This volume on District-wise Educational Statistics for the State of Jammu & Kashmir, is the Eighteenth in the series of such volumes to be brought out in respect of all States/ Union Territories for the quinquennial year 1981-82. The main aim is to high-light the inter-district variations in a state by giving educational data at district level with the help of some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentage of trained teachers, pupil-teacher ratio.

## I N T R O D U C T I O N \_

Regional imbalances exist in the field of Educational Development just as in urbanisation, industrialisation, distribution of income and wealth. With a view to highlight Regional variations in the educational sector, the Ministry of Human Resource Development brings out the publication "Educational Statistics - District-wise" quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. There after it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state every five years by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry in respect of some States. However for the quinquennial year 1976-77, such reviews were brought out for all the States and Union Territories with legislature.

3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as Enrolment Ratios, percentage of Trained Teachers and Teacher-Pupil Ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and are of much use in formulating educational plans at the district level.

## II AREA AND POPULATION

4. Total Area of Jammu & Kashmir State is 222236 Sq.Kms (Provisional) as per 1981 census, including the area illegally occupied by Pakistan & China (78,114 Sq.Kms. is under illegal occupation of Pakistan, 5180 Sq.Kms illegally have been handed over by Pakistan to China & 37,555 Sq.Kms is under illegal occupation of China). In 1976-77 Jammu & Kashmir had 10 districts, by 1981-82 the number of districts increased to 14. Four new districts viz. Pulwama, Kupwara, Budgam & Kargil were formed after the bifurcation of 4 big districts

respectively as Anantnag, Baramulla, Srinagar and Leh. The district-wise area in 1981-82 of Jammu & Kashmir varied from the highest of 82665 Sq.Kms (including 37555 Sq.Kms. illegally occupied by China) in Leh to the lowest of 1371 Sq.Kms in Budgam district.

5. The population of Jammu & Kashmir was 49.99 lakhs in 1977. The same is estimated to have increased to 61.30 lakhs (32.38 lakhs males & 28.92 lakhs females) in 1982. The largest population in 1977 was in Anantnag (9.01 lakh) and the lowest in Leh (1.14 lakh). In 1982, the largest population of 9.66 lakh was in Jammu and the lowest of 0.70 lakhs in Leh. While calculating indices in comparison to Area, the area under illegal occupation of Pakistan & China has been excluded to get actual indices in different districts as well as Jammu & Kashmir State as a whole.

6. The overall density of population per Sq.Kms was 49 in 1977 which is estimated to have increased to 60 in 1982. The density of population per Sq.Kms in 1982 varied widely among districts viz. from 325 the highest in Srinagar to the lowest of 2 in case of Leh district. The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the years 1976-77 & 1981-82 are given in Appendix No.2. The table below gives a general view of the extent of variations in area, population and the density of population in 1982 :-

7. The total Population of the State as well as population of different age groups for the year 1977 and 1982 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 31st March of the year) available from the office of Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 are based on the following formula :-

We assume that:-

$$\frac{P_{6-11}}{P} = \frac{P_i_{6-11}}{P_i} = k$$

$$\therefore P_i_{6-11} = K P_i$$

Where K = is estimated from the formula

$$K = \frac{P_{6-11}}{P}$$

P 6-11 = 6-11 age group population of the State

P = Total population of the State

P<sub>i</sub> 6-11 = 6-11 age group population of the ith district

P<sub>i</sub> = Total population of the ith District.

To get the sex-wise break up of the total population in the various age-groups of the district, first of all the girls population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in the above formula total population is replaced by the girls population. The boys population is obtained by the residual method i.e.

Boys population in the age-group 6-11 = Total population in the age-group 6-11 -  
Girls population in the age-group 6-11.

Similar formulae have been used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-group 11-14 and 14-17 years.

8. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 9.02 lakhs in 1982 (4.97 lakhs boys and 4.05 lakhs girls) which constituted 14.72 of the total population of the State.

9. Similarly, the estimated population in the age-group 11-14 years was 4.61 lakhs in 1982 (2.40 lakhs boys and 2.21 lakhs girls) which constituted 7.5% of the total population of the State.

10. The population in the age-group 14-17 in 1982 is estimated to be 5.44 lakhs consisting of 2.86 lakhs boys and 2.58 lakhs girls. This forms 8.87% of the total population of the State.

11. Thus out of the total population of 61.30 lakhs of the State, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 19.08 lakhs consisting of 10.22 lakhs boys and 8.86 lakhs girls. The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 31.13% of the total population. These percentages separately for boys and girls were 31.57 and 30.64 respectively. District-Wise population in the age-group 6-11, 11-14, & 14-17 for 1977 & 82 are given in Appendix No. 3

### III. LITERACY

12. According to the 1981 census the literacy rate for the State as a whole was 26.67% .

Separate literacy rates for males and females are to be reported 36.29% and 15.88% respectively indicating a wide gap between the two sexes. The literacy rate in respect of Scheduled Castes comes to 22.4%. Although literacy rate for S.C. has been worked out for all the districts but the S.C. Population in 9 districts is negligible. The district-wise details of literacy for general population as well as that of Scheduled Caste is given in Appendix No.6.

IV. GENERAL VIEW

a) Institutions

13. The total number of educational institutions (Schools) in Jammu & Kashmir was 8760 in 1976-77. The same increased to 10499 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 19.85% during the period of 5 years. In 1981-82, Baramulla district had the largest share of institutions (11.8%). The smallest share was of Leh district (1.9%). The district-wise position of institutions is given in Appendix No.1.

b) Enrolment:

14. The total enrolment in all recognised educational institutions (School level) in the State increased from 6.50 lakhs in 1976-77 to 8.67 lakhs in 1981-82. The enrolment increased with an average annual growth rate of 6.7%. Jammu had the largest share of enrolment 21.7% in 1981-82. District-wise position of enrolment and percentage share is given in Appendix No.1.

15. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was 31.8% in 1976-77 which

increased to 35.1% in 1981-82. Among the districts, Srinagar had the highest (44.9%) percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment whereas Kargil had the lowest (15.2%) during 1981-82. In 1981-82 out of the 14 districts, 4 districts had higher percentage of girls enrolment than that of state's percentage and only 3 districts had higher percentage of girls enrolment than that of India's percentage (36.6). Details are shown in Appendix No.4.

c) Extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes :

16. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes or the co-efficient of equality is defined as :-

$$I = \frac{\text{Percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment}}{\text{Percentage of population of Scheduled Castes to total population}} \times 100$$

17. The percentage of Scheduled Castes students to total number of students was 7.5% (7.9% for boys and 6.9% for girls) in Jammu & Kashmir during 1981-82. The percentage of Scheduled Caste population to the total population was 8.3%. Accordingly, the extent of coverage or the co-efficient of equality for S.C. during the year 1981-82 has been worked out as 90.4%. In case of Scheduled Caste students, the highest extent of coverage was in Rajouri (168.9%) and the lowest was in Jammu (63.7%). The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.7.

(d) Teachers

18. The total number of teachers in the State in all Educational Institutions (School level) increased from 32462 in 1976-77 to 40456 in 1981-82 showing an average annual growth rate of 4.9% during this period. Jammu district had the largest share of teachers (16.1%) whereas Leh and Kargil districts had the lowest share (1.4%) each. The details may be seen in Appendix No.1.

19. In 1981-82, the total number of teachers upto school level was 40456 (26585 males and 13871 females) out of which 30568 teachers (20383 males and 10185 females) were trained. The percentage of trained teachers to the number of male, female and total teachers in school education were 76.7%, 73.4% and 75.6% respectively. The percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers had fairly wide variations among the districts from the highest 83.1% in Kathua to the lowest of 63.2% in Poonch district. Taking males and females together, percentage of trained teachers were higher in as many as 7 districts to that of State's percentage but no district had higher percentage than that of India's percentage (88.9). The details may be seen in Appendix No.5. This calls for the need to give more priority to teachers education by the State Government.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION:

20. There were no separate Pre-Primary schools in Jammu & Kashmir State during 1976-77 and 1981-82 also. However, preprimary classes are being run in existing primary & higher level schools. The total enrolment in pre-primary classes was 11026 in consisting of (6780 boys and 4246 girls) out of which 651 (415 boys and 236 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes. The District-wise details are given in Appendix No.8.

VI. PRIMARY EDUCATION

a) Institutions and Teachers

21. The total number of primary schools in Jammu & Kashmir increased from 6078 in

1976-77 to 7525 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 23.8% in five years. In 1981-82, the highest percentage of Primary Schools was in Baramulla (12.2%) and the lowest in Leh (1.9%).

22. On an average in 1976-77, a Primary school was serving an area of 16.7 Sq. Kms. Over a period of 5 years the position improved considerably and a Primary school was then serving an area of 13.5 Sq.Kms. in 1981-82. In 1981-82, the average area served by a Primary School was the minimum (3.1 Sq.Kms.) in the case of Pulwama and the maximum (308.9 Sq.Kms. ) in Leh district.

23. The population served by a Primary school in the State registered a low decrease from 823 to 815 during the period of five years. Among the districts, the population served by a Primary school varied from 373 in Kargil to 1350 in Srinagar in 1981-82. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.9.

24. Total number of teachers in the state increased from 8468 in 1976-77 to 10874 in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 5.7% during the five years period. During this period the number of teachers increased in almost all the districts after combining the teachers of bifurcated districts created during 1977 to 1982. The number of women teachers formed 39.5% of the total number of teachers in 1981-82. The highest percentage of teachers was 12.1% in Srinagar while the lowest percentage (1.7%) was found in Leh district. The pupil teacher ratio of the state level was 24 in 1976-77 and 27 in 1981-82. The pupil teacher ratio varied from the lowest of 18 in Srinagar district to the highest 38 in Jammu. The teacher-pupil ratio in 1981-82 was better in 8 districts than states ratio and in all districts was higher than that for India i.e. 39. Percentage of trained teachers to total

number of teachers in Primary schools was 74.6% (74.0% for men and 75.6% for women) in 1981-82. The percentage of trained teacher was higher in 7 districts than that of State's percentage and was higher in only one district than that of India (86.8%). Details are shown in Appendix No.11.

b) ENROLMENT

25. In 1976-77, the total enrolment in Primary schools in Jammu & Kashmir was 2.01 lakhs which increased to 2.92 lakhs in 1981-82. In classes I-V, the enrolment increased from 4.22 lakhs (2.73 lakhs boys and 1.44 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 to 5.81 lakhs (3.68 lakhs boys and 2.13 lakhs girls) in 1981-82 showing an average annual growth rate of 7.5%. The enrolment growth rates in these classes separately for boys and girls were 6.5% and 9.5% respectively which shows that girls education is getting better deal in the State.

26. The percentage of enrolment in classes I-V to the total population in the age-group 6-11 (also called enrolment ratio) gives the index of the facilities created at the Primary stage of education. In Jammu & Kashmir, the enrolment ratio is estimated to have increased from 59.4 in 1976-77 to 64.4 in 1981-82. In the case of boys alone this percentage has however shown a decline from 77.8 in 1976-77 to 74.1 in 1981-82 but in the case of girls it has increased from 40.8 to 52.5 during this period. Among the various districts taking boys and girls together, the enrolment ratio in 1981-82 was the highest in Poonch (81.6) and the lowest in Budgam (44.2). In 1981-82, the enrolment ratio was higher in 5 districts than that of States ratio but was not higher in any of the districts than that of India (86.8). Details of enrolment are given in Appendix No.10.

(c) Enrolment of S.C.

27. Of the total enrolment of 4.22 lakhs in Classes I-V in 1976-77, 35263 students belonged to Scheduled Castes forming 8.3% of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82, out of the total enrolment in these classes viz. 5.81 lakhs, the enrolment of Scheduled Castes was 47647 forming 8.2% of the total enrolment in Classes I-V. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.12.

(d) Education in Rural Areas

28. Of the total number of Primary schools in the state, 6642 (88.3%) were located in Rural Areas in 1981-82. Out of the total enrolment of 2.92 lakhs in Primary schools in 1981-82, 2.19 lakhs were in the schools located in Rural Areas forming 75.0% of the total enrolment in these schools. District-wise details of institutions, their enrolment and enrolment in Class I-V are given in Appendix No.13.

VII. MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) Institutions and Teachers

29. The total number of Middle schools in the State increased from 1930 in 1976-77 to 2106 in 1981-82, showing an increase of 9.1% during the period under review. In 1981-82, the largest number of Middle schools was recorded in Jammu (259) forming 12.3% of the total number of Middle schools in the state and the lowest being 36 (1.7%) each in Leh and Kargil districts.

30. On an average in 1976-77, a Middle school served an area of 52.5 Sq. Kms. which improved in 1981-82 and a Middle school was then available for every 48.1 Sq.Kms. area. In 1981-82 area served by a Middle school was the lowest in Srinagar district(10.4 Sq.Kms.) and the highest in Leh district (1253.1 Sq. Kms.).

31. The population served by a Middle school in the State increased from 2803 in 1976-77 to 2910 in 1981-82. Among the districts, the population served by a Middle school in 1981-82 varied from as low as 1878 in Kargil district to as high as 3729 in Jammu district. The details are given in Appendix No.14.

32. The number of teachers in Middle schools increased from 10760 in 1976-77 to 13956 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 29.7% during the period of five years. In 1976-77 pupil teacher ratio was 20 which increased to 21 in 1981-82. The pupil teacher ratio varied from 14 in Srinagar to 32 in Rajouri in 1981-82. Teacher pupil ratio in Middle schools was better in 5 districts than that of State's and in all district than that of India being 34 in 1981-82. Percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers in 1981-82 was 77.0% (78.7% for males and 73.5% for females). Taking male and female together the percentage was the highest in Kupwara (86.9%) and the lowest in Srinagar (66.1%). The percentage of trained teachers was higher in 6 districts than the States percentage and none of its district had the higher percentage of trained teachers as compared to 89.8% for India as a whole. The details can be seen in Appendix No.16.

b) ENROLMENT

33. The total enrolment in Middle schools was 2.11 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 2.87 lakhs in 1981-82. The enrolment at the Middle stage i.e. in classes VI-VIII increased from 1.46 lakhs (1.05 lakhs boys and 0.41 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 to 1.80 lakhs (1.22 lakhs boys and 0.58 girls) in 1981-82. This shows an annual growth rate of 4.7 % (3.3 % for boys and 8.2 % for girls) during the period under consideration, which shows that girls education showing an improvement at Middle level too.

34. The percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age-group 11-14 i.e. enrolment ratio gives an index of the facilities at the Middle stage of education. In J & K this percentage was 38.2 in 1976-77 which increased to 39.1 % in 1981-82. In case of boys, the enrolment ratio was 53.7 % in 1976-77 which slightly declined to 51.1 % in 1981-82. The enrolment ratio for girls at this stage were 22.0 % in 1976-77 and 26.2 % in 1981-82. Taking boys and girls together, the enrolment ratio in case of 4 districts were found to be higher than the corresponding states ratio and was higher in 3 districts than the corresponding India's ratio of 43.3 % during 1981-82. At the middle stage, the worked out enrolment ratio indicates a large disparity between the two sexes in almost all the districts. However the position of girls improved considerably during the period 1976-77 to 1981-82. In 1981-82 the highest enrolment ratio was in Jammu district for boys and girls together (60.3) and the lowest was in case of Budgam (23.2). The details may be seen in Appendix No. 15.

c) ENROLMENT OF SC

35. Of the total enrolment of 1.46 lakhs in Classes VI-VIII, 10605 students belonged to Scheduled Castes forming 7.2 % of the total enrolment in 1976-77. During 1981-82, the total enrolment of 1.80 lakhs, the number of students belonging to Scheduled Castes was 12201 forming 6.8 % of the total enrolment in Classes VI-VIII for the state as a whole.

d) MIDDLE SCHOOL EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

36. Out of the 2106 Middle schools in the State, 1687 (80.1 %) were in Rural Areas. Anantnag district had the highest number (210) of Rural Area Middle Schools followed by Kathua (202) and Leh had the lowest (33) in the State during 1981-82. Total enrolment in Rural middle schools was as 1.77 lakhs in 1981-82 forming 61.2 % of the total enrolment in middle schools. Enrolment in classes VI-VIII in Rural Areas in 1981-82 was 1.22 lakhs (0.91 lakhs boys and 0.31 lakhs girls). District-wise position of the Rural Area education at Middle level has been depicted in Appendix No.18.

ENROLMENT BY STANDARD :

37. Appendix No.19 depicts the standard-wise enrolment from class I to VIII. At the state level, the decreasing trend of enrolment in each class over the previous class has been observed. Percentage enrolment of class V to that of class I works out to be 45.7 % and of class VIII to class I as 29.7 % during 1981-82.

VIII HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION  
INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

38. There were 740 High/Higher Secondary schools in 1976-77 which increased to 868 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 17.3 % during the period of 5 years. Among the districts,

the largest number of High/Higher Secondary schools i.e. 156 (18.0 %) are reported to be in Jammu and the lowest of 16 (1.8 %) in Leh district during 1981-82.

39. On an average, there was a High/Higher Secondary school for every 37.9 sq.kms. in 1976-77. By 1981-82, the position improved considerably and a High/Higher Secondary school was available for 116.8 sq.kms. In 1991-82, in Jammu district a High/Higher Secondary school was available for every 19.9 sq.kms. whereas in Leh a High/Higher Secondary school was available for an area of 2819.4 sq.kms.

40. At the state level, there was a High/Higher Secondary school available for 6756 persons in 1976-77. By 1981-82 a High/Higher secondary school was available for 7062 persons. Among the districts in 1981-82, the average population served by a High/Higher Secondary school varied from 3976 persons in Kargil district to 8302 persons in Pulwama district. District-wise details of High/Higher Secondary schools, area and population served by a High/Higher Secondary school is depicted in Appendix No.20.

41. The total number of teachers in High/Higher Secondary schools in Jammu & Kashmir increased from 13098 in 1976-77 to 15626 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 19.3 % during the period under consideration. The increase in teachers was observed in almost all the districts. The women teachers formed 32.1 % of the total number of teachers in High/Higher Secondary schools in 1981-82. Teacher pupil ratio was 18 in 1976-77 which remained the same in 1981-82 also. In 1981-82, the teacher-pupil ratio varied from 10 to 23 among all the districts. The ratio in 1981-82 was found to be better in 6 districts than the corresponding State's ratio and was higher in all the districts than that of India's (27).

Percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers in the state in 1981-82 was 74.9 % (76.5 % for males and 71.5 % for females). Taking males and females together the percentage was higher in 7 districts than corresponding State's percentage and was not to the mark in any district than that of India's being 89.3 %. Details are in Appendix No. 22.

ENROLMENT :

42. The total enrolment in High/Higher Secondary schools of the state was 2.37 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 2.87 lakhs in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 4.2 %. The enrolment in classes IX-XI/XII in 1976-77 was 74,416 (55490 boys and 18926 girls). In 1981-82 the enrolment in classes IX-XI/XII increased to 94474 (65548 boys and 28926 girls) showing an average annual increase of 5.4 %. The average annual increase in enrolment for boys and girls separately works out to be 3.6 % and 10.6 % respectively, showing that girls are getting better deal in this stage too.

43. Enrolment ratio for J & K state at the High/Higher Secondary stage i.e. in classes IX-XI/XII was 21.1 % (30.6 % for boys and 11.0 % for girls) in 1976-77 and 17.4 % (23.0 % for boys and 11.2 % for girls) in 1981-82. Among the districts in 1981-82, the enrolment ratio varied from the highest of 31.0 % in Jammu to the lowest of 8.7 % in case of Budgam district. The enrolment ratio's, are observed to be higher in 4 districts as compared to the corresponding State's percentage and also higher in 4 districts as compared to that of India's (18.0 %). Details are in Appendix No. 21.

ENROLMENT OF SC

44. Of the total enrolment of 74416 in classes IX-XI/XII, the number of students belonging to Scheduled Castes was 3949 in 1976-77 forming 5.3 % of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82, out of the total enrolment of 94474 in classes IX-XI/XII, there were, 4909 students belonging to Scheduled Castes forming 5.2 % to the total enrolment in these classes. The details of enrolment of SC and percentages at district level are given in Appendix No.23.

HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

45. Out of the 868 High/Higher Secondary schools in 1981-82 in the State, 567 (65.3 %) were in Rural Areas. Among the Rural Areas of different districts, the maximum number was in Jammu (68) and the minimum in Leh district (14). Out of the total enrolment of 287116 in High/Higher Secondary schools in the state 130350 (45.4 %) were of institutions in Rural Areas. In classes IX-XI/XII in Rural Area. the enrolment was 25308 (20538 boys and 4770 girls) in 1981-82. The district-wise position is given in Appendix No. 24.

PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER SCHOOL EDUCATION

46. In 1976-77 there were 12 institutions having 1539 students of which 117 were Scheduled Castes. There were 137 teachers in these school. As corresponding data for 1981-82 was not made available by the state govt., no comparison has been made.

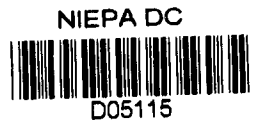
