## *Preface*

Until a few years ago the demand for specific data and indicators incorporating gender aspects was limited promoters of women's rights and rights of disadvantaged groups. With decentralization of governance and planning, the user demand has widened to include decision makers at every level and in every area of social and economic life. 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# RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF WOMEN IN INDIA

## 1. CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS

The Constitution of India not only grants equality to women but also empowers the State to adopt measures of positive discrimination in favour of women for neutralizing the cumulative socio-economic, education and political disadvantages faced by them. Fundamental Rights, among others, ensures equality before the law the equal protection of the laws within the territory of India, prohibits discrimination against any citizen on grounds of religion, race, caste, sex or place of birth and guarantees equality of opportunity to all citizens in matters relating to employment. Articles 14, 15, 15(3), 16, 39(a), 39(b), 39(c) and 42 of all the Constitution are of specific importance in this regard.

## 2. LEGISLATIVE PROVISIONS

Important social legislations to women is:

- (i) The Maternity Benefit Act, 1961;
- (ii) The Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 2002;
- (iii) The Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961;
- (iv) The Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1986;
- (v) The Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act, 1986;
- (vi) The Commission of Sati (Prevention) Act, 1987.

## 3. SPECIAL INITIATIVES FOR WOMEN

### (i) **National Commission for women**

In January 1992, the Government set-up this statutory body with a specific mandate to study and monitor all matters relating to the constitutional and legal safeguards provided for women review the existing legislation to suggest amendments wherever necessary, etc. For the same purpose Government has also set-up The Rajasthan State Commission for Women on 15<sup>th</sup> May, 1999.

**(ii) Reservation for women in Local Self Government**

The 73<sup>rd</sup> and 74<sup>th</sup> Constitution Amendment Acts passed in 1992 by Parliament ensure one-third of the total seats for women in all elected offices in local bodies whether in rural areas or urban areas.

**(iii) The National Plan of action for the Girl Child (1991-2000AD)**

The Plan of Action is to ensure survival, protection and development of the girl child with the ultimate objective of building up a better future of the girl child.

## **RAJASTHAN STATE COMMISSION FOR WOMEN**

**Functions of the Commission-** (1) The Commission shall Perform all or any of the following functions, namely:-

- (i) inquire into any unfair practice, take decisions thereon and to recommend to the Government actions to be taken in that matter;
- (ii) investigate or cause investigations to be made on issues of importance concerning women or issues concerning unfair practices and report thereon to the Government on the corrective measures to be taken,
- (iii) submit to the State Government an annual report or reports on,-
  - (a) the lacunae, inadequacies or shortcomings in the laws in force which affect the constitutional right to equality and fair treatment of women and also on the remedial legislative measures to be taken to meet such situations,
  - (b) the monitoring of the working of laws in force concerning women with a view to identifying the areas where the enforcement of laws is not adequately effective or has not been streamlined and recommending, executive or legislative measures to be taken in amelioration thereof,
  - (c) monitoring the recruitments made to State Public Services and State Public Undertakings and scrutinising the rules and regulations governing such recruitments with a view to reporting to the State Government for action, if any, required to guarantee equal opportunity to women in the matter of such recruitments;



(iv) (a) inspect or cause to be inspected, by any officer of the Commission duly authorised by the Commission in that behalf, any prison, police station, lockup, sub-jail, rescue home or other places of custody where women are kept as prisoners or otherwise, or shelters for women or other similar places run by the State Government or any of its agencies including agencies receiving aid from the Government for the purpose of offering rescue or shelter to women, or hostels intended for women or girls run by any person and all such other places wherein unfair practices against women is complained of and cause further inquires to be made about the treatment that women and girls are subject to at such places and to report to the Government for taking remedial action,

(b) in cases where the Commission is of the view that any public servant has been grossly negligent or grossly indifferent in regard to the discharge of his duties in relation to the protection of the interests of women, it may recommend to the concerned disciplinary authority to initiate disciplinary action;

(v) recommend to Government, the welfare measures to be adopted and implemented by the Government with a view to ameliorating the conditions of women;

(vi) formulate a comprehensive and affirmative scheme for securing equal opportunities for women and devise a programme for implementing such schemes which shall be forwarded to the State Government for approval and on obtaining approval thereof with or without modifications, implement the same or cause the same to be implemented;

- (vii) to recommend to the appropriate authority to take prosecution proceedings in respect of offences committed against women under any statute providing for penalty for violation of the provisions of such statutes;
- (viii) maintain a Comprehensive Data Bank relating to the social, economic and political conditions of women including comparative study, updating the same from time to time, making available such data for use in actions for vindication of the rights of women;
- (ix) recommend to Government to initiate legislation for removal of discrimination in the case of inheritance, guardianship, adoption and divorce or for matters relating to the safeguarding of the dignity of women and the honour of motherhood;
- (x) call for special studies or investigation into specific problems or situations arising out of discrimination and atrocities against women and identify the constraints so as to recommend strategies for their removal;
- (xi) advise on the planning process for socio-economic development of women;
- (xii) fund litigation involving issues affecting a large body of women;
- (xiii) make periodical reports to the State Government on any matter pertaining to women and in particular various difficulties under which women toil;
- (xiv) undertake promotional and educational research so as to suggest ways of ensuring due representation of women in all spheres and identify factors responsible for impeding their advancement, such as, lack of access to housing

and basic services, inadequate support services and technologies for, reducing drudgery and occupational health hazards and for increasing their productivity;

(xv) create awareness about the issues pertaining to women;

(xvi) any other matter which may be referred to it by the Government, the general public, the press or take suo moto cognizance of any rights infringement as it perceived by the Commission to be detrimental to the cause of women.

## DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

### **Annual Exponential Growth Rate**

$$R = [\text{Ln } P(t+10) - \text{Ln } P(t)]/10$$

Where Ln stands for natural logarithms

P(t)= Initial Population

P (t+10)= Population in next census after 10 years

### **Couples Effectively Protected**

Couples effectively protected is defined as the use effectiveness levels of different methods which is indicative of the effective coverage of the eligible couple of all the methods of contraceptions under family planning. The effectiveness is taken to be 100% in case of sterilization and oral pills, 95% in case of conventional contraceptives.

### **Gross Enrolment Ratio**

Gross enrolment ratio at a particular stage of education is defined as the number of pupils per hundred children of the age group corresponding to that stage.

Two stages considered here are primary (I-V) and Middle (VI-VIII) the corresponding age groups for these stages are 6-10 years and 11-13 years respectively. Thus, gross enrolment ratio for primary stage ((I-V) is total enrolment in classes I-V per hundred children in the age group 6-10 years. While interpreting these figures it should be noted that there may be many students outside the age group 6-10 years enrolled in classes I-V. Therefore, enrolment ratios in some age groups can be more than 100.

### **Infant Mortality Rate**

Infant Mortality Rate is defined as the number of deaths under one year of age to the thousand live births in a year.

**Juvenile**

Boys below 16 years of age and girls below 18 years of age are defined a Juvenile. Before 1988 boys and girls below 21 years were taken as juvenile.

**Literate**

A person who can both read and write with understanding in any language is considered as literate and a person who can merely read but cannot write is taken to be not literate.

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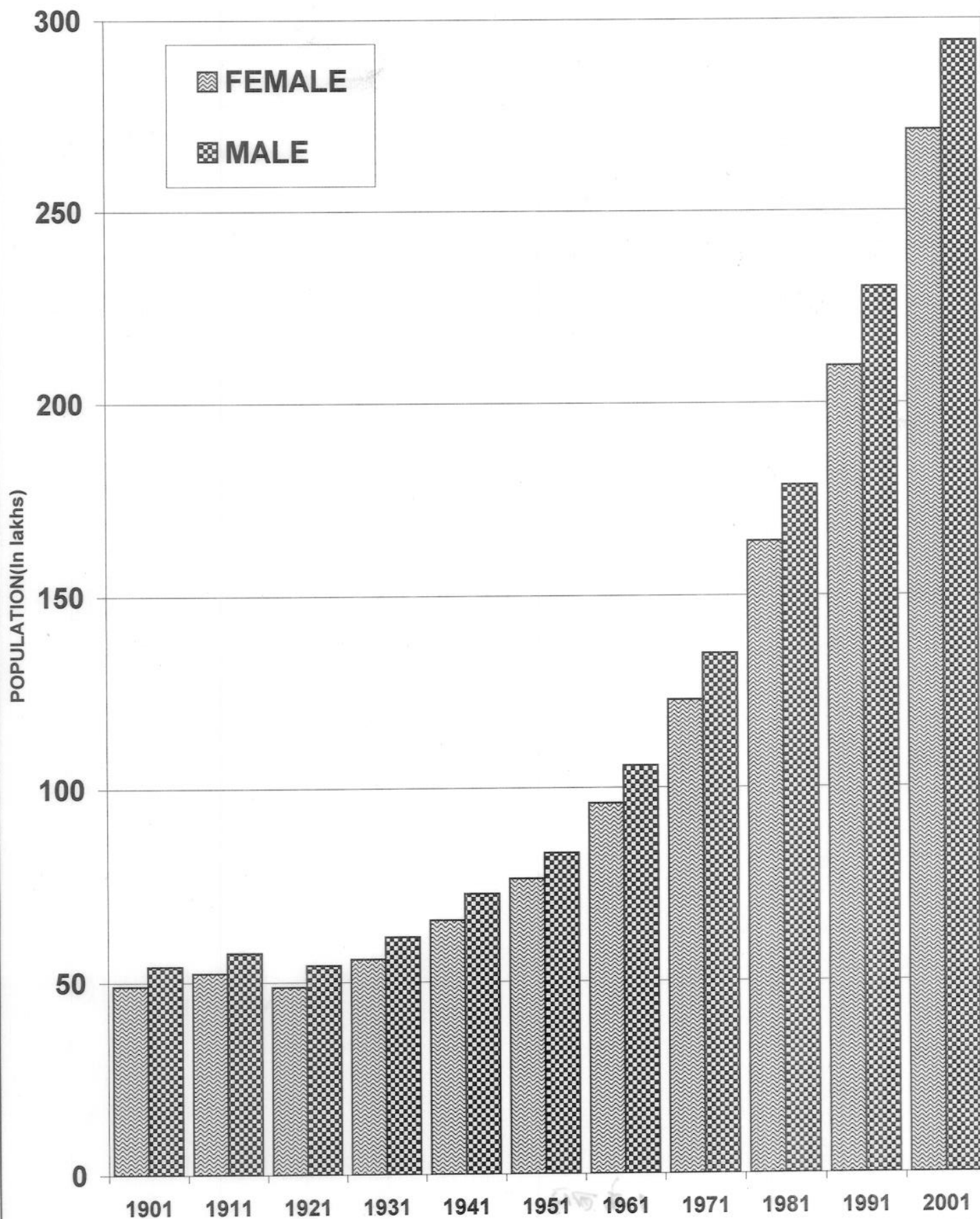

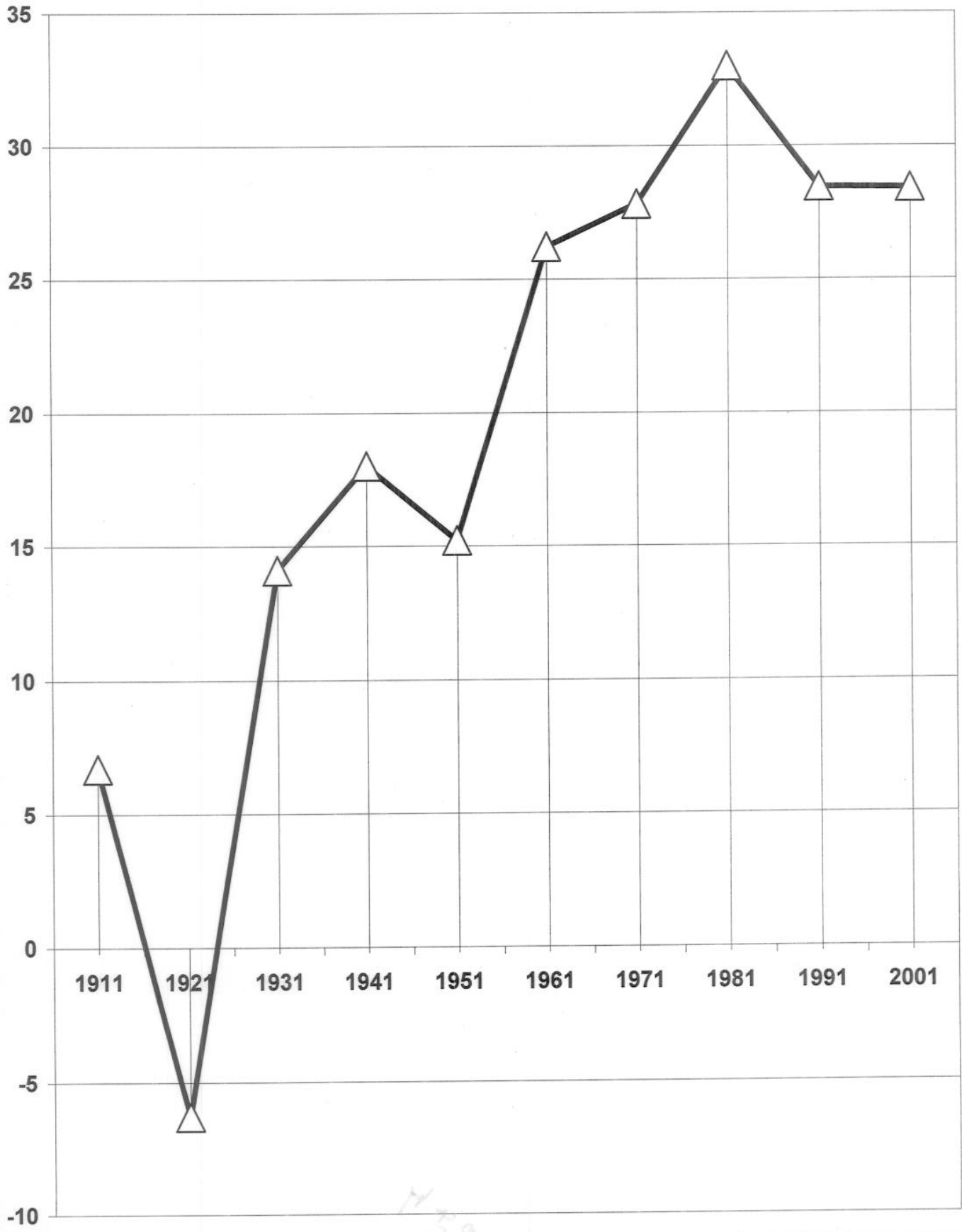

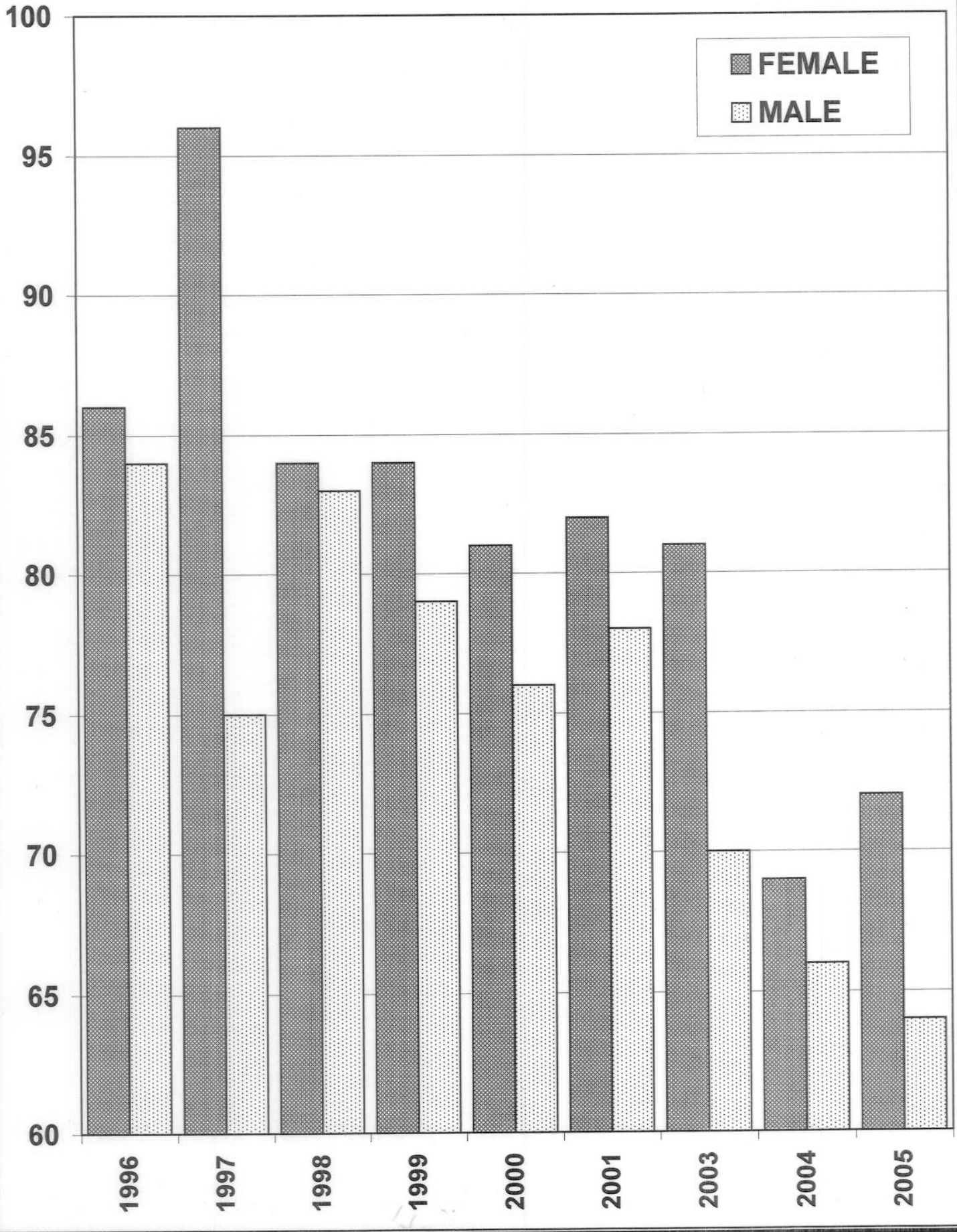

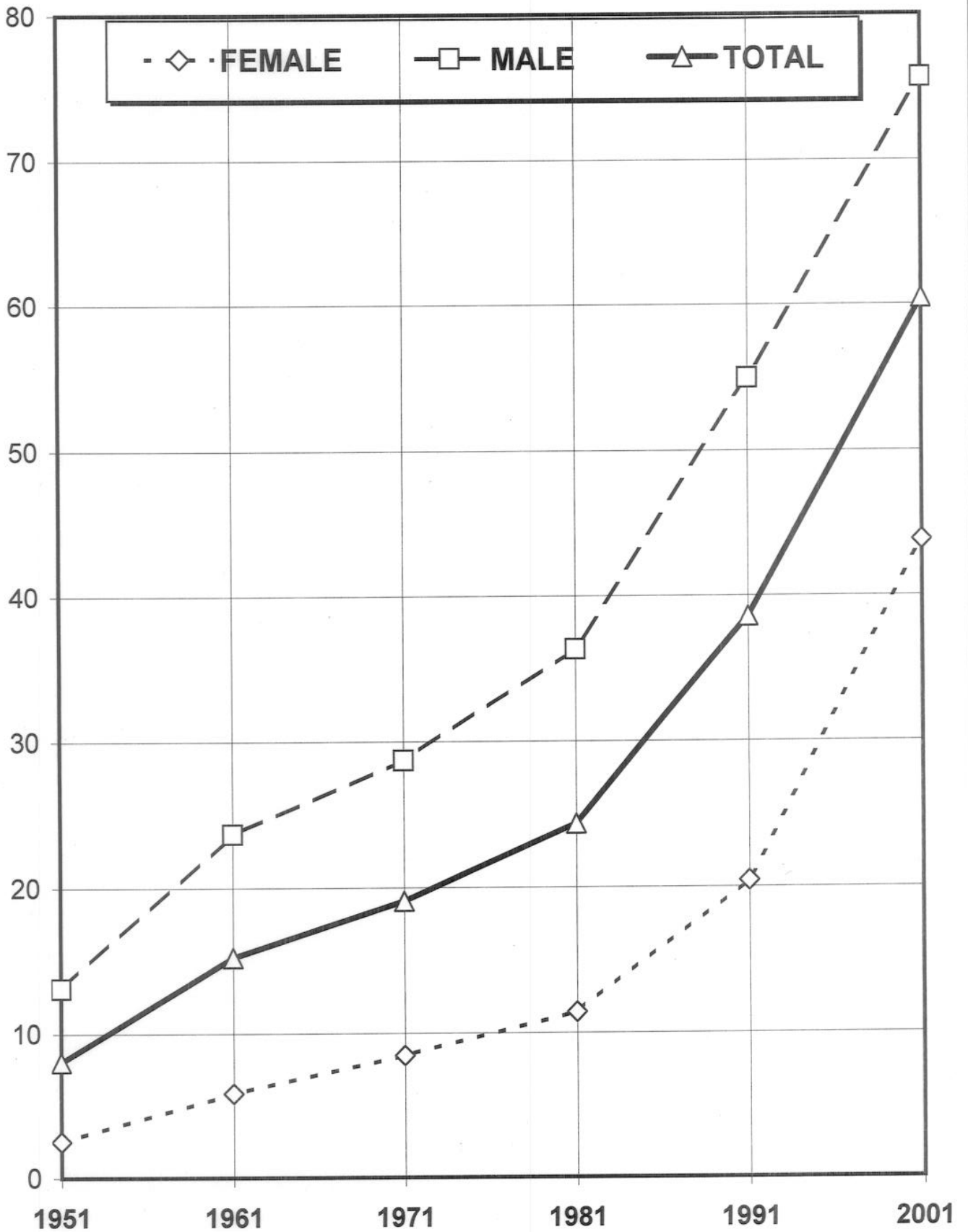

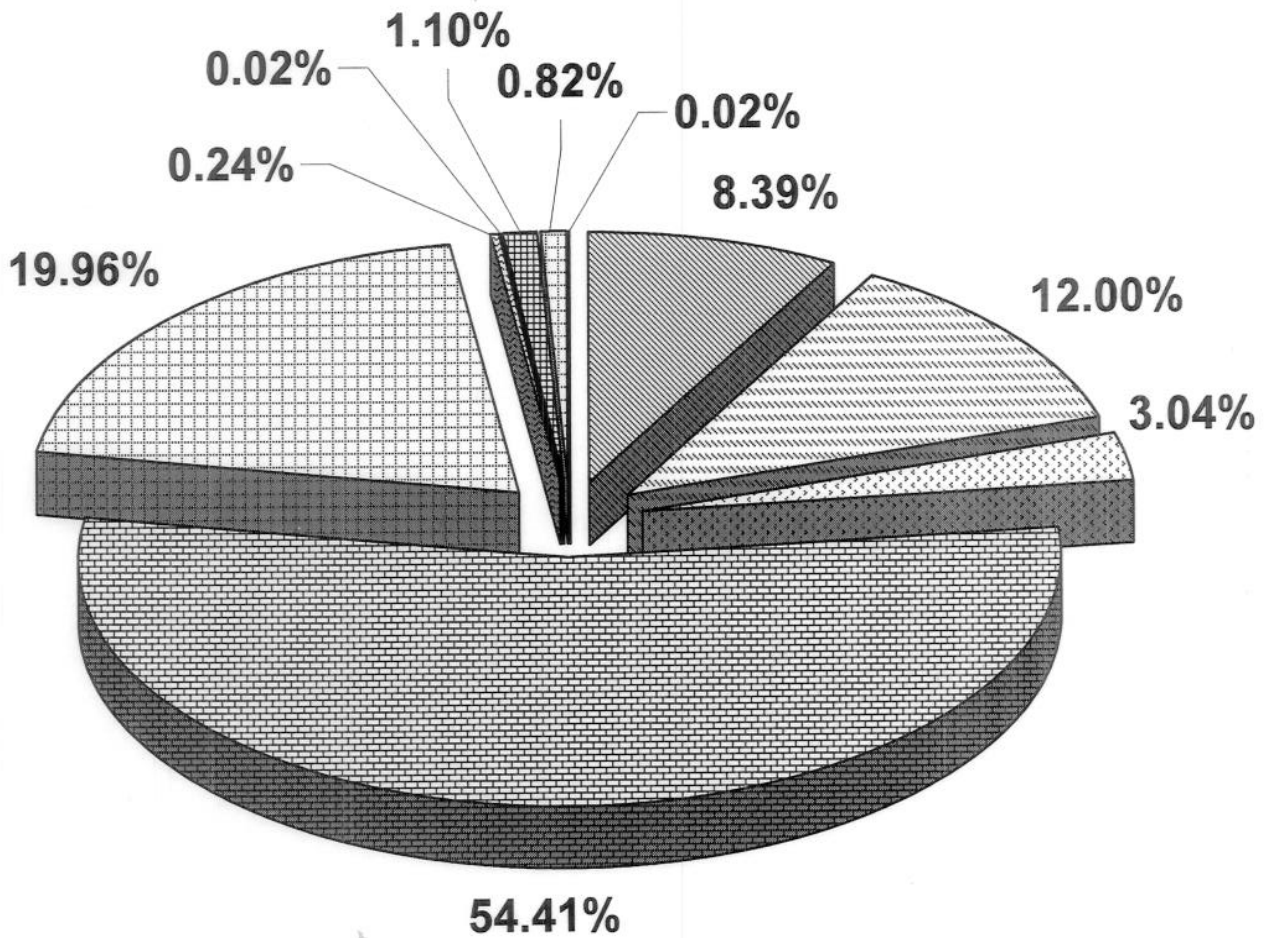

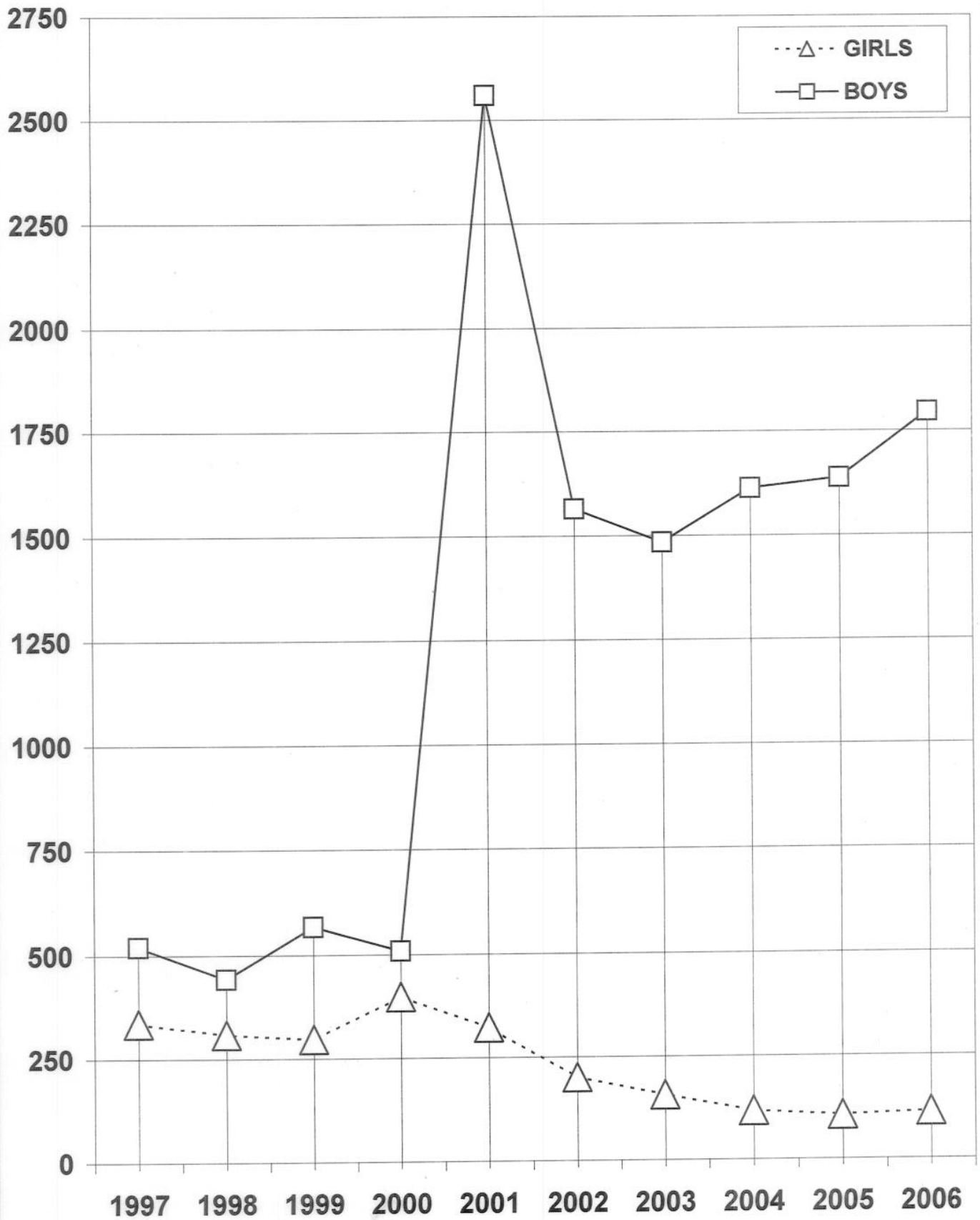
