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### P O P U L A T I O N

Poonch is one of the small districts of our state. As per census of 1981 the population of the District stands at 2.23 lacs which represents 3.74% of the total population of the state. Majority of the people live in rural areas which account for about 94% of the total population. Muslims constitute about 88.84% against 7.57% Hindus. All other communities constitute 3.57 lacs only. About 80% workers are engaged in agriculture as cultivators and agricultural labourers. 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### III-AGRICULTURE

AGRICULTURE is the primary occupation in the District. About 80% of the total working force is engaged in this pursuit. According to village papers the total area of the District is 1.14 lac hectares, Out of which 0.34 lac hectares is cropped. The total irrigated area of the district is over 0.05 lac hectares to which irrigation is mostly provided by canals. Other sources also irrigate small acreages. Detailed information on the various facets of agriculture such as land utilization, irrigation, agricultural extension services etc. are given in this chapter.
