





This volume on District-wise Educational Statistics for the state of Kerala is the Third in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the states and Union Territories. The main aim is to highlight the inter-district variations in a state by giving educational data at district levels with the help of some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentage of trained teachers, pupil teacher ratio and area served by a school etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have widened or narrowed down with time, the data for the year 1981-82 have been analysed and compared with that of 1976-77.

I would take this opportunity to place on record and appreciation of the cooperation received from the Director Public Instruction, Kerala and the project staff of the Planning, Monitoring and Statistics Division who have prepared this report.

INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances exist in the field of Educational Development too just as in urbanisation, industrialisation, distribution of income and wealth. With a view to high light national variations in the educational sector, the Ministry of Human Resource Development brings out the publication Educational Statistics - District-wise quinquennially.

- A volume of this nature was first published by National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. There after it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state every five years by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry in respect of some states. However for the quiquennial year 1976-77 such reviews were brought out for all the states and union territories with legislature.
- For making inter district comparisions possible, some important indices such as Enrolment Ratio Percentage of trained teachers and teacher pupil ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show vide range of variations between the districts and are of much need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

II. AREA D POPULATION

- The rea of Kerala State is 38,863 Sq.Kms. as per 1981 Census. It had 11 districts in 1976 but in 1981 a new district namely Wynad was formed making 12 districts in the State. The area of this new district is 2,132 Sq. Kas, affecting the area of other districts of the State. The district wise area in Kerala varies from 1.9 thousand Sq. Kms in case of Allappey district to 5.1 thousand Sq. Kms. in case of Idukki district in 1981 The estimated population of Kerala State was 241.86 lakhs (120.80 lakhs males and 121.06 lakhs Idm les) (estimated) in whereas the census population was 254.53 lakhs (125.28 lakhs males and 129.26 lakhs females) in 1981. The population varies among the districts from 28.14 lakhs in Quilon district followed by Communere (28.0 lakhs) to 5.54 lakhs in Wynad district (newly formed district). 6.
- 6. The overall density of population per Sq. km, was 622 in 1977 which increased to 655 in 1981 at state level. The density of population in 1981 varied widely among the districts from 1248 the highest in Allappey district to 192 the lowest in Idukki. The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the years 1977 and 1981 are given in Appendix No. 2. Table No. 1 below gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and the density of population in 1981.

7. The population of the State of different age-groups for the years 1977 and 1982 given in this report are based on the revised population (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of the Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 are based on the following formula:-

8. To get the sex-wise break-up of total population in the various age-groups of the districts, first the population of girls is estimated by using the above formula. The boys population is obtained by subtracting girls population from total estimated population.

- 9. The total population of children in the age-group 6-11 was 30.63 lakhs (15.61 lakhs boys and 15.02 lakhs girls) in 1977 which is estimated to have decreased to 29.95 lakhs (15.06 lakhs Boys and 14.89 lakhs Girls) by 1982. In 1982, 6-11 age-group population formed 11.76% of the total population.
- 10. The total population of children in the age-group 11-14 was 17.08 lakes (8.65 lakes Boys and 8.43 lakes Girls) in 1977 which is estimated to have increased to 17.82 lakes (8.83 lakes Boys and 8.99 lakes Girls) by 1982. The percentage of population in the age-group 11-14 to total population in 1982 was 7.00%.
- 11. Similarly the population in the age-group 14-17 in 1977 was 16.41 lakhs (8:25 lakhs Boys and 8.16 lakhs Girls) which is estimated to have increased to 17.15 lakhs (8.60 lakhs Boys and 8.55 lakhs Girls) by 1982. Population in the age-group 14-17 formed 6.73% of the total population in 1982.
- 12. Out of the total Census population of 254.53 lakhs in 1981 of the State, the school-going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 64.92 lakhs consisting of 32.49 lakhs boys and 32.43 lakhs girls. The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 25.5% of the total population. The percentage for boys was 25.9% while for girls it was 25.08%. The district-wise population of different age-groups is jumn in Appendix No.3.

III. LITERACY

13. According to the 1981 Census the effective literacy Rate i.e. the number of literates per hundred of the population in the Kerala State is 70.4. The literacy rates for males and females is 75.3 and 65.7 per hundred respectively. The highest literacy is in Kuttayam (81.7) and the lowest in Palghat (58.0). The literacy rate of Scheduled Castes is 56.0 and of Scheduled Tribes 31.8 at state level. The details are given in the Appendix No.6.

IV. GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS:

14. The total number of Educational Institutions in Kerala was 11,750 in 1976-77 which increased to 12,098 by 1981-82 showing an increase of 0.7% during the period of 5 years. Cannanore district had the largest share of Institutions (14.3%) whereas. Wynad had the lowest (2.0%) in 1981-82. The district wise position of Institutions is given in Appendix No.1.

(b) MNROLABUT:

15. The total enrolment in all Recognised Educational Institutions in the State increased from 55.09 lakhs in 1976-77 to 57.22 lakhs in 1981-82. The Enrolment,

increased with an average annual growth rate of 0.64%. Cannanore had the largest share in Enrolment i.e. 11.3% whereas Wynad had the lowest share of enrolment i.e. 2.1% in 1981-82. District-wise position of enrolment and percentage share is given in Appendix No.1.

- The percentage of Girls Enrolment to Total Enrolment was 47.6 in 1976-77 which slightly increased to 48.3 by 1981-82. Among the districts Kuttayam had the maximum (50.0) percentage of Girls enrolment to total enrolment whereas Wynad had the minimum (46.1) in 1981-82. Out of 12 districts there four districts in which percentage of girls enrolment was below to that of state percentage. Details are shown in Appendix No.4.
- (c) EXPLIT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES:
- 17. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes or the co-efficient of equality is defined as:-
 - Percentage of Enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total enrolment

 Percentage of population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total population.

In Kerala in 1981-82 the percentage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes 18. students to total number of students was 11.3% (11.2% for boys and 11.4% for girls) and 0.7% (0.8% for boys and 0.7% for girls) respectivelly. The percentage for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes population to total population was estimated to be 10.0% and 1.0% respectively. Therefore the extent of coverage or co-efficient of equality at state level works out to be 113.0% and 70.0% respectively. In case of Scheluled Caste students the highest extent of coverage was in Wynad (168.4%) and the lowest in Palghat (73.9%). There are seven districts which reported extent of coverage less than that at state level. On the other hand extent of coverage varied from 800.0% in Kozhikode to 10.5% in Wynad in case of Scheduled Tribes students. There are four districts which reported extent of coverage below to that at state District-wase position for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes students can be seen from Appendix 7 and 8 respectively.

(d) TEACHERS:

19. The total number of teachers in the State in all educational Institutions increased from 1,76,516 in 1976-77 to 1,82,507 in 1981-82, showing an average Annual rate of increase of 0.67% during this period. Quilon had the largest share of teachers 11.6% whereas Wynad had the smallest i.e. 1.6%. Details may be seen in Appendix No.1.

20. In POR-B2 total number of teachers upto school level was 179950 (82,420 Males and 97,530 Merolus) out of which 1,74,175 (79,381 Males and 94,794 Females) were trained teachers. The percentage of trained teachers to the number of males, females and total number of the chers in school education was 96.3%, 97.2% and 96.8% respectively. The percentage of Trained Teachers to total number of Teachers had minor variation among the districts of the States, viz., 99.2% in Kottayam to 92.7% in Malappuram. Details may be seen in Appendix No.5.

V- PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

21. The . mildr of recognised Pre-Primary Schools in Kerala increased from 167 in 1976-7/ to 200 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 19.76% during the period of 5 years. Alleppey reported the highest number of 36 pre-primary schools and Wynad District had only three Pre-Primary school in 1981-82.

Number of teachers in Pre-Primary schools increased from 235 in 1976-77 to 328 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 39.57%.

22, Enrolment in Pre-Primary schools at also the Enr lment in Pre-Primary and Nursery classes increased from 10,854 (5,357 Boys and 5497 Girls) in 1976-77 to 11,12 (5,563 Boys and 5,599 Girls) by 1981-82. In 1976-77 out of 10,854 only to 158 (4.2%) students (232 Boys and 226 Girls) belonged/scheduled Castes and

143 (1.3%) students (74 Boys and 69 Girls) to Scheduled Tribes, whereas in 1981-82 the enrolment percentage of S.C. and S.T. students was 10.6% and 1.6% respectively. Districtwise position is given in Appendix No.9. It has been observed that of these 200 pre-primary schools the substantial number viz. 158 existed in rural areas. Accordingly the major part of the enrolment viz. 7815 (70.3%) belongs to the .-wise details are given in Appendix.10.

PRIMARY EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

- Total number of Primary Schools in Kerala State decreased from 6978 in 1976-77 to 6307 in 1981-82. This decrease is due to that some primary schools are upgraded and some are merged with middle schools. The highest percentage share of Primary Schools was in Cannanore (15.8%) and the lowest in Wynad (2.0%). Average area served by a Primary School was 5.6 Sq.Kms. Whereas facility of separate primary school slightly declined as for an average area of 5.7 Sq.Kms a primary school was available in 1981-82. The Averaged Area served by a Primary school was minimum in Allappey (3.0 Sq. Kms.) and maximum in Idukki district (24.9 Sq.Kms.).
- 24. The average population served by a Primary school in the State was 3466 in 1976-77.

 but facilities slightly declined as on an average a primary school was available for

 3739 in 1981-82. Smong the districts the facilities of primary schools was maximum in Cannanore as on average a primary school served 2730 persons whereas it was minimum in case of Ernakulum

as for 5164 persons only a primary school was available. Details are given in AppendixXII.

25. The total number of teachers in Primary Schools in Kerala decreased from 53,752 in

1976-77 to 51,521 in 1981-82. In 1981-82 the highest percentage share of teachers was in

Cannanore district i.e. 12.16% and the lowest in Wynad district i.e. 1.40%. Women Teachers

formed 54.84% of the total teachers in Primary Schools in 1981-82.

Enrolment

- 26. In 1981-82 the Lotal enrolment in Primary schools in Kerala decreased from 18,43,472 to 17,25,765 in 1981-82 may be due to decrease in primary schools. In Classes I-V, the enrolment increased from 31,92,415 (16,61,227 Boys and 15,31,188 Girls) to 32,21,986 (16,58,763 Boys and 15,63,223 Girls) during this period, with an average Annual increase of 0.18%. Education has been progressing at Primary school level in the State.
- 27. The Percentage of enrolment in Classes I-V to the corresponding population in the Age-Group 6-11 (also called the Enrolment Ratio) gives an index of the facilities created at Primary stage of education. In Acrala, this percentage increased from 104.2% to 107.6% during the period under review. In case of boys, the enrolment ratio increased from 106.4% to 110.1% and for girls the increase was from 101.9% to 105.0%. In 1981-82, the enrolment Ratio was m ximum (139.2%) in Malappuram and minimum in Kuttayam (69.0%). In 6 districts the enrolment ratio works out below to that of state figure. In case of girls the enrolment varied from 114.0% in Cannanore to 69.3% in Kuttayam. In seven districts the

nrolment ratio works out below to the State level percentage. In 1981-82 the number of teachers in primary schools was 51,221 (23,264 men and 28,257)women). The pupil teacher ratio was 34. It is also interesting to note that 96.8% teachers were trained in the primary schools teaching staff forming 95.5% men and 97.9% women trained teachers. Details of district-wise are given in Appendix 13.

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

28. In 1981-82, out of 32.22 lakhs in Classes I-V, 3.72 lakhs and 0.29 lakhs belonged to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribesforming 11.6% and 0.9% respectively. Hence the extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in these classes works out to be 145.33% and 87.25% respectively. District-wise details of enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and their percentages etc. are given in Appendix No.14 and 15.

PRIMARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

- 29. In 1981-82 of the total 6807 primary schools, 5964 (87%) existed in rural areas.

 Maximum number of primary schools have been reported in rural areas of Cannanore (914)

 followed by Mallappuram (725) and the minimum viz. 121 in Wynad rural areas.
- same time enrolment in all primary schools of the rural areas of the state was 15,14,856. At the same time enrolment in Primary

 Classes I-V in rural areas was 27,19 lakhs forming 14.15 lakhs boys and 13.04 lakhs girls.

istrict-wise details are given in Appendix 16.

INSTITUTIONS AND TRACIERS

- 30. The bottol number of Middle Schools in the State increased from 2,744 in 1976-77 to 2765 in 1931-32 showing an average annual increase of 0.15% during the period of 5 years. In 1981-82 the largest number of middle schools were reported in Cannanore (16.49% and lowest in Wynad (2.35%).
- 31. In an average, a middle school served an area of 14.2 Sq. Kms. in 1976-77. The positive slightly imporved by 1931-82 as there was a middle school available for every 14.1 Sq. Kms. In 1981-82 the middle school facilities were the maximum in Kozhikode as for every 7.6 Sq. Kms a school was available but the minimum in case of Idukki (53.8 Sq.Kms).
- 32. The population served by a middle school in the State was 8,814 in 1976-77 but the facility slightly declined as a middle school was available for 9006 persons in 1981-82. Among to Districts, the population served by a middle school in 1981-82 varied from 6,148 is Cannahore to 13,112 in Trivendrum. Details are given in Appendix No.17. The number of teachers in Middle schools also decreased from 50,806 in 1976-77 to 49,433 in 1981-32. District-wise particulars are given in Appendix No.19.

I TROLINET

33. The total enrolment in middle schools was 16.04 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 16.0% lakhs in 1982 32 at an average annual increase of 0.06%. The enrolment at middle stage La. in classes VI-VIII, increased from 15,06,155(7,92,790 Boys and 7,13,365 Girls)

in 1976-77 to 16,25,737 (8,45,933 Boys and 7,78,854 Girls) in 1981-82. This shows an average annual increase of 1.58%. The average annual enrolment increase separately for boys and girls cames out to be 1.36% and 1.83% respectively.

The percentage of enrolment in Classes VI - VIII to corresponding population in the Age-Group 11-14 years, i.e. enrolment ratio, gives an index of facilities available at the middle stage of education. In Kerala this percentage was 88.2 (91.7 for boys and 84.6 for girls) in 1976-77 which increased to 91.2 (95.9 for boys and 86.6 for girls) in 1981-82. In 1981-82 the enrolment ratio was maximum in Trichur District (98.1%). Enrolment ratio was minimum in Kottayam (71.1%). In 7 districts the enrolment ratio was below to that at State level. District-wise position is given in Appendix No.18.

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES.

Of the total enrolment of 15,06,155 in classes VI-VIII 140490 (74,788 boys and 65,702 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in 1975-77 forming 9.32% of the total enrolment. In 1981-82 out of total enrolment of 16,25,787 in these classes, 1.81,747 (94,177 boys and 87,570 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 9,018 (4,95 boys and 4,024 girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes, forming 11.17% and 0.6% respectively. Hence the co-efficient of equality for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled tribes works out to 11.58% and 58,82% respectively. District-wise particulars are given in Appendix No.21 and 22.

MIDDLE E. . EDUCATION IN 1 JRAI AREAS

36. Out of 2765 middle schools in the state, 2500 belonged to rural areas. Cannanore district rural areas reported the highest number of middle schools (420) and the lowest number was 65 in Wyand. Enrolment in middle schools of rural areas was 14.58 lakhs in 1981-82. But at the same time the enrolment of middle classes was 13.95 lakhs which form 85.7% of enrolment of classes VI - VIII of whole of the State. District-wise position of middle schools and enrolment has been depicted in Appendix 22.

ENROLMENT BY STANDIRD

37. Appendix 23 depicts standard-wise enrolment from class I to VIII. At State level the decrease trend of enrolment in each class over the previous class has been observed. Percentage enrolment of class V to that of Class I worked out to 96.1% and of Class VIII to the Class I as 76.2% Dustrict-wise details are given in Appendix 23.

HIGH/HIGHER SECONDIRY EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

38. There were 1687 high/higher secondary schools in 1976-77 which increased to 2116 in 1981-32 showing in increase of 5.0% during the period of 5 years. These schools in 1981-02 included 2080 high and 16 higher secondary schools of 10+2 pattern. Smong the districts during 1981-82 the largest number of high/higher secondary schools (253) existed in wilcon and the smallest number of schools in Wynad (41).

- 39. In an everage, there was a high/higher secondary school for every 23.0 Sq. Kms. in 1976-77. By 1981-82 the position improved considerably and a school was then available for every 18.4 Sq. Kms. In 1981-82 in Trivandrum district a high/higher secondary school was available for every 2.4 Sq. Kms.whereas in Wynad district a school was available for an area of 52.0 Sq. Kms.
- 40. At the state level there was a high/higher secondary school available for every 14,336 pers as in 1976-77. By 1981-82, a high/higher secondary school was available for every 12,029 persons. Among the districts in 1981-82, the average population served by a high/higher secondary school varied from as high as 17,667 in case of Malappuramedistrict to as low as 2,843 in Trivandrum district. District-wise details of high/higher secondary schools are given in Appendix 24.
- 41. The total number of teachers in high/higher secondary schools in Kerala increased from 57,918 in 1976-77 to 78,668 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 35.8% during the period of five years. The increase in teachers was observed in all the districts except Kuttayam and Idukki. Women teachers formed 54.2% of total number of teachers in 1981-32. District-wise particulars are given in Appendix No.26.

EMROLA JI

- 42. The total enrolment in Eigh/Higher Secondary schools of the State was 18,51,782 in 1975-77 which increased to 23,40,650 in 1981-82, showing an average annual increase of 5,07%. The enrolment in classes IX-XI in 1976-77 was 5,80,893 (3,05,917 boys and 2,74,976 girls). In 1981-82 the enrolment in classes IX-XI increased to 8,28,167 (4,22,001 boys and 4,06,106 girls) showing an average annual increase of 8.51%. The average annual increase in enrolment of boys and girls separately works out to be 7.58% and 2.5% respectively.
- 43. The enrolment ratio for Kerala State at the High/Higher Secondary stage i.e., in classes TA-XI increased from 35.4 (37.1 for boys and 33.7 for girls) in 1976-77 to 48.3% (49.1% for boys and 47.5% for girls) in 1981-82. Among the districts in 1981-82, the enrolment ratio varied from 57.6% in Allappey to 34.0% in case of Malappuram district. Detai's are given in Appendix No.25.

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

of the total enrolment of 5,80,893 in classes IX-XI, 26,347 (24,360 boys and 24,467 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in 1976-77 forming 4.6% of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82, out of 8,28,167 enrolled in classes EX-XI, 89,609 (46,840 boys and 42,769 girls) belonged to scheduled castes and

3,416 (1,841 boys and 1,575 gifls) pelonged to scheduled Tribes forming 10.8% and 0.5% respectively of the total enrolment in these classes. Thus the coefficient of equality for Scheduled Tribes works out to be 107.89% and 39.21% respectivel. District-wise details of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes enrolment and their corresponding percentages are given in Appendices No.27 & 28.

HIGH/HIGH SECONDARY EDUCATION IN BURLL ARELS

45. Cut of 2116 high/higher secondary schools in the State 1661 belonged to those in rural mass. Among the rural areas of different districts maximum number viz. 222 existed in our lareas of Quilon district in 1931-82. At the same time of the total enrolment in high/higher secondary schools in the state 18,33,267 or 78.6% belonged to that of rural areas. Enrolment of classes IX to XI in rural areas also works out to 6,96,644 (3,47,696 boys and 3,48,948 girls). This enrolment forms 84.2% of total enrolment in the state. District-wise particulars are given in Appendix 29.

INTERMEDIATE/PRE DEGREE JUNIOR COLLEGES IDUCATION

It has been observed that there are 33 intermediate/pre degree/Junior Colleges of old pattern in the state in 1981-82 whereas their number was 26 in 1976-77 on the other hand empolment in these institutions has shown decreasing trend as it declined from

17,146 in 1976-77 to 9,694 in 1981-82. Among the districts the highest enrolment is reported by Kozhikode (2298) followed by Malappurum (1798) and the lowest by Palghat (96) in 1981-32.

- 47. In these intermediate/pre-degree/junior colleges there were reported 612 teachers in 1976-77 and the number declined to 341 (249 men and 92 women) teachers in 1981-82. District wise position of institutions enrolment and teachers is given in Appendix 30.
- 48. Out of 30 intermediate/pre-degree Junior Colleges in 1981-82, 29 have been reported in rur 1 areas of the state alone. Enrolment of these institutions in rural areas is reported 8324. The highest enrolment is reported in rural areas of Kozhikode (2293) and the lowest in Palghat (96). District-wise details can be seen from Appendix 30.

PROPESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

- 49. The number of schools for professional, vocational, special and other (school) Education in 1976-77 were 148 which rose to 177 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 19. The during the period of 5 years.
- increase. \$25,661 (14,923 beys and 3,738 girls) in 1976-77 to 25,508 (20,516 boys and

4992 girls) in 1931-32. Out of 18,661 students in these classes in 1976-77, 1,772 (1337 boys and 435 girls) belonged to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes forming 9.5% to total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82 out of 25,508 students 2927 (2047 boys and 880 girls) belonged to scheduled castes and 304 (185 boys and 119 girls) belonged to scheduled tribes forming 12.7% and 1.2% respectively of the total number of students in these classes. Number of teachers in Professional vocational, special and other (school) education increased from 1,673 in 1976-77 to 2,927 in 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Appendix 31.
