LOHIT DISTRICT IN BRIEF.

GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURES :-

The Lohit District lies in the Eastern part of Arunachal Pradesh between 95° 15' and 97° 24' East Longitudes and 27° 33' and 29° 22' North Latitudes and its Geographical area is approximately 11402 Sq.K.M. It is bounded by China along the Me-Mohan Line and part of Dibang Valley District in the North, Tirap District to the South, China and Burma to the East and Assam State and part of Dibang Valley District to the West.

TOPOGRAPHY.

The District consists of continuous chains of hills and mountains the altitude of which varies from 500 ft. to 17000 ft. The high mountainous region of the norther boundary is extremely cold and large tracts remain snow bound through most part of the year. The plain areas in the foothills region are intersected by innumerable ravines and water courses and covered by dense tropical forest.

The Lohit, which is the principal river and after which the district is named, rises in the Eastern Tibet and enters the plains at Parasuram Kund, a famous place of Pilgrimage for the Hindus. Kamlang and Noa-Dihing are other main river which flows over the Southern part of the District. These rivers are fed by numbers of turbulent tributaries running through wild mountains and gorges and ultimately join the mighty Brahmaputra in Assam. While flowing over the foot hill areas, these rivers frequently change their courses resulting in heavy erosion and posing a serious challenge to the communication system. During monsoon, sometimes the communication through land route with the rest of the country is completely cutoff and air communication also depends on the mercy of the weather.

The climate of the District varies from place to place. In the foothills region such as Tezu, Chowkham, Namsai, it is extreme hot during summer and moderately cold during winter while at places in high altitude such as Kibithoo, Walong, Hawai, Chaglagan etc it is extremely cold during winter and moderate in summer.

POPULATION.

According to 1971 decennial Census the total Population of the District is 62,865 out of which 35,461 were males and 27,404 females. Sex ratio i.e. the number of females per thousand of males is 773. Sex ratio amongst the local tribes is 1013 females per 1000 males. The density of population is very low i.e. 3 per km².

According to provisional population figures of 1981 Census, the total population of the District is 69400 out of which 38964 are males and 30436 females. Sex ratio, i.e. the number of females per thousand of males is 781. The density of population is very low i.e. 6 per km². The percentage of literacy is 18'33.

Tezu, the District Headquarter, is the only town in the District having the population of 6231 as per 1981 Census.

EDUCATION.

The education department of the District aims at the improvement of the educational standard of the people to

There are one Higher Secondary School, 4 Secondary Schools, 13 M.E. Schools, 83 LP/JB Schools, 5 Pre-Primary Schools, and 5 I.V. Schools in the District as on 31-3-81. Apart from that adult education programme has also been taken up. So far 36 Adult Literacy Centres are functioning in the District.

TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATION.

Communication is one of the vital factor for the development of a region. With this end in view, the Administration has taken up the Scheme of construction of roads and tracks. The Sadiya- Tezu motorable road which came into existence in 1967 had been extended upto Yatong a distance of 117 KM from Tezu. The motorable road connecting Alubari, Chowkham and Namsai had been extended upto plains of Assam. All the Administrative Centres in the District are either connected by roads or porters tracks.

POST AND TELEGRAPH.

There are 30 Post Offices functioning in the District out of which 3 Pos are having Telegraph facilities. Postal facilities are available at all the Administrative Centres either in the shape of Sub-Post Office or Extra Departmental Post Office.

POWER

Inspite of good potentialities the District is still deficient in the supply of power. One Micro-Hydel Project has been commissioned at Durah-Nallah (near Tezu Town) with an installed capacity of 400 K.W. Besides, there are seven more power station having diesel Generating set with a total installed capacity of 554.5 K.W. The electricity generated and consumed during the period under report is 972301 KWH and 875071 KWH respectively.

RURAL WORKS DEPARTMENT

The activities of Rural Works Department are mainly minor irrigation project, rural water supply, distribution of agricultural implements/ machinery etc. So far 140 villages have been provided with water supply facilities and another 55 villages are taken up under the Scheme. During the period under report 9 Minor Irrigation Projects have been implemented and 16 such projects are under progress.

MEDICAL AND PUBLIC HEALTH.

Earlier the people have their own Traditional methods of diagnosis and care, and they used herbs, roots and leaves of some wild plants as preventives or medicine. Some of the tribes had the belief of spiritual cure of the disease and use of medicine was unknown to them. Gradually the modern Scientific method replaced the old traditional one and now there are 19 Health Units (including two Homeopathy Unit) functioning in the different parts of the District. The entire setup in the District comes under the Administrative and Technical Control of the District Medical Officer with his headquarter at Tezu.

The District is also covered by the National Programme such as National Malaria Eradication Programme. Other Programmes such as Expanded Programme of Immunisation, Mother Child Health Programme, Family Welfare Programme etc are also introduced in the District.

CO-OPERATION

The concept of Co-operation was prevalent in the Tribal Society even before the movement was given a proper shape by the Government by introducing various categories of Co-operative Societies. The people of this area have social institutions for the common benefit. The spirit of Co-operation for the benefit of the Society as a whole is traditionally ingrained in them. This spirit has further been boosted up by the Govt. and proper shape to the movement is given by the end of 1957.

The Lohit Co-operative General Stores Ltd. came into existence on the 1st January/1958. Apart from being the oldest, the society also commands a high position on account of its past achievements since then the Co-operative Department can highly claim for the incentive it has generated for a rush room growth of a number of societies in different fields of economic life. During the year under report there are all together 21 Co-operative Societies and one Transport Co-operative Society functioning in the District.

FOREST.

The Forest plays an important role in the economy of the District. Lohit is the second highest forest revenue earning District in the territory, and the forest revenue derived from this District is substantially high. During the period under report there are 9 forest based industries including a major plywood and veneer factory functioning in the District.

AGRICULTURE.

Agriculture is the mainstay of the people of Lohit, on which the economy of the District depends almost entirely. Out of the total District population of 69400 persons the number of cultivators is 18672. In the upper hilly region, the traditional method of shifting cultivation called Jhum is followed by most of the people. Khamptis, Singphos and other minor tribes inhabiting the areas adjacent to the plains of Assam practise WRC and TRC. According to the topography of the land and suitability of crops grown, the food habits of the people also vary.

Apart from agriculture, progressive farmers have also opened Horticulture garden. Agriculture department is providing fruit seedlings to such farmers on subsidised rate.

To introduce the modern method of agriculture the Govt. is providing the cultivators improved varieties of seeds, Agricultural implements, chemicals on subsidy basis.

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND VETERINARY.

The Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Department in the District is playing a vital role in uplifting the rural economy of the Territory. The entire setup is under the Administrative and technical control of the District Veterinary Officer with his headquarter at Tezu. The livestock is one of the main asset of the local people. When there is epidemic the department takes great care to protect these assets. Apart from that the department through its dispensaries located at different places extends free treatment to the animals and takes precautionary measure against the poultry epidemic.

During the period under report, there are 7 Veterinary Dispensary, 9 Veterinary Aid Centre, 12 Cattle Breeding Centre, 1 District Veterinary Hospital and 1 Veterinary Laboratory.

NEC has established one Exotic-Pig Breeding Farm at Loiliang Village (12 KM from Tezu) for development of Pig breeding and rearing.

FISHERY

Because of rough topography the Pisciculture activity could not be carried out in the higher region. However, in the plain areas of the District the department has made a great headway. During the period under report there are 54 village fish ponds 222,600 fingerlings have been distributed.

CRAFTS AND INDUSTRY.

To promote the tribal arts and crafts two craft centres have been functioning in the District. The Craft Centres consist of two units Training and Production, for different crafts such as weaving, carpentry, blacksmithy, silversmithy, carpet making, cane and bamboo work etc. Training in improved methods is imparted to the Local boys and girls in various crafts so as to encourage the growth of industries among them. The main objects of production unit are to manufacture articles to meet the requirements of Local Govt. departments as well as the people, and to provide adequate working facilities to the passed out trainees. Necessary tools and implements at 50% subsidised cost are supplied to the passed out trainees.

Apart from that the department provides guidance to the local people who are interested to take up cottage or small scale industry.

SOCIAL AND CULTURE.

The major tribes inhabiting this District are the Mishim, the Khamptis and the Singphos. The Mishimies are divided into three main groups namely the Idus or Chulikatas, the Taraons or Digarus and the Kamas or Mijus. Out of the three groups, the Idus inhabit in Dibang Valley District. The main languages spoken by the people of this District are Kaman, Taraon, Khampti and Singpho.

The Mishimies have their own custom and religion. The religion of Digarus and Mijus may be defined as a system based on the magico-religious rites and practices to dispel the evil spirit by appeasement. They have apparently developed the conception of high god whom they regard as their supreme creator. The Khamptis and Singphos are Buddhists by religion. The Khamptis believe that attainment of Nirvana or salvation of human soul can be achieved following the noble Eightfold Path. The religious life of the Khamptis is deeply influenced by the Buddhist ethics and morality. The Singphos are the follower of old shamanistic beliefs even though they are Buddhists. They believe in a host of spirits called nats who are malevolent and responsible for causing miseries to human beings. They worship them on a number of occasions.

The main festivals are Reh, Di-Batai, Tailla, Takka etc for Mishimies and Changkeny is the main festival for Khamptis and Singphos.
