
I avail this opportunity to extend my thanks and gratitude to all the District Heads of Departments/Offices for whose co-operation and help made it possible to bring-out this publication.

DIBANG VALLEY DISTRICT  
(A Brief Introduction )

Earlier the Dibang Valley District was a part and parcel and independent and full fledged district w.e.f. 1.8.1980 as per (Re-organisation of District Act, 1980, Act No. 5 of 1980) vide Notification No. Law/Logn-12/79 dated 13-5-1980. The Dibang Valley District has the largest area of 13,029 Sq. Km with the lowest population of 30,978 persons (as per 1981 Census) inhabiting at the rate of 2 (two) persons per Sq. Km. The District consists of a number of sub-Valleys formed by the tributaries of Dibang River, Dri, Mathun, Ithun, Talem, Embra, Ahui and the Sissiri rivers respectively.

The Dibang Valley District is bounded on the North by Tibet and snow capped high mountains of Himalayas, on the South parts of Lohit District and Assam State on the East parts of Tibet and parts of Lohit District and on the West by East Siang District .

This district covers an area of 13,029 Sq. Km with population 30,978 living in 232 villages as per 1981 Census.

The district is a wild, mountainous area and presents a remarkable topographical variety.

This district has two very contrasting features, it is the biggest district in area and the smallest district in population.

POPULATION :-

CENSUS- 1981 (Brief analysis)

The population count of 1981 Census of Dibang Valley District reveals that there are 30,978 people which constitutes only 4.90 % of the total population of the Arunachal Pradesh. Though this proportion is found to be very small i.e. the lowest amongst all the districts, its area is the largest among all the districts of Arunachal Pradesh. When all the districts are Ranked it is observed that, Dibang Valley District Ranks last in Sex Ratio.

The percentage of Scheduled Tribe population of Dibang Valley District to total population is 48.56.

The variation in the population of Dibang Valley District in between 1971 and 1981 Census has been found to be very high i.e. 103.37 % as against only 35.15 % in Arunachal Pradesh.

The largest Circle of Sibang Valley District by size of population is ROING CIRCLE which consists of 18,040 persons out of a total population of 30,970 the percentage being 58.23. The smallest Circle of the district is found to be ANELIH CIRCLE with a population of 781 persons and it contains only 2.52 percent of the district population.

TOPOGRAPHY :-

The Sibang Valley District claims one of the most difficult terrains in Arunachal Pradesh. The worst parts in the entire district are the regions between Ithun, Ahui as well as also Embra and Talon Rivers. The area between KRONLI and foothills had been badly affected by the great earthquake in 1950. The bamboos grasses and high mountain ranges which are covered with snow almost throughout the year. The middle valley is covered with thick tropical and sub-tropical forests. There are innumerable precipitous ridges, gurgling rivers, deep and narrow gorges which inspire awe in minds of travellers. After this middle valley, rain changes into broad and wide valley drained by ORI and ITHUN Rivers. Situated at the elevation of about 1,500 Metres, this region is one of the most beautiful area in Arunachal Pradesh.

MAIN TRIBES :-

Two main Tribes, Namely, IDUS and PAUAMS (Adis) inhabit the Sibang Valley area. The Idu-Mishmies to whom the Sibang Valley belongs are the main dominant tribes of the district. In the foot-hills areas of ROING and JAMBUK Circles, PAUAMS (Adis) are predominant. They originally came from the BAMROH AREA of the East Siang District but now constitute more than half of the population of the ROING and JAMBUK Circles respectively.
