

PREFACE

This volume on District Educational Statistics for the State of Karnataka is 17th in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the States and Union Territories. The main aim is to highlight the inter-district variations in a State by giving educational data at district levels with the help of some important indices such as Enrolment Ratio, Percentage of Trained Teachers, Per Capita Expenditure, Teacher Pupil Ratio etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have widened or narrowed down with time, the data for the year 1976-77 has been analysed in comparison with that for the year 1970-71. Wherever clear data was not available district-wise estimated data has been used.

I take this opportunity to express my appreciation of the co-operation received from the Directorate of Education, Karnataka and the project staff of the Planning, Monitoring & Statistics Division of the Ministry who have prepared this report,

INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of educational development just as in urbanisation, industrialisation, distribution of Income and Wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector, the Ministry of Education & Culture brings out the publication 'Educational Statistics - District-wise' quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research & Training in 1960-61. Thereafter, it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each State, every five years, by the Ministry of Education & Culture. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry.

3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as Enrolment Ratios, Percentage of Trained Teachers in Schools and Per Capita Expenditure on Education have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and hence the need for formulating educational plan at the district level.

II - AREA AND POPULATION

4. The area of Karnataka State (1,91,773 Sq. Kms.) remained unchanged from 1971 to 1977. This State was known as Mysore State in 1971 and its name was changed to Karnataka in November, 1973. Administratively there were 19 districts in Karnataka. However, in 1970-71 the Directorate of Education bifurcated Bangalore district in 2 units i.e. Bangalore city and Bangalore rural for collection of educational data and in 1976-77 it was further bifurcated into 3 units viz. Bangalore South, Bangalore North and Bangalore Rural. The area of these bifurcated units of Bangalore district is not available separately for each sub-district. The district-wise area in Karnataka varies from 17.1 Thousand Sq. Kms. in case of Bijapur district to 4.1 Thousand Sq. Kms. in case of Kodagu (Coorg) district.

5. The population of Mysore State was 292.45 Lakhs in 1971. In 1971 Bangalore city and Bangalore Rural had the highest population (33.59 Lakhs) followed by Belgaum district (24.19 Lakhs) and the lowest was in Kodagu (Coorg) district (3.78 Lakhs). The estimated population of Karnataka was 330.16 Lakhs (168.90 Lakhs Men and 161.26 Lakhs Women) for the year 1977 and among districts it varied widely from 37.92 Lakhs in Bangalore (Bangalore South, Bangalore North and Bangalore Rulral) followed by Belgaum (27.31 Lakhs) and to as low as 4.26 Lakhs in case of Kodagu (Coorg) district.

6. The overall density of population per Sq. Km. was 153 in 1971 which is estimated to have increased to 172 in 1977. The density of population per Sq. Km. also varies widely among the districts viz. from the highest of 478 in Bangalore district (Bangalore North, South and Bangalore Rural) to only 93 in case of North Kannada (Kanara). The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the year 1970-71 and 1976-77 are given in Statement No.(2). Table No.(1) below gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and the density of population in 1977.

7. The total population of the State as well as population of different districts in different age-groups for the year 1971 and 1977 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of the Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 are based on the following formulae:-

We assume that:

P_{6-11} = Denotes 6-11 age-group population of the State

P = total population of the State

P_{6-11}^i = 6-11 age-group population of the i th district

P^i = total population of the i th district

To get the sex-wise break up of total population in the various age-groups of the district first of all the Girls' population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in above formula total population is replaced by the Girls' population. The Boys population is obtained by the residual method i.e.

Boys population in the age-group 6-11 = Total population in the age-group 6-11 - Girls population in the age-group 6-11

Similar formulae are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-groups 11-14 and 14-17 years.

8. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 44.39 Lakhs in 1977 (22.76 Lakhs Boys and 21.63 Lakhs Girls) which constituted 13.44% of the total population.

9. The population in the age-group 11-14 years in 1977 was 24.89 Lakhs (12.50 Lakhs Boys and 12.39 Lakhs Girls) which constituted 7.54% of the total population.

10. Similarly the estimated population in the age-group 14-17 years was 22.80 Lakhs (11.45 Lakhs Boys and 11.35 Lakhs Girls). This formed 6.9% of total population.

11. Thus, out of the total population of 330.16 Lakhs of the State, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 92.08 Lakhs (46.71 Lakhs Boys and 45.37 Lakhs Girls). The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 27.68% of the total population. This percentage for Boys and Girls was 14.14 and 13.74 respectively. The district-wise details may be seen in Statement No.(3).

III - LITERACY

12. According to the 1971 Census, the effective literacy rate, that is, the numbers of literates per hundred of the population (excluding age-group 0-4 years) in the State was 36.83. The literacy rates for Males and Females separately were 48.51 and 24.55 respectively, indicating a wide gap between the two sexes. The district-wise details are given in Statement No.(7).

IV - GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS

13. The total number of educational institutions in Karnataka was 37,966 in 1970-71 which increased to 44,124 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 16.22% during the period of 6 years. Tumkur district had the largest share of institutions (8.12%) and Kodagu (Coorg) the smallest share (1.08%) in 1976-77. The district-wise position of number of educational institutions is given in Statement No.(1).

(b) ENROLMENT

14. The total Enrolment in all recognised educational institutions in the State increased from 47.03 Lakhs in 1970-71 to 56.80 Lakhs in 1976-77. The increase in enrolment is observed in all the districts. The enrolment increased with an average annual increase rate of 3.5%. South Kannada (Kanara) had the highest enrolment i.e. 8.03% whereas Kodagu (Coorg) had the lowest enrolment 1.43% in 1976-77.

15. The percentage of Girls Enrolment to Total Enrolment was 38.78 in 1970-71 which increased to 39.60 in 1976-77. Bangalore South had the highest percentage of Girls to Total Enrolment (45.16) and Bidar had the lowest percentage i.e. 33.8%.

16. The Total Enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions as a percentage of total population increased from 16.08 in 1970-71 to 17.20 in 1976-77 at the State level. The percentage Enrolment to Total population increased in most of the districts barring a few where this percentage decreased marginally. The percentage Enrolment to Total Population in 1976-77 was highest in Bangalore district (Bangalore South and Bangalore North) 27.77 and was lowest in Raichur district i.e. 10.95. The details may be seen in Statement No.(1).

(c) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

17. The Percentage of Enrolment of Scheduled Castes Enrolment to Total Enrolment in all Institutions in the State for the year 1976-77 was 10.8% and the Percentage of Scheduled Caste Population to Total Population was 13.14%. Hence the extent of coverage i.e. the co-efficient of equality for Scheduled Castes was in Gulbarga (94.95%) district and lowest in Dharwar district (54.07). The Percentage of Scheduled Tribe Enrolment to Total Enrolment in the year 1976-77 was 1.0 whereas the Percentage of Scheduled Tribe Population to Total Population was 0.79. Therefore, the extent of coverage (co-efficient of equality) for Scheduled Tribes works out to 126.6%. District-wise details on Population and co-efficient of equality were not available.

(d) TEACHERS /works out to 82.19%. Among the Districts the highest Co-efficient of equality for Scheduled Castes

18. The Total number of Teachers in the State in all educational Institutions increased from 1,36,008 in 1970-71 to 1,54,754 in 1976-77 showing an annual rate of increase of 2.3%. The maximum number of Teachers in 1976-77 was in Dharwar district (11,998) and the minimum number of Teachers was in Kodagu (Coorg) district (2,251). The details may be seen in Statement No.(4). There were 1,26,336 Teachers (92,672 Males and 33,664 Females) imparting School Education in the State. Out of these 1,09,910 Teachers (81,383 Males and 28,527 Females) were trained Teachers. The Percentage of trained Teachers in Schools to Total number of School Teachers works out to 87.8%, 84.70% in respect of Male, Female and total number respectively. Among districts the Percentage of trained Teachers in Schools in 1976-77 varied from South Kannada (93.5%) to 71.5% in case of Gulbarga district. This percentage for Woman Teachers was maximum (93.3) in the case of South Kannada and minimum (67.4) in Raichur district. The details may be seen in Statement No.(6). /and 81.0%

(e) EXPENDITURE

19. The Total Expenditure (excluding Expenditure on Directorate & Inspectorate) of all recognised educational Institutions in the State, was 48.74 Crores in 1970-71 and it increased to 116.16 Crores in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an average annual increase rate of 23.05%. This increase in expenditure was observed in all the districts. The percentage share of expenditure in 1976-77 was highest in Dharwar (10.66) and lowest in Kodagu (Coorg) (1.50).

20. The expenditure per head of population in the State increased from Rs.15.67 in 1970-71 to Rs.35.16 in 1976-77. In six districts the per capita expenditure was more than the State per capita expenditure. The lowest cost per head of population was observed in Raichur district i.e. Rs.17.83 only. The expenditure per Institution also increased from Rs.12,326 in 1970-71 to Rs.26,326 in 1976-77. Among districts the maximum expenditure per Institution was in Bangalore South (Rs.67,743) and minimum in Tumkur (Rs.14,220). The details may be seen in Statement No.(5).

V - PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

21. The number of Pre-Primary Schools in Karnataka increased from 798 in 1970-71 to 1,913 in 1976-77 showing an annual increase rate of 23.3 per cent. The increase in Pre-Primary School was observed in all the districts. Number of Teachers also increased accordingly from 1,732 in 1970-71 to 2,756 in 1976-77.

22. Enrolment in Pre-Primary Schools which was 54,220 in 1970-71 increased to 1,18,564 in 1976-77. Enrolment in Pre-Primary and Nursery Classes was 54,323 (29,363 Boys and 24,960 Girls) in 1970-71 and it increased to 1,18,921 (64,241 Boys and 54,680 Girls) in 1976-77, showing an increase rate of 19.9 per cent per annum. In 1970-71 there were 5,421 students (2,930 Boys and 2,491 Girls) belonging to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes who were studying in these Classes. In 1976-77 there were 23,900 students (12,713 Boys and 11,182 Girls) belonging to Scheduled Castes and 1,183 students (641 Boys and 542 Girls) belonging to Scheduled Tribes studying in Pre-Primary Classes.

23. The expenditure on Pre-Primary Schools increased from Rs.24.33 Lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.66.86 Lakhs in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of 29.1%. The districtwise details may be seen in Statement No.(10).

VI - PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

24. The total number of Primary Schools in Karnataka increased from 21,717 in 1970-71 to 21,977 in 1976-77 showing an increase of only 1.20% over the period of 6 years. The highest percentage of Schools (9.0) was in Tumkur district while the lowest in Kodagu only (0.8) in 1976-77.

25. On an average, in 1970-71, a Primary School in the State was serving an area of 8.8 Sq. Kms. In six years the position improved marginally and a Primary School was available for 8.7 Sq. Kms. in 1976-77. In 1976-77 the average area served by a Primary School was minimum in the case of Bangalore North, South and Rural (3.3 Sq. Kms.) and maximum in the case of Kodagu (Coorg) (22.4 Sq. Kms.).

26. The population served by a Primary School in the State registered an increase from 1,347 in 1970-71 to 1,502 in 1976-77. Among districts the population served by a Primary School varied from 840 in Hassan district to 3,306 in Bangalore North and South in 1976-77. The districtwise details may be seen in the Statement No.(11).

27. The total number of Teachers in Primary School in Karnataka was 34,660 in 1970-71 and it was 32,667 in 1976-77. The highest percentage of Teachers in 1976-77 was in Mysore district (8.72%) and lowest (0.85%) in Kodagu district. The districtwise details may be seen in Statement No.(11).

(b) ENROLMENT

28. The total Enrolment in Primary Schools in Karnataka during 1970-71 was 14.43 Lakhs and it increased to 14.51 Lakhs in 1976-77. In Classes I-V the Enrolment increased from 33.90 Lakhs (19.55 Lakhs Boys and 14.35 Lakhs Girls) in 1970-71 to 38.72 Lakhs (22.18 Lakhs Boys and 16.54 Lakhs Girls) in 1976-77, showing an average annual increase rate of 2.4% per annum. The Enrolment Growth Rates in these Classes separately for Boys and Girls were 2.3% and 2.5% respectively.

29. The Percentage of Enrolment in Classes I-V to the corresponding population in the age-group 6-11 (also called Enrolment Ratio) gives index of the facilities created at the Primary stage of Education. In Karnataka the percentage increased from 84.7 in 1970-71 to 87.2 in 1976-77. In the case of Boys this percentage decreased marginally from 97.9 to 97.4 and in the case of Girls it increased from 71.6 to 76.5 during the period under review. This shows facilities for Girls Education in Primary Classes improved considerably. Among the various districts, taking Boys and Girls together, the Enrolment Ratio in 1976-77 was the highest in Bangalore North and Bangalore South (105.6%) and lowest in Ruchur (61.2%).

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

30. Of the Total Enrolment of 33.90 Lakhs in Classes I-V in 1970-71, 3.61 Lakhs students belonged to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes forming 10.6% of the Total Enrolment in these Classes. In 1976-77, 4.41 Lakhs students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 0.38 Lakhs students belonged to Scheduled Tribes in these Classes. Thus the Percentage of Enrolment of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes students to Total Enrolment works out to 11.36 and 0.98 respectively. The percentage of population of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes to total population was 10.8 and 0.89 respectively. Hence the co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes in these Classes works out to 105.2 and 110.1 respectively. The district-wise details are given in Statements No.(12) & (13).

*The co-efficient of equality or extent of coverage is defined as

(d) EXPENDITURE

31. The Total Expenditure on Primary Schools in Karnataka increased from Rs. 783.51 Lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs. 1560.24 Lakhs in 1976-77. This gives an average annual growth rate of 16.52% during the period of six years.

32. The per capita expenditure in the State on Primary Schools was Rs. 2.68 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs. 4.73 in 1976-77. The expenditure per head of population was maximum in Hasan district (Rs.8.24) and minimum in South Kannada (Rs.1.69) in 1976-77.

33. The cost per student in Primary Schools increased from Rs.54.31 in 1970-71 to Rs.107.51 in 1976-77 at the State level. Among the district, the cost per student in 1976-77 was maximum (Rs.146.05) in North Kannada district and minimum Rs.97.00 in Kolar district. Expenditure on P. Schools as percentage to total expenditure was 16.1% and 13.4% in 1970-71 and 1976-77 respectively. In 1976-77 this percentage was maximum (28.3%) in Hassan and minimum in South Kannada (3.8%). Teacher-Pupil ratio which was 42 in 1970-71 became 44 in 1976-77. The Pupil-Teacher ratio varied from 32 in North Kannada to 55 in Raichur district in 1976-77. The details can be seen from Statement No.(14) and Table No.(2) given below:-

VII - MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

34. The total number of Middle Schools in the State increased from 10,817 in 1970-71 to 11,497 in 1976-77, showing an increase of 6.29% during the period of six years. In 1976-77 the highest percentage of Middle Schools was observed in South Kannada (10.11%) and lowest in Kodagu (Coorg) (1.60%).

35. On an average in 1970-71, a Middle School served an area of 17.7 Sq. Kms. In 1976-77 the position improved marginally and a Middle School was available within an area of 16.7 Sq. Kms. In 1976-77 the area served by a Middle School was less than the State average in as many as 9 districts. The area served by a Middle School was maximum in South Kannada district (7.3 Sq. Kms.) and minimum in Gulbarga district (44.9 Sq. Kms.).

36. The population served by a Middle School in 1970-71 in Karnataka was 2,704 which increased to 2,872 in 1976-77. Among the districts, the population served by a Middle School in 1976-77 varied from 1,706 in North Kannada to 5,429 in Gulbarga district. The details are given in Statement No. 14. The number of Teachers in 1970-71 in Middle Schools increased from 61,618 in 1970-71 to 69,971 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 13.56% during the period of six years. Among districts the maximum number of Teachers was in South Kannada (7,387) and minimum number was in Kodagu (Coorg) (1136). The district-wise details may be seen in Statement No.(15).

(b) ENROLMENT

37. The Total Enrolment in Middle Schools was 23.95 Lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 30.16 Lakhs in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 4.32%. The Enrolment at the Middle stage i.e. in Classes VI-VII increased from 6,72,694 (4,52,230 Boys and 2,20,464 Girls) in 1970-71 to 8,85,484 (5,69,211 Boys and 3,16,273 Girls) in 1976-77. This shows an average growth rate of 5.27% per annum during the period under consideration. The average annual growth rates of Enrolment separately for Boys and Girls in these Classes were 4.31 and 7.24% respectively.

38. The percentage of Enrolment in Classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age-group 11-14 i.e. Enrolment Ratio gives an index of facilities available at the Middle stage of Education. In Karnataka this percentage was 32.1% in 1970-71 which increased to 35.6% in 1976-77. In case of Boys and Girls separately this percentage increased from 42.8% to 45.5% and 21.2% to 25.5% respectively. In 1976-77 taking Boys and Girls together 9 districts had Enrolment Ratio better than the State. The Enrolment Ratio was highest in Bangalore North and South for Boys Girls and Total (67.4, 66.67.0), whereas it was found to be lowest in Raichur (28.9, 9.2 and 19.0). The details may be seen in Statement No.(16).

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

39. Of the Total Enrolment of 6,72,694 in Classes VI-VIII 55,771 student belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes in 1970-71 forming 8.3% of the Total Enrollment in these Classes. In 1976-77 out of 8,85,484 Enrollment in Classes VI-VIII, 69,039 and 7,348 students belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes respectively. The Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes percentages work out to 7.80% and 0.83% respectively. The co-efficient of equality thus in the case of Scheduled Castes is 59.36% and for Scheduled Tribes comes out to 105.06%. The district-wise details may be seen in Statement No.(17).

(d) EXPENDITURE

40. The Total Expenditure on Middle Schools was Rs.1411.55 Lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 3467.32 Lakhs in 1976-77, showing an average annual growth rate of 24.27% during the period under consideration.

41. The per capita expenditure on Middle Schools in the State was Rs.4.83 in 1970-71 and it increased to as high as Rs.10.50 in 1976-77. The increase in per capita expenditure was observed in every district of the State. The range of variation among districts in 1976-77 was as high as 16.98 in South Kannada and as low as Rs.6.76 in Raichur district.

42. The Total Expenditure on Middle Schools in 1970-71 formed 29.0% of the Total Expenditure on Education in the State and it marginally increased to 29.8% by 1976-77. In 1976-77 this percentage was found to be maximum in Belgaum district (42.5%) and minimum (17.8%) in Mysore district.

43. The average cost per student in Middle Schools was Rs.58.94 in 1970-71 and it increased to Rs.114.96 by 1976-77. Among the districts the cost per student ranged from Rs.140.65 to Rs.95.25 in North Kannada and Bellary districts respectively. In 1970-71 the Pupil-Teacher Ratio was 39 which increased to 43 by 1976-77. In 1976-77 Pupil-Teacher Ratio ranged from 37 in North Kannada to 51 in Bellary district. Further details may be seen in Statement No.(18) and Table No.(3) given below:-

VIII - HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION

(e) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

44. Karnataka State had 2,002 High Schools in 1970-71 and this number increased to 2,090 by 1976-77 showing an increase of 4.39% during the period of 6 years. The largest share of High Schools was in Dharwar district (8.8%) and lowest share was that in Kodagu district (1.8%).

45. On an average, there was a High School for every 95.8 Sq. Kms. in 1970-71 and this position improved by 1976-77 and a High School was available at every 91.8 Sq. Kms. at the State level. In 1976-77 there was a High School in Bangalore (North and South) district at every 25.6 Sq. Kms., whereas in Raichur a High School was available for 259.4 Sq. Kms.

46. On an average, at the State level, there was a High School per 14,608 persons in 1970-71 and in 1976-77 a High School was available for 15,797 persons. Among the districts the average population covered by a High School varied from 8,620 to 29,543 in North Kannada and Raichur districts respectively.

47. The total number of Teachers in High Schools in 1970-71 was 23,274 and in 1976-77 it was 20,932 (15,863 Men and 5,069 Women). Among districts the highest number of Teachers was in Belgaum (1,969) and the lowest number was in Kodagu (Coorg) (372.). The district-wise details may be seen in Statement No.19).

(b) ENROLMENT

48. The Total Enrolment in High Schools of the State in 1970-71 was 5,31,823 which became 5,13,124 in 1976-77. In 1970-71 the Enrolment in Classes IX-X was 2,79,691 (1,97,610 Boys and 92,081 Girls) and it increased to 3,43,277 (2,31,280 Boys and 1,11,997 Girls) by 1976-77. This shows an average annual growth rate of 2.8%, 6.1% and 3.6% for Boys, Girls and Total respectively.

49. The Enrolment Ratio in Classes IX and X in Karnataka State was 14.9% in 1970-71 which marginally increased to 15.1% by 1976-77. In the case of Boys this percentage decreased from 21.0 to 20.2 whereas it increased for Girls from 8.8% to 9.9%. Among districts in 1976-77 the Enrolment Ratio was found to be maximum for Boys, Girls and Total in Bangalore North and South districts 31.1, 29.3 and 31.3 respectively and lowest in Raichur (11.1, 3.0 and 7.0). The district-wise details may be seen in Statement No.(20).

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

50. Of the Total Enrolment of 2,79,691 in 1970-71 in Classes IX and X 19,813 students belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes forming 7.1% of the Total Enrolment in these Classes. In 1976-77 out of 3,43,277 students in these Classes there were 23,940 students belonging to Scheduled Castes and 3,930 belonging to Scheduled Tribes forming 6.97% and 1.14% respectively of the Total Enrolment. Thus the co-efficient of equality for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes works out to be 53.04% and 144.30% respectively. Details may be seen in Statement No.(21).

(d) EXPENDITURE

51. The Total Expenditure on High Schools in 1970-71 in the State was 1,030.73 which increased to Rs.1,895.96 Lakhs on High Schools in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an average annual growth rate of 13.99% during this period.

52. The per capita expenditure on High School was Rs.3.52 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.5.74 on High Schools by 1976-77. Among districts the per capita expenditure on High School was highest (Rs.12.76) in Kodagu and lowest (Rs.2.51) in Raichur district in 1976-77.

53. The Total Expenditure on High Schools in 1970-71 formed 21.1% of the Total Expenditure on Education in the State. This percentage for the year 1976-77 was 16.3%. In 1976-77 this percentage was highest in Kolar district (34.0) and lowest in Dharwar (7.3). The cost per student in High Schools was Rs.193.81 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.369.49 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 cost per student was highest in Kolar (Rs.851.63) and lowest (Rs.218.00) in Dharwar. Teacher-Pupil Ratio in High School was 23 in 1976-77 which became 25 by 1976-77. Details may be seen in Statement No.(22) and Table No.(4) given below:-

IX - PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL & OTHERS (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

54. The number of Schools for Professional, Vocational, Special & Other Education Schools in the State increased from 2,200 in 1970-71 to 5,744 in 1976-77 showing an annual increase of 26.8% during the period under review. Data relating to these Schools for 3 districts viz. Bangalore North, Bangalore South and Bangalore Rural for 1976-77 have been given together. The highest percentage share of Schools of these type of Institutions in 1976-77 was in Bangalore (North, South and Rural) (24.23%) and lowest was in Kodagu (0.52%). The number of Teachers in these Schools increased from 3,322 in 1970-71 to 6,814 by 1976-77.

(b) ENROLMENT

55. Total Enrolment in Professional, Vocational, Special & Other Education Schools also increased from 77,319 (65,533 Boys and 11,786 Girls) in 1970-71 to 1,57,773 (1,27,684 Boys and 30,089 Girls) by 1976-77, showing an average annual growth rate of 17.3% (15.8% for Boys and 25.8% for Girls). In 1970-71 out of the Total Enrolment 4,956 (4,498 Boys and 458 Girls) students belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes forming 6.4%. In 1976-77 out of the Total Enrolment of 1,57,773 students in these Schools 35,841 (28,107 Boys and 7,734 Girls) students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 6,254 (5,500 Boys and 754 Girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 22.71% and 3.96% respectively.

(c) EXPENDITURE

56. The Total Expenditure on these Institutions increased from Rs.69.01 Lakhs in 1970-71 to 138.49 Lakhs in 1976-77, showing an increase of 16.75% per annum during this period. Maximum percentage share of expenditure in 1976-77 was observed in Bangalore (North, South and Rural) 24.25% and minimum in Kodagu (0.52%). Districtwise details are given in Statement No.(23).

X - . HIGHER EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

57. Number of Institutions for Higher Education increased from 432 in 1970-71 to 903 in 1976-77, showing an annual increase of 18.20% during the period under review. In 1976-77 there were 7, Universities/Deemed to be Universities/Institutions of National Importance and Research Institutions; 3 in Bangalore district, 2 in Mysore and 1 each in Bangalore North and Dharwar. In 1976-77 there were 362 Institutions for Higher Education, (Degree level and above), out of which 237 Colleges were for Arts, Science & Commerce, 2 for Agriculture & Forestry, 34 for Education, 18 for Engineering, Technology & Architecture and 26 each for Law and Medicine and 19 for other subjects. There were 216 Institutions for imparting Education of below Degree level, 2 Boards of Intermediate/Secondary Education, 316 Pre-Degree/Junior Colleges in the State. District-wise details of these Institutions are given in Statement No.(24).

58. Statement No.(24) also gives Teachers in Higher Education in Karnataka. Total number of Teachers in these Institutions increased from 11,402 in 1970-71 to 21,604 in 1976-77, showing an average annual increase of 14.91% during the period. Among the districts, the highest number of Teachers were in Bangalore South (2,673) and lowest number was in Bidar (301) in 1976-77.

(b) ENROLMENT

59. The Total Enrolment in all Institutions for Higher Education increased from 2,10,864 in 1970-71 to 4,35,036 in 1976-77, showing an average annual growth rate of 17.7%. Of the Total Enrolment in 1976-77, 8,334 students were studying in Universities, Deemed Universities etc.; 1,64,960 in Arts, Science & Commerce Colleges, 2,291 in Agriculture & Forestry; 3,636 in Education; 13,315 in Engineering, Technology & Architecture; 8,265 in Law and 9,814 in Medicine; 4,881 were studying in Institutions of other subjects; 34,499 and 1,85,091 students were studying in Institutions of below Degree Level and Pre-Degree/Junior Colleges respectively. District-wise details are given in Statement No.(25).

60. Statement No.(26) gives the Enrolment in Higher Education by type of Education. The Total Enrolment in Higher Education increased from 2,28,108 (1,79,288 Boys and 48,820 Girls) in 1970-71 to 3,02,468 (2,20,387 Boys and 82,081 Girls) in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 5.9%. Out of the Total Enrolment 70,184 (55,503 Boys and 14,681 Girls) were enrolled for Professional courses and the remaining students i.e. 2,32,284 (1,64,884 Boys and 67,400 Girls) were studying General Education.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

61. In 1970-71 out of 2,28,108 students 10,589 (9,126 Boys and 1,463 Girls) belonged to Schedule Castes & Scheduled Tribes. This formed 4.64% of the Total Enrolment. In 1976-77, out of Total Enrolment of 3,02,468 students of Higher Education, the number of Scheduled Caste was 18,892 (15,641 Boys and 3,251 Girls) and Scheduled Tribes was 3,250 (2,706 Boys and 544 Girls) forming 6.2% and 1.07% respectively. The details may be seen in Statement No.(27).

(d) EXPENDITURE

62. The Total Expenditure on Higher Education in the State increased from Rs.15,54,59,737 in 1970-71 to Rs.44,87,23,154 by 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 31.4% during the period. Details may be seen in Statement No.(28).
