Introduction:

The Department for the Welfare of Minorities and Other Backward Classes, Manipur was established on 30/7/1998 for the welfare of Minorities and OBCs of the State. The main objective for the establishment of MOBC is to take up measures to protect the interests of the Minorities and the Other Backward Classes Communities Socially, Economically, Educationally and also to take up Welfare programmes/schemes for Minorities and Other Backward Classes in the State.

Administrative Set Up:

The following schemes/programmes are being implemented during the year 2010-2011

Centrally Sponsored Schemes(CSS)/Central Plan Schemes(CPS):

1. Construction of Hostels for OBC Boy's and Girl's.

The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India sanctioned an amount of Rs. 75.00 lakhs for construction of 1(one) OBC Girls' Hostel at Kiyamgei during 2009-2010 and the Government of Manipur allocate Rs. 75.00 lakhs as State share for the same during Annual Plan, 2010-2011. The construction is undergoing. Construction of 1(one) no. each of OBC Boys' and Girls' Hostel at D.M. College of Commerce and Ideal Girls' College, Akampat was completed and the hostels were handed over to the respective College Authorities on 12th March, 2010 at a function chaired by Hon'ble Minister(MOBC), Government of Manipur in presence of Hon'ble Minister, Education, Government of Manipur and Hon'ble M.L.A. Thangmeiband A/C.

- 2. **Post-Matric Scholarship-OBC (100% CSS):-**This is a continuing programme to award scholarship to OBC students who are studying both inside and outside the State. This is a 100% Central share scheme. GOI sanctioned and encashed Rs.115.48370 lakhs during 2009-2010 to award scholarship to 10980 OBC students. An amount of Rs. 140.49 lakhs as central share is proposed for 2010-2011.
- **3. Pre-Matric Scholarship-OBC (50:50)(SS:CSS):-** This is a continuing programme .An amount of Rs.100.00 lakhs (State Share) was utilized to award Scholarship to 28000 OBC students. The Central Share utilized during the year is Rs.108.36 lakhs. An amount of Rs. 25.00 lakhs is proposed for 2010-2011 as State Share

4. Schemes under Minority Affairs:-

Recently, the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India sanctioned various schemes for the upliftment of the Minority Educationally, Socially, Economically. Schemes like Post and Pre-Matric Scholarship, Merit cum Means based Scholarship for Minority students, Multi-Sectoral Development Plans have been taken up.

- (a). **Pre-Matric Scholarship-Minority (25:75)(SS:CSS):** This is a continuing programme. A total of 2200 Muslim students and 8580 Christian students were awarded scholarship during 2009-2010. The physical target for 2010-2011 is to award scholarship to 2000 Muslim, 7800 Christians, 27 Sikhs, 18 Budhists, and 9 Parsis students.
- (b). **Post-Matric Scholarship-Minority (100% CSS):-** This is a continuing programme . A total of 696 Muslim students and 2730 Christian students were awarded scholarship during 2009-2010. The physical Target for 2010-2011 is to award fresh scholarship to 400 Muslim, 1560 Christian, 11 Sikhs, 9 Budhists, 2 Parsis. 89 Muslim, 41 Christian renewal students were targeted to award scholarship during the year.
- (C). Merit cum Means based Scholarship to Minority Communities (100 % CSS):- This is a continuing programme. A sum of Rs.22.94388 lakhs was encashed to benefit 20 Muslim and 78 Christian Students during 2009-10 . The implementation for 2010-2011 is not yet completed. The physical target for 2010-2011 is to award scholarship to 20 Muslim and 78 Christian students.
- (d). **Multi Sectoral Development Plans(CPS):-** Under Multi Sectoral Development Plan for Minority concentrated Districts of Manipur which is a flagship programme under Prime Minister's 15 Point Programme for the welfare of Minority, MoMA, GoI, an amount of Rs. 93.48 crores were released by the Ministry to implement various programmes like IAY, Infra Structure Development(construction of labour rooms, school buildings, chowkidar quarters etc), at 6(six) Minority Concentrated Districts of Manipur, ITI, Drinking Water programmes at Thoubal District and Integrated Watershed Development Programme at Ukhrul District. State Government also contributed Rs. 6.00 crores as state share during 2009-2010 and 2010-2011.

5. Economic Development Programme:- An amount of Rs.602.00 lakhs is allocated to benefit beneficiaries under Poultry, Fishery, Irrigation Pump, Vegetable farming, Embroidery, Tea Stall, Rickshaw, Goods carrier etc schemes. The physical Target is given below;

- **6. Skill Development Programme**:- An amount of Rs. 69.96 lakhs was encashed to benefit 1398 beneficiaries(OBC and Minority) under Bamboo Crafts(666 trainees), Embroidery(245 trainees), Tailoring(244 trainees), Carpentry(243 trainees) schemes for 2010-2011
- **7. Housing:-** Under this scheme 4 bundles of CGI each sheets shall be provided to the poor and needy Minorities and OBC communities. An amount of Rs.699.86 lakhs was utilized to benefit 1681 OBC and 2242 Minority beneficiaries during 2009-2010. Another amount of Rs. 700.00 lakhs is allocated to benefit 1680 OBC and 2240 Minority beneficiaries during 2010-2011.
- **8. Health:-** Under this Scheme financial assistance is provided as token compensation to their treatment in various ailments to OBC and Minority patients in the treatment of different kinds of diseases. Minor, Moderate, Major , Complicated/Terminal diseases have been given grants of Rs.3000.00, Rs.4000.00 and Rs.5000.00/ Rs.7000.00 per patients respectively. An amount of Rs. 60.00 lakhs is encashed for 2010-2011 to benefit 691 OBC and 1017 Minority patients.
- **9. Coaching Programmes:-** Under this programme a sum of Rs. 35.00 lakhs is allocated for Remedial and other related coaching programmes for the year 2010-2011.

Grants-in-Aid Bodies

- (a) Wakf Board, Manipur:-An amount of Rs. 33.00 Lakhs(Plan) and Rs. 3.00 lakhs(Non-Plan) is allocated as Grant-in-aid to Wakf Board, Manipur to meet its over-heads, office expenditures and to implement development schemes like protection and preservation of Wakf property, financial assistances to poor and meritorious students in Technical and Diploma Courses and Islamic Education etc.
- (b) Haj Committee: An amount of Rs. 6.00 lakhs was released to the Committee to meet various works related to Haj Pilgrimage and other related works of the Committee.
- (c) Manipur State Minorities Commission:- An amount of Rs. 12.00 lakhs is allocated for the Commission to meet its over -heads office expenditures and to implement development schemes/programmes in relation to the protection of Minorities rights, Awareness Programmes of Minority and other Misc. expenditures.
- **(d). Minorities and Other Backward Classes Economic Development Society:-** An amount of Rs.34.00 lakhs is allocated to implement various Socio-Economic Development activities of Minorities and OBC communities of the State. The Society is the State Channelising agency for NMDFC and NBCFDC, New Delhi. The Society is implementing various Socio-Economic Development programmes of Minorities and OBC communities of the State with Self Help Groups. The Society is extending educational loan for courses like MBBS, B.E., NDA and MCA/MBA students.
- **(e). State Commission for OBC:-**The State Government has constituted a State Commission for Other Backward Classes to look into the reservation policy of OBCs and suggest measures for upliftment of OBCs in the State. Funds are provided for the functioning of the Commission and other related activities like remuneration of the Chairman/Members/staff, office expenses, POL, sty, TA/DA and Misc. expenses. An amount of Rs.20.00 lakhs was released to the Commission for 2010-2011.
