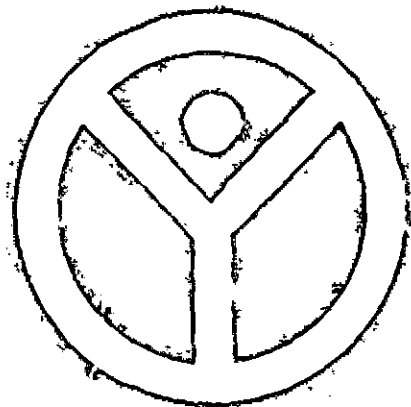

PREFACE

This publication contains detailed statistics regarding progress of Adult Education in Haryana State during the year 1980-81. It also provides some basic information regarding position of Literacy in the State.

Last year a similar compilation indicating the statistics on Adult Education as on 30-9-1979 was brought out. In the new attempt some additional statements regarding position of Literacy, grants received from the Govt. of India and the evaluation of learners have been added. Besides a precise history regarding progress of Adult Education in Haryana since the state came into being has been included. I hope, the booklet should be of great use for planning the future expansion of the programme of Adult Education and also serve as a permanent record.

PROGRESS OF ADULT EDUCATION IN HARYANA

The programme of Adult Education in Haryana is nearly three decades old. Much before the formation of Haryana State some schemes pertaining to Adult Education were in operation in the erstwhile state of Punjab in some areas now comprising Haryana.

At the time of formation of Haryana State two Mobile Squads with 58 Social Education Centres were functioning in the districts of Jind and Mohindergarh. Besides, 180 Adult Literacy Centres—60 centres each in the districts of Ambala, Karnal and Rohtak were functioning.

In the year 1968-69 a new centrally sponsored scheme called 'Farmers Functional Literacy Project' with 100% assistance from Government of India was started in the District of Rohtak and 60 centres were started. In the following years, the programme was extended to five more districts of Ambala, Gurgaon, Hissar, Karnal and Sirsa as per details given below :—

The total No. of centres under this programme upto 1976-77 was 360.

In 1975-76 another scheme "Non-Formal Education for the age group 15-25 years" was started in two districts of Bhiwani and Jind. Under this programme the cost between Government of India and the State Government was shareable on 50:50 basis i.e.

the entire cost of one district was met by the Government of India and that of the other by the State Government. Two hundred centres, 100 in each district were started. The scheme was extended to the districts of Gurgaon and Karnal during the year 1976-77 and 100 centres in each of these districts were started. At the end of 1976-77 the total number of centres under this scheme was 400.

In nut shell the total number of centres under various schemes upto the end of 1977-78 was 998 as per details given below :—

All the above centres continued functioning during 1978-79.

National Adult Education Programme

The Government of India started the National Adult Education Programme as a mass campaign w.e.f. 2nd Oct. 1978. The new programme envisages the imparting of Literacy, Functionality and Awareness to illiterate youth in the age group 15—35 years. The main focus of the programme is on Rural population with particular emphasis on women and persons belonging to weaker sections of the society. During the year 1978-79, 1440 new Adult Education Centres under the Centrally Sponsored Programme and 862 new centres under the State schemes were sanctioned. Thus in all the number of centres upto the end of 1978-79 rose to 3300. Out of these only 2856 centres could be started. Of this 1465 were for women, which formed 51.3% of the total. The number of beneficiaries during 1978-79 was 66037 out of this 33094 were women comprising 50.1% of the total coverage. The total expenditure on Adult Education during the year under the various schemes was Rs. 41.50 lakhs—Rs. 21.25 lakhs under Centrally Sponsored Programme and Rs. 20.25 lakhs under the State Schemes.

Progress during 1979-80

During the year 1979-80, 200 more Adult centres were

sanctioned under the Centrally Sponsored Programme, thereby raising the total number of centres to 3500. Of these 2400 centres were under 'Centrally Sponsored Programme' and 1100 under 'State Programme.' Under the Centrally Sponsored Programme the two schemes namely "Farmers Functional Literacy Project" and "Non Formal Education for the age group 15—25 years" were brought under one canopy with the new nomenclature of "Rural Functional Literacy Project". Out of these 3500 centres, 3302 centres were actually opened upto 31.3.1980. Of these 1884 were for women which constituted 57.0% of the total.

The emphasis of the programme continued to be on Rural areas. Out of these 3302 centres, 2958 were functioning in Rural areas and this accounted for 89.5% of the total number of centres.

The total number of beneficiaries under the programme was 72693—32879 men and 39814 women. Women comprised 54.7% of the total. The number of beneficiaries belonging to Scheduled castes was 17380—8742 men, 8638 women. The percentage belonging to Scheduled Castes to total coverage was 23.9. The population of Scheduled Castes in Haryana is nearly 20% and it is happy to note that the coverage of Scheduled Castes under the Adult Education Programme exceeded this figure. The expenditure on Adult Education during the year was Rs. 50.82 lakhs—Rs. 33.74 lakhs under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes and Rs. 17.08 lakhs under the State Programme. For the first time under the programme an evaluation for the learners was undertaken on a uniform and Scientific basis. The number of adults who successfully completed the programme was 40,089, out of which 21333 were women. The women were 53.2% of the total. The number of Scheduled Castes completing the course successfully was 11635. Of whom 5614 were women who formed 48.2% of the total. Vis-a-vis the total enrolment, the number of adults who completed the course successfully, the percentage was 55.1% in general and 16.0% for persons belonging to Scheduled Castes.

The achievement is encouraging keeping in view the fact that the new programme is in its infancy and still some of the teething troubles have yet to be eliminated. Another factor has also to be kept in mind is that under the Adult Education Programme persons who are to be tackled belong to diehard core.

Progress during 1980-81

During the year 1980-81 the programme has not been extended.

Emphasis has been on consolidating, strengthening and improving the programme. On 30.9.80 the number of centres actually functioning was 3312—1856 for women and 1456 for men. Women centres were 56% of the total. The number of centres in the Rural areas was 2969 accounting for 89.03% of the total.

The number of beneficiaries on this date was 75167—40525 women and 34642 men. Women were 53.9% of the total. The number of beneficiaries belonging to Rural Areas was 68920 constituting 92.6% of the total coverage. The number of beneficiaries belonging to Scheduled Castes was 17081—9712 men and 8369 women. Women constituted 49% of the total. The anticipated Budget expenditure for the year 1980-81 is Rs. 66.01 lakhs. The present programme covers 35 blocks in all the 12 districts. 3 blocks in each district except Faridabad where only two blocks are covered.

Voluntary Organizations

The Adult Education Programme is mainly run by the State Government. The contribution by the private agencies is negligible. During 1979-80, two Voluntary Organizations i.e. Janta Kalyan Samiti, Rewari, and Social Work & Research Centre, Khori (M. Garh) were given grant by the Government of India. They ran 10 & 53 centres respectively. The enrolments in these centres was 3559 on 31.3.80.

The U.G.C. sanctioned seed money to 9 colleges and Kurukshetra University. Only I.B. College, Panipat started 10 centres with an enrolment of 263.

Two Nehru Yuvak Kendras at Karnal and Gurgaon ran 36 centres with an enrolment of 2811.

During 1980-81, only Social Work and Research Centre Khori and Nehru Yuvak Kendra, Karnal and I.B. College Panipat have undertaken this work.

IMPROVEMENT

New Experiments

For the smooth running of the programme, financial and administrative procedures have been streamlined to a large extent. Adequate financial and administrative powers have been delegated.

Supervision has been improved and minimum norms for touring have been laid down for various functionaries in the field. Close liaison is being kept with other development departments through the District Adult Education Boards, and they have started participating in the training programme of Instructors and Supervisors in a big way. In most of the villages Committees have been set up to promote the programme.

The following steps have been taken by way of new experiment to promote the programme :—

1. The Instructors have been given free hand to take up new experiments within the available resources or with the help of the community and it has been decided to reward good workers.
2. The training period of 21 days for instructors have been split up. On the pay day there is appraisal of the programme. The difficulties encountered by them are solved and experiences are shared. New experiments and innovations are narrated by the instructors for the benefit of their Co-workers. This day is treated as an "Orientation-cum-Follow up day". The training imparted is not theoretical but is given a practical bias under the new arrangement. 10 days training is given during the monthly meetings and 11 days training in one lump.
3. The totality of progress of the programme in the State is reviewed every quarter in meeting of District Adult Education Officers, Project Officer and Asstt. Project Officers. These meetings are of two days duration and are held by rotation at various district headquarters. Some supervisors and instructors from the field also participate in these meetings and they narrate their experiences and innovations. This help in cross fertilization of ideas. These meetings are also treated as training days for Project Officers and Asstt. Project Officers.

The present programme touches only a fringe of the problem. The path is full of obstacles but never the less there is a ray of hope.
