The Statistical Hand Book of Kokrajhar district, 1990-91 is the third series of publication next to 1976. Before that publication was done in the year 1974 and 1976 as Sub-divisional Statistical Hand Book by the then Statistical Officers. After that constant attempt was made to publish the Statistical Hand Book in the consecutive years of 1977 to 1990, it could not be successful due to various constraints faced by the district branch of the Department.

The importance of the District Statistical Hand Book is necessary for formulation and policy making of various development activities by the Govt. specially in the present Government policy of decentralised Planning at the Sub-divisional level. Proper Planning is possible only when statistical data of each and every subject is available with the planners.

Attempt has been made to compile the numerical data incorporating various socio economic activities of the various Govt. Semi Govt. and even from private agencies up to the year, 1990-91. But most of the data could not be presented up-to-date due to lack of scope and time. Moreover due to reorganisation of Kokrajhar district the actual data covering the geographical boundary of the new district could not be made available due to which most of the data are meant for Old Kokrajhar district boundary that is covering part of Bongaigaon district. This technical constraints will be overcome only after publication of new Census Hand Book of 1991 population Census.

I express my gratitude to various departments for their operation that made success in publication of this Hand Book. Continuous efforts will be done in improvement of the Hand Book by presenting up-to-date data for the newly constituted district. I also thank Shri M. Rahman, Lecturer, Kokrajhar College and the Circle Officer, Sidli for designing and correction of newly constituted Kokrajhar district Map incorporated in this Hand Book.

Any suggestion for improvement for quality and coverage of future publication will be acknowledged with thanks.
