I. POPULATION

This chapter gives data on population structure in the district. Composition of population by sex, rural/ Urban areas, working force and its distribution by occupational groups are also given.

As per 1981 census the population of the district is 2.99 lakhs against 2.17 lakhs in 1971. About 95% of the population lives in the rural areas. The working force is 42% of the total population. The population during the decade 1971-81 has registered growth rate of 34.47% against 28.97% for the state as a whole.
