This volume of District Educational Statistics for the state of Himachal Pradesh is the eighth in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the States and Union Territories for the quinquennial year 1981-82. The main aim is to highlight the inter-district variations in a State by giving educational data at district levels with the help of some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentages of trained teachers, teacher pupil ratio etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have added or narrowed down with time, the data for the year 1981-82 has been compared with that for the year 1976-77.

I N T R O D U C T I O N

"Regional imbalances exist in the field of Educational Development too just as in Urbanisation, industrialisation, distribution of income & wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector, the Deptt. of Education of the Ministry of Human Resource Development brings out the publication "Educational Statistics-District-wise" quinquennially

2 A volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research & Training in 1960-61. Thereafter it was decided that such reviewing will be brought out in respect of each state every five year by the Deptt. of Education of the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry in respect of some states. However for the quinquennial year 1976-77, such reviews were brought out for all the states and Union Territories having legislatures.

3. For making inter-districts comparison possible some important indices such as enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers and teacher-pupil ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and are of much need for formulating educational plans at district level.

II. AREA AND POPULATION

4. Administratively there are 12 districts in Himachal Pradesh. The area of the State is 55,673 sq. kms. which varies from 1118 sq. kms. in the case of Hamirpur District to 13,835 sq. kms. in Lahaul and Spiti district. The estimated population which was 39.16 lakhs in 1976-77 increased to 42.81 lakhs in 1981-82, (21.69 lakhs males and 21.12 lakh females). The population was the highest in Kangra district and lowest in Lahaul & spiti.

5. The over-all density of population per sq. km. in 1977 was 70 which slightly reduced to 69 in 1981. The density of population per sq. Km. varies widely from 269 in Hamirpur district to 2 in Lahaul and spiti. The area, total population and density of population for different districts in the year 1976-77 and 1981-82 are given in Statement No. 2. Table No. 1 below gives a general view of extent of variation in Area, Population and density of population in 1981.

7. The total population of the state as well as population of different age groups for the year 1977 are based on the revised population projections (as on 1st March of the year) and that of the year 1981 is based on the actual census data available from the office of the Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 have been worked out using the following formula:-

We assume that,

$$\frac{P_{6-11}}{P} = \frac{P_{i6-11}}{P_i} = K$$

$$P_{i6-11} = KP_i$$

Where K is estimated from the equation $K = \frac{P_{6-11}}{P}$

- P_{6-11} - denote 6-11 age group population of the state
 P - Total population of the state.
 P_i - 6-11 age group population of the i th District.
 P_i - Total population of the i th District.

8. To get the sex-wise break up of the total population in the various age-groups of the districts, first of all, the girls' population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in the above formula total population is replaced by girls' population. The boys enrolment is obtained by the residual method as
- $$\text{Boys population in the age group 6-11} = \text{Total population in the age group 6-11} - \text{Girls population in the age-group 6-11}$$
9. Similar formulae are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age group 11-14 & 14-17 years.
10. The total population of the children in the age group 6-11 years was 5.72 lakhs in 1981 (2.91 lakh boys and 2.81 lakh girls) which formed 13.3% of the total population of the State.
11. Similarly the population in the age-group 11-14 years was 3.34 lakhs in 1981 (1.71 lakh boys & 1.63 lakh girls) which constituted 7.8% of the total population.
12. The population in the age-group 14-17 in 1981 was 2.88 lakhs which was 6.7% of the total population.
13. Out of the total population of 42.81 lakhs the school-going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 11.95 lakhs (6.07 lakhs boys and 5.88 lakhs girls) which constituted 27.9% of the total population (males 27.9% & females 27.8%).

III. Literacy

According to the 1981 census the effective literacy rate i.e. the number of literates per hundred of the population excluding the age-group 0-4 in the state was 42.5% males 53.2% and females 31.5%. The details are given in Statement No. 7.

General view :

15. INSTITUTIONS The total number of educational institutions at school level in Himachal Pradesh was 6533 in 1976-77 which increased to 8824 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 35.1% during the period of five years. Kangra district has the largest share of institutions (18.0%) and Lahaul and spiti the lowest share (2.2%) in 1981-82. The district-wise position of number of educational institution is given in statement No. 1.

16. ENROLMENT The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions in the State increased from 7.04 lakhs in 1976-77 to 8.85 lakhs in 1981-82. Increase in enrolment has been reported in all the districts except in case of Bilaspur, Hamirpur, Kangra, Sirmur and Una. The enrolment increased at an annual average exponential rate of growth of 4.03%. Kangra had the highest share of enrolment i.e. 26.5% where as Lahaul and spiti had the lowest share of 0.5% during 1981-82.

17. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment in 1976-77 was 36.6% which increased to 39.9% in 1981-82, marking an improvement in the percentage improvement of girls in all districts. Percentage enrolment of girls' to total enrolment is given in Statement

No. 4.

18. TEACHERS: The total number of teachers in 1981-82 was 30556 as compared to 27002 in 1976-77. The increase in number of teachers has been observed in all the districts. There were 8373 women teachers in 1981-82 forming 27.4% of the total ^{number of teachers}. Kangra district has the largest number of women teachers i.e. 2342 where as Kinnaur had only 71 women teachers. Out of 30,556 teachers 29,314 were trained. The percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers is 95.9% (16.0% trained men and 95.7% trained women teachers). Among districts percentage of trained teachers varied from 92.7% in Kullu to 97.2% in Kangra district. District-wise details are given in Statement No. 5.

19. EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES.

Extent of coverage is defined as $I = \frac{\text{Percentage of Enrolment of SC/ST to Total Enrolment}}{\text{Percentage of population of SC/ST to total Population}}$

The literacy rates of general population that of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes is given in Statement No. 6. A total number of 175808 Scheduled Caste students were enrolled in 1981-82. Out of which 110362 were boys & 65446 were girls. The percentage of Scheduled Caste enrolment to total enrolment was 19.9% (20.7% boys & 18.5% girls). The district of Solan registered 24.7% whereas Lahaul & Spiti registered only 0.6% enrolment among Scheduled Castes compared to total enrolment. Percentage of Scheduled Castes to total population is 24.6 in 1981-82 for the state as a whole. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes in school education comes to 80.9% at state level. In districts the coverage varied from 20.0% in Kinnaur district to 26.1% in Lahaul and spiti. District-wise details are given in Statement No. 7.

20. Enrolment percentage of Scheduled tribes to total enrolment is 3.4% for boys and 2.3% for girls in 1981-82. The percentage is the highest in Lahaul and spiti i.e. 90.3%. The percentage of Scheduled Tribes to the total population is 4.6% for the state as a whole. The extent of coverage for this community works out to 55.1% at state level. Statement No. 8 shows district-wise details. The extent of coverage is highest in Kullu (132.36% and lowest in Hamirpur and Una.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION :

21. The number of recognised Pre-Primary schools decreased to 10 in 1981-82, from 13 in 1976-77. Enrolment in Pre-Primary schools in 1976-77 was 806 and it reduced to 583 in 1981-82. 3968 children were enrolled in different classes in Pre-Primary stage out of which 238 were Scheduled Castes. The district of Shimla registered 1045 children out of which 89 were Scheduled Castes. District-wise break up is given in Statement No. 9.

Enrolment of Scheduled Caste children in 1981-82 was 23 out of which 17 were boys and 6 girls. 22 teachers were there, all trained ladies.

23. In rural areas, the total enrolment in schools was 19 out of which 10 were girls. Enrolment at Pre-Primary stage as a whole was 1413, (850 Boys & 563 girls) Details are given in Statement 10.

VI. PRIMARY EDUCATION :

24. The total number of Primary Schools increased from 4276 in 1976-77 to 6227 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 3.7% over the five year period. Kangra had the largest number of schools i.e. 1131 whereas Kinnaur had only 134.

25. In 1976-77 a primary school served 13.0 sq. km. of area. In five years the position improved marginally had a primary school was available for 9.1 sq. km. In Bilaspur district the average area served by a Primary school was minimum in 1976-77 as well as in 1981-82. In 1976-77 a primary school in Bilaspur district served 6 sq. km. and it reduced to 3.8 sq. km. in 1981-82.

26. The average population served by a Primary School in the state was 916 in 1976-77 and it came down to 687 in 1981-82. Among the districts the average population served by a primary school varied from 10021 in Hamirpur district to 221 in Lahaul and spiti.

27. The total enrolment in classes I-V increased from 4.72 lakhs in 1976-77 to 5.66 lakhs in 1981-82 (2.82 lakhs boys and 1.90 lakhs girls in 1976-77) and (3.20 lakhs boys & 2.46 lakhs girls in 1981-82) showing an average annual increase of 3.32 per annum. The enrolment growth rates in these classes separately for boys and girls were 2.44% & 4.47% respectively.

28. The percentage of enrolment in classes I-V to the corresponding population in the age-group 6-11 (also called Enrolment ratio) gives an index of the facilities created at the primary stage of education. In Himachal Pradesh the enrolment ratio increased from 95.8 to 98.8 during the said period of 5 years.

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES :

29. In 1976-77 the Scheduled Castes formed 18.7% of the total enrolment in classes I-V. In 1981-82, 1.29 lakh Scheduled Castes were enrolled and the enrolment percentage was 22.7%. The district of Kangra showed the highest number of Scheduled Castes enrolled in 1981-82, reaching 30874 in classes I-V while Lahaul & Spiti enrolled only 23 children. Sex-wise details are given in Statement No. 14.

30. Similarly, in 1976-77, 3.4% of Scheduled Tribe students were enrolled out of the total students enrolled in classes I-V, whereas in 1981-82, 3.3% ST, student were enrolled. In 1981-82 there were 18598 ST students in the age group 6-11. In the district of Una no Scheduled tribe was enrolled. Whereas Chamba district showed the largest enrolment of 8461 scheduled tribes. In the district of Lahaul and Spiti 99.1% of the students enrolled were Scheduled Tribes.

EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS :

31. In 1981-82, there were 6077 Primary schools in rural areas and 5,27,115 children were enrolled in these schools.

32. Out of a total number of 32815 habitations, 5630 were having Primary schools in them. Up to a distance of 1 Km., there were 12665 primary schools and upto 2 Kms. there were 8558 primary schools.

VII. MIDDLE EDUCATION :

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

33. The total number of middle schools in the state increased from 968 in 1976-77 to 1049 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 8.37% during the period of five years. The Kangra district had 195 schools while Lahaul and Spiti had 17 schools only.

34. The average population served by middle school in Himachal Pradesh in 1976-77 was 57.5 sq. kms whereas in 1981 it reduced to 54 sq. kms. In 1981-82 in Hamirpur district 9 middle schools served an average of 17.5 sq. kms. A maximum of 813.8 sq. kms. was served by a middle school in Lahaul and spiti.

35. The average population served by a middle school in Himachal Pradesh in 1976-77 was 4045 but the number increased to 4080 in 1981-82. Details are given in Statement No. 18.

36. Enrolment at the middle stage increased from 1,43,867 in 1976-77 to 218,585 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 51.93% over the five year period. There was a marked improvement in the enrolment of girls. It increased from 40834 in 1976-77 to 72676 in 1981-82. In the middle stage also the district of Kangra registered maximum number of enrolment in 1982-82 i.e. 61,365 out of which 39762 were boys and 21603 were girls.

37. In 1981-82, there were 5512 teachers teaching in the middle schools out of which 99.4% were trained teachers. The teacher-pupil ratio was 16. Among districts the maximum number of teachers were in Kangra district (1003) and the minimum number was in Lahaul & Spiti (84). The lowest percentage of trained lady teachers was in Bilaspur district and it was 99.1%.

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES :

38. In 1976-77, 18483 Scheduled Caste students were enrolled out of which 15,025 were boys and 3458 were girls forming 12.8% of the total enrolment at middle stage. In 1981-82, the position has doubled itself to a total of 37170 Scheduled Caste students. (26642 boys and 10528 girls) forming 17% of the total enrolment where 18.2% were boys and 14.5% were girls. The district of Solam has maximum 21.1% Scheduled Caste students.

39. In 1981-82, 5837 students were Scheduled Tribes enrolled in the middle stage, its number was 3616 in 1976-77, marking an average annual increase of 12.38%.

CAUTIONS TO BE OBSERVED
IN THE MIDDLE STAGE

INSTITUTIONS AND ENROLMENT IN RURAL AREAS IN MIDDLE STAGE

40. Out of the total enrolment of 2,18,585 in 1981-82, 1,90,139 students were enrolled in rural areas in the classes VI-VIII. There were 1019 Middle schools in such areas out of which 39% were housed in pucca buildings.

VIII. HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION:

41. In 1976-77, there were 559 High/Higher Secondary Schools in Himachal Pradesh whose number increased to 691 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 23.6% with in a period of 5 Years. The district of Kangra had a maximum of 158 High/Higher Secondary Schools whereas Lahaul and Spiti had only 13 such schools in 1981-82.

42. On an average in 1976-77, 99.6 sq. kms. were served by a High/Higher Secondary School. This position improved in 1981-82 and a High/Higher Secondary School was available for every 82 sq. kms. District-wise details are given in Statement No. 25.

43. On an average at the state level, there was a High/Higher Secondary School for 7005 persons in 1976-77, the position improved in 1981-82 as a High/Higher Secondary School had served 6195 persons.

44. Among the districts, the average population covered by a High/Higher Secondary School varied from 3567 to 9181 in Lahaul & Spiti & Kullu Districts respectively.

ENROLMENT:

45. The total enrolment in Classes IX-XI/XII in 1976-77 was 66445 which increased to 73705 in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 2.10%.

46. There was a 10.9% increase in enrolment in classes IX-XI/XII during the five year period from 1976-77 to 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Statement No. 26.

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES :-

47. Of the total enrolment of 73705 in 1981-82 in classes IX-XI 9754 students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 1854 students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 13.23% and 2.50% respectively of the total enrolment in these classes. The Kangra district had the largest number of Scheduled Castes enrolled in Classes IX-XI their number being 2290 and as for Scheduled Tribes the Chamba district stood first, enrolling 474 students in these classes. Details are given in Statement No., 28 and 29.

HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS :

48. Himachal Pradesh had a total number of 691 schools in 1981-82 out of which 588 were located in rural areas. Kangra district had the maximum number of 139 schools 63% of the rural schools had pucca school buildings. Out of the total enrolment 168417 students were enrolled, of which 57438 were boys and 14267 were girls. Details are given in Statement No. 30. * in rural High/Higher Secondary Schools. In classes IX-XI a total of 71705 students were enrolled.

49. RETENTION

Statement No. 31 gives district-wise enrolment in classes I-VIII. In the year 1981-82 Figures in parenthesis indicates percentage enrolment in each class compared to the total enrolment in Class I. This statement shows the usual declining trend in enrolment because of the increasing number of dropouts. In 1981-82 the retention rate for class II was 81.4% which declined to 40.7% for class VIII. All districts show a similiary downward trend. These indicated low retention rate for higher classes.

PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER SCHOOL EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS:

50. The number of schools for professional, vocational, special and other (school) education

school in the state increased from 717 in 1976-77 to 847 in 1981-82 showing an annual increase of 3.63% during the period under review. The district of Kangra had largest number of such institutions i.e. 104 while Lahaul and Spiti had only 20 such institutions only. The number of teachers in these schools increased from 783 in 1976-77 to 966 in 1981-82.

ENROLMENT:

51. The total enrolment in professional, vocational, special and other education schools also increased from 16355 in 1976-77 to 20692 in 1981-82 (91235 boys & 11569 girls) showing an average annual increase of 5.30%. In 1976-77, there were 4804 Scheduled Caste and 1784 Scheduled Tribe students in such courses and the number increased to 5873 and 1946 respectively by 1981-82. Details are given in Statement No. 32.
