REVENUE ACCOUNT OF THE STATE BUDGET
THE REVENUE BUDGET 1993-94 (BUDGET ESTIMATE)

The fiscal operations (under the revenue account) of the Government during 1993-94 are estimated to result in a deficit of Rs. 61817 lakhs, the estimate of expenditure being Rs. 430676 lakhs and of Revenue Rs. 368859 lakhs.





THE BUDGET RUPEE ITS SOURCES AND USES 1993-94 BUDGET ESTIMATE



REVENUE 1993-94 (BUDGET ESTIMATE)

During the financial year 1993-94 the revenue of the State is estimated at Rs. 368859 lakhs out of which Rs. 71404 lakhs is the State's share of Central Taxes, Rs. 213993 lakhs is the receipt from the State Taxes and duties and Rs. 83462 lakhs by way of non-tax revenue.

EXPENDITURE 1993-94 (BUDGET ESTIMATE)

Out of the total estimate, expenditure of Rs. 430676 lakhs during 1993-94 Rs. 266673 lakhs is for developmental purposes Rs. 65072 lakhs is for servicing the debt of the State, Rs. 36846 lakhs is for Administrative Services and Rs. 11926 lakhs is for collection of State taxes and duties.

TRENDS IN REVENUE RECEIPTS 1985-86 TO 1993-94

The total estimated revenue receipts of Rs. 368359 lakhs in 1993-94 is higher by Rs. 32243 lakhs in comparison with 1992-93 (R.E.) and Rs. 231742 lakhs more than the similar figure in 1985-86.

Receipts by way of taxes and duties in 1993-94 are estimated at Rs. 285397 lakhs and those by way of non-tax items of revenue Rs. 83462 lakhs. Receipts from taxes and duties during 1993-94 form 77.37% of the total revenue and non-tax revenue 22.63%. The corresponding figures for the year 1992-93 (R.E.) are 76.81 and 23.19% respectively for tax revenue and non-tax revenue. Tax revenues have increased by 204% and non-tax revenue by 169% during the period 1985-86 to 1993-94 (B.E.)






TAX REVENUE 1993-94 (BUDGET ESTIMATE)

The State's share of Central taxes during 1993-94 is estimated at Rs. 71404 lakhs which is Rs. 4555 lakhs higher than the share in 1992-93 (R.E.). Receipts from States taxes and duties during 1993-94 show an increase of Rs. 22306 lakhs over the receipts in 1992-93 (R.E.). From the table given below it would be seen that the percentage of State Taxes and Duties to total tax revenue has decreased from 77.80 in 1985-86 to 74.98 in 1993-94 and in respect of the share of Central Taxes there has been an increase from 22.20 in 1985-86 to 25.02 in 1993-94.






STATE TAXES AND DUTIES 1993-94 (BUDGET ESTIMATE)

During the financial year 1993-94 the total receipts from State taxes and duties are estimated at Rs. 213993 lakhs. Of this revenue from Sales Tax form 69.08% and State Excise Duty 10.98% Revenue from Sales Tax shows an increase of 9.50% during 1993-94 over receipts in 1992-93 (R.E.) and 222% over 1985-86.

NON-TAX REVENUE 1993-94 (BUDGET ESTIMATE)

During the Financial Year 1993-94 non-tax revenue is estimated at Rs. 83462 lakhs which is 22.63% of the total Revenue Receipts. It is Rs. 5331 lakhs or 6.89% higher than the receipts during 1992-93 (R.E.). Grant-in-aid from the centre forms 67 % of the total non-tax revenue during 1993-94.







EXPENDITURE MET FROM REVENUE 1993-94 (BUDGET ESTIMATE)

Estimate of expenditure under the revenue account for 1993-94 comes to Rs. 430676 lakhs which is Rs. 4553 lakhs or 11.83% higher than the revised estimate of the expenditure incurred under the revenue account during the year 1992-93 (R.E.).

Out of the expenditure during 1993-94 Rs. 266673 lakhs or 61.92% is for developmental purposes which is Rs. 20996 lakhs or 8.55 % higher than the expenditure incurred in 1992-93 (R.E.). Non-developmental expenditure is estimated at Rs. 164003 lakhs during 1993-94 which is Rs. 24555 lakhs or 17.6% higher than that of 1992-93 (R.E.) Development expenditure has increased by 157% and non-development expenditure by 301% from 1985-86 to 1993-94 (B.E.).

During the year 1993-94 out of the estimated expenditure for developmental purpose Rs. 238428 lakhs 89.41% is for Social and Development Services, Rs. 8309 lakhs (3.12%) is for Irrigation, Rs. 7811 lakhs (2.93%) is for Public Works and Rs. 4559 lakhs (1.71%) is for Forests.









BUDGET ESTIMATE**




**STATE TAXES



PER CAPITA EXPENDITURE 1991-92











VIITH & VIIITH FIVE YEAR PLANS KERALA STATE PLAN




VIITH PLAN 1985-90 TOTAL RUPEES 24.39 CRORES
