



## I N T R O D U C T I O N

This Report deals with the provision of educational facilities available for children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in the country during 1966-67. The information contained in this publication is mostly based on the educational data collected annually from all the States and Union Territories in a prescribed Form entitled 'Form A-1'. Besides depicting the progress of educational facilities provided to students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes during the year 1966-67, it gives inter-alia a comparative picture with the previous year.

2. The coverage of this publication is mainly restricted to the enrolment of children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes at different levels of education beginning from pre-primary education up to the highest stage of education with all the possible bifurcation into different standards of education. It also gives sex-wise and State-wise comparison of the progress of education among the children belonging to these castes. An attempt has also been made to work out the extent of coverage at different stages and levels of education in respect of these communities.

3. The population statistics included in this Report relate to 1971 Census Data and no attempt has been made to estimate the population of these communities for the year under report. Further, the publication gives mainly the statistical progress based on the factual data collected from various primary sources and no attempt has been made to draw any conclusion or insinuation, although some analysis of the data has been done wherever desirable with a view to give at a glance the progress of education among the children of various age-groups of these communities.

4. Appendices 'A' and 'B' give respectively the State-wise details of progress made in providing educational facilities to the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe communities.

5. Opportunity is taken to convey the thanks of the Ministry of Education & Social Welfare to all the State Governments and Administrations of Union Territories who supplied the basic statistics for the preparation of this publication.

S U M M A R Y

Educational facilities have expanded substantially in the country since Independence. This is reflected by the phenomenal increase in the number of institutions of different types, enrolment therein, number of teachers employed and the educational expenditure incurred thereon. Table I below, which gives the percentage of coverage of the population of different school-going age-groups, indicates at a glance the significant developments that have taken place in the field of education during the post-Independence period:

2. Although all-round expansion of education has been witnessed in the post-Independence era, it has not spread over uniformly in the country. There still remain certain areas and social communities as well as some groups of population which lag far behind others in the development of education. Some special efforts are, therefore, required to accelerate the pace of educational development in such backward areas, social groups of population, like; girls, Scheduled Castes, scheduled Tribes, backward classes and other communities living in hill areas.

3. The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment in the country increased from 10.9 in 1965-66 to 11.1 in 1966-67. The corresponding percentage increase for Scheduled Tribes remained the same at 4.2 in both the years. In terms of extent of coverage, the overall position improved slightly from 74.7 in 1965-66 to 76.00 in 1966-67 in the case of Scheduled Castes, while it remained the same at 60.9 for both the years in case of Scheduled Tribes. The extent of coverage remaining constant in case of Scheduled Tribes may not be considered as alarming feature for it implies that the enrolment of this community at least kept pace with the increase in the population of this community. However, there is a case for making efforts to improve the coverage of population of this community.

Table 2 below indicates the comparative position of enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in various types of institutions in India for the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 and also gives the extent of coverage. (\*)

The details of enrolment of children belonging respectively to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, studying in various educational institutions in different States and Union Territories are given in the statements included in Appendices 'A' and 'B' of the Report.

4. If a fair deal had been given to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, the extent of coverage should have been 100 or in other words, the percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total enrolment should have been equal to the percentage population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total population. An index of greater than 100, implies that the educational advance of Scheduled Castes/Tribes is more than that of the total population and thereby shows that there are some other social groups whose condition is even worse than that of the general population. If this index is less than 100 it may be concluded that the Scheduled Castes/Tribes have still some lee-way to make. In such cases, special efforts are needed to be made to improve their enrolment. The smaller the extent of coverage, the greater the need for making such efforts.

5. For analysis of this subject in detail as well as because of the different position obtaining amongst Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes so far as educational facilities are concerned, it has been felt desirable to divide this report into two parts. Part I deals with educational development of Scheduled Castes and Part II gives out the educational development of Scheduled Tribes.

P A R T - I

EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES FOR SCHEDULED CASTES

Population of Scheduled Castes

6. According to 1971 Census the population of Scheduled Castes was about 80.00 millions and formed 14.6% of the total population of the country. Table 3 below gives State-wise break-up of the population of this community as well as its percentage of total population.

It will be seen that <sup>the</sup> largest population of Scheduled Castes (24.7%) was found in Punjab followed by Himachal Pradesh (22.2%) and West Bengal (19.9%). The smallest proportion of Scheduled Caste population (0.1%) was reported by Arunachal Pradesh.

7. The population of Scheduled Caste for the year 1967 is not available, but for the purpose of this Report it has been assumed that the percentage of Scheduled Caste population to the total population of each State as recorded in 1971 Census holds good for 1967 as well.

Enrolment of Scheduled Castes

8. Table 4 below depicts the all-India picture of the total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of institutions during the years 1965-66 and 1966-67:-

It is observed that the total enrolment increased from 76.8 lakhs in 1965-66 to 81.5 lakhs in 1966-67, giving an increase rate of 6.1% during this period. The girls' enrolment included in the total, however, increased from 21.16 lakhs in 1965-66 to 22.91 lakhs in 1966-67. Additional enrolment during the one year period was of the order of 4.61 lakhs and the major increase of 2.37 lakhs in Primary Schools alone was noteworthy.

9. The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment and the extent of coverage in various types of educational institutions is given in Table 5 as under:

The overall extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste candidates increased from 74.7 in 1965-66 to 76.0 in 1966-67. The extent of coverage in respect of universities and colleges for general education is shown to have gone down from 31.5 in 1965-66 to 30.8 in 1966-67, but this fall was due to the reclassification of various categories of educational institutions as higher educational institutions and institutions of school standard. Some of the institutions shown as colleges in 1965-66 have been categorised as institutions of school standard in 1966-67.

The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes in 1965-66 was more than 100 in four States, namely; Assam, Gujarat, Kerala and Maharashtra and two Union Territories, viz; Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Manipur. In case of Union Territory of Tripura, the extent of coverage was 100 in 1965-66. In 1966-67 these States and Union Territories reported extent of coverage as more than 100.

Progress of Educational Facilities

12. A review of the progress of educational facilities available to Scheduled Caste students during the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 indicated an overall improvement in their enrolment. The position varied from State to State and also over various types of institutions. Statements II to IX in the Appendix 'A' indicate State-wise progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of educational institutions.

13. A brief comparative review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes as percentage to the total enrolment and the extent of coverage for the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 in various types of educational institutions is given in the following paragraphs:

(i) Pre-Primary Schools

While the total enrolment in pre-Primary Schools in the country increased from 2.15 lakhs in 1965-66 to 2.30 lakhs in 1966-67, thus, registering an increase of 7% during this period, the enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased from 11,530 (5.4% of the total) in 1965-66 to 14,909 (6.5% of the total) in 1966-67. As seen from Statement II in Appendix 'A', the maximum increase in the enrolment of Scheduled Castes in pre-primary schools was reported by Madhya Pradesh, where it increased from 743 in 1965-66 to 3,081 in 1966-67. This improvement in enrolment is also indicated by the increase in the extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students from 37.0 in 1965-66 to 44.5 in 1966-67. The State-wise percentage of enrolment and extent of coverage are indicated in Table 8:

(ii) Primary Schools

The total enrolment in the Primary Schools in the country increased from 372.2 lakhs in 1965-66 to 381.8 lakhs in 1966-67, showing an increase of 2.6% during the year 1966-67. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased from 48.0 lakhs in 1965-66 to 50.4 lakhs in 1966-67, thus registering an increase of 5% during the year 1966-67. The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment in Primary schools increased from 12.9 in 1965-66 to 13.2 in 1966-67. The extent of coverage also showed an increase from 88.4 in 1965-66 to 90.5 in 1966-67. State-wise position of these percentages is shown in Table 9 below. However, details of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Primary schools by States and Union Territories for the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 are given in Statement III of Appendix 'A'.

(iii) Middle Schools

The total enrolment in Middle Senior Basic Schools for the country increased from 167.2 lakhs in 1965-66 to 175.8 lakhs in 1966-67, registering an increase of 4.9% in 1966-67. Corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased from 15.8 lakhs in 1965-66 to 16.8 lakhs in 1966-67. Scheduled Caste students formed 9.4% in 1965-66 and this percentage increased to 9.6% in 1966-67. Corresponding figures of extent of coverage were 64.4 and 65.8 in the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 respectively. State-wise figures of percentage and extent of coverage are shown in Table 10 given below:-

(iv) High/Higher Secondary Schools

Total enrolment in High/Higher Secondary Schools for the country as a whole increased from 123.9 lakhs in 1965-66 to 135.0 lakhs in 1966-67 registering an increase of 9.0% in the year 1966-67. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students was 9.6 lakhs in 1965-66 which increased to 10.6 lakhs in 1966-67, showing an increase of 10.4% during 1966-67. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to the total enrolment was 7.7% in 1965-66 which increased to 7.8% only in 1966-67. Corresponding figures for the extent of coverage were 52.7 and 53.4 in the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 respectively. Enrolment percentage and extent of coverage are shown in Table 11 below.

(v) Schools for Vocational and Technical Education

Total Enrolment in Vocational and Technical Schools of the country was 2,47,021 in 1965-66. Of this the number of Scheduled Caste students was 18785 and formed 7.6 percent of the total enrolment. In 1966-67, while the total enrolment of all communities in these schools decreased to 2,25,475, the enrolment of scheduled caste students increased to 21,864 and formed 9.7 percent of the total enrolment. Corresponding extent of coverage was 66.4 in 1966-67. State-wise enrolment percentages and the extent of coverage have been indicated in Table 12.

(vi) Schools for Special Education

Schools for physically and mentally handicapped children and the reformatories are generally taken under Schools for Special Education. In the year 1965-66, 22,828 students from all communities were enrolled in these institutions of which 2,272 were scheduled caste students. These students formed 10.0 percent of the total enrolment. In the year 1966-67 total enrolment increased to 25,071 of which 2,217 were Scheduled Caste students. Scheduled Caste students formed 8.8 percent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage for Scheduled Caste enrolment in 1966-67 was 60.3. The State-wise figures of percentage enrolment and extent of coverage are delineated in Table 13 as below:-

During 1965-66, 2.30 lakhs Scheduled Caste students were enrolled and they formed 13.0 percent of the total enrolment of 17.69 lakhs. Total enrolment of all communities in these institutions during 1966-67 was 17.50 lakhs. Of these, Scheduled Caste students were 2.35 lakhs which formed 13.4 percent of the total enrolment. The extent of coverage for all-India in 1966-67 worked out to 91.8. Figures for percentage enrolment and extent of coverage are indicated in Table 14 given below. Enrolment figures for Scheduled Caste students in Special Education Schools and other Education Schools may be seen from Statement VII of the Appendix 'A'.

(viii) Schools for Vocational, Special and Other Education taken together

Total enrolment of all communities in all the above categories of schools in 1965-66 was 20.59 lakhs of which scheduled caste students were 2.51 lakhs forming 12.29 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage was 84.2. In 1966-67 the total enrolment decreased to 20.00 lakhs but the enrolment of scheduled caste students increased to 2.59 lakhs showing 13.0 percent of the total enrolment. Extent of coverage was recorded as 89.0 in 1966-67.

(ix) Institutions for Higher Education, Universities and Colleges of General Education

The total number of students enrolled in these institutions increased from 12.51 lakhs in 1965-66 to 14.21 lakhs in 1966-67, i.e. an increase of 13.6 percent during 1966-67. The enrolment of Scheduled Caste students also increased from 57,496 in 1965-66 to 64,043 in 1966-67 including 6,620 girls. That shows an increase of 11.4 percent during 1966-67. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes was 4.6 percent in 1965-66 which slightly declined to 4.5 percent in 1966-67. The extent of coverage too declined from 31.5 in 1965-66 to 30.8 in 1966-67. The comparative percentage enrolment and extent of coverage for these two years have been indicated below in Table 15. Detailed data on enrolment in Universities and colleges of general education in 1966-67 have been depicted in Statement VIII of Appendix 'A'.

(x) Colleges of Professional Education

Enrolment of all Communities as a whole was 6.16 lakhs in 1965-66 which increased to 6.93 lakhs in 1966-67. The Scheduled Caste students enrolled were 29,851 (including 4,532 girls) in 1965-66 and this enrolment increased to 34,402 (including 4,431 girls) in 1966-67. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students as percentage to the total enrolment/in 1966-67. The extent of coverage was recorded as 33.2 percent and 34.2 percent in the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 respectively. Statewise percentages of enrolment and extent of coverage are shown in Table 16 below:-

(Colleges and Schools)

A composite picture of State-wise enrolment, percentages and extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste Students in institutions for Professional, Special and Other Education (both colleges and schools) during the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 has been shown in Table 17. Total number of students enrolled in these colleges and schools was 27.51 lakhs in 1965-66 and it increased to 27.96 lakhs in 1966-67. Of the total, the number of scheduled caste students were 2.83 lakhs in 1965-66 and 2.92 lakhs in 1966-67. Enrolment percentage of scheduled caste students to the total enrolment was 10.3 and 10.4 during the years 1965-66 and 1966-67. Extent of coverage of scheduled caste students increased from 70.5 in 1965-66 to 71.2 in 1966-67.

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES BY STAGES OF EDUCATION

15. So far, the progress in enrolment of Scheduled Caste students by type of institutions only has been discussed. Comparative picture of enrolment and extent of coverage for the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 has been shown in respect of different categories of institutions. However, the correct idea about the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Caste students can be had only from the stage-wise position of enrolment as discussed in the following paragraphs.

Table 20 indicates the enrolment of all communities as well as of Scheduled Caste students alone by stages of education for the year 1966-67. Enrolment of scheduled castes as percentage to the total enrolment for different stages of education has also been indicated.

(i) Primary Stage

The number of classes constituting the primary stage of education varies from State to State. For the sake of uniformity, the first five classes of schools have been taken to constitute the primary stage in all States/Union Territories of India. Total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Classes I-V increased from 59,38,390 in 1965-66 to 62,59,325 in 1966-67. The number of girl students during 1965-66 and 1966-67 was 17,58,690 and 18,93,907 respectively. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to total enrolment was 11.8 in 1965-66 and 12.0 in 1966-67. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students in these classes was 82.2 in 1966-67. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students at primary stage, percentages to the total enrolment and extent of coverage figures for 1966-67 in respect of each State of India have been indicated in Table 21. Enrolment by classes at primary stage and by States are included in Statement X of Appendix 'A'.

(ii) Middle Stage

Number of classes constituting middle stage too are not the same in all the States and Union Territories. But in most of the States and Union Territories classes VI, VII and VIII are treated as the middle stage of school education. Hence for the sake of uniformity classes VI-VIII (3 classes) are taken under middle stage for all the States and Union Territories. In 1965-66 Scheduled Caste Students enrolled at middle stage were 9,78,855 of whom 1,98,004 were girls. Scheduled Caste students formed 9.3 percent of the total enrolment in 1965-66. Corresponding Scheduled Caste enrolment was 10,60,234 (including 2,19,382 girls) in 1966-67. The students of Scheduled Caste Community formed 9.5 percent of the total enrolment at this stage during this year. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes under this stage of education was 65.1 in 1966-67.

Table 22 depicts the position of the numbers enrolled, enrolment percentages and extent of coverage at middle stage in various States and Union Territories. Class-wise enrolment at middle stage is given in Statement XI of Appendix A.

(iii) High/Higher Secondary Stage

The number of classes which comprises High/Higher Secondary stage also varies from State to State in India. But for the purposes of this report this stage has been taken to comprise of classes IX and above for all the States and Union Territories. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students at this stage was 3,96,626 of whom 64,887 were girls in 1965-66. Scheduled Caste students formed 7.8 percent of the total enrolment. Corresponding enrolment for 1966-67 was 4,29,237 of whom 72,967 were girls. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students was 53.4 in 1966-67. Position of enrolment and extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students in these classes at High/Higher Secondary stage has been depicted in Table 23. Details of class-wise enrolment for classes IX and above by States may, however, be seen in Statement XII of Appendix 'A'.

(iv) Enrolment by Classes at School Stage

Table 24 depicts the percentage of Scheduled Caste enrolment to total enrolment in various classes (Pre-primary to higher secondary stage) and extent of coverage for the year 1966-67. The percentage of Scheduled Caste Students to all the classes at school stage was 11.0 in 1965-66 which increased slightly to 11.2 percent in 1966-67. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students at school stage was 76.7 in 1966-67.

(v) Vocational, Special and Other Education (School Standard)

Vocational Education includes inter-alia Agriculture, Commerce, Teachers Training, Technical/Industrial and Arts and Crafts Schools etc., Special Education includes institutions for mentally and physically handicapped children and reformatory schools, Other Education relates to institutions of oriental studios, social (Adult) education and other specified education. During the year 1965-66, the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in Vocational Education was 21,206 forming 7.2 percent of the total enrolment. Corresponding figures for Special and other Education were 2,272 and 2,30,088 forming 9.8 and 12.5 percent respectively of the total enrolment of all communities at these stages of education. In 1966-67 the Scheduled Caste students enrolled were 22,692 in Vocational Education forming 8.4 percent of the total enrolment. Scheduled Caste enrolment in schools for Special Education and Other Education was 2,217 and 2,36,471 respectively. The percentage to the

total enrolment in this year were 8.8 and 13.0 respectively. Enrolment percentages and the extent of coverage in respect of vocational, special and Other Education (School Standard) has been indicated in detail in Table 25. Details of the enrolment for vocational, special and other types of education (School standard) are given in Statements XIII and XIV of Appendix A.

(vi) Higher Education (General)

In 1965-66 the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in general higher education was 74,528 (including 6,299 girls), forming 5.6 percent of the total enrolment. Scheduled Caste girls formed 1.9 percent of the total girl students in these classes. In 1966-67 Scheduled Caste enrolment was 83,609 of whom 7,843 were girl students. During this year, Scheduled Caste students formed 5.6 percent of the total enrolment. Corresponding extent of coverage was 38.4 in 1966-67. Table 26 indicates the enrolment of Scheduled Castes by different stages of general higher education.

(vii) Professional and Other Higher Education

Enrolment of Scheduled Castes in 1965-66 was 32,471 of whom 4,268 were girls. In 1966-67 Scheduled Caste enrolment at this stage of education increased to 37,579. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment was 4.4 in 1966-67 and the extent of coverage was 30.1. Stage-wise distribution of Scheduled Castes has been given in Table 28.

It will be seen that the percentage of population of Scheduled Tribes was highest in Nagaland (88.6%) and lowest in Uttar Pradesh (0.2%) among States. Among Union Territories, the highest percentage of Scheduled Tribe population (92.9%) was reported by L.M. & A. Islands and the least (0.9%) was reported by Goa, Daman and Diu. The Union Territory of Delhi and Pondicherry had no population of Scheduled Tribes in their respective Territories.

17. The population of Scheduled Tribes for the year 1967 is not available, but for the purpose of this Report it has been assumed that the percentage of Scheduled Tribe population to the total population of each State as recorded in 1971 Census holds good for 1967 as well.

Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes

18. Table 32 below depicts the all-India picture of the total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in various types of educational institutions during the years 1965-66 and 1966-67.

It is seen that the total enrolment of children belonging to Scheduled Tribes increased from 29.79 lakhs in 1965-66 to 30.60 lakhs in 1966-67, giving an increase rate of 2.7% during this period. Girls enrolment included in the total, however, increased from 8.07 lakhs (27.1%) in 1965-66 to 8.43 lakhs (27.5%) in 1966-67. A percentage of Scheduled Tribes enrolment to total enrolment was 4.2 during both the years under review.

Progress of Educational Facilities

22. A review of the progress of the educational facilities available to Scheduled Tribe students during the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 indicated almost constant position of the enrolment in various types of educational institutions, it being varied from State to State. Statements I to XVI in Appendix 'B' indicate State-wise position of the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in various types of educational institutions.

23 A comparative review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled tribes as percentage to the total enrolment and the extent of coverage for the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 in various types of educational institutions is given in the following paragraphs:

(i) Pre-Primary Schools

Enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in Pre-Primary schools decreased from 7,260 (3.4% of the total) in 1965-66 to 7,195 (3.1% of the total) in 1966-67. However, enrolment of Scheduled Tribe girls increased from 3,354 in 1965-66 to 3,452 in 1966-67. Corresponding percentage of the extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes students was 49.3 and 44.9 in 1965-66 and 1966-67 respectively. The State-wise data is delineated in Table 36 as hereunder:

(ii) Primary Schools

Whereas the total enrolment in Primary schools in the country as a whole increased from 3.72 crores in 1965-66 to 3.82 crores in 1966-67, enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students increased from 20.32 lakhs in 1965-66 to 20.56 lakhs in 1966-67. However, the percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment showed a decline from 5.5% in 1965-66 to 5.4% in 1966-67. The extent of coverage was 79.7 and 78.3 in 1965-66 and 1966-67 respectively. State-wise position of the enrolment percentage and extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes in Primary schools in 1965-66 and 1966-67 is indicated in Table 37 below:

### (iii) Middle Schools

Total enrolment in Middle schools of a country as a whole increased from 1.67 crores in 1965-66 to 1.76 crores in 1966-67 showing an increase of 6.01%. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Tribes increased from 5.57 lakhs to 5.76 lakhs, thus registering an increase of 5.2% in 1966-67. The total enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in middle schools formed only 3.3% of the total enrolment of all communities in this type of schools in the country. The extent of coverage remained at 47.8 in both the years. State-wise position of the enrolment percentage and the extent of coverage is given in Table 3B below:

(iv) High/Higher Secondary Schools

While the total number of students belonging to all communities enrolled in High and Higher Secondary Schools increased from 1.24 crores in 1965-66 to 1.35 crores in 1966-67, the corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Tribes increased from 2.07 lakhs to 2.31 lakhs during this period. In the case of the former the rate of increase was 8.9%, it was 11.6% in the latter case. Comparative picture of State-wise enrolment for these two years is given in Statement V in Appendix 'B'. The coverage of enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students as percentage of the total enrolment remained the same at 1.7 during both the years and so also the extent of coverage, which remained at 24.6 during this period. (v) Schools for Vocation & Technical Education

Total enrolment in vocational and technical schools in the country as a whole was 2.47 lakhs in 1965-66 of which only 2.4% formed the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes. In 1966-67, the corresponding total enrolment of the country as a whole was 2.25 lakhs of which 2.9% constituted the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribe students increased from 35.2 in 1965-66 to 42.0 in 1966-67. State-wise enrolment percentage and extent of coverage has been given in Table 40.

(viii) Schools for Other Education

Total enrolment in schools for other education decreased from 17.69 lakhs in 1965-66 to 17.50 lakhs in 1966-67. Similarly, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students declined from 1.50 lakhs to 1.49 lakhs during this period. While the percentage of Scheduled Tribe students remained at 8.5 in both the years, the extent of coverage increased from 122.6 in 1965-66 to 123.2 in 1966-67. State-wise picture can be seen from Table No.42.

(viii) Institutions for Higher Education, Universities and Colleges of General Education

While the total enrolment in these institutions increased from 13.48 lakhs in 1965-66 to 15.22 lakhs in 1966-67, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students increased from 14,165 in 1965-66 to 16,214 in 1966-67. However, the percentage of Scheduled Tribe students belonging to all communities studying in these institutions remained the same at 1.1 in both the years. Similarly, the extent of coverage also remained at 15.9 during both the years. While the detailed position of the enrolment by States in these Institutions is given in Statement VIII in Appendix 'B', a comparative picture of the enrolment percentages and the extent of coverage is given in Table 43.

(ix) Institutions for Professional, Special and Other Education (Colleges & Schools)

Total enrolment of all communities in these types of institutions increased from 27.51 lakhs in 1965-66 to 27.96 lakhs in 1966-67. The Scheduled Tribes enrolment in these institutions increased from 1.62 lakhs in 1965-66 to 1.63 lakhs in 1966-67 registering an increase of 0.6%. The Scheduled

Tribe students enrolment formed 5.8% of the total enrolment in the country as a whole in 1966-67 as against 5.9% during the previous year. Corresponding figure of the extent of coverage was 85.5 and 84.1 in 1965-66 and 1966-67 respectively. The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students and extent of coverage, State-wise, is indicated in Table 44 below.

(x) Colleges of Professional Education

The number of students studying in Colleges of Professional Education in the country increased from 6.16 lakhs in 1965-66 to 6.94 lakhs in 1966-67. The corresponding figure of Scheduled Tribe students was 5,659 in 1965-66 and 7,128 in 1966-67. The Scheduled Tribe students formed 0.9% of the total enrolment in 1965-66 and it slightly increased to 1.0 in 1966-67. Corresponding extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes in the country as a whole was 13.0 in 1965-66 and 14.7 in 1966-67. State-wise details of the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes as percentage to the total and the extent of coverage are given in Table 45 below:

General School Education

(i) Primary Stage

As already stated, the number of classes constituting the primary stage varies from stage to stage. But for the sake of uniformity Classes I-V have been taken to form primary stage in all States/Union Territories for the purpose of this report. Total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes at the primary stage in the country as a whole increased slightly from 24.05 lakhs in 1965-66 to 24.54 lakhs in 1966-67. Correspondingly, the girl's enrolment of this community increased from 6.70 thousands to 6.90 thousands. However, percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment at this stage declined from 4.8 in 1965-66 to 4.7 in 1966-67. Corresponding figures of extent of coverage was 69.2 in 1965-66 and 68.1 in 1966-67. State-wise enrolment at primary stage in respect of each class is given in statement X in Appendix 'B'. However, the enrolment of primary stage of Scheduled Tribe students and extent of coverage is indicated State-wise in Table 47.

(ii) Middle Stage

Here also in order to maintain uniformity, classes VI-VIII have been taken to constitute the middle stage in all the States and Union Territories of the country in respect of the State-wise variation in this regard. Scheduled Tribe students enrolled at this stage were of the order 2.90 lakhs in 1965-66. Of this, 0.62 lakh were girls. The corresponding figures of 1966-67 were 3.11 lakh and 0.63 lakh respectively. Middle stage enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students formed 2.8 percent of the total enrolment in both the years under review. Corresponding extent of coverage also remained at 40.6 in both the years. For class-wise enrolment a reference may be made to Statement II in Appendix 'B'. State-wise enrolment and its percentage to total enrolment as well as extent of coverage are given in Table 4B below.

(iii) High/Higher Secondary Stage

For the purposes of this Report, the high/higher secondary stage of general school education has been taken to consist of classes IX and above in all the States in respect of the varied system of school classes. The total number of Scheduled Tribe students studying at this stage was 1.02 lakhs, of whom 18,021 were girls in 1965-66. It increased to 1.08 (including 19,294 girls) in 1966-67. However, percentage of Scheduled Tribe enrolment to the total enrolment and extent of coverage remained 2.0 and 29.0 during both the years under review. Class-wise enrolment has been furnished in Statement XII in appendix 'B'. Table 49 gives State-wise enrolment, percentage enrolment and extent of coverage in respect of High/Higher Secondary classes.

(iv) Enrolment by Classes at School Stage

Table 49 gives class-wise percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment and extent of coverage in respect of general school education during 1966-67. Although, enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in general school education (classes pre-primary to higher secondary)

(v) Vocational, Special and Other Stages of School Standard

Scheduled Tribe students enrolled in Vocational/Professional schools increased from 6,398 in 1965-66 to 6,710 (including 1,346 girls) in 1966-67. Percentage of Scheduled Tribe enrolment to the total enrolment increased from 2.2 in 1965-66 to 2.5 in 1966-67. Corresponding extent of coverage was 31.7 in 1965-66 and 36.2 in 1966-67. State-wise break-up of enrolment in various stages of Vocational education is given in Statement XIII in appendix 'B'. Scheduled Tribe enrolment in special education schools increased from 409 in 1965-66 to 632 (including 100 girls) in 1966-67. It formed 1.8 percent of total enrolment in 1965-66 and 2.5 percent in 1966-67. Corresponding figure of extent of coverage was 26.0 in 1965-66 and 36.2 in 1966-67. The number of Scheduled Tribe students studying in other education schools showed a slight decline from 1,49,675 in 1965-66 to 1,49,004 in 1966-67. However, percentage of the Scheduled Tribe students enrolled to the total enrolment as well as extent of coverage

Scheduled Tribe Students enrolled in general higher education increased from 13,483 (including 2,364 girls) in 1965-66 to 15,739 (including 2,853 girls) in 1966-67. It formed 1.0 percent of the total enrolment. The corresponding percentage of Scheduled Tribe girls was 0.7 in 1965-66. In 1966-67 the percentage of Scheduled Tribe enrolment to the total enrolment remained at 1.0 but the percentage of girls increased to 0.8.
