With the establishment of District Development Boards and the annual Cabinet review of development plans at district level, an important first step has been taken in decentralising the Planning process in Jammu and Kashmir. There is, of course, a great deal more to be done in terms of giving content to district plans, preparation of long term prospective plans and the strengthening of the district level planning machinery. In order to take the process of decentralised planning further, district plans would necessarily have to become more specific and based on greater statistical analysis. The present issue is the fifth in the series containing data upto 1981-82. The data incorporated in the Hand-Book have been updated and widened in scope. II - AGRICULTURE

Agriculture is the main occupation in the District and about 91% of the working force is engaged in this pursuit. The District has a reporting area of 6.19 Lakhs hectares. Net Area sown is about 0.09 Lakhs hectares. The main crop is wheat and maize are not grown and most of the area is under small millets.
