



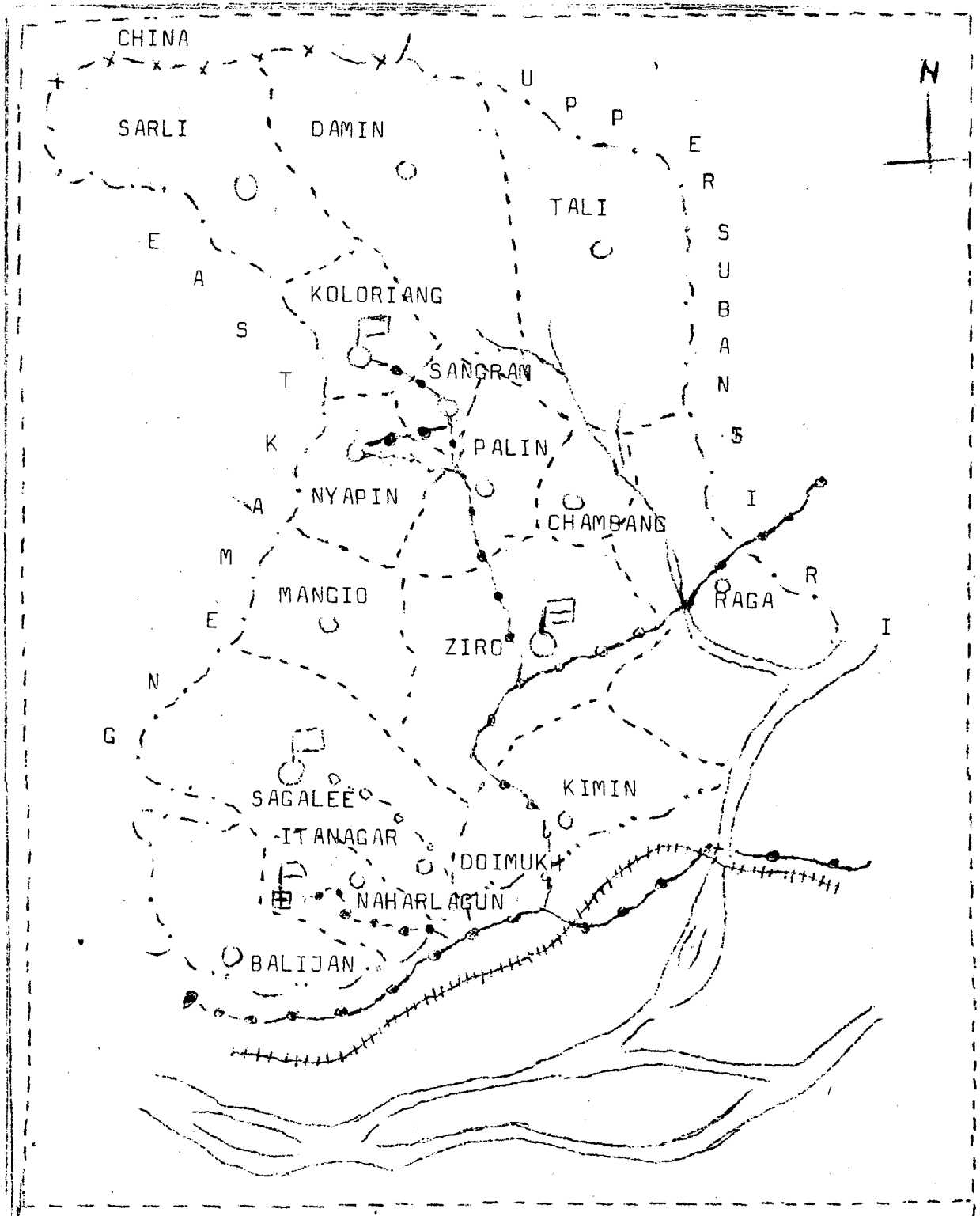

H I G H L I G H T S

1. GEOGRAPHICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE FEATURES :-

The Lower Subansiri District covers approximately an Area of 13010 Sq.Kms. The part of the district is mountainous terrain with Hill Ranges. It lies between Latitude 26°55'N and 28°21' N and Longitude 92°40' E and 94°21'E.

The District is bounded by China(Tibet) and some part of Upper Subansiri District to the North, West Siang and some part of Upper Subansiri District to the East, Assam State to the south and east Kameng District to the West.

Average Annual Rainfall of this district is 246 Centimetres.

It has three towns and 865 inhabited villages and it is divided into 4(four) Major Sub-Divisions and 17 Circles. The Deputy Commissioner is the overall Incharge of the District, Panchayat Raj System exists in the district. At present, the District has 10 CD/IRD Blocks.

2. POPULATION AND SOCIO ECONOMIC CONDITIONS :-

According to 1991 Census, (prov.) total population of the District is 154,591 persons. Of this Male population is 81,425 persons and rest are Female Population. Density of population is 11 persons per Sq,Kms.(+) 32.74 percent of the total population are literate, 73.81 percent of the total ~~population~~ Working population are cultivators(as per 1981 Census). Agriculture is the main occupation of the inhabitant/indigineous population of the District.

3. ROAD AND COMMUNICATIONS:-

The District has 544.84 Kms surfaced and 93.09 Kms. length of unsurfaced roads. Most of the Administrative Head Quarters are connected by roads with the District Head Quarter. Regular Bus Service exists from Ziro to North Lakhimpur/Itanagar and some other Administrative places/Head Quarters.

There are 3 Nos. Post Offices with Telegraph Facilities, 27 Nos. EDBPO, 3 Nos Telephone Exchanges with S.T.D. Facilities and 3 Nos. ordinary Telephone Exchanges functioning in the district.

4. AGRICULTURE, VETERINARY, FISHERY AND FORESTRY/LOGGING:-

The District has 48032 Hectres of land available for cultivation. Of this, Net Sown Area is 36.230 Hects. 34,865 Metrictonnes Cereal Crops (Paddy, Maize, Millet and Wheat) produced during the year 1990-91.

It has 14 Nos. of Veterinary Dispensaries, 13 Nos Veterinary Aid Centres at different Administrative places. It has 10 Nos. Govt. Fish Farms, 63 Nos. People Fish Farms, 1921 Nos village Fish Ponds. 179.10 Metric Tonnes Fish and 21,85 Lakh nos fish seeds produced during the reference year 1990-91.

5. MINERALS AND INDUSTRIES :-

There is no Economic Important Mineral Resources found in the district as yet.

There are 4 Nos. Training-cum-production Centre, 5 Nos Weaving Units, 1 No. Knitting Unit and 2 Nos. Sericulture Demonstration Farms functioning in the district. 85 Nos. Trainees were trained and passed out in different crafts during 1990-91 as per report available to us.

6. IRRIGATION AND FLOOD CONTROL SYSTEM :-

The District has 123 nos Minor Irrigation Channels and 2,713.39 Hectres Irrigated Land Area.

An expenditure of Rs. 318.44 Lakh were duly incurred as on 31.3.90 for construction of these M.I.C. in the district. Under Soil Conservation Schemes, 6.39 Lakh rupees expenditure were incurred (By RWD, Ziro Division only) for 319 Hectres land protection/Land Development works during 1990-91

Besides, one District Hospital at Ziro, One General Hospital at Maharlaqun, 28 Nos Health Units/Dispensaries were functioning in different Administrative Head Quarters/Places. 530 villages, ^{including 2 P.O. towns} and 2 Capital towns have been provided with Drinking Water Supply Facilities/Schemes during the year 1990-91 under report as on reference date.
