Any suggestions for improvement of this annual publication of Statistical Hand Book will be most welcome.

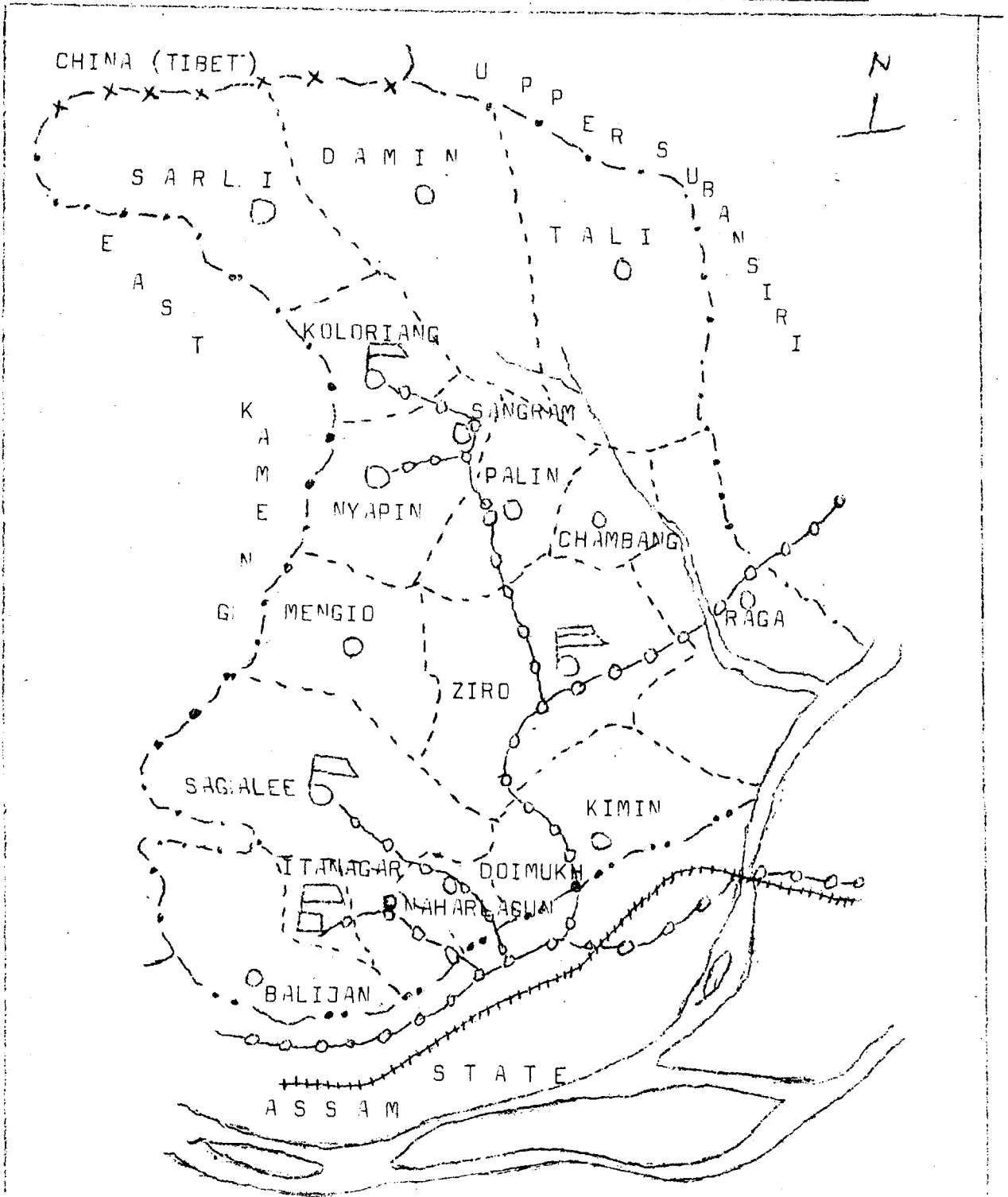

H I G H L I G H T S.

1. GEOGRAPHICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE FEATURES:-

The Lower Subansiri District covers approximately an Area of 13010 Sq. Kms. . The part of the district is mountaneous terrain with Hill Ranges. It lies between Latitude 26°55'N and 28°21'N and Longitude 92°40'E and 94°21'E.

The District is bounded by China(Tibet) and some part of Upper Subansiri District to the North, West Slang and some part of Upper Subansiri District to the East, Assam State to the South and East Kameng District to the West.

Average Annual Rainfall of this district is 276 centimetres.

It has 3 towns and 858 inhabited villages and it is divided into 4 Major Sub-Divisions and 17 Circles. The Deputy Commissioner is the overall Incharge of the Dist. Panchayat Raj System exist in the district. At present the district has 10 CD/IRD Blocks.

2. POPULATION AND SOCIO ECONOMIC CONDITIONS:-

According to 1991 Census(Provisional), Total population of the District is 1,54,591 persons, Of this Male population is 81,425 persons and rest are Female. Density of population is 11 persons per sq.km.(+) 32.74% of the total population are literate. 62.77 % of the total main working population are cultivators. Agriculture is the main occupation of the inhabitant of the District.

3. ROAD AND COMMUNICATION:-

The District has 535.522 kms surfaced and 876.147 kms length of unsurfaced roads. Most of the Administrative Head quarters are connected by roads with the District Head Quarters. Regular Bus Service exists from Ziro to North Lakhimpur/Itanagar and some other Administrative places/H.Qs.

There are 3 nos. of Post Office with Telegraph facilities, 32 nos. Post offices without Telegraph facilities (J=6+EDBPO=26), and 7 nos. Telephone Exchanges (STD=4+others=3) functioning in the District. Apart from this one Head Post office is functioning at Itanagar.

4. AGRICULTURE, VETERINARY, FISHERY AND FORESTRY:-

The district has 39,252 Hectrs of land available for cultivation. Of this, Net sown Area is 28,417

hects, 38,671 Metric tonnes Cereal crops (Paddy, Maize, Millet and Wheat) produced during the year 1991-92.

It has 14 nos. of Veterinary Dispensaries, 15 nos Veterinary Aid Centres at different Administrative places. It has 10 nos. Govt. Fish Farms, 91 nos. people Fish Farms, 1953 nos. village Fish Ponds. 192 Metric Tonnes Fish and 21.00 lakh Nos. Fish seeds produced during the reference year 1991-92.

The District has 1,36,300 hectares Reserve Forest area under different Forest Divisions and 149.45 lakh rupees revenue earned from the forest products grown in the district during the year 1991-92.

5. MINERALS AND INDUSTRIES:-

There is no economic important Mineral Resources found in the district as yet.

There are 5 nos Training-cum-production Centres, 5 nos Weaving units and 3 nos Sericulture Demonstration Farms functioning in the district. 87 nos Trainees were trained in different Craft during 1991-92.

6. MINOR IRRIGATION:-

The District has 131 (prov.) nos Minor Irrigation Channels and 4393.93 hectares Irrigated land area.

An expenditure of Rs.318.44 lakh were incurred as on 31-3-91 for construction of Minor Irrigation Channel in the district.

7. SOCIAL SERVICES:-

The district has 236 nos of Govt. and 12 nos of Private Education Institutions with a total Enrolment of 31955 students.

Besides, one District Hospital at Ziro, one General Hospital at Nananlogun, one R.K. Mission Hospital at Itanagar, one T.B. Centre at Ziro, 30 nos Health Units/Dispensaries were functioning in different Administrative head quarters/places. 587 nos villages and 3 towns have been provided with drinking water supply facilities/schemes as on 31-3-92.
