

REVIEW OF ACHIEVEMENTS IN SOLAN DISTRICT-1982

General:- Solan is known as the gateway to the capital of Himachal Pradesh. This District came into existence on 1st Sept. 1972 as a result of re-organisation of old Shimla District and erstwhile Mahabaleshwar District.

For the administrative convenience the District is divided into five tehsils namely Solan, Kandaghat, Malagarh and Arki. Malagarh tehsil was further divided into two parts creating new Sub-tehsil Ranshehar. This District has four administrative Sub-Divisions with the headquarters at Solan, Kandaghat, Arki and Malagarh. There are five community development Blocks viz. Solan, Dharanpur, Malagarh, Kunihar and Kandaghat. The Development Blocks are co-terminus with the tehsil boundaries except Malagarh development Block which covers Malagarh tehsil as well as Ranshehar Sub-tehsil.

2. Location and Boundaries

Solan District is bounded by Shimla District in the north and by Punjab and Haryana in the south, by Sirmour District in the east and in the west by the Bilaspur District. It is located between the longitudes 76.42 & 77.20 and latitudes 30.50 & 31.15 north. The elevation of the District ranges from 300 to 3000 metres above mean sea level. The terrain is mostly mountainous. High mountains start from the central region and extend upto northern, eastern and north-eastern corner of the District comprising Solan, Kasauli, Kandaghat and part of Arki tehsil. These tehsils are situated amongst the highest mountains of the District. Mangal area of Arki tehsil is situated in a very difficult terrain of high mountains. As such this area was declared as "Backward Area" by the Govt. Mountains of lower elevation are found in western and southern parts of the District comprising of Malagarh and Arki Tehsil. Boon valley in Malagarh tehsil is the most fertile tract whereas the Saproon valley is its second part in Solan tehsil though much smaller in size.

3. Area and Population

The Geographical area of Solan District according to Surveyor General of India is 1936 sq. Kms. which is 3.5% of the State area. There are 2537 populated and 166-unpopulated villages in the district. The district has a population of 3,03,280 which is 7.08% of the Pradesh population. The over all increase of the population over the last decade is 27.75% as per census 1981 compared to 1971 census.

The rural population witnessed 26.30% increase while it has been 36.24% for urban population as per 1981 census. The increase in the population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes has been 37.38% over the last decade which is 32.35% of the total population while in 1971 the percentage of SC/ST to total population was 30.36%. The density of population has also increased from 123 to 157 as compared to last Census report of 1971.

As compared to 1971 census the percentage of workers has shown a slight decrease from 35.45% to 34.41% (main workers). The percentage of agricultural labourers has gone-up from 1.56 to

AGRICULTURE

Agriculture is the main stay of the rural economy of the District. Sixty eight percent of the working population of the District is deployed on agriculture such as cultivation, animal rearing, fishing etc. Maize, Wheat, Rice and pulses etc. are the main crops of the District. Cash crops such as sugar-cane and Potato are also grown in the District. Vegetable cultivation has also taken a boost. The District's Geographical area of 1,30,223 Hect. out of which 45,415 Hect. is cultivable which comes to be 25.20% of the total area. Despite of hilly topography of the District more area has been brought under cultivation. The percentage increase in the net cultivated area has shown slight increase of 0.04% as compared to last year i.e., 1980-81. Similarly, the cropped area has shown decreasing trend from 71861 during 1980-81 to 70,296 during 1981-82.

The production of various crops witnessed decreasing trend due to unfavourable climate. Drought almost all over the District effected the outturn of crops. Rains are a pre-requisite for the cultivation in hilly terrain. This is because irrigation facilities could not be created here to the extent possible in plains.

The geographical configuration of the District which extend from the lower elevation to higher elevation with a facility of irrigation provided a good scope for vegetables cultivation in the District. The District is also suited for growing the off season vegetables like tomato, caurium, etc. The cauliflower and cabbages is also grown in the district and exported to the plains.

HORTICULTURE:-

The hilly topography and agro climate conditions of the District is very congenial for the development of horticulture in general and cultivation of temperate and stone fruits in particular. The development of Horticulture Plant for fruit production such as citrus, stone fruits, Ber orchards, apple cultivation, mango, guava fruits, Wall nut and Anla et-c., has shown a good results. The area under horticulture has marked a increase. The area under horticulture has increased from 7673 hect. to 8339 hect. which comes to 9.35% during the year 1981-82. The production of fruits has shown slight decrease due to un-favourable climate conditions.

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY:-

Agriculture is supplemented by Animal Husbandry. Agriculture production much depends on the live-stock available. Agriculture is viable if adequate animal stock is there to feed by way of manure etc. These activities allied to agriculture play a significant role in supplementing the income of farmers. This District has a Live-stock population of 3.36 lakhs as per Live-stock Census, 1982 which shows 7.12% increase as compared to 1977 Live-Stock census. There are 739 Live-Stocks per 100 Hect. cultivated land and according to 1982 live stock census whereas the average was only 687 per 100 Hect. cultivated land when compared to live-Stock census 1977. The Poultry population has also increased from 15263 (1977 Live-Stock-Census) to 32319 (Live-Stock Census, 1982) which indicates that the people of this District has taken keen interest in poultry farming.

All types of veterinary facilities are provided at 12 hospitals and 25 dispensaries to sustain the growth of Live-Stock and preserve the cattle wealth in the Distt. with a view to provide

increased facilities, a veterinary Hospital & a vety. dispensary were opened in the District during the year 1981-82. There are 19 artificial insemination centres to provide artificial insemination of cows and buffaloes facilities to the people. The artificial insemination with Jersey semen is provided with all the Vety. Institutions.

There exists a food manufacturing units established by agro-Industry corporation located at Paranoos under the fed & fooder programme. Concentrates are supplied to the eligible beneficiaries on no profit no loss basis. The chilling Plant facilities are also provided to for collecting the milk from far off Villages of the District. The training facilities under diary programmes are also provided to the farmers of the District.

7. MEDICAL & PUBLIC HEALTH:-

Continuously the Medical & Public Health care is being paid much attention by the Government. Every year increased medical & Public Health facilities are being provided to the people. No doubt the increased medical facilities have brought down the death rate considerably and improved the health of the people. This can be judged from the fact that 4263 Births as against 125 deaths were registered in the District during the year 1982. In the District 4 Hospitals, 4 Primary Health Centres, 22 Allopathic and 31 Ayurvedic dispensaries were scattered all over the District as on 31st December, 1982 to provide the medical & public health facilities. The heli facility has also been extended upto Primary Health Centres. In the Hospitals and Dispensaries 5,79,634 patients were treated during the year 1982 out of which 60629 were indoor patients and 5,19,005 outdoor patients.

Since the family planning is the "National Programme" as such, it received much attention of the Government. During this year 839 vasectomy and 804 tubectomy operations were performed as compared to 635 Vasectomy & 373 tubectomy operations during the last year 1980-81. Apart from sterilisation operations, I.U.C.D., insertion and C.C./others methods too have become more familiar over a past few years.

8. EDUCATION:-

The importance of education has increased in a modern civilisation. It is essential for the Social uplift of the masses without which development programmes are of not much success. In 1971 literacy in this District was 29.31 percent, male literates being 40.31 percent and female 17.30 percent. During seventies this District could make a considerable stride in the field of education bringing literacy percentage in 1981 to 40.90 percent, male literates being 52.09 percent and female literates 28.88 percent, there by showing an over-all growth of 77.44%.

During the year 1981-82 in the District 18 Primary Schools were opened. As on 31.3.1982 as many as 482 Primary School 70 Middle Schools, 44 High Schools/Higher Secondary schools & 2 Degree Colleges before a period of 5 years. This clearly indicates the strident mark in the field of education.

9. CO-OPERATION:-

The Co-operative movement which has assumed a significant place in the wake of planning is doing much headway in creating a sense of collective march on the path of progress and were spread over, District as compared to 334 primary schools 63

the rural people. The co-operative movement has played a larger role in making the rural people self-reliant.

The co-operative structure in the district comprises 160 agricultural cooperative societies which caters to the needs of rural people for crop loans requirements, allied activities and consumer goods. Besides there are 24 non-agricultural societies, 2 urban banks, 7 secondary societies, 33 non-agriculture & non-credit societies and state central-bank helping the rural masses in different spheres. Some co-operative societies were liquidated during the year 1981-82 which bring down the total number of co-operative societies from 281 as on 31-3-1981 to 277 as on 31-3-1982. Despite of this fact the membership of the co-operative societies came up from 34 thousand as on 31-3-1981 to 36 thousand as on 31-3-1982, similarly, working capital and Share Capital of the co-operative Societies have also increased from 420 lakhs and 66 lakhs to 472 lakhs & Rs.73 lakhs respectively as compared to last year i.e., 1980-81. The loan was advanced to the tune of 184 lakhs during the year 1981-82 when it was only 145 lakhs during last year.

10. POWER.

Electricity has become the necessity for all the sections of the people. While rural electrification has diversified uses such as lighting of houses, supply of power to agricultural pump sets, lift irrigation schemes, small scale industries and cottage industries etc. It increases the agricultural production as well as industrial production, and creates more employment opportunities to the rural youth. With this aim in view the rural electrification has gathered momentum over past some years.

More and more villages are being electrified every year which brings up the percentage of electrified villages to 60% of the total inhabited villages as on 31.3.82. When the percentage of electrified village was only 43 % before five years. The percentage of electrification is higher in Kandaghat tehsil i.e 81.84 % followed by 65.88 in Arki tehsil as on 31.3.82. No energy is generated in this District. The entire purchase is from outside the District. The consumption of electricity has also increased from 409 lakhs KWH to 439 KWH during the year 1981-82. The consumption of electricity for tube-well, water supply has shown an upward trend, the rural electrification got the priority. The consumption of electricity for tube-wells has also increased from 520 thousand KWH to 1703 thousand KWH.

11. LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT

There are four employment units in the District to help the job seekers in getting their placement, during the year 1982. Employment Exchanges registered 4267 candidates as job seekers. There are 12874 job seekers on the Live Register of Employment Exchanges, out of which 110 job seekers are post graduates, 545 graduates, 5964 matriculates/higher Secondary 3847 Middle or below and 2408 illiterate. The placement done in respect of 498 job seekers which is only 3.87 % of the candidates on the Live-Register.

At the end of the year 1981-82 there were 5706 regular Govt. Employees, 7913 contingent paid/work-charged/daily paid workers 1297 employees were working in public undertaking/Corp. and 371 employees in local bodies/cantonment Boards.

12. FOREST

Forest has special economic significance in an economy of the District. It provided employment on a large scale to the people of the District since many a small scale industries/cottage industries are based on the forest for its raw materials.

In the District 49,331 hectares land is under the forest which is 27.37 % of the total geographical area. There are 6083 hectares land under 'Reserved Forest' 29049 hectares under 'Protected Forest' and 14,119 hectares under Un-demarcated and un-classified forests.

In the District during the year 1981-82 there has been income to the tune of Rs. 28.79 lakhs as compared to Rs. 20.76 lakhs during the year 1980-81 from minor forest products such as bamboo canes, fodder and grazing Grass, resin and gums.

13. TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS

Roads are the life lines of the District depicting the future course of progress without which speedy progress cannot take place. Roads are also necessary to improve the Social and Economic standard of the people. This way Solan District has the privilege of being served by railway and National Highway from Kalka to Shimla which linked important places of the District. At the end of March 82 the motorable lane stood at 1740 Kms. out of which the length of double motorable lane was 136 Kms and motorable single lane was 904 Kms besides this there was ~~133~~ 87 Kms long jeepable roads and 3130 Km long roads which was less than jeepable road. There has also been increase in the length of motorable single lane roads.

Roads transport is the only mode of mechanised transport available to serve the people of the District. The rail transport is not adequate in the District. The air and water transport is not available to the people. The Himachal Road Transport Corporation's depot at Arwanoo & Nalagarh running buses on 99 routes, as against 67 routes as compared to last year. The fleet strength of the corporation as on 31.3.32 stood at 103 vehicles which comprises of 101 buses and a car and a jeep.

WELFARE

The welfare of the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes and other weaker section of the society is receiving the continuous attention of the Govt. As a result, various schemes for amelioration of economic conditions and social uplift of these classes is undertaken every year.

These classes are being benefitted mainly under three schemes i.e welfare of Backward classes, Social welfare and Nutrition Programme.

The educational and technical scholar-ship are given to the students of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes and to the backward classes during 1981-82. The scholarship including technical scholarship is given to the tune of Rs. 1,58,000 under the scheme of welfare of scheduled castes whereas, last year this assistance was of the order of Rs. 1,45,300. The books and slates were also distributed among the students of SC/ST and denotified tribes to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- during the year under review. The assistance under follow-up programme, subsidy for house construction, construction of drinking water supply schemes, assistance for setting up of industries legal aid and electrification of Harijan basties were also provided to the Scheduled Caste families.
