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## I - AREA AND POPULATION.

According to 1981 Census, the population of the District was 3.28 Lakhs as against 2.58 Lakhs recorded in 1971. Above 97% of the population lives in rural areas. 81% of the working force is engaged in Agriculture which is the backbone of the economy in the District. Muslims account for 96.61% of the population and are the largest community in the District.

This chapter gives data on population structure of the District as per Census of 1981 and its composition by Sex, Religion, Literacy rate, Rural/Urban area etc. The details of working population and its distribution by occupational groups are also given.

### III - AGRICULTURE.

Data on land utilization, Irrigation, extension service etc, are given in this chapter. Agriculture is the primary occupation in the District. About 98% of the population in the District lives in villages and 81% of the working force is engaged in Agriculture. According to village papers the total area of the District is 0.67 Lakh hectares out of which 0.45 Lakh hectares is cropped. The total irrigated area of the District is 0.23 Lakh hectares. Irrigation is provided mostly by canals though other sources also irrigate small areas. Detailed information on the various facets of agriculture is given in this chapter.
