitoring and Statistics Division who have prepared this report.

As final figures of expenditure on education were not available only Provisional figures of expenditure have been given throughout this publication.

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I N T R O D U C T I O N

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of Educational Development just as in urbanisation, industrialization, distribution of income & wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector, the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare brings out the publication "Educational Statistics : District-wise" quinquennially.

2. A Volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. Thereafter it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each State every five year by the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry.

3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers and per capita expenditure on education have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and hence the need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

II. AREA AND POPULATION

4. There were 10 districts in Himachal Pradesh in 1971. After re-organisation of the State, there are now twelve districts in 1977. However the total area of the State remained the same after re-organisation. It had an area of 55,673 Sq. Kms. which varied from 1,167 Sq. Kms. in case of Bilaspur district to 12,015 Sq. Kms. in Lahaul and Spiti district.

5. The population of Himachal Pradesh was 34.54 lakhs in 1971. It is estimated to have increased to 39.16 lakhs (19.51 lakhs Males and 19.65 lakhs Females) in 1977. The population was the highest in Kangra (13.25 lakhs) and the lowest in Lahaul & Spiti (0.24 lakh) in 1971. In 1977 also the estimated population varies widely among the 12 re-organised districts from 9.07 lakhs in Kangra to 0.27 lakh in Lahaul & Spiti.

6. The over all density of population per Sq. Km. was 62 in 1971 which is estimated to increase to 70 in 1977. The density of population per Sq. Km. varies widely viz. from 1971, the highest in Una to only 2, the lowest in Lahaul & Spiti in 1977. The area, total population and density of population for different districts in the years 1970-71 and 1976-77 are given in Statement No.2. Table No.1 below gives a general view of extent of variation in Area, Population and density of population in 1977.

7. The total population of the State as well as population of different age groups for the year 1971 and 1977 given in the report are based on the revised population projections (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 have been based on the following formula:-

We assume that,

To get the sex-wise break up of the total population in the various age groups of the district i.e. first of all the girls population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in the above formula total population is replaced by the girls population. The boys enrolment is obtained by the residual method i.e.

Similar formulae are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-groups 11-14 & 14-17 years.

8. The total population of the children in the age-group 6-11 years was 4.92 lakhs in 1977 (2.43 lakhs boys and 2.49 lakhs girls) which formed 12.6% of the total population of the State.

9. Similarly the population in the age-group 11-14 years was 2.79 lakhs in 1977 (1.39 lakhs boys and 1.40 lakhs girls) which constituted 7.1% of the total population.

10. The population in the age-group 14-17 in 1977 was 2.53 lakhs, consisting of 1.25 lakhs boys and 1.28 lakhs girls. This formed 6.5% of the total population.

11. Thus of the total population of 39.16 lakhs of the State, the school going population in the age group 6-17 years was 10.24 lakhs consisting of 5.07 lakhs boys and 5.17 lakhs girls. The population in the age group 6-17 years constituted 26.2% of the total population. Among the males it formed 26.0%, while among the females it formed 26.3%.

III. LITERACY

12. According to the 1971 census the effective literacy rate that is the number of literates per hundred of the population excluding the age group 0-4 in the State was 37.2. The literacy rates for males and females were 50.2 and 23.5 respectively indicating a wide gap between the male and female literacy rates. Details are given in Statement No.7.

IV. GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS :

13. The total number of Educational institutions in Himachal Pradesh was 5,088 in 1970-71 which increased to 5,902 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 16.0% during the period of 6 years. Kangra had the largest share of institutions (17.7%) and Kinnaur had the lowest share (2.1%). District-wise position of Institutions is depicted in Statement No.1.

(b) ENROIMENT :

14. The total enrolment in all the recognised Educational Institutions in the State increased from 5.62 lakhs in 1970-71 to 7.05 lakhs in 1976-77. The increase in enrolment is observed in all the districts. The enrolment increased at an annual average exponential rate of growth of 3.9%. Taking both boys and girls together increase in enrolment was the highest in Kangra followed by Mandi and Simla and was the lowest in Lahaul & Spiti.

15. The percentage of girls which was 32.4 in 1970-71 increased to 36.0 in 1976-77. Among the districts Hamirpur (40.0) had the highest percentage of girls in 1976-77 and the lowest in Chamba (27.8%).

16. The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions as a percentage of total population increased from 16.3 to 18.1 at the State level during the period under consideration. The percentage enrolment increased considerably in all the districts. The percentage enrolment in 1976-77 was the highest in Hamirpur (25.0) and the lowest in Chamba (10.6).

(c) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF S.C. AND S.T.

17. Extent of coverage or coefficient of equality for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes were 74.3% & 75.6% respectively at the State level in 1976-77. Details can be seen in Statements 8 and 9.

(d) TEACHERS :

18. The total number of teachers in all the educational institutions increased from

from 23 thousands in 1970-71 to 28 thousands in 1976-77 showing an annual rate of growth of 3.1% during the period. In 1976-77 the percentage of Trained Teachers was 99.2. This percentage for men teachers was 99.3 and for women teachers 98.9. Among the districts the percentage of trained teachers varied from 97.8 in district of Solan to 100.0 in Kinnaur.

(e) EXPENDITURE (Provisional) :

19. The total expenditure (direct & indirect expenditure) of all recognised educational institutions in the State, was Rs.13.01 crores in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.24.15 crores in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an average annual rate of growth of 14.3%. The expenditure increased in all the districts. The percentage increase in expenditure was the highest in Simla followed by Kangra and Mandi.

20. The expenditure on education per head of population increased from Rs.37.7 in 1970-71 to Rs.61.7 in 1976-77. In four districts the per capita expenditure was more than the state per capita expenditure. The lowest per capita expenditure was observed in Una (47.4) and the highest in Lahaul & Spiti. The district-wise details are given in Statement No.5.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

21. The number of Pre-Primary schools in Himachal Pradesh increased from 12 in 1970-71 to 13 in 1976-77. In 1970-71 there was no pre-primary school in Simla. The total number of teachers in the state slightly increased from 32 in 1970-71 to 41 in 1976-77.

22. The enrolment in Pre-Primary classes increased from 1,876 to 3,757 during the period of 6 years. This shows an annual average exponential growth rate of 12.7%. Simla had the highest enrolment of 1,069 followed by 771 in Kulu.

23. The expenditure on pre-primary schools decreased from Rs.1,34,837 to Rs.1,01,315 during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77.

VI. PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

24. The total number of primary schools in Himachal Pradesh increased from 3,768 in 1970-71 to 4,276 in 1976-77. This shows an increase of 13.5% during the period of 6 years. The highest percentage of primary schools was in Kangra district (17.1%).

25. In 1970-71, a primary school had to serve, on an average, an area of 14.8 Sq. Kms. The position improved in 1976-77 as a primary school was serving an area of 13 Sq. Kms. The average area served by a primary school was more than the State average in case of four districts viz. Lahaul & Spiti (119.0 Sq. Kms) followed by Kinnaur (72.8 Sq. Kms)

26. The population served by a primary school in the state decreased slightly from 917 to 916 during the period of the 6 years. In 1976-77 a primary school served a population of 1,582 in Hamirpur district. Among the other districts, the population served by a primary school varied from 264 in Lahaul & Spiti to 1,582 in Hamirpur. The district-wise details are given in statement-11.

27. Total number of teachers in primary schools in Himachal Pradesh also increased from 7,828 in 1970-71 to 8,191 in 1976-77. This shows an average growth rate of 0.77% during the period under consideration. During the period of 6 years, there was an increase in the number of teachers in all the districts. The number of women teachers formed 26.1% of the total number of teachers in 1976-77.

(b) ENROLMENT :

28. In 1970-71, the total enrolment in primary schools in Himachal Pradesh was 2.18 lakhs which increased to 2.54 lakhs in 1976-77. In classes I-V, the enrolment which stood at 3.71 lakhs (2.33 lakhs boys and 1.38 lakhs girls) increased to 4.72 lakhs (2.81 lakhs boys and 1.91 lakhs girls) in 1976-77. This shows an average exponential growth rate of 4.1% per annum. The average exponential enrolment growth rates in these classes were 3.1% and 6.1% separately for boys and girls which is showing that better progress has been made in girls education in the State.

29. The percentage enrolment in classes I-V to the total population in the age group 6-11 (also called enrolment ratio) give an index of the facilities created at the primary stage of education. In Himachal Pradesh this percentage increased from 80.1 to 95.8 during the period of 6 years. In case of boys alone the increase was from 99.0% in 1970-71 to 115.5% in 1976-77 and in case of girls from 60.5% to 76.7% during the same period. Taking boys and girls together, the enrolment ratio in 1976-77 was more than 100 in four districts whereas 7 districts enrolment was less than the State average of 95.8%.

(c) ENROIMENT OF S.C. AND S.T.

30. Of the total enrolment 3.71 lakhs in classes I-V in 1970-71, 60,751 belonged to the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes. They formed 16.4% of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1976-77 the total enrolment was 4.72 lakhs in classes I-V. There were 88,465 students belonging to scheduled castes which formed 18.7% of the total enrolment in these classes. The percentage of S.C. population to total population was 22.2. The co-efficient of equality*, therefore, comes to nearly 84.2%. Similarly 16,083 students belonged to scheduled tribes which formed 3.4% of the total enrolment in these classes. The district wise details are given in Statement No.12 and 13.

(d) EXPENDITURE (Provisional) :

31. The total expenditure on primary schools in Himachal Pradesh increased from Rs.325.16 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.503.43 lakhs in 1976-77. This gives an average annual growth rate of 9.1% during the period under consideration.

32. The per capita expenditure on primary schools in the State was Rs.9.4 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.13.0 by 1976-77. The per capita expenditure was minimum in Kulu (Rs.7.1) and maximum in Kinnaur (Rs.48.8) in 1976-77.

33. The total expenditure on primary schools in 1970-71 formed 25.0% of the total expenditure on education in Himachal Pradesh. In 1976-77 this percentage decreased to 20.8. In 8 districts, the percentage expenditure on primary schools was more than the State average. Expenditure on primary schools as percentage of total expenditure in education was the highest in Kinnaur (Rs.59.6) and the lowest in Simla (Rs.10.5).

34. The cost per student in primary schools increased from Rs.149.4 in 1970-71 to Rs.198.2 in 1976-77. Among the districts, the cost per student was the highest in Kinnaur (Rs.930.1) followed by Lahaul & Spiti (Rs.644). In case of primary education there is a negative correlation between the cost per student and the teacher pupil ratio. The cost per student is the lowest where the teacher pupil ratio is the highest. The teacher pupil ratio decreased from 28 to 31 during the period under consideration. The pupil teacher ratio varied from 13 in Lahaul & Spiti to 43 in Hamirpur and Kangra. The details can be seen from Statement 14.

VII. MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

35. The total number of Middle schools in the State increased from 742 in 1970-71 to 968 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 30.5% during the period of Six years. In 1976-77 the highest percentage increase in the number of Middle schools was recorded in Kangra district (17.8%).

36. In 1970-71, a Middle school had to serve on an average, an area of 75.0 Sq. Kms. The position improved considerably in 1976-77 as a Middle school was then available for every 57.5 Sq. Kms. area. In 1976-77 the average area served by a Middle school was more than the State average in four districts. The area served by a Middle school was the minimum in the hilly districts of Lahaul & Spiti (667.5 Sq. Kms.), Kinnaur (344.9 Sq. Kms.), Kulu (110.9 Sq. Kms.) and Chamba (106.4 Sq. Kms.).

37. The population served by a Middle school of the State decreased from 4,655 to 4,045 during the period of 6 years. Among the districts, the population served by a middle school varied from as low as 1,483 in Lahaul & Spiti to as high as 5,576 in Una. The details are given in Statement No.15. During the same period the number of teachers in the middle schools also increased from 6,230 to 8,020 showing an increase of 28.7% during the period under consideration.

(b) ENROLMENT :

38. The total enrolment in middle schools which was 1.27 lakhs in 1970-71 increased to 1.81 lakhs in 1976-77, whereas the ~~enrolment at the middle stage~~

increased from 1.18 lakhs (89 thousand boys and 29 thousand girls) in 1970-71 to 1.44 lakhs (1.03 lakhs boys and 41 thousand girls) in 1976-77. This shows an average exponential growth rate of 3.4% per annum during the period under consideration. The average exponential growth rates of enrolment in these classes were 2.4% and 5.9% separately for boys and girls.

39. The percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age group 11-14 gives an index of facilities created at the Middle stage education. In Himachal Pradesh this percentage increased from 47.1 to 51.5 during the period of 6 years. In case of boys alone the increase was from 69.8% in 1970-71 to 74.1% in 1976-77 and in case of girls it increased from 23.5% to 29.1% during the period under consideration. Taking both boys and girls together, the percentage enrolment in case of 4 districts was more than the corresponding state percentage in 1976-77. This percentage indicates a wide gulf between the education of boys and girls. This disparity between the two sexes did exist in all the districts of the state. The highest enrolment ratio in respect of girls was in Hamirpur (44.5), whereas, the lowest was in Kinnaur (11.6). The details may be seen in Statement No.16.

(c) ENROIMENT OF S.C. AND S.T. :

40. Of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII 17,416 students belonged to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes in 1970-71. Of the total enrolment 18,483 students belonged to scheduled castes in 1976-77. forming 12.8% of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII. The percentage of S.C. population to total population was 22.2. Thus the co-efficient of equality comes out nearly 57.7%. Similarly 3,616 students belonging to scheduled tribes formed 2.5%

of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII in 1976-77.

(d) EXPENDITURE - (Provisional) :

41. The total expenditure on middle schools increased from Rs.306.26 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.585.05 lakhs in 1976-77, showing an annual average growth rate of 15.2% during the period under consideration.

42. The per capita expenditure in the state was only Rs.8.9 in 1970-71, which increased to Rs.14.9 in 1976-77. Each district has recorded an increase in the per capita expenditure except Chamba district in which there is slight decline. The range of its variation among the districts was from Rs.11.3 to Rs.38.7.

43. The total expenditure on middle schools in 1970-71 formed 23.5% of the total expenditure on education in the state. By 1976-77 this percentage increased to 24.2%. In 9 districts, the percentage expenditure on middle schools was more than the state average.

44. The cost per student in middle school which was Rs.242.0 in 1970-71 increased to Rs.323.3 in 1976-77, at the state level. Among the districts the cost per student ranged from Rs.192.3 in Una to Rs.1202.7 in Lahaul & Spiti. In 1976-77 pupil teacher ratio was 23 and the same varied from 8 in Lahaul & Spiti to 33 in Hamirpur and Una. Further details can be seen in statement No.18.

VIII. HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

45. The number of high/higher secondary schools in Himachal Pradesh increased from 435 in 1970-71 to 559 in 1976-77. This shows an increase of 28.5% during the period under review. The increase in number of high/higher secondary schools was shared by all the districts except Kangra in case of which the number of schools decreased during the period under consideration. Among the districts the number of high/higher secondary schools were the maximum in Kangra forming 22.7% of total number of schools in the State followed by Simla (15.7%).

46. On an average, there was a high/higher secondary school for every 128 Sq. Kms. in Himachal Pradesh in 1970-71. By 1976-77 a high/higher secondary school was available for every 99.6 Sq. Kms. There was a high/higher secondary school in Una district for every 32.6 Sq. Kms. of area. In Lahaul & Spiti district, one high/higher secondary school was available for an area of 1335.0 Sq. Kms.

47. At the State level, on an average, there was a high/higher secondary school for every 7,941 persons in 1970-71. By 1976-77, a high/higher secondary school was available for every 7,005 persons. Among the districts the average population covered by a high/higher secondary school varied from as high as 10,875 in Kulu to as low as 2,961 in Lahaul & Spiti.

48. The total number of teachers in high/higher secondary schools in Himachal Pradesh increased from 8,008 in 1970-71 to 9,967 ^{in 1976-77,} showing an increase of 24.5% during the period under consideration. During the period of 6 years, there was an increase in the number of teachers in all the districts. Women teachers formed 31.3% of the total number of teachers in 1976-77.

(b) ENROLMENT :

49. The total enrolment in high/higher secondary schools in 1970-71 in Himachal Pradesh which was 1,99,211, increased to 2,49,989 in 1976-77. This shows an average annual exponential growth rate of 3.8% during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. The enrolment of the secondary and higher secondary stage i.e. in classes IX-XI was 54,284 (42,741 boys and 11,543 girls) in 1970-71 which increased to 66,445 (50,545 boys and 15,900 girls) in 1976-77. Showing an average exponential growth rate of 3.4% at this stage during this period. Corresponding growth rates for the boys and the girls were 2.8% and 5.4% during the period under consideration. Among the districts, the percentage increase in enrolment in these classes varied widely.

50. For the state as a whole the enrolment ratio at the high/higher secondary stage (classes IX-XI) was 24.4% in 1970-71 which increased to 25.2% by 1976-77. In case of boys it increased from 38.1% to 40.3%, while in case of girls from 10.5% to 12.4%. In case of Kulu and Simla districts the enrolment ratio decreased slightly from 13.9 to 13.0 and 31.2 to

23.7 respectively. In Lahaul and Spiti district there was appreciable increase in the enrolment ratio from 9.0 to 19.6. The enrolment ratio was the highest in Hamirpur (44.1) and the lowest in Kinnaur (8.7).

(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T. :

51. In 1970-71 of the total enrolment in classes IX-XI 6,292 students belonged to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes which formed 11.6% of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1976-77 there were 7,232 students belonging to scheduled castes and 1,342 scheduled tribes. The percentage of S.C. and S.T. students to total enrolment in these classes were 10.9 and 2.0 respectively where as the percentages of S.C. and S.T. population to the total population in the State were 22.2 and 4.1 respectively. The co-efficient of equality for the scheduled caste and the scheduled tribe students in these classes were 49.1% and 48.8% respectively. The details of enrolment and percentages can be seen in the Statement No.21.

(d) EXPENDITURE (Provisional) :

52. The total expenditure on high/higher secondary schools in the State increased from Rs.500.49 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.880.58 lakhs in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an annual growth rate of 12.7% during the period.

53. The percapita expenditure on high/higher secondary schools at the state level was Rs.14.5 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.22.5 by 1976-77. The per capita expenditure

on high/higher secondary schools was the highest in Lahaul & Spiti (Rs.57.4) and the lowest in Sirmur (Rs.14.6).

54. The total expenditure on high/higher secondary schools in 1976-77 formed 38.5% of the total expenditure on education in Himachal Pradesh. By 1976-77 this percentage slightly decreased to 36.5, In 6 districts, the percentage expenditure spent on high/higher secondary schools, was more than the state average. The expenditure on high/higher secondary schools as percentage of total expenditure on education was the highest in Hamirpur (Rs.45.5) and the lowest in Sirmur (Rs.28.0).

55. The cost per student in high/higher secondary schools has increased from Rs.251.2 to Rs.352.2 during the period of 6 years. In case of high/higher secondary education there is negative correlation between the cost per student and the pupil teacher ratio. The pupil teacher ratio is the lowest where the cost per student is the highest. The pupil teacher ratio remained static at state level during the period under consideration. In 1976-77 the pupil teacher ratio varied from 11 in Lahaul & Spiti to 32 in Hamirpur. The details can be seen in statement No.22.

IX. PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION.

56. The number of Schools for Vocational, Professional, Special and other education increased from 73 in 1970-71 to 23 + 694 (Social adult educational institutions, district-wise break up is not available) in 1976-77.

57. The total enrolment in Professional and Vocational (School) education also increased from 2,863 (2,369 boys and 494 girls) in 1970-71 to 2,458 + 15,424 enrolment in (social adult educational institutions district-wise break up of which is not available). This constitutes 1811+7832 boys and 647+7592 girls. In professional and vocational (school) education the enrolment of S.C. & S.T. students was 315 (288 boys and 27 girls) in 1970-71. This enrolment increased to 350+4454 (social adult education) for scheduled caste students and 60+1724 (social adult education) for scheduled tribe students by 1976-77. The break-up of enrolment for S.C. & S.T. students in social adult education has not been available for different districts. The number of teachers also increased from 69 in 1970-71 to 89+694 in 1976-77.

58. The total expenditure on these institutions increased from Rs.6,37,421 to Rs.13,18,619 + Rs.2,57,151 relating to expenditure on social adult education institutions for which district-wise break-up is not available. During the period under review, district-wise information on professional, vocational, special and other education (school) can be seen from statement No.23.

HIGHER EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

59. Regarding Institutions for higher education there was only one University at Simla in 1970-71. By 1976-77 there were two institutions i.e. one university at Simla and one Research Institution at Solan District. In 1976-77 there were only 60 affiliated institutions (43 degree level and 17 below degree. Of the degree level affiliated institutions 25 were arts and science colleges, 2 Agriculture, 1 Forestry college, 3 Education, one Medical and 12 other colleges. There was no Arts & Science college in the districts of Kinnaur and Lahaul & Spiti where as Kangra and Simla each has 5 degree level colleges. There is one Board of Intermediate education in the state at Simla. The total number of institutions of higher education increased from 58 to 63 during the period under consideration. Details can be seen from Statement No.24.

60. Statement No.24 also gives district-wise statistics of teachers in the institutions of higher education in Himachal Pradesh. Total number of teachers in these institutions was 996 in 1970-71 which increased to 1,238 in 1976-77. The highest number of teachers in higher education institutions was in Simla (356) and the lowest in Bilaspur (39).

(b) ENROIMENT :

61. The total enrolment in institutions of higher education in the state was 17,983 in 1976-77. Of this, 11,561 students were studying in Arts and Science colleges, 521 in

Agriculture and Forestry, 237 in Education, 315 in Medical colleges, 1,161 in other, colleges and 1,157 students were studying in university and Research institution one each only in the state. The total enrolment in institutions for higher education was the highest in Simla (5,628) and the lowest in Chamba (519). District-wise details are given in Statement No.25.

62. Statement No.26 gives the enrolment in higher education by stages. The total enrolment at this stage increased from 14,522 (11,695 boys and 2,827 girls) in 1970-71 to 16,083 (12,386 boys and 3,697 girls) in 1976-77. Showing an average exponential growth rate of 1.6% per annum. Of the total enrolment during 1976-77 nearly 12,188 students were enrolled for General education and 3,895 in professional education. The enrolment at this level increased in all the districts except Bilaspur and Kulu.

(c) ENROIMENT OF S.C. AND S.T. :

63. There were 1,293 students belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes communities studying for higher education in 1970-71. This formed 8.9% of the total enrolment in higher education institutions.

64. Similarly 1,359 scheduled castes and 659 scheduled tribes studying for higher education in 1976-77 formed 8.4% and 4.1% of the total corresponding enrolment respectively in higher education classes at the state level. The co-efficient of equality of S.C. and S.T. students at the higher education stage were 38.3% and 100% respectively.

(d) EXPENDITURE :

65. The total expenditure on higher education in the state increased from Rs.146.83 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.431.49 lakhs (Provisional) in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an average annual growth rate of 32.3% during the period under review.

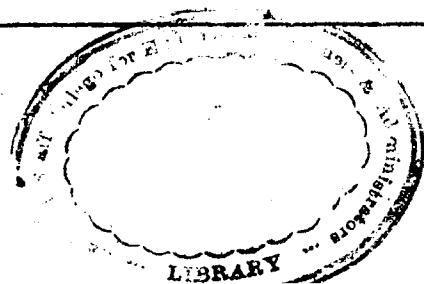
