Agriculture is the main occupation in the District and about 91% of the working source is engaged in this pursuit. The District has a reporting area as 0.19 Lakhs hectares. Net Area sown is about 0.09 Lakhs hectares. The main crop is wheat and maize are not grown and most of the area is under small millets.
