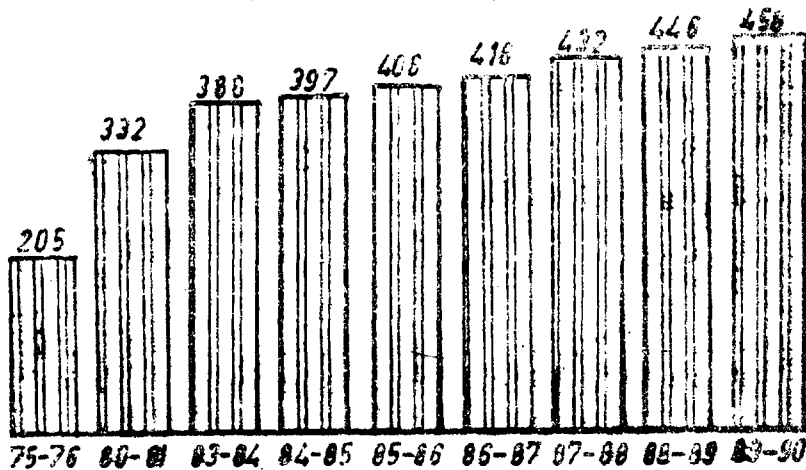

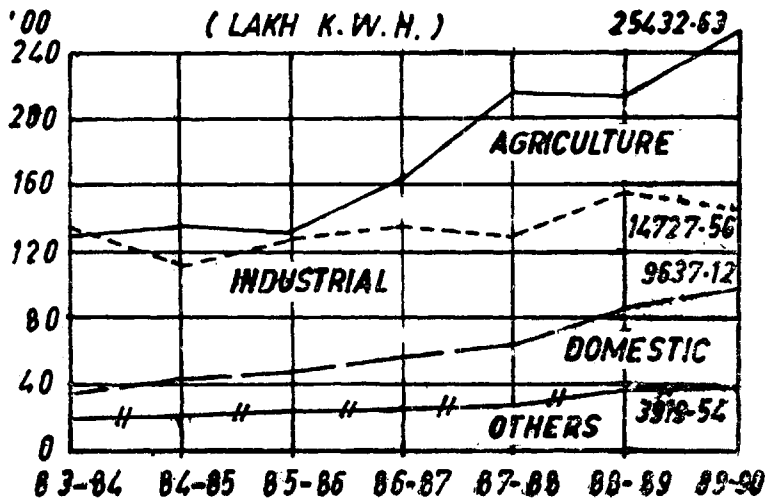

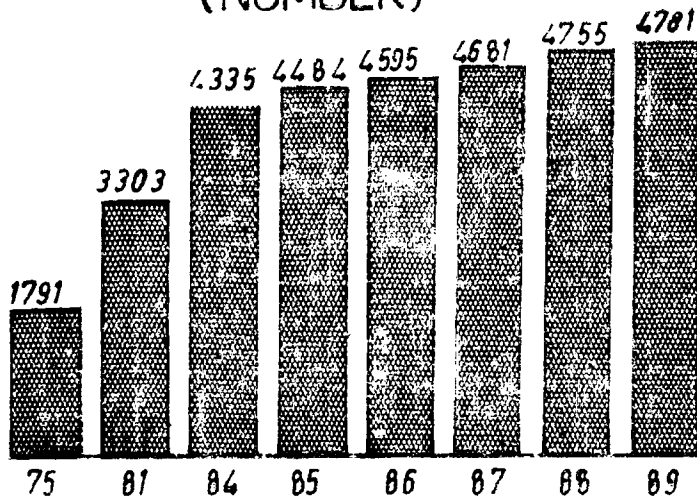

STATE INCOME & PER CAPITA INCOME

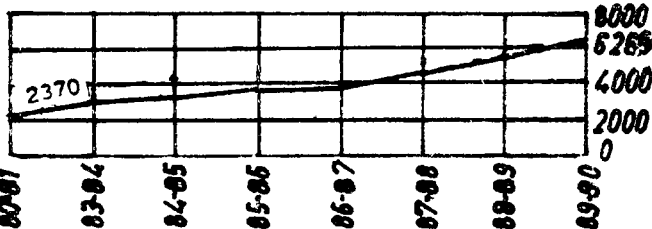
(AT CURRENT PRICES)

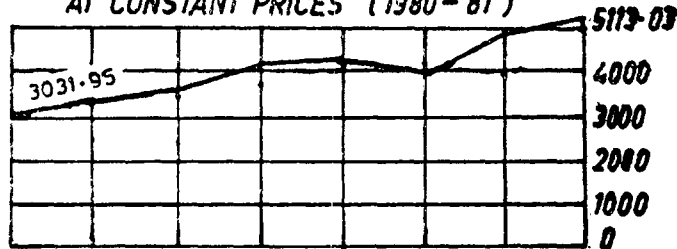

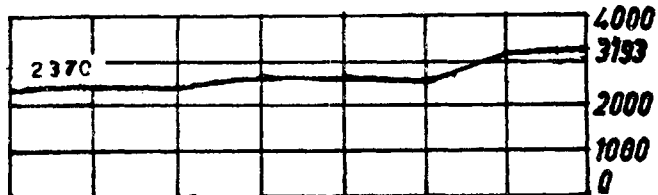
AT CONSTANT PRICES (1980-81)

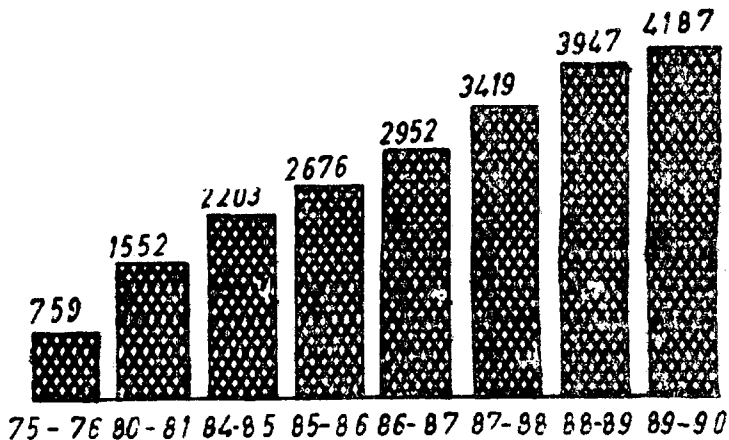

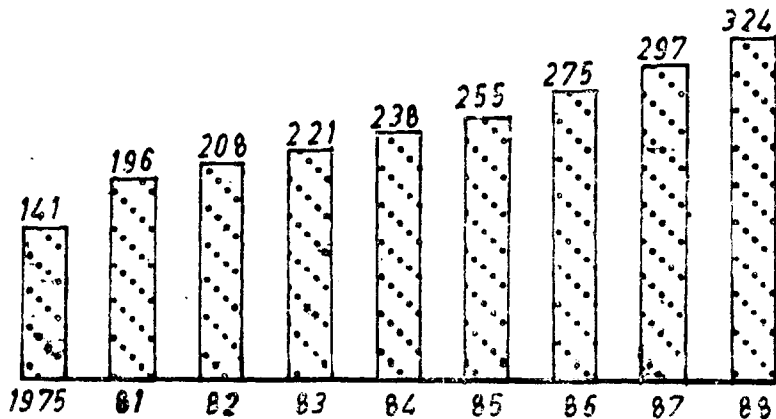
