PART - I
CHAPTER - I

1.1. PHYSICAL ASPECTS OF THE DISTRICT:

GENERAL:- The District derived its name from Mahabubnagar, its headquarters town which was named a Mir Mahboob Ali Khan, the VI Nizam of Hyderabad. It is located between 16° and 17° Latitudes and 77° E longitudes. It is bounded on the north by Ranga Reddy and Nalgonda Districts, on the east by Nalgonda and Guntur Districts, on the South by the rivers Krishna and Tungabhadra and on the west Raichur and Gulbarga Districts of Karnataka State. The area of the District is 18432 Sq.K.Ms. The total population of the District according to the 1981 census count is 24,44,619 persons consisting 12,32,684 Males and 12,11,935 Females.

The District may be physiographically divided into more or less two distinct regions, the plains region with low lying scattered hills and extensive Amrabad-Pherhabad, Plateau, a continuous range of hills of an average elevation of about 800 Mtrs. extending more or less east west along the Krishna River on the southern boundary of the District. The hill range is interspersed by several deep valleys which are almost inaccessible from the plains.

HILLS:- The District is comparatively elevated in the north and west and a gradual declivity is noticed in the attitude from the north west to the south east. There are hill ranges in the South east of the District, extending from north to south of Achampet Taluk consisting of (flat topped hills). The hills appear as though they are piled one above the other.

RIVERS:- Two important rivers viz., Krishna and Tungabhadra flow through the District. The Krishna river enters Andhra Pradesh in Makthal Taluk of this District and covers Makthal, Gadwal, Atmakur Wanaparthy, Kollapur, Alampur and Achampet Taluks. The Tungabhadra flows through the Taluks of Gudur and Alampur. The Dindi river which is a tributary of Krishna flows through Kalwakurthy and Achampet and joins the Krishna river, 18 miles east of Chendragiri Peddewagu and Chinnewagu are the other tributaries of the Krishna in the District.

CLIMATE:- The climate of the District is generally hot. The average maximum temperature in the summer months generally varies between 90° to 100° . The year may be broadly divided into four seasons. The summer season starts by about the middle of February and continues upto the 1st week of June. The south west monsoon season follows and extends upto the end of September. October and November constitute to post monsoon or the retreating monsoon season.

RAIN FALL:- The average annual rainfall in the District is 942.6 mm. The rainfall increases from south to the north in the district. The rain fall in the season accounts for 77% of the annual rainfall, September being the雨iest month. The District gets some rain in the post monsoon months.

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SOILS:- The Major soil group is red earth, comprising loamy soils (dubba), sandy loams, (Chelka) and sandy clay loams. Black soils mostly clayed loams and deep clays occur as narrow strips along side the banks of the Krishna and Tungabhadra and the natural streams and Vrigus. The loamy sands are brown to red in colour and poor in fertility. The sandy loams occur on sloping terrains with good surface drainage. The soils, in general, are non-saline and non-alkaline. Clayed loams and clays are found in appreciable extent in Alampur and Gadwal Taluks and also in patches in Kodangal, Makthal, Kollapur and Attakur taluks. They are dark-grey brown to dark-grey in colour and are slowly permeable and poorly drained.

FLORA:- The forest in this district are known to contain timber trees like Bijisal (*Pterocarpus-mersupium*) Nall-Mudi, (*Terminalia tomentosa*), Pippa (hardwickia binjva) Ebony (Teak) Bobul (*Acacia erioloba*) Mango and tamarind. The forest consists of brush wood tarvar (*Cassia auriculata*) and other plants used for fuel.

FAUNA:- Wild life was fairly abundant in the inaccessible plateau regions of Amrabad and Farhabad. But due to indiscriminate shooting in the past, much of the wild life has been reduced. Some of the wild animals found in Mahabubnagar forests are Tigers (*Felis tigris*), Panther (*Felis pardus*), wild Dog (*Canis lupinus*) and Hyena (*hyaena hyaena*) and Sloth Bear (*Melursus Ursinus*).

Of the herbivorous animals, spotted deer (*Cervus axis*), Nilgai (*Boselaphus tragocamelus*), Sambar (*Servus unicolor*), Black buck (*Antelope cervicapra*), Chinkara (Wild goat), porcupine and wild boar are common.

Of the winged game, sparrow dove, ring dove, partridge, red jungle fowl, Brush quail, Green peacock, Partridge, Common mallard, large whistling teal, grey duck etc., were common.

PLACES OF TOURIST INTEREST:

RANGAPOOR:- (Achampet Taluq). Rengapur is situated at a distance of 100 K.Ms on the Mahabubnagar Amrabad Bus route. This place attained religious importance in the district owing to the existence of the famous Ummaheshwara Shrine, which is at a height of about 152 Mtrs. in the Srisailam range of hills. The style of construction indicates that it belonged to the region of the Chalukya of Kalyani. The archaeological findings reveal, that this place was an imported Hindu religious centre even in the (7th century A.D.). The festival of Umamaheshwara which is celebrated for six days from Pushya Sudha Padyami (December-January) and Hazrath Niranjan Shah Veli Urs which synchronises with the festival of Umamaheshwara are largely attended.

ALAMPUR:- (Alampur Taluk) Alampur is situated at a distance of 10 K.Ms from Alampur road Railway Station on the Secunderabad Dronachalam section of the South Central Railway. This place is located on the bank of Tungabhadra and a large number of antiquities belonging to the Chalukyan period are found. This place is also known as the western gateway to Srisailam temple and also as Dakshinakasi (Varanasi of the South). The two groups of temples- Brahmashwara and Peepanatha have made Alampur a popular spot. The plans and decorations of these temples resemble the plans and carvings of some of the rock cut temples of Western India. The temple called, Navabrahmalaya, the idol of Baladeva Brahmashwars is resplendent and is supposed to be a Jyotirlinga. An interesting feature here is that any quantity of water used for Abhisheka goes inside and not a drop comes out.

The other shrines of this place are those of Siva, Narasimha, Surya, Mahishasura Mardhani,

Venkateshwara, Kameshti and Virabhadra. The Hindu festivals that attract a large number of devotees are that of Balaji Brahmashwara, Suryanarayana, Narasimha Veerabhadra, Sangameshwara, of Jogulambha. A muslim fort and Shah Ali Dargah of 17th Century are also in existence.

BORAVELLI:- (Alampur Taluk). This village is situated at a distance of three kilometres from Manop. Railway Station. An ancient fort constructed by eminent architects with twenty bastions, seven entrances and a moat is a place of interest in the village. The art and architecture of western Chalukyas can be seen in the exquisitely sculptured temples at the place.

NARWA:- (Atmakur Taluk). This village lies at a distance of 22 K.Ms from Atmakur and 32 K.Ms from Sirimangal Railway Station. A fort with 12 bastions belonging to the 16th Century can be seen in the middle of the village. The bastions, a Rangamahal and an Bhugul sala (elephant stable) are in ruins. The places of worship include the shrine of Venkateshwara, Siva and Sanjivaraya.

GADWAL:- (Gadwal Taluk). Gadwal is a town in between the rivers Krishna and Tungabhadra and it is noted for the harmonious co-existence of Andhra and Karnatic cultures. A big fort with twenty one bastions constructed by Sholapuram is reminiscent of the Chalukyan art.

Hendloom weaving is an important industry of this place. Gadwal sarees are noted for their exquisite silk and "Zari" work and command a good market throughout India. The temple of Chennakeshava is held in great veneration. Brahmotsavam celebrated in honour of the deity is attended by a large number of devotees.

Dowlat Veli Urs, Maslen Veli Urs and Siddipasha Urs are the celebrations which attract devotees from other places also.

MALDAKALLU:- (Gadwal Taluk). Maldskallu is at a distance of 18 K.Ms from Gadwal Railway Station and lies on the Gadwal - Iejea Bus route. It is also known as "Girusafhala Kshetram". The Venkateshwara statue in the temple is believed to be self-manifest (swayamvyaktom) and the Brahmotsavam is attended by a large number of Hindu devotees.

VELDANDA:- (Yeldandha) (Kakilakurthy Taluk). This place is located at a distance of 51 K.Ms from Jedcherla Railway Station on the Hyderabad - Kakilakurthy bus route. Some of the excavations reveal that this village existed about six centuries back in a very prosperous condition. A crude water distribution system, a drainage, a dilapidated fort, a number of walls etc., which have been unearthed, are a proof of its prosperity. The Yadavas of this place celebrate Srikrishna Jayanthi with great pomp and splendour.

KOSGI:- (Kodangal Taluk) Kosgi is a town situated at a distance of 13 K.Ms from Kodangal. Kosgi was once famous for the handwoven cotton and silk cloth. The ramparts round the village which speak of its historical past, can be seen even today. Handloom weaving is an important industry of Kosgi.

PANGAL:- (Panugallu) (Kollapur Taluk) Pangal is situated at a distance of 13 K.Ms from Wanaparthy. It is an ancient place of historical importance. It is situated at an height of about 548 Metres about the main sea level. A place of interest in the village is the historical hill fort which is two and a half Kilometres in length and one and a half Kilometre in breadth with seven walls, seven towers and a citadel called "BALA HISSAR" in the centre. The village is also known as Qila Pangal. A number of ruined forts and inscriptions can be seen on the hillocks even today. This village is believed to have been associated with the famous "Balanagamma Katha".

KOILKONDA:- (Mahabubnagar Taluk). The village is situated at a distance of about 22 K.Ms from Mahabubnagar Town. The place of interest here is the fort perched on a hill, built by "KOYADORAS". Another building of interest at the village is an "IDGAHA" the "QUIBLA WALL", of which represents a queer style of architecture. The places of worship are the shrines of Narasimha, Ramagiri (Ramkonda) and the Dargah of Fathima Bi, on the hill. About 8 K.Ms from the village, a medium size Irrigation Project called "KOILSAGAR" Project has been constructed across the Peddavagu, a minor tributary of Krishna. The western stretch of the Reservoir is surrounded by high hills and renders it a picturesque scene. A small but beautiful guest house exists on a small hillock at the extreme left flank of the Dam.

MAHABUBNAGAR:- (Mahabubnagar Taluk). Mahabubnagar Town is about 96 K.Ms from Hyderabad City by road. It is the headquarters of the taluk, the Revenue division of the district of the same name. The important place of interest Mahabubnagar is the famous banyan tree called "PILLALA MARRI", which is about 3 K.Ms from town. There is a shrine of a Muslim saint under the tree. From a distance the tree presents the appearance of a small hillock with green foliage but on reaching nearer, it looks like large green umbrella under which about a thousand people can easily take shelter. The tree is very old one and covers an area of about 3 acres. Mahabubnagar has good communication facilities to all the imported places in and out side the district both by Rail and Bus.

MANYAMKONDA (MANIKONDA):- (Mahabubnagar Taluk) Manikonda is situated at a distance of 5 K.Ms from Manyamkonda Railway Station. The place was originally a thick forest and the hill on which "Lord Venkateshwara" established himself was in the heart of the forest. This shrine of Laxshmi Venkateshwara is on a hill 915 Mtrs. highat a distance of two Kilometres from the village. The temple is ninety one metres by twenty three metres hewn out of a huge rock. Against the back wall

appears the idol of Lord Venkateshwara claimed to be self-manifested, resembling the idol at Tirupati. The Venkateshwara Brahmotsavam during January - February and the Alivelu Manga Tayaru Brahmotsavam during February - March attract a large number of pilgrims.

NANAIARAYANPET:- (Makthal Taluk) This town is situated at a distance of 26 K.Ms from Makthal. Cotton Handloom weaving and Kamali weaving are the major industries in this Town. There are a number of temples at this place.

"Jogammaguda" (Wanaparthy Taluk). Jogammagudem is situated at a distance of 5 K.Ms from Hyderabad, on the Hyderabad-Mahabubnagar bus route. This village is considered as Uttara Rameshwaram on account of a big pond occupying an area of about 1,674 Sq.Metres and a huge Sivalingam believed to be the biggest in India.

S SIRIRANGAPURAM:- (Wanaparthy Taluk). This Village is situated at a distance of 24 K.Ms from Wanaparthy. The most important place of worship in the village is the shrine of Ranganatha, situated a furlong away from the village on an elevated place, surrounded practically on all sides by the water of Rengamudram tank. People believe that the temple is as important as the one at Srirangam in the south. Brahmotsavam celebrated from Palgundu Shuddha Astami to Bahula Vidiya is an important annual feature attracting many devotees.

WANAPARTHY:- (Wanaparthy Taluk). Wanaparthy is about 125 K.Ms from Hyderabad and 90 K.Ms from Kurnool on the Hyderabad-Kurnool bus route. The temple of the place the shrine of Vitthaleshwara is an ancient and important one with the icon of Penduranga Vithal resembling the Pandaripur in Maharashtra State. There is a Polytechnic at this place. The Sardasager Project situated at about 6 K.Ms from Wanaparthy Road Railway Station, has the biggest Spillway Dam in the World.

The following criteria were adopted for treating a place as Urban Area at the 1981 Census.

- i) A minimum population of 5000,
- ii) At least 75% of the male working population is in non agricultural
- iii) A density of population of atleast 400 persons per Sq.K.M.

As per the above criterie, there were 11 Urban Areas in the District.

Later from November 1985, the district was divided into 64 Mandals. According to the number of Mandals, the District is the second largest in the State.

1.5. On perusing the above figures it is clear that the district is most backward economically and educationally. Compared to the State, more people live in rural areas and more people are engaged in agriculture. The main profession of the population is only agriculture, even though only 45% of the land is used for agriculture and out of this only 11.34% is under irrigation. According to the area of the crops, the following are the major crops in the District. "Jawar, Groundnut, Castor Paddy"

There are only 5 Major and medium Irrigation Projects in the District. They are

- 1) Rajoli Banda Diversion scheme
- 2) R.D.S. Scheme
- 3) Saralasagar - Irrigation Project
- 4) Koilsagar - Irrigation Project
- 5) Ramangad - Lift irrigation scheme

For the majority of irrigation lands, minor projects and wells are the main source.

As such the district is backward in agriculture for want of irrigation sources.

The District is also backward in industries. There are no major industries in the District. About 400 small scale industries are setup in the district, in which majority are Agrobased only.

In the field of literacy also the District is backward. "It is one of the two backward districts of the State, Adilabad stands in the last with 18.79% and above. This Mahabubnagar stands with 19.4%

In the literacy of girls also, it is below the State average.

In the District, Meldakal, Dharoor and Ghattu Mandals are most backward with the literacy of less than 10%

The following Mandals are placed on top of the list with a literacy of more than 30%, Gadwal, Mahabubnagar, Narayanpet, Venaparthy and Jadcherla.

CHAPTER - I

1.6. The Fifth All India Educational Survey was started in the State in June 1987, the reference date is 30.9.1986. For each District one Deputy Educational Officer was designated as Dist. Survey Officer. All the details of information to be collected were explained to the Dist. Survey Officers in the Training Class conducted in the Office of the Director of School Education, Hyderabad from 18.6.1987 to 26.6.1987.

In this survey 3 types of forms V.I.F., S.I.F. and U.I.F. were supplied for the collection of the data from All Villages and Schools of this District.

In V.I.F. the details of the habitation wise estimated population, age group wise estimated child population and all education facilities available were collected.

In U.I. F. the same information of Urban areas was collected.

In S.I.F. the particulars of Class-wise and age-wise enrolment, staff position and other physical facilities were collected.

: 11 :

As per the criteria a village is a revenue village as listed in 1981 Census. The habitation is defined as : District cluster of houses existing in a compact and contiguous manner with a local name and with a population of not less than 25. Keeping in view the above criteria, habitations located in villages and all other particulars as given in V.I.F. were collected.

To collect the data and to consolidate, Mandal Educational Officers and Supervisors of N.E. were entrusted with the work at the rate of One Officer for each Mandal.

A training class was conducted for all the Mandal incharges at Mahabubnagar on 6th and 7th July 1987. The District Survey Officer explained the salient features of the survey to the Headmasters of the Secondary Schools in Divisional level Headmasters' conferences in 2nd and 3rd week of July 1987.

In the last week of July '87 Divisional level meetings were conducted for the Mandal incharges. In these meetings few filled in V.I.F., U.I.F. and S.I.F. forms were checked by the Dist. Survey Officer and necessary suggestions and guidance were given to the Mandal incharges for completion of the work.

In the month of September 1987 all forms were checked at the District headquarters. Mandal Level consolidated forms were received and distributed to the Mandal incharges in 1st week of November 1987.

In the 2nd and 3rd weeks of November '87 training classes for the consolidated work were conducted at Divisional level. The Mandal incharges completed the consolidation work in December, 1987 and the same were checked at the District headquarters in the month of December 1987.

Meanwhile the District Survey Officer were asked to attend the office of the Director of School Education alongwith all S.I.F., U.I.F., and V.I.F., forms of the District.

These forms were verified under the guidance of State Survey Officer, in the Office of the Director of School Education in 1st fortnight of the February 1988. All verified forms were handed over to State Survey Officer for consolidating the data on computers.

A training class was conducted for the Dist. Survey Officers for the preparation of District report , in the Office of the D.S.E., from 30th November to 2nd December 1988.

The District consolidated tables were prepared manually from March 1989 to May 1989 at the District Headquarters.

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District consolidated tables were submitted in the D.S.P's office on 14.6.1989 after due verification.

The District report is prepared in the month of May 1990.

CHAPTER - II

2.1. There are 2525 Habitations in the District, and the total population of the District is 24,33,660 (Rural area).

Out of 2525 Habitutions 2076 habitations are having Primary Education facility within the habitation itself, thus 82% of habitations and 97% of population is covered with primary education facility within the habitations.

Out of these habitations 2244 habitations including the above 2076 are having Primary Education facility within a radius of one K.M.

The population of these habitation is 23,87,505, thus 88.9% of habitations and 93.1% population is covered with facility of primary school facility within a radius of one K.M.

71 Habitutions are proposed for opening of new Primary Schools, covering 109 habitations.

Out of 64 Mandalas the following 15 are having the Primary Education facility for all habitations i.e., 100% habitations are covered, Alempur, Atmekur, Chinna Chintakunta, Damargidda, Gadwal Makthal, Maledkal, Midjil, Narwa, Pangal, Pebbaire, Peddamendadi, Tedoor, Telkapally and Uppununthal.

The following 4 Mandalas are having the lowest facility of Primary Education i.e., 86% habitations.

2.2. Out of 1463 villages in the District, 11 villages are having more than 50% S.C. population and out of these 11 villages, 10 villages are having Primary Education facility.

Out of 1463 villages in the District 39 villages are having more than 50% S.T. population and out of these 39 villages 31 villages are having Primary Education facility.

Distribution of schools Rural and Urban area wise and also management wise is given in Table No.8.

Out of 1919 Primary Schools in the District 1854 are in the Rural areas, and 65 in Urban Area majority of schools i.e., 1846 are under the management of Local bodies.

2.4. Out of 1919 Primary schools in the District only 1260 in all managements put together are having Pecca buildings.

Magnoor Mandal is having the lowest facility of School buildings with only 7 buildings for 27 schools.

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Particularly out of 29 Govt. Primary schools only 20 are having Pucca buildings (Rented). There is not even a single own building for Govt. Primary Schools.

Out of 1260 schools having buildings 1047 are single room buildings.

For all Primary Schools under all managements about 3000 additional rooms are required the details are given in Table No.12.

Out of 6675 Primary Sections in the District only 2487 have Black Boards. An additional number of 4188 Black Boards are required to enable the facility of Black Boards for all sections.

The following 11 Mandals are having Black Boards for more than 50% sections, Addakal, Bijnapally, Dhawade, Jagcherla, Kalwakurthy, Madgul, Mahatunegar, Midjil, Negarkurnool, Pebhair and Utkoor

The following 10 Mandals are having less than 25% of required Black Boards. Amangal, Balanagar, Takkondapally, Veldanda, Dhanwada, Dharoor, Iejja, Kollapur, Kothur and Narayanpet.

Out of 1919 Primary Schools only 44 schools are having the facility of Urinals and Lavatories. 16 schools have separate Urinals and Lavatories.

As on 30.9.1986, 932 schools are single teacher schools in the District (including 36 teachers working elsewhere on deputation). Thus 48.6% schools are single teachers in the following 22 Mandals more than 50% are single teacher Primary Schools. Amangal, Amrabad, Balanagar, Balmoor, Bomraspet, Damargiada, Dultabed, Dharoor, Firoognagar, Gedwal, Ghettu, Ghanpur, Iejja, Kothur, Meddum, Mekthal, Meganoor, Manopad, Pebhair, Peddemendadi, Veldanda and Weddepally.

2.5. In the District, Primary sections are provided in 2317 schools. In all these sections 4409 teachers are handling Primary Classes the distribution of teachers is given in the table below.

2.6. RURAL:- The total enrolment in primary classes is 2,25,268 out of this the girls are 37%. The enrolment of S.C. students is 16.4% and enrolment of S.T. children is 6.8%. The proportion of S.C. population in the rural areas is 16.4% and the S.T. population is 6.3%. The enrolment of S.C. & S.T. children in Primary Schools is in proportion to their population

URBAN:- The total enrolment in Urban Area Primary classes is 33,620 out of this Girls are 43%.

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The enrolment of S.C. children is 13.7% and S.T. children 2%. The proportion of S.C. population in Urban Area is 8.9% and S.T. Population is 0.76%. The enrolment of S.C. and S.T. children is more than their proportion to the total population. It is due to the Hostel facilities in Urban Areas.

2.7. The gross enrolment ratio in the age group of 6-11 is 86% and the age specific enrolment ratio in the same age group is 60.9%. The details are given in Table No.32.

The teacher pupil ratio for Primary Classes is 1:6 in Rural Area 1:46 in Urban Areas.

CHAPTER - III

3.1. Out of 2525 Habitations 473 habitations are served by Upper Primary facility within habitation. The population of these habitations is 11,99,917 i.e., 49.3% of population is served by Upper Primary facility.

In addition to the above 1188 habitations are served with Upper Primary facility within a radius of 3 K.Ms. The total population of these 1188 habitations is 7,18,577 i.e., 29.5%.

In total 78.8 percent of population is served by Upper Primary facility within a walkable distance of 3 K.Ms.

Keeping in view the criteria given, 57 Upper Primary Schools are proposed in the District by way of upgrading the existing primary schools, covering 60 habitations.

By upgrading the 57 schools an additional population of 74,360, i.e., 3% will be covered.

The following 10 Mandals are having the Upper Primary for more than 90% of the population within the habitation. Addakal, Bijnapally, Devarkadra, Gopalpet, Jidcherla, Kalwakurthy, Kodair, Madgul, Pehtair and Veengandla.

The following two Mandals are having upper primary facility for about 50% of the population (lowest) within the habitation, Damargidda and Dharoor.

3.2. Out of 1463 villages 11 are having more than 50% of S.C. population and out of these no village is having the Upper Primary section facility.

39 Villages are with a population of more than 50% S.T. and out of these only 8 villages are having upper primary facility.

3.3. There are Upper Primary sections in 511 schools in Rural Areas and in Urban Areas the figure is 84. The details are shown in Table No.8.

: 15 :

3.4. In Rural areas 297 Upper Primary Schools are having pucca buildings out of 321 Upper Primary schools.

In Urban Areas 22 Upper Primary Schools are having pucca buildings out of 38 Upper Primary schools, the details are shown in Table No. 10.

In rural areas only 20 Upper Primary Schools out of 321 are having nominal libraries.

In Urban Areas 29 Upper Primary Schools, out of 38 schools are having library facilities.

In Rural areas only 105 out of 321 Upper Primary Schools are provided with Urinals and Lavatories.

In Urban areas 30 out of 38 schools are provided with Urinals.

In rural areas only 11% female teachers and in Urban Area 45% female teachers are working. The proportion of untrained teachers in Rural area is 2.6% and in Urban Area 1.8%.

3.6. ENROLMENT:- VI to VIII Classes.

The total enrolment in the District is 59,569. The girls are 31%.

In Rural areas total enrolment is 43,293. Out of this 27.7% are girls.

The proportion of S.C. children in Upper Primary classes is only 12.6%.

The proportion of S.T. children in Upper Primary classes is only 3.6%.

The proportion of S.C. population in Rural Area is 16.4% and S.T. proportion is 6.3%

The enrolment S.C. and S.T. children in Upper Primary sections is not in proportion to their Population. It is below the proportion.

The total enrolment in Urban Areas is 16,276, out of this Girls are 40.5%.

The proportion of S.C. children is 12.9% and S.T. children is only 3.6%.

The proportion of S.C. population is 8.9% and S.T. population is 0.76%.

Comparative to the population the enrolment of S.C. and S.T. children in Urban Area is much more, due to Hostel facilities.

3.7. The gross enrolment ratio in the age group 11-14 is 23.2% in Rural areas and 70% in Urban areas. The age specific enrolment ratio in 11-14 age group is 17.9% in rural and 50.3% in Urban Area.

The details are shown in Table 32.

The teacher pupil ratio for Rural Areas is 1:27 and in Urban Areas it is 1:25.

CHAPTER - IV.

4.1. There are 238 Secondary Schools and 20 Higher Secondary Schools in the District, out of these 192 are in Rural Areas and 46 are in Urban Areas.

Out of 20 Higher Secondary Schools, 9 are in Rural areas and 11 in Urban Areas. All these are in Government management only.

12 out of 20 Higher Secondary Schools are having secondary sections attached to them.

4.2. Only 185 habitations with a population of 6,59,279 are covered with a secondary school facility within the habitations. This is only 27% of the total population. The figure shows that the Secondary School facility is very poor in the District.

In addition to the above, there is Secondary Education facility for 1879 habitations with a population of 1453714 within a radius of '8' K.Ms. Thus the total 86.8% of population is covered with secondary education facility within the habitation or at a distance of 8 K.Ms.

4.3. Only 10 habitations with a population of 84604 are covered with Higher Secondary facilities, The percentage of this population is only 3.5%.

Thus the Higher Secondary facility in the District is very poor when compared with the needs of population.

In addition to the above, 411 habitation with a population of 419584 are having the Higher Secondary School facility within a radius of 8 K.Ms. Thus 20.7% of the total population is covered with Higher Secondary facility within the habitation or at a distance of 8 K.Ms.

4.4. All Secondary Schools and Higher Secondary Schools are having library books but no secondary school has a separate library and Librarian.

In rural areas for 197 Secondary schools there are 1680 teachers. Out of these, 1568 are male and 112 female teachers. There are only 51 untrained teachers in total.

In Urban Area for 53 Secondary Schools 844 teachers are teaching, out of these 574 male and 265 female teachers. There are only 7 untrained teachers in total, the figure shown that in Urban Area the female teachers are more in number than in rural area, the details are given in Table Nos. 17, 18.

There are no laboratories in any Secondary School.

: 17 :

In Higher Secondary Schools, 18 are having separate laboratories for subject wise and for '2' there is only one Lab. for all subjects.

250 Schools are having secondary sections. In these schools 463 trained teachers in Science subjects are teaching Science.

In 20 Higher Secondary Schools 30 teachers are teaching Science subjects.

4.5. ENROLMENT IN RURAL AREAS (IX & X).

The total enrolment in Secondary sections is 17827, the enrolment of girls is only 22.3%, the enrolment of S.C. students is 12.4% and S.T. students enrolment is only 3%.

The total enrolment in Higher Secondary sections is 3925, the enrolment of Girls is only 17.9%. The enrolment of S.C. students is 16.1% and S.T. students enrolment is 2.4%.

ENROLMENT IN URBAN AREAS (IX - X):

The total enrolment in secondary schools is 9419. The enrolment of Girls is 39%. The enrolment of S.C. students is 11.3% and S.T. students enrolment is 3%.

In Higher Secondary Schools the total enrolment is 8048, the Girls enrolment is 26.4%, the enrolment of S.C. students is 8.8% and S.T. students is 1.9%.

Enrolment of Girls in both Secondary and Higher Secondary schools is better in Urban Areas, than in Rural areas. The enrolment of S.C. students is almost the same in Rural Areas and Urban areas in Secondary stage. The details are given in tables 22, 23.

4.6. In Rural areas, 172 out of 192 schools are provided with Urinals and Lavatories. In Urban Areas all 46 schools are provided with Urinals and Lavatories.

All 20 Higher Secondary Schools are provided with Urinals and Lavatories.

All Secondary and Higher Secondary schools are having physical Education Teachers.

4.7. All 20 Higher Secondary Schools are having 'Science' and 'Arts' courses. Only two Higher Secondary Schools are having Commerce and 4 Higher Secondary Schools are having Vocational Courses.

CHAPTER - V.

5.1. 646 Villages are having 699 Non Formal Educational Centres at Primary level only in Rural Areas and in Urban Areas only 6 Urban areas are having 65 Centres.

: 18 :

The enrolment in Rural Areas is Boys 11809 and Girls 5536, the percentage of Girls is 31.9%. In Urban Areas 1067 Boys 557 Girls are enrolled. The percentage of Girls is 34.3%.

As on 30.9.1986 the following Mandals do not have Non Formal Education Centres. Addakal, Balanagar, Bhootpur, Bomraspet, Doulabed, Gopalpet, Gharpur, Jadcherla, Kelwakurthy, Kodangal, Kothekota, Midjil, Nagarkurnool, Pebbair, Peddamandadi, Telkapally, Wangoor and Wanaparthy.

5.2. As on 30.9.1986, there are 595 Adult Education Centres with an enrolment of 17850. They are functioning in 361 villages and in Urban Areas there were 5 centres with an enrolment of 150 in two Urban Areas.

Two Projects of Adult Education are functioning covering 31 Mandals, the rest do not have Adult Education Scheme.

5.3. There are no special schools for the Disabled children.

There are no recognised pre-primary classes in the District.


MAP OF MAHABUBNAGAR DIST
