
I N T R O D U C T I O N

Any suggestion from users for improvement of the publication will be gladly invited and accepted.

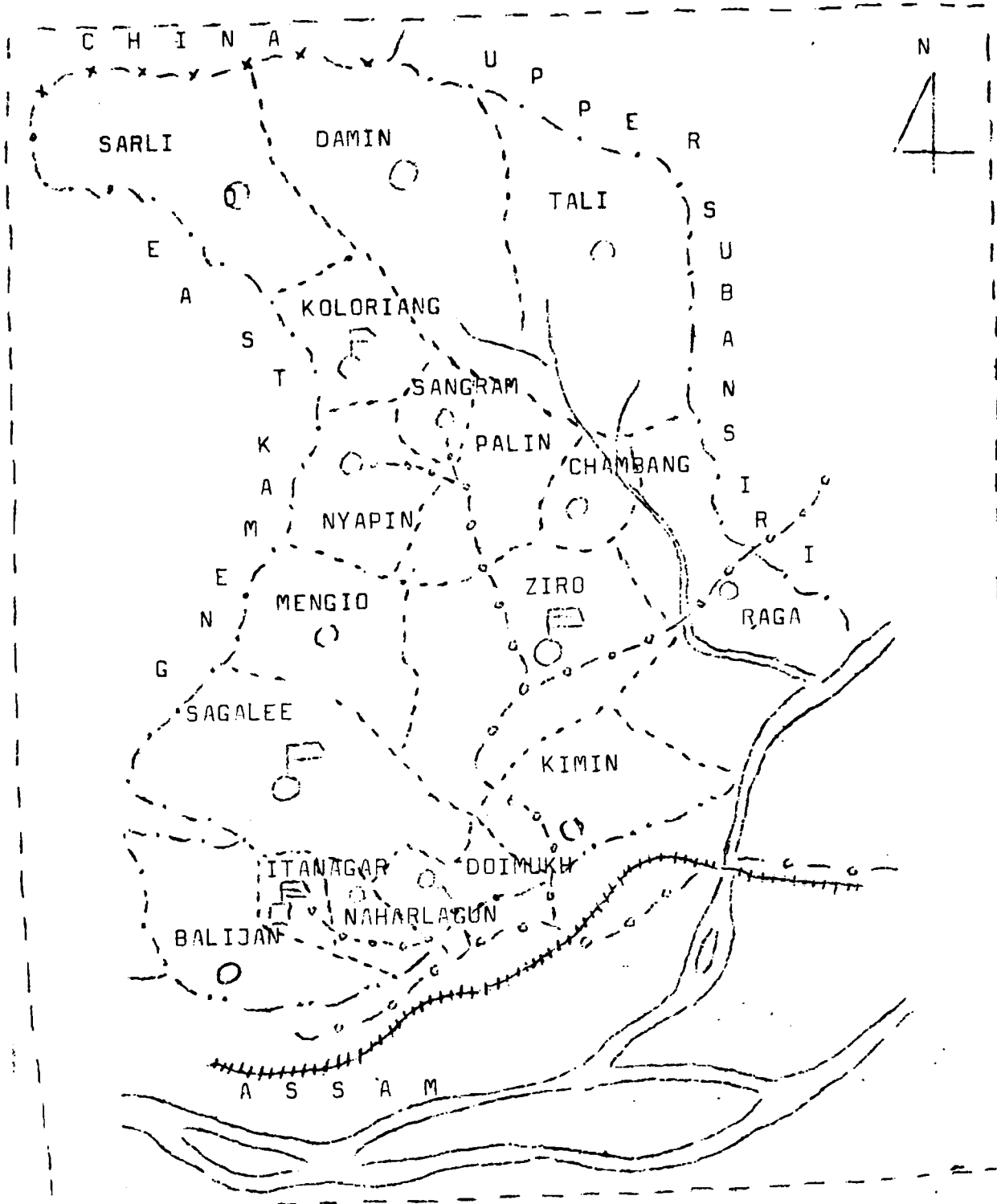

Film Shows, distribution of radio sets/T.V.Sets to the village/ Administrative places and many other publicity measures are being done by them.

EMPLOYMENT:-

There are two numbers employment cells, one under DC, Ziro and another under ADC, Naharlagun functioning in the district. Total 426 nos job seekers registered their names in the Ziro Employment Cell during 1989-90.

LIBRARY:-

There are two public Library, one at New Itanagar and another at Naharlagun, One district Library at Ziro functioning in the district.

Total 71,015 nos books in different languages such as English, Hindi, Assamese, Bangali, Malayalam, etc. are available in this libraries.

SOCIAL CULTURE:-

Several Social and Cultural organisations have been formed in the district based on social, religion and other relevant aspects of life of the tribal people. An eventful response from these organisations reflects in their festivals.

The major festivals are Dree, Myoko and Murung of Apatani's and Sirom-Molo-Sochum, Nyokum and Yulo on the festival of Nishi's. Govt. provides financial assistance as "Grant in Aid" to celebrate the festival by tribal people.

HIGHLIGHTS

LOWER SUBANSIRI DISTRICT.

BRIEF HISTORY:-

Prior to 1914, the Balipara Frontier tract was a part of Lakhimpur district in Assam. In 1946 this Tract was divided into two Administrative Jurisdictions, one was Sela Sub-Agency and the other was Subansiri area. In 1954, Subansiri area was marked as the Subansiri Frontier Division, ^{and} was renamed as the Subansiri District in 1964.

On 13th May, 1990, the district was further bifurcated into two districts as (1) Upper Subansiri District and (2) Lower Subansiri District. The Headquarters of Lower Subansiri District is Ziro, the headquarters of erstwhile Subansiri District.

PHYSICAL FEATURE:-

The Present Lower Subansiri District covers approximately an area of 13,010 Sq. Km. The entire part of the district is mountainous terrain with hill ranges ranging approximately from 200 Mtrs to 1600 Mtrs. above sea level.

The district lies approximately between latitude 26° 55' North and 28° 21' North and Longitude 92° 40' East and 94° 21' E.

The most important river of the district are Kamala ^{and} Kuru. Kamala river originating from Tibet (China) flowing through Damin, Tali, Raga Circles meets the Subansiri River at East boundary of the district. The District got its name from the river Subansiri which originating from China (Tibet) flowing through east boundary of the district and the area of Upper Subansiri District meets Brahmaputra. Kuru river meets Kamala above Tamen. Other important rivers of the district are Pugo, Rein, Persen, ~~Siptu~~, Penir, Kate, Kering, Bor etc.

BOUNDARY:-

Lower Subansiri District is bounded by China (Tibet) and some part of Upper Subansiri district to the North, West Siang and some part of Upper Subansiri District to the East, Assam State to the South and East Kameng district to the West.

CLIMATE:-

Climatic conditions are varied in different altitudinal hill ranges. In the foot hill areas moderate climatic conditions are formed through out the year whereas in the high altitude belt areas, i.e. northern part, such as Ziro and its nearby places winter months are extremely cold and the summer months are neither much cold nor much hot. During 1989 annual rainfall of Ziro is 151.91 Cms.

ADMINISTRATIVE SET UP:-

In the year 1974, the capital of the State was transferred in this district at Itanagar and as such the district has been divided into four Sub-divisions namely Ziro, Sagalee, Koloriang and Capital complex Sub-division and 17 circles namely Ziro, Palin, Chambang, Tali, Rana, Kimin under Ziro Sub-division; Sagalee, Mengio, Doimukh, Balijan under Sagalee sub-division; Koloriang, Sarli, Damin, Nyapin, Sangram under Koloriang sub-division and Old Itanagar, New Itanagar under capital complex sub-division.

The Capital complex Sub-division is under the charge of one Additional Deputy Commissioner with its Head Quarters at Naharlagun. Sagalee and Koloriang sub-division respectively are under the charge of one Extra Assistant Commissioner. The lowest administrative units are circles and each circle is looked after by one circle Officer. The Ziro sub-division is looked after by the Deputy Commissioner, who is over all incharge of the District.

Apart from this under Panchayat Raj Schemes, Zilla Parishad at district level, Anchal Samiti at the Block and Gram Sabha, the grass root bodies at the village level exist in the district. The district has 10 CD/IRD Block and each block is looked after by the respective CO/EAC of the Circle/Sub-divisions who acts as Ex-officio Block Development Officer.

POPULATION :-

According to 1981 census, total population of the district is 1,12,650 person and out of this 59,756 are male and 52,894 persons are female population spread over 770 inhabitant villages and 2 towns. Total rural population is 98,534 persons and total urban population is 14,116 persons.

The urban population is spread over only old Itanagar (Naharlaqun town and New Itanagar town. 0.52 percent of the total population is Schedule Caste and 77.77 percent of the total Population is Schedule Tribes. Sex ratio is 616 females per thousand Males, percentage of literate to total population is 19.52 Rural Literate is 14.61 percent. ~~and Urban literate is 53.79 percent.~~ Such variation is caused by the towns of capital complex.

The major tribes are Apatani, Banoro, Hill Miri, Mikir, Sulung, Tagin and Nishang group. Nishang group includes Nishang Nishi, Banani, and Defla or Nishi.

COMMUNICATION :-

(a) Road communication : ~~Through~~ the most of the villages and Administrative places are not yet approached by vehicle, however, a number of roads have been constructed in the district and some are under construction to make link with the remote Administrative places.

At present the district has ~~11452786~~ Kms. road length as on 31st March, 1990 and of this 485.84 Kms. surfaced road (Metalled+Gravelled) and 660.66 Kms. unsurfaced road (Katcha).

The district Head Quarters Ziro is connected by metalled road with North Lakhimpur, a district town of Assam state; Itanagar, The capital town of it's state; Danorijo, the district Head Quarters of Upper Subansiri District and with Doimukh, Palin, Raga, Saqales. The administrative places of the district.

Daily Bus services from Ziro-North Lakhimpur, Ziro-Itanagar and Ziro-Danorijo route exist. But service from Ziro-Plain and Ziro to Raga are available only on every alternate day.

"Bayudoot" Air service from Ziro and Itanagar is also available, but not flies in a regular manner as yet.

Goods are being carried generally by road transport, by air dropping and to the interior villages by porters.

(b) POST AND TELEGRAPH COMMUNICATION:-

As on 31st March/1990, there are two numbers sub-post offices with Telegraph facility, one Head post office with tele facility at Itanagar and 27 nos EDPO at different administrative headquarters functioning in the district. Out of 6 nos telephone Exchanges 3 nos with STD facility at Ziro and at Itanagar/Naharlagun functioning in the district.

FOREST:-

Total forest area of Lower Subansiri District is 5,87,60 Hectares and of this Reserve forest area is 1,22,270 Hectares.

Forest is a good ~~source~~^{source} of income for the state to earn revenue. During 1989-90 an amount of Rs. 164.08 lakhs revenue earned from the forest products grown in the district.

AGRICULTURE:-

Agriculture is the main occupation of the inhabitant of the district 44.58 percent of the total district rural population are cultivators.

Jhum cultivation is practised where sufficient WRC (Irrigated) land is not available. Paddy, Maize, Millet are the main crops grown in the district. Govt provides assistance to the farmers for improved method of cultivation under different schemes to increase the crop production in the district.

The district has 44,004 Hectares of land available for cultivation. Out of this net sown area is 36,230 Hectares and the area under crops (Main crops) is 36,552 Hectares. During the year 1989-90.

(MINOR IRRIGATION):-

A good numbers of MIC were constructed by the Govt. under RWD to increase the crops yeild and to develop WRC (Irrigated land area in the district.

The district has 142 nos MIC with a command area of 2,578.27 Hectares approximately as on 31 March/1990.

ANIMAL HUSBANDARY AND VETERINARY SERVICE:-

The economic status of a family of the district is assessed with number of animals (Specially Mithuns) he possesses. Again meat is a staple food for the people of the district. So, livestock plays an important role in the Socio Economic life of the people of the district. Govt. provides necessary assistance to livestock farmers for more production of Milk, Eggs and meat. The livestock population are treated in the Govt. dispensaries with free of cost.

As on 31-3-90, there are 14 nos veterinary dispensaries, 13 nos veterinary aid centres and 12 nos cattle up-grading centres functioning in the district.

During 1989-90, animals and birds were treated 37,302 (General cases) nos, vaccinated 21,439 nos and castrated 2261 nos in the veterinary dispensaries/aid centres of the district.

FISHERIES:-

Fish is one of the dietary items to the people of the district. Fishery activities started in the district with an aim that the people can earn an extra income by selling fish in addition to meet their domestic consumption. Govt. offers assistance to the fish farmers under different schemes and the people from the remote areas are interestedly coming forward to take up a scheme.

As on 31-3-90, the district has 11 nos Govt. Fish Farms, 39 nos people fish farms, and 1,901 nos village fish ponds.

During 1989-90, production of fish in the district was 140 M.ton and 10.77 Lakhs nos fish seed produced and 10.00 Lakhs nos fingerlings distributed to the fish farmers in the district.

MEDICAL & PUBLIC HEALTH:-

A great emphasis has been laid on the field that the people of the district can receive better treatment within the district and considering this point of view Govt. has opened Hospitals/Health Units at all the administrative places Head quarters.

At present the district has 2 nos General Hospitals (Dist. Gen. Hospital=1, State Gen. Hospital=1) 24 nos Health units/Dispensaries (Including one R.K. Mission Hospital at Ita.), 3 nos Homeo Dispensaries, 1 Ayurvedic Dispensary and 1 T.B. centre.

During 1989-90, the patients treated in different Hospital/Health Centres or units were 3,19,354 nos including 9,679 indoor patients.

Family welfare Programme:-

Under this programme, persons sterilised 324 nos, IUCD inserted 424 nos and condoms distributed 9,802 nos during 1989-90.

NMER:-

Under this programme, total 47,342 nos blood slides collected and out of this 2,597 nos cases were radically treated in the district during 1989-90.

DRINKING WATER:-

As on-31-3-90, approximately 353 nos villages/Hamlets and 2 nos towns were provided with drinking water supply facilities in the district.

EDUCATION:-

A good number of Educational institutions have been set up at different villages/Administrative Head quarters with an aim to increase literacy rate through formal education and achieve an effective result, Books, hostel facilities et. are being provided with free of cost to the local students upto class VIII.

At present the district has 231 nos Govt educational institutions and 10 nos private schools with the enrolment of 24,172 nos students.

ELECTRICITY AND POWERS:-

The district has 3.750 M. Watts Micro Hydrel Generating installed plant and 3.587 M.Watts Diesel Plant and by this it covers 180 nos villages (Approx) and 2 nos capital towns in the district.

Most of the villages are yet to be provided with the electricity. However it is being increased year by year.

During 1989-90, 7.712 million KWH electricity generated and 3.618 million KWH electricity consumed by different uses like domestic, commercial and public lighting under Ziro electrical Division.

INDUSTRY:

To promote local traditional crafts and arts and other industrial endeavours, Govt. provides assistance for skilled men and opened 7 nos training cum production centres in the district. Apart from this 80 nos Small scale industries have been set up by private individual with the Govt. assistance with an aim to earn good income through it.

An electronic unit for assembling T.V. Sets, Quartz clocks, mini megaphones, radio etc. has been set up at Itanagar in the capital of the state.

Two nos sericulture demonstration farms one at Bali-jan and other at Kokila are also functioning in the district. 519 nos eri cloths, 25 nos pat cloths and 9 nos mulberry cloths were produced in these farms during 1989-90.

CO-OPERATIVE :

Co-operative movement was started first in this district by opening one society at Ziro during the year 1958.

Now, the district has 36 nos societies at different administrative places,

The important significant of this movement is to supply the essential commodities to the consumers at cheaper rate.

SUPPLY:-

Essential commodities of food items are being carried generally by road transport, air dropping and by head load porters wherever necessary and procured by Civil Supplies Department from the F.C.I as per allotment by the Govt. of India.

Public distribution is done through the government owned units (CPO) in air field areas and through FPS owned by both private Businessmen and co-operative in road transport areas.

During 1989-90 ^{1,99,268} M.T food items like rice, wheat, sugar etc. and 6,09,000 litres K.Oil were procured against this district and distributed by the state Government.

BANKING:-

As on 31-3-90, 6 nos SBI, 2 nos UCO, 4 nos Gramin Bank, 1 no. Purbanshal Bank, 1 no. Vijaya Bank and 7 nos. Co-operative Apex Bank are functioning in the district. ^{at} Different administrative Head Quarters Purbanshal Bank and Vijaya Bank are located at Itanagar, in the capital of the state.

The state Bank of India is playing a important role in providing loan etc. to the weaker sectors.

RURAL DEVELOPMENT:-

IRDP was launched in this district during the year 1978-79 and all the 10 Blocks were brought under this programme. District Rural Development Agencies (DRDA) looks after its function through its DD/IRD Blocks. Apart from IRDP some other programme such as the National Rural Employment programme (NREP), Rural Landless Employment Guarantee Programme (RLEGP), Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) and Assistance to small and Marginal Farmers for Agricultural Production are also being carried out.

Subsidy and Bank Loans are being provided to the beneficiaries under this scheme.

POLICE AND CRIME:-

There are 10 nos of police station functioning in the district. 153 nos crime cases (other than Itanagar Capital @om ex area) reported during the year 1989-90.

PUBLICITY:-

There are two nos Publicity Units, one state Govt. another of central Govt. functioning in the district.
