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

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P R E F A C E

This volume on District Educational Statistics for the State of Bihar is the eighth in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the States and Union Territories. The main aim is to highlight the inter-district variations in a State by giving educational data at district levels with the help of some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentage of trained teachers, per capita expenditure, teacher pupil ratio, etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have widened or narrowed down with time, the data for the year 1976-77 has been analysed and compared with that for the year 1970-71.

I take this opportunity to express my appreciation of the co-operation received from the Directorate of Education, Bihar and the Project Staff of the Planning, Monitoring and Statistics Division of the Ministry who have prepared this report.

INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of Educational Development just as in urbanisation, industrialization, distribution of income and wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector, the Ministry of Education and Culture brings out the publication "Educational Statistics : District-wise" quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. Thereafter, it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each State every five years by the Ministry of Education and Culture. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry.
3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers and per capita expenditure on education have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and hence the need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

II. AREA AND POPULATION

4. After re-organisation of the State in 1977, there are now 31 districts as against 17 in 1971. However, the total area of the State remained the same after reorganisation. In 1977, the district-wise area varies from 1.9 thousands Sq. Kms. in case of Begusarai district to 18.3 thousands Sq. Kms. in case of Ranchi district.

The increase in number of districts from 17 in 1970-71 to 31 in 1977 is due to bifurcation of the following districts:-

Rest of the districts in 1977 remained as these were in 1971. The figures shown at item No. 34 against the title "Anglo-Indian" under column 2 pertain to the Anglo-Indian students spread all over the state and are not included in any district.

5. The population of Bihar was 562.60 lakhs in 1971. For 1977, the estimated population is 633.78 lakhs (325.78 lakhs Males and 308.00 lakhs Females). The highest population was in Darbhanga district (52.25 lakhs) and the lowest in Dhanbad district (14.64 lakhs) in 1971. In 1977 also the estimated population varied widely among the 31 reorganised districts from 35.88 lakhs in Santhal Paraganha district to 12.48 lakh in Gopalganj district.

6. The overall density of population per Sq. Km. was 324 in 1971 which is estimated to have increased to 364 in 1977. The density of population per Sq. Km. in 1977 varied widely among districts viz. from 791, the highest in Patna to only 133 the lowest in Palamu. The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the years 1970-71 and 1976-77 are given in Statement No. 2. Table No. 1 below gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and the density of population in 1977.

7. The total population of the State as well as population of different age groups for the year 1971 and 1977 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14, and 14-17 are based on the following formula:-

We assume that,

$$\frac{P}{P_{6-11}} = \frac{P^i}{P_{6-11}} = K$$

$$P_{6-11} = K P^i$$

Where K is estimated from the equation $K = \frac{P_{6-11}}{P}$

P_{6-11} = denote 6-11 age-group population of the State.

P = Total population of State.

P^i_{6-11} = 6-11 age-group population of the i th District.

P^i = Total population of the i th District.

To get the sex-wise break up of total population in the various age-groups of the district, first of all the girls population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in the above formula total population is replaced by the girls population. The boys population is obtained by the residual method i.e.

Boys population in the age-group 6-11 (=)

Total population in the age-group 6-11 (-)

Girls population in the age-group 6-11

Similar formulae are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-groups 11-14 & 14-17 years.

8. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 83.62 lakhs in 1977 (43.00 lakhs boys and 40.62 lakhs girls) which formed 13.19% of the total population of the State.

9. Similarly the estimated population in the age-group 11-14 years was 45.54 lakhs in 1977 (23.55 lakhs boys and 21.99 lakhs girls) which constituted 7.19% of the total population.

10. The population in the age-group 14-17 in 1977 was 41.72 lakhs, consisting of 21.70 lakh boys and 20.62 lakhs girls. This formed 6.58% of the total population.

11. Thus out of the total population of 633.78 lakhs of the State, the School going population in the age group 6-17 years was 170.88 lakhs consisting of 88.25 lakhs boys and 82.63 lakhs girls. The population in the age group 6-17 years constituted 26.96% of the total population. The percentage for boys was 27.08%, while for girls it formed 26.83%.

III - LITERACY

12. According to the 1971 census the effective literacy rate that is the number of literates per hundred of the population (excluding the age group 0-4) in the State was 23.5. The literacy rates for males and females were 35.8 and 10.2 respectively indicating a wide gap between the two sexes. Details are given in Statement No. 7.

IV - GRAM VIDIYALAYA

(a) INSTITUTIONS :

13. The total number of Educational Institutions in Bihar was 53,743 in 1970-71 which increased to 66,041 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 12.41% during the period of 6 years. The district of Santhal Pargana had the largest share of institutions (7.3%) and Begusarai had the lowest share (1.5%) in 1976-77. The district-wise position of Institutions is given in Statement No. 1.

(b) ENROLMENT :

14. The total enrolment in all recognised Educational Institutions in the State increased from 59.8 lakhs in 1970-71 to 78.02 lakhs in 1976-77. The increase in enrolment is observed in all the districts (by adding up enrolment of bifurcated districts in 1976-77). The enrolment increased with an average annual compound growth rate of 3.9%. Ranchi had the highest enrolment while Nowrangpur district shows the lowest enrolment in 1976-77.

15. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was 21.8 in 1970-71 which increased to 26.1 in 1976-77. Among the districts Ranchi (38.4) had the highest percentage of girls and the lowest in East Champaran district (18.1) in 1976-77 (Anglo Indian schools in whole of Bihar State had the highest percentage of girls i.e. 45.6).

16. The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions as a percentage of total population increased from 10.5 in 1970-71 to 12.3 in 1976-77 at the State level during the period under consideration. The percentage enrolment to total population increased considerably in all the districts. The percentage enrolment to total population in 1976-77 was the highest in Patna district (17.0) and the lowest in West Champaran district (7.4).

(c) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF S.C. AND S.T.

17. The extent of coverage of total enrolment to the total population in the year 1976-77 is 12.3%. However, the coefficient of equality for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes were 60.3% & 95.5% respectively at the State level in 1976-77. Details can be seen in Statement Nos. 8 & 9.

(d) TEACHERS :

18. The total number of teachers in the State in all educational institutions increased from 1,73,435 in 1970-71 to 2,32,445 in 1976-77 showing an annual rate of increase of 5.7% during the period. The number of total women teachers in the State increased from 17,717 in 1970-71 to 30,104 in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 11.9%. In 1976-77 the percentage of Trained Teachers in school education was 91.4. Among the districts the corresponding percentages for Male and Female teachers were 91.8 and 88.5 respectively.

The percentage of trained teachers in schools varied from 96.4 in Madhubani District to 82.1 in Hazaribagh district. (Anglo Indian Schools, however, had the lowest percentage of trained teachers in schools i.e. 67.5%). The percentage of women trained teachers in schools was highest (96.2%) in Begusarai District and the lowest (69.0%) in Giridih District.

(e) EXPENDITURE*

19. *The total expenditure (excluding expenditure on Directorate & Inspectorate) of all recognised educational institutions in the State, was Rs.43.35 crores in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.133.03 crores in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an average annual rate of growth of 34.5%. The expenditure increased in all the districts (taking together the expenditure on bifurcated districts). The percentage share of expenditure in 1976-77 was the highest in the case of Patna (9.6) and the lowest in the case of Nawda (1.0). Total expenditure on Anglo Indian Schools was Rs.2,88,619 which forms 0.2% of the total expenditure on all the schools in the State.

20. The expenditure on education per head of population in the State increased from Rs.7.7 in 1970-71 to Rs.21.9 in 1976-77. In 7 districts, the per capita expenditure was more than the State per capita expenditure. The lowest per capita expenditure in 1976-77 was observed in Nawda (Rs.10.0) and the highest in Patna (Rs.50.4). The expenditure per institution also increased from Rs.7,380 in 1970-71 to Rs.20,144 in 1976-77. The maximum being in Patna District (Rs.47,352) and the lowest in Giridih District (Rs.9,425). The district-wise details are given in Statement No.5.

21. The number of

V - PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

21. The number of Pre-Primary Schools in Bihar decreased from 14 in 1970-71 to only 3 in 1976-77.

Similarly total number of teachers in Pre-Primary Schools decreased from 49 in 1970-71 to 20 in 1976-77.

22. Among the districts only Bhojpur and Patna had the facilities of pre-primary education while Anglo Indian Schools had 775 (422 boys + 353 girls) students on rolls in

pre-primary classes. The enrolment in Pre-Primary classes was 1565 in 1970-71 and 1261 in 1976-77. 47 students (23 boys and 24 girls) belonging to Scheduled Castes and 9 (10 boys and 9 girls) students of Scheduled Tribes were enrolled in Pre-Primary classes in 1976-77.

23. The expenditure on pre-primary schools decreased from Rs.1,15,165 in 1970-71 to Rs.73,593 in 1976-77.

VI - PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

24. The total number of primary schools in Bihar increased from 46,823 in 1970-71 to 51,244 in 1976-77, showing an increase of 9.4% over the period of 6 years. The highest percentage of primary schools (5.3%) was in Singhbhum district while the lowest percentage was in Begusarai District (1.3%).

25. On the average, in 1970-71, a primary school was serving an area of 3.7 Sq. Kms. Over the period of 6 years this position improved slightly and a primary school was serving an area of 3.4 Sq. Kms. in 1976-77. In 1976-77, the average area served by a primary school was the minimum in the case of Patna and Nalanda (1.7 Sq. Kms.) and maximum in Palamu (7.4 Sq. Kms.).

26. The population served by a primary school in the State registered an increase from 1202 to 1237 during the period of the 6 years. Among the districts the population served by a primary school varied from 890 in Santhal Pargana to 1981 in Begusarai in 1976-77, The district-wise details are given in Statement No.11.

27. Total number of teachers in primary schools in Bihar also increased from 82,639 in 1970-71 to 1,08,565 in 1976-77. This shows an average annual increase rate of 5.23% during the period of 6 years. During this period there was an increase in the number of teachers in all the districts (Adding up teacher of Bifurcated districts in 1976-77). The number of women teachers formed 14.0% of the total number of teachers in 1976-77. The highest percentage of teachers was 6.5 in Santhal Paraganas while lowest percentage i.e. 1.5 was found in Nawada District.

(b) ENROLMENT :

28. In 1970-71, the total enrolment in primary schools in Bihar was 32.34 lakhs which increased to 41.66 lakhs in 1976-77. In classes I-V, the enrolment increased from 42.13 lakhs (31.44 lakhs boys and 10.68 lakhs girls) in 1970-71 to 60.89 lakhs (43.47 lakhs boys and 17.42 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 showing an average annual exponential growth rate of 6.3% per annum. The enrolment growth rates (compound) in these classes separately for boys and girls were 6.4% and 10.5% respectively which shows that girls education is getting better deal in the State.

29. The percentage of enrolment in classes I-V to the total population in the age group 6-11 (also called enrolment ratio) gives index of the facilities created at the primary stages of education. In Bihar this percentage increased from 56.4 to 72.8 during the period of 6 years. In case of boys alone the increase in percentage was from 81.6 in 1970-71 to 101.1 in 1976-77 and in the case of girls from 29.6 to 42.9 during the same period. Among the various districts, taking boys and girls together, the enrolment ratio in 1976-77 was the highest in Singabhoom (94.7%) and the lowest in West Champaran district (45.2%).


(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T.

30. Of the total enrolment of 42.13 lakhs in classes I-V in 1970-71, 7.55 lakhs students belonged to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes forming 17.9% of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1976-77, the enrolment of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students changed to 5.60 lakhs and 5.62 lakhs and formed 9.2% and 9.2% respectively of the total enrolment in these classes. *The co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in these classes works out to 65.3% and 104.6% respectively. The district-wise details are given in Statement Nos. 12 and 13.



IN THE AGE-GROUP 6-11 (1970-71)




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PERCENTAGE ENROLMENT (GIRIS) IN CLASSES I-V TO
POPULATION IN THE AGE GROUP 6-11 (1970-71)




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
PERCENTAGE ENROLMENT (TOTAL) IN CLASSES 1-7 TO
POPULATION IN THE AGE GROUP 6-11 (1970-71)




PERCENTAGE ENROLMENT (BOYS) IN CLASSES I-V TO POPULATION

(d) EXPENDITURE :

31. The total expenditure on primary schools in Bihar increased from Rs.1248.20 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.3784.61 lakhs in 1976-77. This gives an average annual growth rate of 33.9% during the period under consideration.

32. The per capita expenditure on primary schools in the State was Rs.2.22 in 1970-71, which increased to Rs.5.97 by 1976-77. The per capita expenditure in 1976-77 was the lowest in Nawada district (Rs.3.67) and the highest in Vaishali district (Rs.10.56).

33. The cost per student in primary schools increased from Rs.38.6 in 1970-71 to Rs.90.8 in 1976-77 at the state level. Among the districts, the cost per student was the highest in West Champaran District (Rs.173.4) followed by Palamu district (156.7) and was the lowest in the case of Nalanda (Rs.52.1). (Anglo Indian schools had the maximum expenditure per student viz. Rs.345.1). The teacher pupil ratio improved marginally from 39 to 38 during the period under consideration. The pupil teacher ratio varied from 27 in West Champaran district to 52 in Nalanda district. The details can be seen from Statement No.14.

VII- MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS:

34. The total number of Middle schools in the State increased from 8,133 in 1970-71 to 10,422 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 28.1% during the period of six years. In 1976-77 highest number of Middle schools was recorded in Ranchi district (5.7%).

35. On an average, in 1970-71, a Middle school served an area of 21.4 sq. kms. The po improved considerably in 1976-77 and a Middle school was then available for every 16.7 sq. area. In 1976-77 the area served by a Middle school was less than the State average in 19 districts. The area served by a Middle school was the lowest in Patna (5.9 sq. kms.) and highest in the case of Palamu (39.3 sq. kms.).

36. The population served by a Middle school in the State decreased from 6,918 in 1970- to 6,081 in 1976-77 i.e. during the period of 6 years. Among the districts, the population served by a middle school in 1976-77 varied from 4,150 in Nalanda to 9,772 in W. Champaran district. The details are given in Statement No. 15. The number of teachers in Middle schools also increased from 47,542 in 1970-71 to 71,918 in 1976-77 showing an imcreas of 51.3% during the period i.e. an annual growth rate of 8.5%.

(b) ENROLMENT :


37. The total enrolment in Middle schools was 15.77 lakhs in 1970-71 and it increased to 22.99 lakhs in 1976-77 which shows an average annual growth rate of 7.6%. The enrolment at the middle stage i.e. in classes VI-VIII increased from 8.73 lakhs (7.27 lakhs boys and 1.46 lakhs girls) in 1970-71 to 9.67 lakhs (7.80 lakhs boys and 1.87 lakhs girls) in 1976-77. This shows an average exponential growth rate of 1.7% per annum during the period under consideration. The average annual exponential growth rates of enrolment separately for boys and girls in these classes were 1.2% and 4.2% respectively.

38. The percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age group 11-14 i.e. enrolment ratio gives an index of facilities available at the Middle stage of education. In Bihar this percentage was 22.6 in 1970-71 and 21.2 in 1976-77. In case of boys enrolment ratio was 36.2% in 1970-71 and 33.1% in 1976-77. However, it increased in the case of girls from 7.8% to 8.5% during the period under consideration. Taking boys and girls together, the percentage enrolment in case of 14 districts was more than the corresponding state percentage in 1976-77. At middle stage this percentage indicates a wide disparity between the two sexes in all the districts. However, the position of girls improved slightly during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. In 1976-77, the enrolment ratio was highest in Patna for boys, girls and total (59.1, 23.1 and 42.3), and the lowest for boys and total in West Champaran district (17.2 & 11.3) whereas the lowest enrolment ratio for girls was in Nawada district i.e. only 2.2. The details may be seen in Statement No. 16.

(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. & S.T. :


39. Of the total enrolment of 8,72,635 in classes VI-VIII 1,16,217 students belonged to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in 1970-71 forming 13.3% of total enrolment. Out of the total enrolment of 9,66,901, the number of students belonging to Scheduled Caste in 1976-77, forming 14.9% of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII. The co-efficient of equality for Scheduled Caste therefore comes out to 48.9. Similarly out of the total enrolment in these classes 66,445 students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 5.9% of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII in 1976-77. The co-efficient of equality in the case of Scheduled Tribes thus comes out to 67.1.

POPULATION IN THE AGE-GROUP 11-14 (1970-71)






PERCENTAGE ENROLMENT (TOTAL) IN CLASSES II-IV TO



POPULATION IN THE AGE - GROUP 11-14 (1975-77)





(d) EXPENDITURE :

40. The total expenditure on Middle schools increased from Rs.781.15 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.26,79.86 lakhs in 1976-77, showing an average annual growth rate of 40.5% during the period under consideration.

41. The per capita expenditure on Middle schools in the State was only Rs.1.39 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.4.23 in 1976-77. Each district has recorded an increase in the per capita expenditure during the period under consideration. The range of variation among the districts is from Rs.5.82 in the case of Dhanbad to Rs.2.52 in the case of Vaishali.

42. The total expenditure on Middle schools in 1970-71 formed 18.0% of the total expenditure on education in the State, which increased to 20.1% in 1976-77. In as many as 23 districts, the percentage expenditure on Middle schools was more than the State percentage. The percentage of expenditure on Anglo-Indian schools was 1.8.

43. The average cost per student in Middle schools which was Rs.49.5 in 1970-71 increased to Rs.116.6 in 1976-77, at the State level. Among the districts the cost per student ranged from Rs.231.7 in W. Champaran to Rs.61.3 in Vaishali. (Anglo Indian schools however had the maximum cost per students viz. Rs.346.4). In 1970-71 pupil teacher ratio was 33 which decreased to 32 in 1976-77. Among the districts the teacher pupil ratio varied from 18 in case of Nalanda to 41 in case of Hazaribag. Further details can be seen in Statement No.18.

VIII - HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

44. It is significant to note that the stage of Higher Secondary Education comprising of 4 years of schooling was abolished during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. As a result there were only High Schools comprising of 2 years of education in the State in 1976-77. The number of High/Higer Secondary Schools in Bihar increased from 2,598 in 1970-71 to 2,972 in 1976-77. This shows an increase of 14.4% during the period under review. Taking together the number of High Schools of bifurcated districts in 1976-77 the increase in number of High Schools was shared by all the districts. Among the districts/largest number of High Schools was in Monghyr district (185) while the smallest number was located in Gopalganj and Katihar (45 each).

45. On an average, there was a High/Higer Secondary School for every 66.9 Sq. Kms. area in Bihar in 1970-71. By 1976-77 a High School was available for every 58.5 Sq. Kms. In 1976-77 there was a High School in Patna district for every 17.6 Sq. Kms. area, whereas in Palamu district, one High School was available for an area of 230.9 Sq. Kms. only.

46. On an average, at the State level, there was a High/Higer Secondary School for every 21,655 persons in 1970-71. By 1976-77, a High School was available for every 21,325 persons. Among the districts the average population covered by a school varied from as high as 38,876 in W. Champaran to as low as 13,039 in Nalanda.

47. The total number of teachers in High/Higer Secondary Schools in Bihar increased from 23,336 in 1970-71, to 32,601 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 15.1% during the period under consideration. During the period of 6 years, there was an increase in the number of teachers in all the districts adding up number of teachers in 1976-77 of the bifurcated districts. Women teachers formed 8.7% of the total number of teachers in 1976-77.

(b) ENROLMENT :


48. The total enrolment in High/Higer Secondary Schools of the State in 1970-71 was 8,16,309 which increased to 9,71,092 in High Schools in 1976-77. This shows an average annual exponential growth rate of 2.65% during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. The enrolment of the Secondary and Higher Secondary stage i.e. in classes IX-XI was 5,42,048 (4,91,721 boys and 50,327 girls) in 1970-71. The enrolment at the High stage i.e. classes IX & X was 3,79,188 (3,26,389 boys and 52,799 girls) during 1976-77. Among the districts, the percentage of enrolment in these classes varied from 7.8% in Patna district to 1.8% in Nawada district.

49. The enrolment ratio for Bihar State at the High/Higer Secondary stage was 15.6% in 1970-71. The enrolment ratio at High stage i.e. classes IX & X was 9.1% (15% boys and 2.6% girls) in 1976-77. There is wide desparity in the enrolment ratio in all the districts among boys and girls. Percentage/enrolment was found to be maximum in Patna for boys, girls and total (26.2, 8.7 and 18.1) and minimum in Purnea for boys & total (8.5 and 5.2) whereas lowest for girls was in Nawada (0.5).

(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T.


50. Of the total enrolment of 5,42,048 in classes IX to XI, 49,507 students belonged to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in 1970-71 which formed 9.1% of the total enrolment in these classes. Out of the total enrolment of 3,79,188 in High School classes in 1976-77, 24,027 students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 22,094 to Scheduled Tribes in classes IX & X. The percentage of S.O. and S.T. students to total enrolment in these classes were 6.3 and 5.8 respectively where as the percentage of S.C. and S.T. population to the total population in the State were 14.1 and 8.8 respectively. Therefore, the co-efficients of equality for the

POPULATION IN THE AGE-GROUP 14-17 (1970-71)



TO POPULATION IN THE AGE-GROUP 14-17 (1970-71)




PERCENTAGE ENROLMENT (TOTAL) IN CLASSES IX-XI




PERCENTAGE ENROLMENT (GIRLS) IN CLASSES IX-X TO

Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes communities worked out to be 44.7% and 65.9% respectively. The details of enrolment and percentages can be seen in the Statement No. 21.

(d) EXPENDITURE :

51. The total expenditure on High/Higher Secondary Schools in the State increased from Rs.804.40 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.2353.08 lakhs on High Schools in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an average annual growth rate of 32.1% during the period under consideration.

52. The per capita expenditure on High/Higher Secondary Schools at the State level was Rs.1.43 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.3.71 on High Schools by 1976-77. Among the districts the per capita expenditure on High Schools was the highest in Patna district (Rs.8.17) and the lowest in Sitamarhi (Rs.1.80).

53. The total expenditure on High/Higher Secondary Schools in 1970-71 formed 18.6% of the total expenditure on education in Bihar. By 1976-77 the percentage expenditure on High Schools was 17.7. In 17 districts, the percentage expenditure spent on High/Higher Secondary Schools was more than the State average. The expenditure on High/Higher Secondary Schools as percentage of total expenditure on education was the highest in Bhojpur (32.9) and the lowest in Muzaffarpur (7.4). Anglo Indian Schools, however, had the maximum expenditure as percentage to total expenditure (89.1).

54. The cost per student in High/Higer Secondary Schools was increased from Rs.98.5 in 1970-71 to Rs.242.3 in 1976-77 during the period of 6 years. Among the districts, it varies from Rs.350.7 in the case of Santhal Paragana to Rs.138.5 in the case of Singhbhum (Anglo Indian Schools, however, had the maximum cost per pupil Rs.647.4). The pupil teacher ratio increased marginally at the State level during the period under consideration from 29 to 30 in 1976-77. The pupil teacher ratio varied from 21 in Nalanda to 44 in Hazaribag. The details can be seen in statement No.22.

IX - PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION.

55. The number of Schools for Vocational, Professional, Special and Other Education increased from 684 in 1970-71 to 808 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 18.1% during the period of 6 years.

56. The total enrolment in Professional and Vocational (School) education also increased from 53,303 (45,688 boys and 7,615 girls) in 1970-71 to 85,179 (69,911 boys and 15,268 girls) in 1976-77 showing an average annual exponential growth rate of 6.24% (8.8% for boys and 16.7% girls). In professional and vocational (school) education the enrolment of S.C. & S.T. students was 1042 (873 boys and 169 girls) in 1970-71. In 1976-77, the enrolment of S.C. and S.T. students was 957 (835 boys and 104 girls) and 970 (886 boys and 84 girls) respectively. The percentage of S.C./S.T. students to total enrolment in these courses was 1.12 & 1.13 respectively. Number of

teachers in these courses increased from 2814 in 1970-71 to 3538 in 1976-77 showing average annual increase of 4.3%.

57. The total expenditure on these institutions increased from Rs.41.1 lakhs in 1970-71 to 72.64 lakhs in 1976-77 during the period under review showing an average annual growth of 12.8%. Among the districts the maximum expenditure in 1976-77 on this account is shown by Patna (7%) whereas minimum i.e. 0.6% is shown by Nawada district. District-wise information on professional, vocational, special and other education (school) can be seen from Statement No.23.

X - HIGHER EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

58. Number of institutions for Higher Education increased from 491 in 1970-71 to 592 in 1976-77, showing an increase of 20.6% during this period. In 1976-77 there were 14 Universities Deemed to be Universities, Institutions of National Importance and Research Institutions. Out of these 3 each are located in Patna and Darbanga districts & the rest 1 each in 8 different districts. In all there were 340 Affiliated Institutions of Degree Level, 186 below Degree Level, 7 Boards of Intermediate Education and 45 Intermediate/Jr. Colleges. Of the 340 affiliated institutions (Degree Level), 226 were for Arts, Science and Commerce ranging from 1 each in Giridih district and Palamu district to 24 in Patna district. There were 3 institutions for Agriculture and Forestry, 1 each in Muzaffarpur, Bhagalpur and Ranchi districts. One for Business Management in Muzaffarpur. Out of 12 institutions for Education, 2 are in Patna and 3 are in Ranchi and the rest 1 each in the other 7 districts. There were 6 Colleges for Engineering and Technology and these were located one each in Patna, Muzaffarpur, Bhagalpur, Dhanbad, Singhbhum and Ranchi districts. There were 28 institutions for Medicines in the State out of which the highest number (8) is found to be in Patna.

59. Statement No.24 gives district-wise statistics of teachers in the institutions of higher education in Bihar. Total number of teachers in these institutions increased from 12,105 in 1970-71 to 15,803 in 1976-77 showing an average/increase of 5.1% during the period. Amongst 1 annual districts the number of teachers in institutions for higher education was the highest in Patna (2302) and the lowest in Giridih (55).

(b) ENROLMENT :

60. The total enrolment in all institutions of higher education in the State was 2,47,647 in 1970-71 which increased to 2,87,394 in 1976-77 showing an average annual exponential growth rate of 2.3%. Of this, 2,02,875 students were studying in Arts, Science and Commerce Colleges, 509 in Agriculture and Forestry, 41 in Business Management, 5430 in Engineering Technology and Arch., 6102 in Law, 11252 in Medical Colleges and 5314 students were studying in other courses. 9,558 students were studying in universities, Research Institutions, Deemed to be Universities and Institutions of National Importance. The total enrolment in institutions for higher education was the highest in Patna (37,133) followed by Ranchi (28,879) and the lowest in Giridih (1,300). District-wise details are given in Statement No.25.

61. Statement No.26 gives the enrolment in higher education by type of education. The total enrolment in higher education increased from 2,47,647 (2,25,825 boys and 21,822 girls) in 1970-71 to 2,79,882 (2,42,968 boys and 36,914 girls) in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 2.2%. Out of the total enrolment 62,19,338 (1,89,477 boys and 29,,861 girls) students were enrolled for General Education and 60,544 (53,491 boys and 7,053 girls) in Professional Education during the year 1976-77.

(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T. (

62. There were 21,943 (19,578 boys and 2,365 girls) students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Communities studying for higher education in 1970-71. This formed 8.9% of the total enrolment in higher educational institutions.

In 1976-77 their number increased to 25,319 i.e 12,067 (11,505 boys and 562 girls) Scheduled Castes and 13,252 Scheduled Tribes. These formed 4.3% and 4.7% of the total enrolment in higher education classes at the State level for the two communities. The co-efficient of equality of S.C. and S.T. students at the higher education stage were 30.6% and 53.4% respectively.

(d) EXPENDITURE :

63. The total expenditure on higher education in the State increased from 1459.37 lakhs in 1970-71 to 4412.12 lakhs in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 11.15% during the period under review. Among the districts, the highest expenditure was recorded by Patna (18%) and the lowest in case of Giridih district (0.2%) during the year 1976-77.
