This volume on District-wise Educational Statistics for the State of Karnataka, is the fourth in the series of such volumes to be brought out in respect of all States/Union-Territories for the quinquennial year 1981-82. The main aim is to high-light the inter-district variations in a state by giving educational data at district level with the help of some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentage of trained teachers, pupil-teacher ratio etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances are narrowed down with time, the data for the year 1981-82 has been compared with that for the year 1976-77.

I take this opportunity to express my appreciation of the cooperation received from the Director of Education, Karnataka and the project staff of the Planning, Monitoring and Statistics Division who have prepared this report.

## I N T R O D U C T I O N -

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of educational development just as in urbanisation, industrialisation, distribution of income and wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector, the Ministry of Human Resource Development brought out the publication "Educational Statistics - District-wise quinquennially.

2. Volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research & Training in 1960-61. Thereafter, it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state, every five years, by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out for all the States and Union Territories with legislature.

3. For making inter district comparison possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers and teacher pupil ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and are of much need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

## II - AREA AND POPULATION

4. The area of the Karnataka State is 191773 Sq. Kms. as per 1981 Census. Administratively there are 19 districts in Karnataka state but since 1976-77 the Bangalore District have 3 units i.e. Bangalore North, Bangalore South and Bangalore Rural in view of collection of Educational data by the Directorate of Education of the Karnataka State. The area of these bifurcated units of Bangalore District is not available separately for each sub-district. The district-wise area in Karnataka varies from 17.1 thousand Sq. Kms. in case of Bijapur district to 4.1 thousand Sq. Kms. in case of Kodagu (Coorg) district.

5. The estimated population of Karnataka state was 330.16 lakhs (168.90 lakhs Men and 161.26 lakhs Women) in 1977. In 1977 Bangalore District (comprising all the three sub-district) had the highest population (37.92 lakhs) followed by Balgaum (27.31 lakhs) and the lowest was in Kodagn (Coorg) district (4.26 lakhs). The estimated population of Karnataka was 371.36 lakhs (189.23 lakhs Men and 182.13 lakhs Women) for the year 1982 and among districts it varied widely from 49.48 lakhs in Bangalore (Bangalore North, Bangalore South and Bangalore Rural) followed by Balgaum (29.80 lakhs) and to as low as 4.62 lakhs in case of Kodagn (Coorg) district.

6. The overall density of population per sq. Km. was 172 in 1977 which is estimated to have increased to 194 in 1982. The density of population per Sq.Km. also varies widely among the districts viz. from the highest of 618 in Bangalore (Bangalore North, Bangalore South and Bangalore Rural to only 104 in case of North Kannada. The area, total population and density of populations for different districts for the year 1976-77 and 1981-82 are given in Appendix No.2. Table No. 1 gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and density of population in 1982:

7. The total population of the state as well as population of different districts in different age-groups for the year 1977 and 1982 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of the Registrar General of India. District wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 are based on the following formula:-

We assume that:

$$\frac{P_{6-11}}{P} = \frac{P_i^{6-11}}{P_i} = K$$

$$P_i^{6-11} = KP_i$$

where K is estimated from the equation  $K = \frac{P_{6-11}}{P}$

$P_{6-11}$  = Denotes 6-11 age-group population of the State

P = total population of the State

$P_i^{6-11}$  = 6-11 age-group population in the ith district

$P_i$  = total population of the ith district

8. To get the sex-wise break-up of total population in the various age-groups of the district, first of all the Girl's population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in above formula total population is replaced by the Girls' population. The Boys population is obtained simply by subtraction of girls population from total population.

9. Similar formulas are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-group 11-14 and 14-17 years.

10. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 49.17 lakhs in 1982 (24.74 lakhs Boys and 24.43 lakhs girls) which constituted 13.2% of the total population.
11. The population in the age-group 11-14 years in 1982 was 26.95 lakhs (13.70 lakhs Boys and 13.25 lakhs Girls) which constituted 7.3% of the total population.
12. Similarly the estimated population in the age-group 14-17 years was 24.43 lakhs (12.53 lakhs boys and 11.90 lakhs girls). This formed 6.6% of the total population.
13. Thus, out of the total population of 371.36 lakhs of the State, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 100.55 lakhs (50.98 lakhs Boys and 49.57 Girls). The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 27.07% of the total population. This percentage for Boys and Girls was 26.9% and 27.1% respectively. The district-wise details may be seen in Appendix No.3.

### III. Literacy

14. According to the 1981 Census, the literacy rate, that is, the members of literates per hundred of the population in the State was 38.5. The literacy rates for Males and Females separately were 48.8 and 27.7 respectively indicating a wide gap between the two sexes. Number of literates per hundred in case of Scheduled Caste Community is 20.6 and in case of Scheduled Tribe Community is 20.1. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.6.

### IV. GENERAL VIEW

#### (a) INSTITUTIONS

15. The total number of educational institutions of school level in Karnataka was 44,124 in 1976-77 which increased to 49,578 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 12.36% during the period of 5 years. Tumkur district had the largest share of institutions (7.1%) and Kodagu the smallest share 1.2% in 1981-82. The district-wise position of number of educational institutions is given in Appendix No.1.

#### (b) ENROLMENT

16. The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions in the State increased from 47.03 lakhs in 1976-77 to 64.99 lakhs in 1981-82. The increase in enrolment is observed in all the districts except minor decrease in case of Kodagu district. The enrolment increased with an average annual increase rate of 7.6%. Belgaum had the highest share of enrolment i.e. 10.9% whereas Kodagu had the lowest share of 1.2% during 1981-82.

17. The percentage of girls enrolment to Total Enrolment was 40.8% in 1976-77 which slightly declined to 40.6% in 1981-82 of 21 districts. Percentage of girls enrolment declined in 7 districts. Sex-wise breakup of enrolment figures for different districts is given in Appendix 4.

(c) TEACHER

18. Total number of teachers in school education in the State increased from 133150 in 1976-77 to 163429 including those of pre-degree colleges in 1981-82. The increase has been observed in all the districts. District-wise position is given in Appendix 4. In 1981-82 of the total of 154156, 47,296 or 31% were to female teachers in all kinds of schools. Among total 138089, trained teachers were 41815 or 30.2% were women teachers. It has been seen that among all teachers in schools of all types 89.6% are trained. Among Male teachers 90.1% are trained and among female teachers 88.4% are trained. Among districts percentage of trained female teachers varies from 50.3% in North Kannada to 98.1% in Dakshina Kannada. District-wise details are given in Appendix No.5.

(d) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND TRIBES

Extent of coverage is defined as:

$$I = \frac{\text{Percentage of enrolment of SC/ST to total enrolment}}{\text{Percentage of population of SC/ST to total population}} \times 100$$

19. Of the total enrolment in school education 825200 belonged to scheduled caste communities which comes out to 12.7% (13.3% for boys and 12.0% for girls). Among the districts the percentage of Scheduled Castes varied from 24.2% in Kolar to 4.4% in Dakshina Kannada. Percentage of S.C. population to total population is 15.1% in 1981-82 for the state as a whole. The extent of coverage, of Scheduled Castes in school education comes to 84.1% at state level. Extent of coverage among the districts varies from 123.2% in Mysore to 59.4% in Gulbarga. District-wise details are given in Appendix No.7.

20. Enrolment percentage of scheduled tribe communities in school education is 2.7% (2.9% for boys and 2.4% for girls) in 1981-82. The percentage was the highest in Kodagu (5.7%) and the lowest in Hassan (2.0%). Percentage population of S.T. to the total population is 4.9% for the state as a whole. Extent of coverage for this community works out to 55.1% at state level. The extent of coverage varies from 250.0% in Hassan to the lowest in Chitradurga (15.5%). District-wise details are given in Appendix No.8.

V. P.R.E-PRIMARY EDUCATION:

21. The number of Pre-Primary schools in Karnataka increased from 1913 in 1976-77 to 3830 in 1981-82 showing an annual increase rate of 20.04 percent. The increase in Pre-Primary Schools was observed in all the districts except in case of Shimoga. Number of teachers also increased accordingly from 2756 in 1976-77 to 4936 in 1981-82.

22. Enrolment in Pre-Primary Schools which was 1,18,564 in 1976-77 increased to 2,33,420 in 1981-82. Enrolment in Pre-Primary and Nursery classes was 1,18,921 (64,241 Boys and 54,680 Girls) in 1976-77 and it increased to 2,33,420 (1,27,520 Boys and 1,05,900 Girls) in 1981-82, showing an increase rate of 19.25 percent per annum. In 1976-77 there were 23,900 students (12,718 Boys and 11,182 Girls) belonging to scheduled castes and 1183 students (641 Boys and 542 Girls) belonging to scheduled tribes who were studying in these classes. In 1981-82 there were 41,845 students (23125 Boys and 18720 Girls) belonging to scheduled castes and 7074 students (3975 Boys and 3099 Girls) belonging to scheduled tribes studying in Pre-Primary classes. District-wise details are given in Appendix No.9.

23. In 1981-82 of the total 22537 pre-primary schools in the state only 532 were in rural areas having an Enrolment of 32885 (19760 boys and 13123 girls). Among the districts highest number of pre-primary schools were in rural areas of Mysore (48) followed by North Kannada (47). District-wise details of pre-primary schools and their enrolment is given in Appendix No.10.

VI. PRIMARY EDUCATION:

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

24. The total number of Primary Schools in Karnataka increased from 21,977 in 1976-77 to 22,439 in 1981-82 showing an increase of only 2.10% over the period of 5 years. The highest percentage of schools (8.79%) was in Kolar district while the lowest in Kodagu being only 0.82 in 1981-82.

25. On an average, in 1976-77 a Primary School in the State was serving an area of 8.7 Sq.Kms. In five years the position improved marginally and a Primary School was available for 8.5 Sq.Kms. in 1981-82. In 1981-82 the average area served by a Primary School was minimum in case of Bangalore North, South and Rural (3.5 Sq. Kms.) but the most backward position was in case of Kodagu where for 22.3 Sq. Kms. only a primary school was available.

26. The population served by a Primary School in the State was 1,502 in 1976-77 but the position slightly deteriorated in 1981-82 as on an average a school was available for the population of 1655 persons. Among the districts the population served by a Primary School varied from 893 in Hassan district to 4734 in Dakshina Kannada in 1981. The district-wise details may be seen in the Appendix No.11.

27. The total number of teachers in Primary Schools in Karnataka was 32667 in 1976-77 and it was 34153 in 1981-82. The highest percentage of Teachers in 1981-82 was in Bangalore Rural district (9.75%) and lowest (0.67%) in Kodagu district. In 1981-82 in all primary schools of the State 89.2% are trained. At the same time 86.5% female teachers are trained whereas trained men teachers are 90%. The district-wise details may be seen in Statement No.13.

(b) ENROLMENT

28. The total Enrolment in Primary Schools in Karnataka during 1976-77 was 14.51 lakhs which it increased to 15.34 lakhs in 1981-82. In classes I-V the Enrolment increased from 38.72 lakhs (22.18 lakhs Boys and 16.54 lakhs Girls) in 1976-77 to 44.01 lakhs (24.39 lakhs Boys and 19.62 lakhs Girls) in 1981-82, showing an average annual increase rate of 2.73% per annum. The Enrolment Growth Rates in these classes separately for Boys and Girls were 1.99% and 3.72% respectively.

29. The percentage of Enrolment in Classes I-V to the corresponding population in the age-group 6-11 (also called Enrolment Ratio) gives index of the facilities created at the Primary stage of Education. In Karnataka the percentage increased from 87.2 in 1976-77 to 89.5 in 1981-82. Among the various districts taking Boys and Girls together, the Enrolment Ratio in 1981-82 was the highest in Bangalore North and Bangalore South (115.2%) and the lowest in Raichur (61.9).

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

In 1981-82 5.73 lakhs students belonged to S.C. & 1.09 lakhs students belonged to S.T. in these classes.

30. Of the total enrolment of 38.72 lakhs in classes I-V in 1976-77, 4.41 lakhs students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 0.38 lakhs belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 11.36% and 0.98% respectively of the total Enrolment in these classes. Thus the percentage of Enrolment of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes students to total Enrolment work out to 13.0% and 2.5% respectively. Hence the co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in these classes work out to 86.09 and 51.02 respectively. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.14 and 15.

The co-efficient of equality or extent of coverage is defined as:-

(d) EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS:

31. Of the total number of Primary Schools in the State, 19559 or 87% were located in rural areas only. It is also interesting to note that all the primary schools located in rural areas are having pucca building. Further of the total enrolment (15,34,300) in primary schools 11,53,804 belonged to that of rural areas. District-wise details of primary schools, enrolment and primary stage enrolment are given in Appendix No.16.

32. The total number of habitations in rural areas of the state was 4 Among these 27040 had primary schools in them. Also in whole state 40904 had primary schools in them and around upto the distance of 2 Kms. District-wise details are given in Appendix No.1

VII. MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

33. The total number of Middle Schools in the State increased from 11,497 in 1976-77 to 12,797 in 1981-82, showing an increase of 11.3% during the period of five years. In 1981-82 the highest percentage of Middle Schools was observed in Dakshina Kannada (9.49%) and the lowest in Kodagu (1.54%).

34. On an average in 1976-77, a Middle School served an area of 16.7 Sq.Kms. In 1981-82 the position improved marginally and a Middle school was available within an area of 15.0 Sq. Kms. In 1981-82 the area served by a Middle school was less than the State average in as many as 8 districts. The area served by a Middle school was minimum in Bangalore District (Bangalore North, South and Rural) (6.6 Sq. Kms.) and maximum in Gulbarga district (44.9 Sq. Kms.)

35. The population served by a Middle School in 1976-77 in Karnataka was 2872 but position deteriorated marginally in 1981-82 as for a population of 2902, a school was available. Among the districts, the population served by a Middle School in 1981-82 varied from 1766 in North Kannada to 4861 in Gulbarga district. The details are given in Appendix No.18. The number of Teachers in Middle Schools increased from 69971 in 1976-77 to 83,543 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 19.39% during the period of five years. Among districts the maximum number of teachers was in Dakshina Kannada (8,216) and the minimum number was in Kodagu (1,483). Among teachers employed in Middle schools of the state 91.2% are trained.

Among the districts percentage of women trained teachers varies from 9% in Dakshina Kannada to 78.0% in Gulbarga. In 9 of the 21 districts the percentage of trained teachers is above the state average. The district-wise details may be seen in Appendix No.18.

(b) ENROLMENT:

36. The total enrolment in Middle Schools was 30.16 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 3639 lakhs in 1981-82 showing an average annual growth rate of 20.65%. The Enrolment at the Middle stage i.e. in classes VI-VIII increased from 8,85,484 (5,69,211 Boys and 3,16,273 Girls) in 1976-77 to 10,78,211 (7,19,309 Boys and 3,58,902 Girls) in 1981-82. This shows an average growth rate of 4.35% per annum during the period under consideration. The average annual growth rates of Enrolment separately for Boys and Girls in these classes were 5.27% and 2.69% respectively.

37. The percentage of Enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age-group 11-14 i.e. Enrolment Ratio gives an index of facilities available at the Middle stage of Education. In Karnataka this percentage was 35.6% in 1976-77 which increased to 40.0% in 1981-82. In case of Boys and Girls separately this percentage increased from 45.5% to 52.5% and 25.5% to 27.1% respectively. In 1981-82 taking Boys and Girls together 9 districts had Enrolment Ratio higher than the State average. The Enrolment Ratio was the highest in Bangalore North and South for Boys, Girls and Total (83.4%, 66.1% and 75.3%), whereas it was found to be 21.3 (32.8 for boys and 9.7 girls) the lowest in Raichur. The details may be seen in Appendix No.19.

(c) MIDDLE EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

38. Among all the middle schools 9916 <sup>or</sup> 77.5% were located in rural areas only during 1981-82. Among the districts the largest number (988) are in rural areas of Belgaum. At the same time enrolment in Middle Schools of rural areas was 23,09,587 (12,96,613 boys and 10,12,976 girls). Enrolment of these schools formed 63.5% of total enrolment in all middle schools of the state. District-wise position is given in Appendix No.23.

(d) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

39. Of the total Enrolment of 8,85,484 in classes VI-VIII, 69,089 and 7,348 students belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes forming 7.80% and 0.83% respectively in 1976-77. In 1981-82 out of 10,78,211 Enrolment in classes VI-VIII, 1,18,368 and 22,340 students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes respectively. The co-efficient of equality thus in the case of scheduled castes is 72.84% and for scheduled tribes comes out to 12.85%. The district-wise details may be seen in Appendix No.21 and 22.

VIII. HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION:

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS:

40. Karnataka State had 2090 High/Higher Secondary Schools in 1976-77 and this number increased to 2791 by 1981-82 showing an increase of 33.54% during the period of 5 years. The largest share of High/Higher Secondary Schools was in Dharwar district (8.67%) and lowest share was that in Kodagu district (2.04%).

41. On an average, there was a High/Higher Secondary School for 918 Sq. Kms. in 1976-77 and this position improved by 1981-82 and a High/Hr. Secondary School was available at every 68.7 Sq. Kms at the State level. In 1981-82 there was a High/Hr. Secondary school in Bangalore (North, South & Rural) district at every 21.0 Sq. Kms. whereas in Raichur only one High/Hr. Secondary school was available for 175.1 Sq. Kms.

42. On an average, at the State level, there was a High/Hr. Secondary School per 15797 persons in 1976-77 but position improved during the period under review in 1981-82 a High/Hr. Secondary school was available for 13306 persons. Among the districts the average population covered by a High/Hr. Secondary School varied from 8104 to 22298 in Kodagu and Raichur districts respectively.

43. The total number of teachers in High/Hr. Secondary schools in 1976-77 was 20932 which increased to 31,520 (24770 Men and 6750 Women)  $\angle$  in 1981-82. Among districts the highest number of teachers was in Belgaum (2533) and the lowest number was in Bidar (813). In 1981-82 of all the 31520 teachers, 88.1% are trained. At the same time 87.9% are trained among male teachers and 88.6% among female teachers.  $\angle$  Female trained teachers was the highest in Dakshina Kannada (96.1%) and the lowest in Bidar (58.8%). In 8 of the 21 districts percentage of female trained teachers was above the state average percentage. The district-wise details may be seen in Appendix No. 24 and 26.

(b) ENROLMENT

44. The total Enrolment in High/Higher Secondary Schools of the State in 1976-77 was 5,13,124 which increased to 8,19,979 in 1981-82. In 1976-77 the Enrolment in classes IX-XII was 3,43,277 (2,31,280 Boys and 1,11,997 Girls) and  $\angle$  increased to 4,29,635  $\angle$  the (3,10,100 Boys and 1,13,235 Girls) by 1981-82. This shows an average annual growth rate of 7.36% (10.22% and 5.03% for Boys, Girls respectively).



45. The Enrolment Ratio in classes IX to XII in Karnataka State was 15.1% in 1976-77 which marginally increased to 17.6% by 1981-82. In the case of Girls this percentage decreased from 9.9% to 9.5% whereas it increased for Boys from 20.2% to 25.2%. Among the districts the Enrolment Ratio was found to be maximum for Boys, Girls and Total in Bangalore North and South districts 42.1, 29.1 and 36.0 respectively and lowest in Raichur (13.5, 2.9 and 8.3 %). The district-wise details may be seen in Appendix No.25, in 1981-82.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

∠ during 1981-82

46. Of the Total Enrolment of 3,43,277 in classes IX/XI-XII/23,940 students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 3930 students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 7.0% and 1.1% respectively of the total Enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82 out of 429635 students in these classes, there were 48012 students belonging to scheduled castes and 11572 students belonging to scheduled tribes forming 11.2% and 2.7% respectively of the total Enrolment. Thus the co-efficient of equality for scheduled castes and scheduled tribes worked out to be 74.17% and 55.10% respectively. Details may be seen in Appendix No.27 & 28.

(d) HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS:

47. Out of 2791 High/Higher Secondary Schools in the State 1310 were located in rural areas. Among the rural areas of different districts maximum number viz. 151 existed in rural areas of Dakshina Kannada. At the same time, of the total enrolment in High/Higher Secondary schools in the state 3,40,086 or 41.47% belonged to that of Rural Areas. Enrolment of classes IX-XI/XII in Rural Areas also worked out to 340086 (250494 Boys and 89592 Girls). This enrolment forms 79.15% of the total enrolment in the state. District-wise position is given in Appendix No.29.

48. Appendix No.30 gives district-wise enrolment of classes I to VIII in year 1981-82. Figures in parenthesis give percentages of all classes separately to those of enrolment in class of respective districts. It has been observed that retention rate of enrolment in class V was 38.2% in 1981-82 at state level. Among the districts this retention rate varies from 65.6% in Dakshina Kannada followed by 65.1% in Bangalore North to 21.9% in Bidar. However retention rate in class VIII was observed 22.4% for the state as a whole. Among the districts retention rate was the highest in Dakshina Kannada 53.6% followed by Kodagu(52.9%) and the lowest in Tumkur (6.5%).

Higher Secondary Schools of,

INTERMEDIATE/PRE-DEGREE JUNIOR COLLEGES EDUCATION:

49. The total number of Intermediate/Pre-Degree/Junior Colleges in the State had decreased from 316 in 1976-77 to 70 in 1981-82 which may be due to the introduction of 10+2 Pattern in the State. Their enrolment figure also decreased considerably i.e. from 1,85,041 in 1976-77 to 23,554 in 1981-82. Among the districts the highest enrolment is reported by Bangalore South 3,708 (1863 Boys and 1845 Girls) in 1981-82 and the lowest by Chikmagalur 196 (175 Boys and 21 Girls) in 1981-82.

50. The number of teachers working in these institutions were 6951 in 1976-77 which also decreased to 1,062 (773 Men and 289 Girls) teachers by 1981-82.

51. Out of the 70 intermediate/Pre-Degree/Junior colleges in 1981-82, only 19 have been reported to be in Rural Areas of the state. Enrolment in these institutions is reported to be 3473. The highest enrolment is reported in Rural Areas of Bangalore (Rural) 693 students and the lowest in Bidar (35).

PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER(SCHOOL) EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

52. The number of Schools for Professional, Vocational, Special and Other(School) Education in the State increased from 5744 in 1976-77 to 7653 in 1981-82 showing an annual increase of 6.64% during the period under review. The highest percentage share of schools of these type of institutions in 1981-82 was in Dharwar(10.16%) and the lowest in Bidar(0.02%). The number of teachers in these Schools increased from 6814 in 1976-77 to 9277 in 1981-82.

(b) ENROLMENT

53. Total Enrolment in Professional, Vocational, Special and Other Education Schools also increased from 1,57,773 in 1976-77 to 2,48,349 (1,81,420 Boys and 66,929 Girls) in 1981-82 showing an average annual growth rate of 11.48%. In 1976-77 out of the total Enrolment 358,411 (281,07 Boys and 77,34 Girls) students belonged to scheduled castes and 62,54 (5,500 Boys and 754 Girls) students belonged to scheduled tribes forming 22.71% and 3.96% respectively of the total enrolment. In 1981-82 out of the total enrolment of 2,48,349 students in these schools 437,217 (36,879 Boys and 68,48 Girls) students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 23,951 (19,576 Boys and 4,375 Girls) students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 17.6% and 9.64% respectively. District-wise details are given in Appendix No.32.
