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## INTRODUCTION

This Report gives an account of the development of educational facilities for children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in India during 1975-76. This report is based mainly on the statistical data supplied by the State Governments and Administrations of Union Territories in a prescribed form.

The proposed publication covers mainly the enrolment of children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes at different levels of education beginning from pre-primary education upto the highest stage of education with all the possible bifurcations into different standards of education. Sex-wise and State-wise comparisons of progress of education among the children belonging to these communities have also been made. The coefficient of equality at different levels of education in respect of these communities has also been worked out.

The population statistics included in this Report are estimated on the basis of 1971 Census figures. No attempt has been made to draw any inference or insinuation based upon the factual data depicted in the report, although some analysis of the data has been given wherever desirable in order to highlight the progress of education among the children of various age-groups belonging to these communities.

The State-wise details of progress made in providing educational facilities to the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe communities are presented in Appendices 'A' and 'B' respectively.

The Ministry of Education & Social Welfare highly appreciates the assistance of all the State Governments and Administrations of Union Territories who supplied the basic statistics for the preparation of this report. Suggestions for making the report more useful in future may please be addressed to the Deputy Secretary(Planning) in this Ministry.

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SUMMARY

There has been a tremendous expansion in the provision of educational facilities in India. Remarkable increase has been noticed in the number of institutions of different types enrolment therein, number of teachers employed and the educational expenditure incurred thereon. Table I below, giving the percentage of coverage of the population of all communities of different school-going age-groups, indicates at a glance the significant developments that have taken place in the field of elementary education since 1960-61 :

2. Although all-round expansion of education has been witnessed yet it has not spread over uniformly in the country. There still remain certain areas and social communities as well as some groups of population which lag far behind others in the development of education. Special efforts are, therefore, required to be made to accelerate the pace of educational development in such backward areas, special groups of population like girls, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, backward classes and other communities living in hill areas.

3. The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes to the enrolment of all communities increased from 11.1 and 4.6 in 1974-75 to 11.5 and 4.7 in 1975-76 respectively. In terms of coefficient of equality, the overall position improved slightly from 76.0% to 78.8%, in the case of Scheduled Castes and it decreased from 66.7% to 62.8% in the case of Scheduled Tribes during this period. The decrease in coefficient of equality of Scheduled Tribes is mainly on account of taking revised population figures of Scheduled Tribe population by which the Scheduled Tribe population has increased from 6.9% to 7.49%. The decrease is, therefore, more apparent than real.

Table 2 below gives a comparative position of enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in various types of institutions in India for the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 and also brings out the improvements in the coefficient of equality\* in different types of institutions in 1975-76 as compared to 1974-75.

State-wise details of enrolment of children belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes studying in various types of educational institutions are given in the statements included in Appendices(A) and (B) respectively of the report.

4. Accepting equality of opportunities for children belonging to all communities the coefficient of equality for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes children should be 100. In other words the proportion of the enrolment of SC/ST to total enrolment should equal to the proportion of population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total population and its percentage equal to 100. An index greater than 100 implies that the educational advance of Scheduled Castes/Tribes is more than that of the total population and thereby shows that there are some other social groups in the general population whose condition is even worse than that of the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes. If this index is less than 100 it indicates that the Scheduled Caste/Tribes have still some lee-way to make. In such cases, special efforts are needed to be made to improve their enrolment. The smaller the coefficient of equality, the greater the need for making such efforts. The Coefficient of equality of 78.8% in case of Scheduled Castes and only 62.8% in case of Scheduled Tribes indicates the extent to which educational facilities were availed of by these communities in 1975-76. This index also highlights the effort that is required to improve conditions which may attract children of these communities to educational institutions.

5. For analysis of this subject in details separately for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, this report has been divided into two parts. Part I relates to the educational development of Scheduled Castes and Part II deals with the educational development of Scheduled Tribes.

#### P A R T - I

##### EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES FOR SCHEDULED CASTES :

6. The population of Scheduled Castes as per the 1971 Census was about 82.48 million which formed 15.05% of the total population of India. This is the revised population for 1971 based on the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Orders (Amendment) Act, 1976. The State-wise break-up of the population of this community as well as its percentage to total population are given in Table 3 on the next page.

It will be seen that the highest percentage of population of Scheduled Castes (24.71 per cent) was found in Punjab followed by Himachal Pradesh (23.35%) and Uttar Pradesh(21.62%). The smallest proportion of Scheduled Caste population (0.38%) was reported in Meghalaya. The States/U.T.'s of Nagaland, A & N Islands, Arunachal Pradesh and Lakshadweep had no/negligible Scheduled Caste Population.

7. The population of Scheduled Castes for the year 1976 is not available but for the purpose of this report it has been assumed that the proportion of Scheduled Caste population to the total population of each State and Union Territory as recorded in 1971 Census holds good for 1976 as well.

### B. Enrolment

Table 4 below depicts the all-India picture of the total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of institutions during the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 :-

It will be observed from table 4 that the total enrolment of Scheduled Caste Students increased from 103.46 lakhs in 1974-75 to 109.06 lakhs in 1975-76 giving a growth rate of 5.4% during this period. The girls enrolment included in the total, however, increased from 30.56 lakhs in 1974-75 to 32.56 lakhs in 1975-76 at a growth rate of 6.5%. Additional enrolment during this period was of the order of 5.60 lakhs and a major part of it, namely 2.62 lakhs was in Primary/Junior basic schools.

9. The percentage of Scheduled Caste enrolment to the total enrolment and the coefficient of equality for various types of educational institutions is given in Table 5 below :

Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment increased from 11.1 in 1974-75 to 11.5 in 1975-76. Correspondingly the coefficient of equality increased from 76.0% to 76.4%. Percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased in all types of educational institutions except in case of pre-primary schools which remained stationary. The coefficient of equality decreased slightly in case of enrolment in pre-primary and middle schools as well as colleges for general education.

C. State-wise Enrolment

10. The State-wise break-up of percentage of Scheduled Castes enrolment to the total enrolment during the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 is given in Table below :

Appreciable increase in the percentage of Scheduled Castes enrolment to total enrolment has been noticed in case of Assam, Karnataka, Punjab, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal. In other cases there was marginal increase or slight decrease except in case of Haryana and Dadra & Nagar Haveli, where the decrease was of the order of 0.6%.

#### D. Coefficient of Equality

11. Table 7 below indicates the state-wise co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Castes for the years 1974-75 and 1975-76.

The co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Castes in 1974-75 was more than 100% in case of Assam, Gujarat, Kerala, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Tripura and Dadra & Nagar Haveli. This continued to be so in 1975-76 also, except in case of Kerala where it came down to 97%. Tamil Nadu reached a coefficient of equality of nearly 100% (99.4%) in 1975-76 for 93.8% in 1974-75. This indicator works out more than 200% in case of Meghalaya and Dadra, Nagar Haveli on account of negligible Scheduled Caste population. In 1975-76 the Co-efficient of equality was less than the national average of 76.4% in case of Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Chandigarh and Delhi.

#### E. Progress of Enrolment by types of institutions

12. A general review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes during the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 indicates an overall improvement. However, the participation varied from State to State and also over various types of institutions. Statements II to XVI in Appendix 'A' indicates State-wise progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of educational institutions.

13. A brief comparative review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes as percentage to the enrolment of all communities for each category of schools and the corresponding co-efficient of equality for the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 is given in the following paragraphs :

##### (i) Pre-Primary Schools

The total enrolment in Pre-Primary Schools in the country increased from 3.66 lakhs in 1974-75 to 3.88 lakhs in 1975-76 thus registering an increase of 6.0% during this period. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased from 26,902 (7.4% of the total) in 1974-75 to 28,529 (7.4% of the total) in 1975-76. The State-wise percentage of enrolment and co-efficient of equality are indicated in Table 8 below. The details of enrolment figures are given in Statement II of Appendix 'A'.

### (ii) Primary Schools

The total enrolment in Primary Schools in the country increased from 464.95 lakhs in 1974-75 to 467.61 lakhs in 1975-76 showing an increase of only 0.55% during this period. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased from 61.42 lakhs in 1974-75 to 64.04 lakhs in 1975-76, thus, registering an increase of 4.3% during the same period. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment in primary Schools was 13.2 in 1974-75 which increased to 13.7 in 1975-76. Figures for the co-efficient of equality were 90.4% and 91.0% in the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 respectively. State-wise position of these percentages is shown in Table 9 below. However, details of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Primary Schools by States and Union Territories for the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 are given in Statement III of Appendix 1A.

### (iii) Middle Schools

The total enrolment in Middle/Senior Basic Schools in the country increased from 230.34 lakhs in 1974-75 to 236.42 lakhs in 1975-76 registering an increase of 2.6%. Corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased from 22.54 lakhs in 1974-75 to 23.73 lakhs in 1975-76.

Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment showed an increase from 9.8 in 1974-75 to 10.0 in 1975-76. However, there was a slight decrease in the coefficient of equality from 67.1 in 1974-75 to 66.4 in 1975-76. State-wise figures of percentage and coefficient of equality are shown in Table 10 given below. Enrolment figures have been given in Statement IV of Appendix 'A'.

(iv) High/Higher Secondary Schools.

Total enrolment in High/Higher Secondary Schools for the country as a whole increased from 185.47 lakhs in 1974-75 to 191.86 lakhs in 1975-76 registering an increase of 3.4%. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students was 15.55 lakhs in 1974-75 which increased to 17.02 lakhs in 1975-76, showing an increase of 9.5 during this period. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to the total enrolment showed an increase from 8.4 in 1974-75 to 8.9 in 1975-76 and consequently the co-efficient of equality also increased from 57.16% in 1974-75 to 59.1% in 1975-76. Percentage enrolment and co-efficient of equality by States are shown in Table 11 below. Enrolment figures are given in statement V of Appendix A.

(v) Schools for Vocational and Technical Education

Total enrolment in Vocational and Technical schools in the country was 1,81,731 in 1974-75. Of this, the number of Scheduled Caste students was 16,550 and formed 9.1 per cent of the total enrolment. In 1975-76, the total enrolment of all communities in these schools increased to 1,90,969 and the enrolment of Scheduled Castes students increased to 18,190 forming 9.5 percent of the total enrolment. Corresponding co-efficient of equality decreased from 62.3% in 1974-75 to 65.1% in 1975-76. State-wise enrolment percentage and the co-efficient of equality have been indicated in Table 12 below. The enrolment figures may be seen from Statement VI of Appendix 'A'.

(vi) Schools for Special Education

Schools for physically and mentally handicapped children and the reformatories are generally taken under schools for Special Education. In the year 1974-75, 29,127 students from all communities were enrolled in these institutions of which 2,732 were scheduled caste students. These students formed 9.4 per cent of the total enrolment in the year 1974-75. In 1974-75 total enrolment increased to 30,035 of which 3,011 were scheduled caste students. Scheduled Caste students formed 10.0 percent of the total enrolment during the year under report. The corresponding coefficient of equality for Scheduled Caste enrolment increased from 64.4% in 1974-75 to 66.4% in 1975-76. The State-wise figures of percentage enrolment and co-efficient of equality are delineated in Table 13 as below. Enrolment figures may be seen from Statement VII of the Appendix 'A'.

(vii) Schools for other Education

Other Education covers mainly schools for Adult Education and Oriental Studies. During 1974-75, of 6.43 lakhs students studying in these schools, 0.56 lakhs were Scheduled Caste students. They formed 8.8 per cent of the total enrolment. Total enrolment of all communities in these institutions in 1975-76 was 6.58 lakhs. Of these, Scheduled Caste students were 0.78 lakhs. They formed 11.3 percent of the total enrolment. Co-efficient of equality increased from 60.3% in 1974-75 to 75.1% in 1975-76. State-wise figures for percentage enrolment and co-efficient of equality are indicated in Table 14 below. Enrolment figures for Scheduled Caste students in Special Education Schools and other Education Schools may be seen from Statement VII of Appendix 'A'.

(viii) Schools for Vocational, Special and Other Education taken together

Total enrolment of all communities in the above categories of schools in 1974-75 was 8.54 lakhs of which Scheduled Caste students were 75,756 forming 8.9 percent of the total enrolment. The corresponding co-efficient of equality was 61.0%. In 1975-76 the total enrolment increased to 8.79 lakhs and the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased to 95,876. Scheduled Caste students formed 10.9 percent of the total enrolment. The corresponding co-efficient of equality for Scheduled Castes in 1975-76 was 72.7%.

(ix) Institutions for Higher Education, Universities and Colleges of General Education.

The total number of students enrolled in these institutions increased from 32.98 lakhs in 1974-75 to 33.32 lakhs in 1975-76 i.e. an increase of 1.0 per cent during this period. The enrolment of Scheduled Caste students also increased from 2,28,108 in 1974-75 to 2,35,222 in 1975-76. This shows an increase of 3.1 per cent during 1974-75 and 1975-76. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes was 6.9 in 1974-75 which increased to 7.1 per cent in 1975-76. However, the coefficient of equality decreased slightly from 47.3% in 1974-75 to 47.2% in 1975-76. The comparative percentage enrolment and co-efficient of equality for these two years have been indicated below in Table 15. Detailed data on enrolment in Universities and Colleges of general education in 1975-76 are depicted in Statement VIII of Appendix 'A'.

(x) Colleges of Professional and Other Education.

The enrolment of all communities in these colleges as a whole was 10.71 lakhs in 1974-75 which increased to 11.07 lakhs in 1975-76. The Scheduled Caste students enrolled were 63,928 (including 7,679 Girls) in 1974-75 and this enrolment increased to 68,199 (including 8,798 Girls) in 1975-76. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students as percentage to the total enrolment in 1974-75 was 6.0 per cent which increased to 6.2 per cent in 1975-76. The coefficient of equality was recorded as 41.1% and 41.2% in the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 respectively. State-wise percentage of enrolment and co-efficient of equality are shown in Table 16 below. State-wise figures of enrolment for different types of professional institutions viz. Agriculture, Commerce, Engineering, Technology and Architecture, Law, Medicine and Teacher Training are given in Statement IX of Appendix 'A'.

#### (xi) Colleges for Professional Education

The number of students studying in Colleges for Professional Education in the country increased from 9.50 lakhs in 1974-75 to 9.80 lakhs in 1975-76. The corresponding figures of Scheduled Castes students were 58,910 in 1974-75 and 62,742 in 1975-76. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment increased from 6.2 in 1974-75 to 6.4 in 1975-76. Consequently the co-efficient of equality remained stationary at 42.5 during this period. Enrolment in Agriculture increased from 1,617 to 1,849 in commerce it rose from 12,908 to 13,423, in Engineering, Technology and Architecture it went up from 17,707 to 18,104, in Law it improved from 3,701 to 4,219, in Medicine it increased from 7,860 to 8,820, in Teacher Training Colleges it improved from 13,331 to 14,508 and in other Professional Colleges it went up from 1,786 to 1,819. The position of Scheduled Castes enrolment in major types of colleges for professional education is given in table 17 on the next page.

(xii) Institutions for Professional, Special and Other Education(Colleges and Schools)

A composite picture of State-wise enrolment, percentages and co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Caste Students in institutions for Professional, Special and Other Education (both Colleges and Schools) during the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 has been shown in Table 18 below. Total number of students enrolled in these colleges and schools was 19.25 lakhs in 1974-75 and it increased to 19.86 lakhs in 1975-76. Of the total, the number of Scheduled Caste students were 1.40 lakhs in 1974-75 and 1.64 lakhs in 1975-76. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to the total enrolment was 7.3 and 8.3 during the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 respectively. Consequently, co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Caste students increased from 50.0% in 1974-75 to 55.1% in 1975-76.

G. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste by Stages of Education

15. So far, the progress in enrolment of Scheduled Castes students by type of institutions only has been discussed. Comparative picture of enrolment and co-efficient of equality for the year 1974-75 and 1975-76 has been shown in respect of different categories of institutions. However, the correct idea about the progress of enrolment of scheduled caste students can be had only from the stage-wise position of enrolment as discussed in the following paragraphs:

Table 20 indicates the enrolment of all communities as well as of scheduled caste students alone by stages of education for the year 1975-76. Enrolment of Scheduled Castes as percentage to the total enrolment for different stages of education is a good indicator of position of enrolment of Scheduled Caste in comparison of other communities. The Scheduled Castes form about 15 per cent of the total population and the difference between this percentage and the percentage of scheduled caste enrolment to total enrolment indicates the lee-way which needs to be made up to bring the Scheduled Castes at par with other communities.

(i) Primary Stage

The number of classes constituting the primary stage of education varied from State to State. For the sake of uniformity the first five classes of schools have been taken to constitute the primary stage in all States/Union Territories of India. Total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Classes I-V increased from 79,00,821 in 1974-75 to 82,44,638 in 1975-76. The number of Girl students during 1974-75 and 1975-76 was 25,23,295 and 26,58,531 respectively. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment showed an increase from 12.2 in 1974-75 and 12.6 in 1975-76 and consequently the coefficient of equality also increased from 83.6% in 1974-75 to 83.7% in 1975-76. Educational wastage among Scheduled Caste students at Primary Stage was 67.8 per cent in 1975-76, as compared to 68.5 per cent in 1974-75. Maximum wastage in Education at Primary Stage was in Manipur (87.6%) and minimum in Jammu & Kashmir(17.7%). Figures relating to enrolment of Scheduled Castes' percentage to the total enrolment, coefficient of equality and percentage of wastage at Primary stage for the year 1975-76 in respect of each State/Union Territory of India have been indicated in Table 21 below. Enrolment by classes at Primary stage and by States is given in Statement X of Appendix 'A'.

### (ii) Middle Stage :

Number of classes constituting Middle stage too is not the same in all the States and Union Territories. But in most of the States and Union Territories Classes VI, VII and VIII are treated as the Middle stage of school education. Hence, for the sake of uniformity, Classes VI-VIII (3 classes) are taken under Middle stage for all the States and Union Territories. In 1974-75 Scheduled Caste students enrolled at Middle stage were 14,13,348 of whom 3,39,322 were Girls. Scheduled Caste students formed 9.3 percent of the total enrolment in 1974-75. Corresponding Scheduled Caste enrolment was 15,30,260 (including 3,76,889 Girls) in 1975-76. The students of Scheduled Caste community formed 9.3 per cent of the total enrolment at this stage during this year. The Co-efficient of equality of scheduled castes under this stage of education was 63.9% in 1975-76. Table 22 depicts the position of the number enrolled, enrolment percentage and coefficient of equality at Middle stage in various States and Union Territories. Class-wise enrolment at middle stage is given in Statement XI of Appendix 'A'.

### (iii) High/Higher Secondary Stage

The number of Classes which comprises High/Higher Secondary Stage also varies from State to State in India. But for the purpose of this report this stage has been taken to comprise of Classes IX and above for all the States and Union Territories. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students at this stage increased from 5,95,740 (including 1,16,167 girls) in 1974-75 to 6,54,733 (including 1,30,973 girls) in 1975-76. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment increased from 8.0 in 1974-75 to 8.8 in 1975-76. Consequently the coefficient of equality increased from 54.8 in 1974-75 to 58.5 in 1975-76. Position of enrolment and coefficient of equality of scheduled caste students

in these classes at High/Higer Secondary stage has been depicted in Table 23 below. Details of Class-wise enrolment for Classes IX and above by States may, however, be seen in Statement XII of Appendix 'A'.

(iv) Enrolment by Classes at School Stage.

Table 24 depicts the percentage of Scheduled caste enrolment to total enrolment in various classes (pre-Primary to Higher Secondary stage) and Co-efficient of equality for the year 1975-76. Total enrolment of scheduled caste students in General School Education increased from 99.43 lakhs in 1974-75 to 104.69 lakhs in 1975-76. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment was 11.3 in 1974-75 which increased to 11.7 in 1975-76. The co-efficient of equality of Scheduled Caste students at school stage also increased from 77.4% in 1974-75 to 77.7% in 1975-76.

(v) Vocational, Special and Other Education  
(School Standard)

Vocational Education includes inter-alia Agriculture, Commerce, Teacher Training, Technical/Industrial and Arts and Crafts Schools etc., Special Education includes institutions for mentally and physically handicapped children and reformatory schools and Other education relates to institutions of oriental studies, social(adult) education and other specified education. During the year 1974-75, the enrolment of scheduled caste students in vocational education was 17,721 forming 8.3 per cent of the total enrolment. Corresponding enrolment in schools for special and other Education was 61,832 which formed 8.3 per cent of the total enrolment of all communities. In 1975-76 the scheduled caste students enrolled were 19,506 in Vocational Education forming 8.7 per cent of the total enrolment.

Scheduled Caste enrolment in schools for special and other education was 82,058 forming 10.7 per cent of the total enrolment during the year under report. Enrolment percentage and the co-efficient of equality in respect of Vocational, Special and Other Education(School Standard) increased from 8.3% and 56.9% in 1974-75 to 10.2% and 67.8% in 1975-76 respectively and their subject-wise break-up have been shown in Special and Other type of education(School Standard) in Statements XIII and XIV of Appendix 'A'.

#### (vi) Higher Education(General)

In 1974-75 the enrolment of scheduled caste students in General Higher Education was 2,40,504 (including 34,230 girls) forming 7.8 per cent of the total enrolment. Scheduled Caste Girls formed 4.0 per cent of the total Girl students in these classes. In 1975-76 scheduled caste enrolment in General Higher Education was 2,46,406 of whom 35,680 were Girl students. During this year, scheduled caste students formed 7.9 per cent of the total enrolment. Scheduled Caste girls formed 4.1% of the total enrolment during 1975-76. Table

26 indicate the enrolment of scheduled castes by different stages of General Higher Education.

#### (vii) Professional and Other Higher Education

Enrolment of scheduled castes in 1974-75 was 82,399 of whom 7,645 were Girls. In 1975-76 scheduled caste enrolment at this stage of education increased to 89,626 (including 9,546 Girls). Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment showed an increase from 5.7 to 6.0 and so also the Coefficient of equality which increased from 39.0% to 39.9% in years 1974-75 and 1975-76. It will be seen that the percentage of population of scheduled tribes was the highest in Nagaland (88.6%) and the lowest in Uttar Pradesh (0.2%) among States. Among the Union Territories, the highest percentage of scheduled tribes population (93.8%) was reported by L and the lowest (0.9%) was reported by Goa, Daman & Diu. Among the States-Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir and Punjab had no population of scheduled tribes. Similarly, the Union Territories of Chandigarh, Delhi and Pondicherry had no population of Scheduled Tribes.

#### B. Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes

17. Table 32 below depicts the all-India picture of the total enrolment of scheduled tribes in various types of educational institutions during the years 1974-75 and 1975-76.

It will be seen from the above table that the total enrolment of children belonging to scheduled tribes increased from 42.73 lakhs in 1974-75 to 44.43 lakhs in 1975-76 at a growth rate of 4.0%. Girls enrolment included in the total, however, increased from 12.87 lakhs in 1974-75 to 13.56 lakhs in 1975-76. The percentage of scheduled tribe enrolment to total enrolment was 4.6 during 1974-75 which increased to 4.7 per cent in 1975-76.

E. Progress of Enrolment by type of institutions

21. A general review of the progress of enrolment of scheduled tribes during the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 shows an increase in the enrolment in various types of educational institutions except in States of Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and Dadra & Nagar Haveli where there is slight decrease in total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes. There are no Scheduled Tribes in Union Territories of Delhi and Chandigarh except small migratory population whose children study in the schools of these territories. Statements II to XVI in Appendix 'B' indicate State-wise position of the enrolment of scheduled tribes in various types of educational institutions.

22. A comparative review of the progress of enrolment of scheduled tribes as per centage to the total enrolment and the coefficient of equality for the years 1974-75 and 1975-76 in various types of educational institutions is given in the following paragraph

(i) Pre-Primary Schools

Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes children in Pre-Primary Schools increased from 28,284 (7.7% of the total) in 1974-75 to 30,565 (7.9% of in 1975-76 of the total). Similarly enrolment of scheduled tribe girls showed an increase from 14,058 in 1974-75 to 14,873 in 1975-76. Correspondingly, the coefficient of equality of scheduled tribes students decreased from 111.6 in 1974-75 to 105.6 in 1975-76. The State-wise data are delineated in Table 36 as here under:-

### (ii) Primary Schools

Total enrolment in Primary Schools in the country as a whole increased to 467.51 lakhs in 1975-76 as compared to 464.95 lakhs in the year 1974-75. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Tribes increased from 28.68 lakhs in 1974-75 to 29.33 lakh in 1975-76. The percentage enrolment of scheduled tribes to the total enrolment was 6.0 and 6.3 in 1974-75 and 1975-76 respectively. The coefficient of equality was 87.0% in 1974-75 and 84.1% in 1975-76. State-wise position of the enrolment percentage and coefficient of equality of scheduled tribes in Primary Schools in 1974-75 and 1975-76 is indicated in Table 37 below:-

### (iii) Middle Schools

Total enrolment in Middle Schools in the country as a whole increased from 230.34 lakhs in 1974-75 to 236.42 in 1975-76 showing an increase of 2.6%. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Tribes increased from 8.84 lakhs to 9.40 lakhs, thus, registering an increase of 6.3% during this period. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment of all communities in this type of schools in India was 3.8% in 1974-75 and 4.0% in 1975-76. However, the coefficient of equality which was 55.1% in 1974-75 came down to 53.4% in 1975-76. State-wise position of the enrolment percentage and the coefficient of equality is given in Table 38.

#### (iv) High / Higher Secondary Schools

While the total number of students belonging to all communities enrolled in High and Higher Secondary Schools increased from 185.47 lakhs in 1974-75 to 191.86 lakhs in 1975-76, the corresponding enrolment of scheduled tribes increased only from 7.3 lakhs to 4.101 lakhs during this period. In the case of the former the rate of increase was 3.4%, it was 7.5% in the latter case. Comparative picture of State-wise enrolment for these two

y ears is given in Statement V in Appendix 'B'. The coverage of enrolment of scheduled tribe students as percentage of total enrolment showed a slight increase from 2.0% in 1974-75 to 2.1% in 1975-76. The co-efficient of equality of scheduled tribes decreased from 29.0% to 28.0% during this period. State-wise position of the enrolment percentage and the co-efficient of equality is indicated in Table 39 below:-

## (v) Schools for Vocational and Technical Education

Total enrolment in Vocational and Technical Schools in the country as a whole was 1.82 lakhs in 1974-75 of which only 7,103 were scheduled tribes forming 4.4% of the total enrolment. In 1975-76, the corresponding total enrolment of the country as a whole was 1.91 lakhs of which 7,903 constituted the enrolment of scheduled tribe students. The percentage of Scheduled Tribe enrolment to the total enrolment was 4.1% during the year under report. The coefficient of equality of scheduled tribe students decreased from 63.8% in 1974-75 to 54.7% in 1975-76. State-wise enrolment percentage and coefficient of equality have been given in Table 40 below:

(vi) Schools for Special Education

While the total number of students enrolled in Schools for Special education increased from 29,127 in 1974-75 to 30,035 in 1975-76, the corresponding enrolment of scheduled tribe students decreased from 694 in 1974-75 to 611 in 1975-76. The percentage of scheduled tribe enrolment decreased from 2.4 in 1974-75 to 2.0 in 1975-76 and so also the co-efficient of equality decreased from 34.8% to 26.7% during the period under report. State-wise percentage enrolment and coefficient of equality are indicated in Table 41 below.

(vii) Schools for Other Education

Total enrolment of all communities in Schools for other education increased from 6.43 lakhs in 1974-75 to 6.58 lakhs in 1975-76. The enrolment of scheduled tribes in this type of schools increased from 37,204 to 50,383 during this period. The percentage of scheduled tribe students increased from 5.8 in 1974-75 to 7.7 in 1975-76 and so also the coefficient of equality which increased from 84.1% to 102.8% during this period. (viii) Institutions for Higher Education, Universities and Colleges of General Education

The total enrolment in these institutions increased from 32.98 lakhs in 1974-75 to 33.32 lakhs in 1975-76. Similarly, the enrolment of scheduled tribe students increased from 58,854 in 1974-75 to 60,554 in 1975-76. The percentage of scheduled tribe students to students belonging to all communities studying in these institutions decreased slightly from 1.9 in 1974-75 to 1.8 in 1975-76 and so also the co-efficient of equality which decreased from 27.5% to 24.0% during the period under report. While the detailed position of the enrolment by States in these institutions is given in Statement VIII/Appendix 'B', a comparative picture of the enrolment percentages and the coefficient of equality is given in Table 43 below:-

(ix) Colleges of Professional and Other Education

Enrolment of all communities in these colleges as a whole was 10.71 lakhs in 1974-75 which increased to 11.07 lakhs in 1975-76. The Scheduled Tribe students enrolled were 16,123 (including 2,658 girls) in 1974-75 and this enrolment increased to 18,456 (including 2,999 girls) in 1975-76. The enrolment of Scheduled Tribes as percentage to the total enrolment remained constant at 1.7 per cent in both these years. The coefficient of equality decreased from 24.6% to 22.7% during the years under report. State-wise percentage of enrolment and coefficient of equality are shown in Table 44 below. (x) Colleges of Professional Education

The number of students studying in colleges of Professional Education in the country increased from 9.50 lakhs in 1974-75 to 9.80 lakhs in 1975-76. The corresponding figures of scheduled tribe students were 15,657 in 1974-75 and 17,948 in 1975-76. The percentage enrolment of scheduled tribes to total enrolment increased from 1.7 in 1974-75 to 1.8 in 1975-76. The coefficient of equality decreased from 24.6 to 24.0 during the years under report. Enrolment in Agriculture rose from 349 to 385, in commerce it increased from 2,025 to 2,255, in Engineering & Technology it ~~came~~ up from 3,810 to 5,038, in Medicine it improved from 1,804 to 2,073, in Teacher Training it increased from 5,178 to 6,363 and in Law the increase was from 1,467 to 1,559. (xi) Institutions for Professional, Special and Other Education (Colleges and Schools)

While the total enrolment of all communities in these institutions increased from 19.25 lakhs in 1974-75 to 19.86 lakhs in 1975-76, the corresponding enrolment of scheduled tribes increased from 61,129 in 1974-75 to 69,458 in 1975-76. The Scheduled Tribes students in these institutions formed 3.9% of the total enrolment in 1975-76 as against 3.2% during the year 1974-75. ## General School Education

### (i) Primary Stage

As already stated, the number of classes constituting the Primary stage varies from State to State. But for the sake of uniformity, classes I-V has been taken to form Primary stage in all States/Union Territories for the purpose of this report. Total enrolment of scheduled tribes at the Primary stage in the country as a whole increased from 34.67 lakhs in 1974-75 to 35.72 lakhs in 1975-76. Correspondingly, the girls enrolment of these communities increased from 10.79 lakhs to 11.24 lakhs. Percentage enrolment of scheduled tribes to the total enrolment at this stage was 5.4 both in 1974-75 and 1975-76. The coefficient of equality decreased from 78.3% to 72.1% during this period. Educational wastage among Scheduled tribes at Primary Stage was 78.1 per cent. Among States, educational wastage in Orissa (85.9%), Manipur (82.1%), Madhya Pradesh (82.1%), Assam (80.9%), Tripura (80.8%) and Rajasthan (79.2%) was more than that of the national average. Among Union Territories, maximum wastage at Primary stage was in Dadra & Nagar Haveli (87.9%). Figures relating to enrolment of scheduled tribes, percentage to the total enrolment, coefficient of equality and percentage of wastage at primary stage in respect of each State/Union Territory of India have been delineated in Table 49 below. State-wise enrolment at Primary stage in respect of each class is given in Statement X in Appendix 'B'.

### (ii) Middle Stage

Here also in order to maintain uniformity, Classes VI-VIII have been taken to constitute the Middle stage in all the States and Union Territories of the country irrespective of the State-wise variation in this regard. Scheduled tribe students enrolled at this stage were of the order of 4.62 lakhs in 1974-75. Of this, 1.22 lakh were Girls. The corresponding figures of 1975-76 were 4.91 lakhs and 1.33 lakh respectively. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment improved from 3.0 in 1974-75 to 3.1 in 1975-76. However, the coefficient of Equality decreased from 43.5 to 41.4 during this period. For Class-wise enrolment a reference may be made to Statement XI in Appendix 'B'.

(iii) High/Higher Secondary Stage

For the purpose of this report, the High/Higher Secondary

stage of General School Education has been taken to consist of Classes IX and above in all the States and Union Territories irrespective of the varied system of School classes. The total number of scheduled tribe students studying at this stage was 1.92 lakhs, of which 45,573 were Girls in 1974-75. This increased to 2.05 lakhs (including 50,594 Girls) in 1975-76. The percentage of scheduled tribe enrolment to the total enrolment at this stage increased from 2.6 in 1974-75 to 2.8 in 1975-76. The coefficient of equality were 37.7% in 1974-75 and 37.4% in 1975-76. Class-wise enrolment has been furnished in Statement XII in Appendix 'B'. Table 51 below gives State-wise enrolment, percentage enrolment and coefficient of equality in respect of High/Higher Secondary classes.

(iv) Enrolment by Classes at School Stage

Table 52 gives Class-wise percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment and coefficient of equality in respect of General School Education during 1975-76. The enrolment of scheduled tribe students in General School Education (Classes Pre-Primary to Higher Secondary) increased from 41.55 lakhs in 1974-75 to 43.07 lakhs in 1975-76. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled tribes to total enrolment of all communities and the coefficient of equality were 4.7 and 68.1 and 4.8 and 64.1 in 1974-75 and 1975-76 respectively.

(V) Vocational, Special and Other Stages of Education of School Standard

Scheduled tribe students enrolled in Vocational/Professional schools stage increased from 4,950 in 1974-75 to 8,927 in 1975-76. Percentage of scheduled tribe enrolment to the total enrolment showed an increase from 3.7 in 1974-75 to 4.0 in 1975-76. Corresponding coefficient of equality was 53.6% in 1974-75 and 53.4% in 1975-76. State-wise break-up of enrolment in various stages of Vocational education is given in Statement XIII in Appendix 'B'. Scheduled tribes enrolment in Special and Other Education School stage increased from 38,040 in 1974-75 to 51,240 in 1975-76. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to total enrolment increased from 5.7 per cent in 1974-75 to 6.7 per cent in 1975-76 so also the coefficient of equality which increased from 73.9% to 89.5% during the period under review. While State-wise enrolment in Special and Other Education (School Standard) is given in Statement XIV in Appendix 'B', Table 53 indicates percentage enrolment and coefficient of equality during the year 1975-76.

Scheduled tribe students enrolled in General Higher Education increased from 51,963 (including 10,276 Girls) in 1974-75 to 53,008 (including 11,499 Girls) in 1975-76. The percentage of scheduled tribe enrolment to total enrolment was 1.7% both in 1974-75 and 1975-76 and the percentage of girls increased from 1.2 in 1974-75 to 1.3 in 1975-76. 
