A SYNOPSIS OF EAST SIANG DISTRICT

INTRODUCTION

East Siang is one of the important district of the state of Arunachal Pradesh. The district has an area of 6512 Sq.Km. with a population of 70,451. It is bounded by Dibang valley district in the East, West Siang in the North and West and Lakhimpur district of Assam in the South. Prior to 1st June 1930 when it became full fledged district, it was an independent Sub-Division under an Addl. Deputy Commissioner of the Erstwhile Siang District. The name Siang has been derived from the Siang River which is better known to outsiders as Brahmaputra. Siang is the local dialect of Adi inhabitants of the valley means artery of river.

HISTORICAL GENESIS:

The evolution of this district has followed a chequered path. Pasighat, its present district Head quarter however, has been its nucleus, although this evolution. Pasighat was originally a Sub-Division of the then Frontier Tract. The division of the Tract into two independent units viz. Nisimi Hills and Abor Hills districts which later became Lohit and Siang districts respectively made Pasighat the District HQ of Siang frontier Division. In 1953, Along was made the district HQ of Siang retegating Pasighat to the Status of Sub-Divisional HQ. under the overall control of an Asstt. Political Officer. In the month of November 1956 the Pasighat Sub-division was elevated to the status of an independent Sub-division under the overall control of an Addl. Political Officer with enhanced powers in Judicial, Financial and Administrative matters. In the year 1965, the Addl. Political Officer, Pasighat was redesignated as Addl. Deputy Commissioner. Finally on the 1st June 1980, East Siang District came into being with Pasighat as its district HQ.

PHYSIOGRAPHY

East Siang district is lying approximately between $27^{\circ}43'$ and $29^{\circ}20'$ North Latitudes and $94^{\circ}42'$ and $95^{\circ}35'$ East Longitudes. It covers an area of 6512 Sq.Km. The topography of the district is mountainous in the North while gradually descending Southward till it culminates in the plains of Assam. The sivalik foothills lose identity and the lower Himalaya Ridges loose its width of the trend in East Siang district. River siang (with its major tributaries such Yamne, Siyum, Siku and Simong) is the major river of the district. It has in general a Southernly flow till its confluence with the Siyum river. On its course the river siang, with its innumerable small & large subsequent and obsequent tributaries sculptured the present landscape of the East Siang district into number of gorges and valleys through which the mighty siang flows into the Brahmaputra River.

The varied orography has a profound influence on the climate which varies according to the elevation and location. The mountainous parts in the north enjoys a mountain-type climate while the low-lying narrow peripheral plains and the valleys experience tropical climate.

Owing to the generally East West orientation of the High mountain ranges, particularly in the North-South-Easterly rain bearing Monsoon winds exert their full impact on the windward sides and over the valleys. Copious rainfall during the monsoon is therefore another important feature of the climate on this district.

Wind Circulation: Wind circulation is mainly influenced by the nature of terrain, which gives rise to various types of local winds. Winds blowing through mountain gaps emerge out of the gaps as strong currents. December and January are generally the coldest months and July & August are generally the warmest months.

The average minimum temperature and Rainfall for the year 1986 is 13.47 centigrade and 326.6 mm respectively. The average maximum temperature is 22.30 Centigrades which recorded by the Indian Meteorological Deptt. Pasighat.

POPULATION:

According to 1981 Census the total population of the district stands at 70,451. The average density of population per Sq.Km. is 11. The literacy rate is recorded at 26.04. Sexwise there are about 350 females per 1000 males. The Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes population of the district is 259 and 50,728 persons respectively. Pasighat, the district HQ has an Urban population 9,139. Percentage of scheduled Tribes population to the total population of this district is 72.00 i.e. 5th in rank. Decadal change from 1971 to 1981 is 49,005 and 70,451 respectively, which percentage decadal (1971-1981) variation is (+) 43.76 as against 35.15 percent in Arunachal Pradesh percentage, of Total workers to total population is 49.45 and Non-worker to total population is 50.05. The growth rate in the district is 43.76 percent i.e. 3rd in rank in the range of growth.

LOCAL PEOPLE:

The Adi tribe and its Sub-tribes, viz. Minyong, Padam, Pasi etc are the inhabitants of this district.

Socio cultural portrait of the local people. The major tribes that inhabit the East Siang District are "The Adis". Though quite a number of tribal groups, scattered over a fairly large area, are designated as "Adis" they are bound together by a common language with slight dialectical variations from place to place. A similarity of culture and territorial affinity is also seen among all these groups. In the East Siang district, the Sub-groups of the Adis are Gallong, Simong, Kerka, Padam, Minyong, Millang, Pasi and Panqi. Adi means a "hill man". By nature, they are of independent character.

The "Solung" is the main festival of "Adis". The solung festival is a manifestation of the "Adis" fertility cult. There are different versions of its origin,

but the most commonly accepted one is that the Adis were asked by Kine-Nime, the goddess of wealth and prosperity, to perform the Solung puja. The wide and over lapping channels of communications cross-cutting through variety of themes like Art, Literature, Music and culture have brought about an wonderful configuration of Socio religious diversities having it the basis for emotional and political integration of the people of the district as a whole.

ADMINISTRATIVE SET UP :

The Deputy Commissioner is at the head of the District Administration. The district is divided into two Sub-Divisions viz. Pasighat and Mariyeng. Pasighat Sub-Division has got six Circles i.e. Pasighat, Rebe, Ruksin, Nari, Pangin, Boleng and four circles namely Marriyang, Geku, Yingkiong, Korko (Jengging) are under Marriyang Sub-Division Boleng, Yingkiong and Mariyeng Circles are under the Extra Asstt. Commissioners, but rest of the circles are headed by the Circle officers.

TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATION:

East Siang is communicated by Air, Rail Road and Ferry and developing its transport and communications not work smoothly. Mirkong-Selek in Assam in the nearest rail head and Oirungmghat and Sonari ghat of the nearest Ferry ghat for Pasighat. Also private Buses are plying from Pasighat to Itanagar the capital regularly, Vayudoot service in operation since July '86 from Pasighat to Calcutta touching Dibrugarh, Lilabari, Ziro and Along every alternative days.

Regular ferry service across river Brahmaputra connects this district with Dibrugarh town in Assam except Rebo all circle HQrs of the district are connected with rest of the country by an all weather road. There exist elementary landing facilities for small planes and helicopter at Pasighat air field.

POST AND TELEGRAPH:

The postal department has got 2 Sub-offices in the district of which telegraph facility is available only in two offices Pasighat and Hill top (JIC). Besides there are 26 Extra Departmental Post Offices in the district, and 21 Nos of EDOPO proposed for the district.

Telephone services are available only in Pasighat HQ. The Telephone Exchange of Pasighat is having AX-3 type of Board with capacity of 100 telephones. Efforts has been made to make it 200 telephone during 1987. Micro-wave telephone system also working to nearest station of North Eastern region and also progress to link up important places of India in near future.

AIR/DOOR JAWASHAN :

All India Radio, Pasighat was established on 6.3.1956. This is a low power station spread around 300 Sq. Km. Area of foot hills region of East Siang. Extension of Television service in Pasighat taken up and work of T.V. transmission centre is in progress and expected to function in near future, which will transmit programme from Delhi by relay.

BANK :

State Bank of India is the only Nationalised Bank having business in this district, it has got its branches at Pasighat, Pangin, Yingkiong.

The Rural Bank has opened a Branch at Pasighat in November, 1983 with its Branch at Sille, Lumbo, Ruksin, Lebo, Hirem and two more branch opened during this year 1986 at Boleng and Geku.

The Office of the Lead Bank also working at Pasighat HQ. overall performance in Agriculture sector is 66.48%. Among them State Bank of India is 33.39% A.P. Rural Bank is 112.12% and A.P.s Co-op Apex Bank Ltd is 64.04%. In this district INOP schemes were going to link up with Bank credit during the year 1986 for the first time.

As on December/1986 overall Credit Deposit Ratio in the district is 21.75%, State Bank of India is 19.90% and Arunachal Pradesh Rural Bank is 22.46%.

AGRICULTURE :

The efforts of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh have been mainly diverted towards integrated Agricultural development and the programmes i.e. of discouraging shifting cultivation, encouraging permanent cultivation, popularising the use of fertilizers and other manures, introduction of high yielding and improved varieties of seeds, introduction of Commercial crops, distribution of improved tools and machinery, horticulture development, Plant protection, irrigation and Soil conservation measures etc. have received attention over the years.

The total available land for cultivation in the district is 19,964 hect. and in the district Paddy is the mainly grown and maize millet and other cash crops are secondary.

The Agriculture department is providing the Farmers with grant of subsidy for development of land and also providing High Yielding seeds, fertilizers and tools at subsidised rates in an effort to grow more food.

During the year 1985-86 the yield rate of Paddy is 11.0, Maize is 10.5, Millet is 7.0, Mustard is 10.0 and Potato is 65.5.

There are one Govt. Agricultural farm at GTC at Pasighat and a Farmer Training Centre at GTC complex for development of Agricultural activities in this district.

GRAM SEVAK TRAINING CENTRE :

This institute was started in the year 1950 under the name "The Agriculture Training Institute". During the year 1956 it was converted into Gramsevak training Centre.

The main objectives of this institution are to train in rural development works of various categories by organising (a) Pre-Induction courses (b) Refresher and condensed courses (c) Specialised programme.

Extension, mostly by the Farmers' Training programme, Agriculture information service, Adoption of villages and Blocks so far, 994 VLW trainees have completed 2 years training course.

In addition to above, various special training courses were also organised such as, Intensive course of Agriculture, Condensed courses for Agriculture Inspector, Refresher courses for VLW's, Agri. Horti. census training for officers, Soil testing for A.I. H.I. etc., plant protection for P.I., PPI etc., Horticulture training for VLW's, Refresher courses for Gramsevika short courses for Associate women workers, short refresher courses for Veterinary field ass'tt. short courses for Anganwadi workers, Trisem, Milk training for VLW's are also undertaken wherever required to implement the schemes/programmes.

During the current session (1985-86) there are 53 VLW(Jr) undergoing training of 2 years duration and 23 Veterinary Field Assistant completed their one years course. Live stock Demonstration farm sold 13,792. Ltrs. of Milk during the year 1985-86. The institute also has undertaken trials and demonstration of Pre-released and released varieties of various crops.

The training centre has got one well equipped soil testing laboratory where the soil sample from various districts are received and analysis report with necessary recommendation are forwarded to the concerned district for necessary trial on particular crops.

The Gram sevak training Institute is having a Printing press, Fish pond, Chick rearing centre and Dairy, Poultry, Piggery, Duckery and a Fodder farm for demonstration purposes.

FARMER'S TRAINING CENTRE :

The farmer training Centre, Pasighat was started in 1972. It is located in the same campus of the Gram sevak training centre. It is the first and at present one of the three centres of Arunachal Pradesh. The general objectives of the centre is to provide training support for bringing about more production by imparting need based, skill and production oriented vocational training to the farmers and farm women. It endeavours to enlighten the farmers regarding improved Agricultural and Home science technologies by conducting various types of training programmes in the fields as well as villages of the farmer itself.

The training programme of the Centre include
(a) Institutional training (b) Demonstration cum training
(c) Specialised training for conveners of Farmer discussion groups (d) Specialised training on home science (e) Conducted tour of farmer and (f) Village adoption programme.

EDUCATION:

East Siang district is the only district of Arunachal Pradesh where almost all the villages are covered under Primary education. There are 4 Higher Secondary Schools, 6 Secondary Schools, 16 Middle Schools, 195 Primary schools, One Vivekananda Kendriya Vidhyalaya and one Kendriya Vidyalaya. In addition to that 23 Nos of Adult Education Centre and 80 Nos of Rural functional literacy project is also existing to increase the literacy rate of this district.

COLLEGE:
J. N. COLLEGE

J.N. College, Pasighat was established in the year 1964. At the very outset the College was affiliated to Gauhati University till 1979 and thereafter to Panjab University Chandigarh upto 1985. Now it has been affiliated of Arunachal University at Itanagar. The college offered under graduate courses in Arts, Science and Commerce both pass and honours courses with the subject in English, Economics, Education, Geography, History, Political science as well as only pass courses in Hindi, Assamese and Adnl. English. Science courses were introduced with Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Mathematics in the year 1974, with the opening of P.G. Classes in Political science and History in 1981 and Commerce classes in 1983. J.N. College is now one of the few Colleges in North Eastern Region imparting education on such diverse fields of knowledge.

The college has got 10 Hostel building for boys and 1(One) building for Girls. J.N. College Library is one of the most well-equiped libraries in whole of North Eastern region. Moreover 16 Nos of periodicals, 73 Nos of Journals, 9 Nos of News paper and morethan 20,000 Books are also available in the library.

The total strength of lecturers and students in the College were 50 and 643 respectively as on 31.3. 1986. Total 65 Nos Graduated during the session 1985-86 among them 60 in Arts, 1 in Commerce 4 in Science and also 2 Nos Post graduated in History. J.N. College, Pasighat is lauded as the premier Institution on the land for its glorious role in training and educating the youths and students who are to-day leading Arunachal in all walks of her life.

POLICE ADMINISTRATION:

The office of the Subdt. of Police is located in Pasighat, the District HQ. In the district there are two Police station, one 'A' Class and one 'B' class at Pasighat and Luksin respectively. A judicial lock up situated at Pasighat in addition to that two out post stationed at Mirmir and Depi also 'B' class station are planned to be operated at Mebo, Pengin, Toleng, Mariveng and Yingkiong in near future. Total 4 WR operation centre is also working in this district.

ELECTRICITY:

The total installed capacity in the district is 24,45,246 K.W.H. of which Micro Hydel accounts for 22,67,813 KWH and rest 1,77,423 KWH is generated from generating sets. Total consumption of Electricity is 13,20,396 and 19 Nos of village electrified during the year 1985-86 and total 65 village have already been electrified in total of 143 villages. Hydel project is expected to boost Micro-Hydel capacity to tune of 1000KW to extend electricity to more places including Commercial and Industrial sector to develop the area.

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY & VETERINARY:

The Animal Husbandry & Veterinary and Key village office was started functioning since 1976-77. Presently 3 Vety. dispensary and 10 Vety. Aid centres, one mobile vety. dispensary. 30 Key village Centre are functioning in this district. The district is having one School Veterinary Science & training centre and one Diagnostic Laboratory to upgrade the Vety. activities in this district.

CO-OPERATIVE:

Presently 21 Co-operative societies are functioning in the district, out of 13 Co-operative, 3 College/School/Trencees Cooperative, 4 Consumers Co-operatives and 1 Industrial Cooperative, 5 Nos of Co-operative Fair price shop also functioning in this district for distribution of essential commodities to the consumers.

CIVIL SUPPLY :

In the district, the Civil supply department makes provision of food stuff, building material and petroleum products through dealers public distribution system cover 80% of the total population during the year. Out of 57 Nos of Fair price shop 26 run by the Govt and 31 run by the private sector.

INDUSTRIES:

The department of the Industry is functioning in the district with Asstt. Director of Industries as Head. Saw mill is the most important industry in this district

The district is having 3 Craft centres at Pasighat, Yingkiong and Jengging and 6 weaving centre in Pasighat, Yingkiong, Jengging, Mriyang, Boleng and Berung and also 4 Sericulture farm cum demonstration centre functioning in this district. There are 11 nos of Saw mills and 35 Nos of SSI Units are also functioning in this district. Also Industrial Estate established during the year 1981 with 10 acres of land.

INTEGRATED RURAL DEVELOPMENT:

Integrated Rural Development scheme starting the economic osmosis in the 3 rock bottom of poverty have been launched in 1979. During the year 1985-86 1030 Beneficiaries assisted by I.R.D.P, 2493 beneficiaries assisted by I.C.D.S, 70298 man days generated by the N.R.E.P scheme 1215 Nos benifitted by A.S.M.F. programme. 46.00 lakh have been spent for the implementation of various schemes.

RURAL WORKS DEPARTMENT:

To uplift the Socio-economic standard of life of rural people the rural work department plays a vital role. The department constructed length of village road is 10.05 KM, and water supplied 28 more villages, 5374 lectures area irrigated during the year by this department.

FISHERIES:

There are two Govt. fish farm, 545 village fish ponds in this district. During the year fish production is 27.05 M/Ton and fish seed production is 2,83,000. Fingerlings were supplied to the fish pond owners at free of cost to develop the fisheries. The area under pisciculture both normal and I.R.D.P. is 38.17 Hectres which include water area development and paddy cum pisciculture.

FOREST:

The Pasighat Forest Division started functioning since April, 1978. The division presently covers whole of the East Siang district with its HQ at Pasighat. At present there are four Range, 1 account beat 8 numbers of Non-accounts beat under the Division and 65.96 lack revenue earned by this Division during the year. The Yingkiong Forest Division having 3 Ranges, 1 No. of Accounts beat and 2 Nos of Non-account beats.

WILD LIFE DIVISION:

There is one wild life division namely Lali Wild Life sanctuary Division stationed at Pasighat since 1979. Divisions covers an area of 180 Sq.Km of East Siang District.

MEDICAL AND PUBLIC HEALTH:

There is only one General Hospital at Pasighat and 1 Sankar Mission and 15 Health Units having provision of 120 (including T.B.) Beds and 240 Beds respectively. Total patients treated in indoor 7985, in outdoor 171924 in addition to that One Health Training Research centre imparting training for two years course of Auxiliary Nurse cum Midwife and two years course of Health Asstt.(Jr.). During the year all the 22 Nos of ANM appeared and have been passed

Further during the year a Multipurpose training for Health Asstt. is imparted in this Centre by batch to educate them in various sphere of Medical & Public Health for village level Medical care.

The District Medical Officer is looking after the Health Units of East Siang District, Malaria Eradication programme and Immunisation programme. The Asstt. Director of Health is looking after the General Hospital & Health training centre of this district.

T.B. Programme

The District T.B. Centre, Pasighat is Headed by District Tuberculosis Officer to detect and control of T.B. in both East and West Siang District. The centre has got 30 Beds and 241 patients treated during the year.

Leprosy colony:

The Shreemanta Sankar Mission is having 110 bedded capacity at Pasighat. Total 32 outdoor and 270 indoor leprosy patients treated during the year with the care of one Medical Officer and one Pharmacist.
