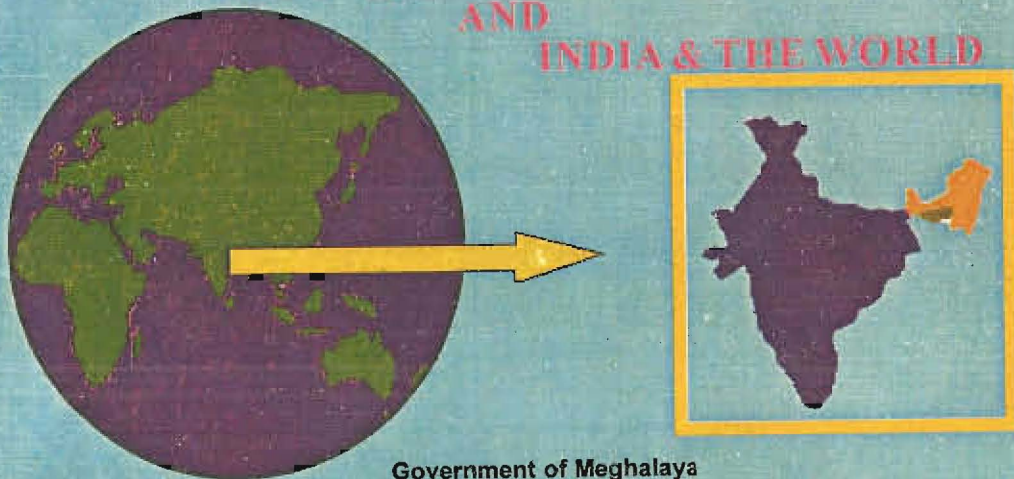

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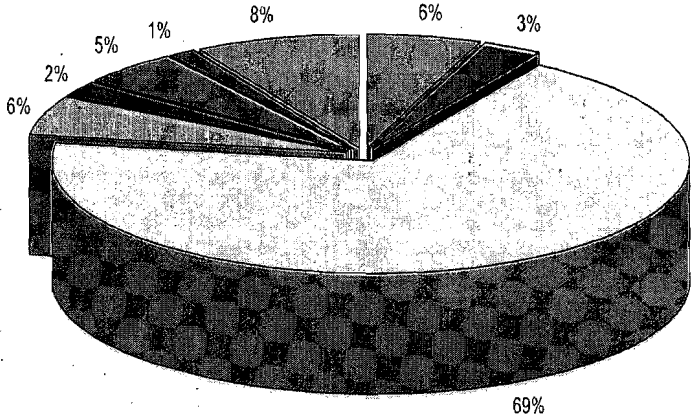
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### Population of North Eastern States, 2001

Census Population of North Eastern States

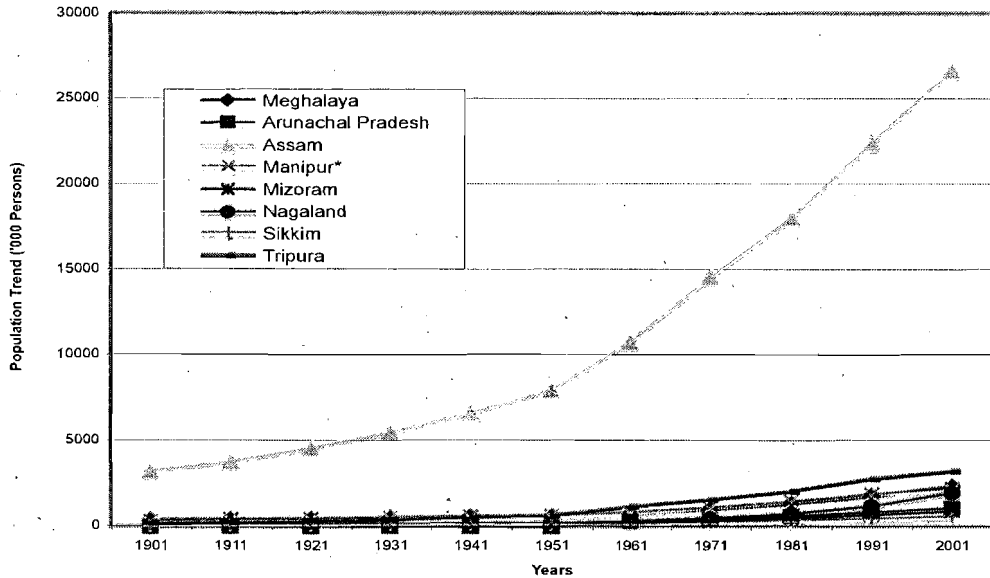

Estimated Birth, Death and Natural Growth Rate, 2004

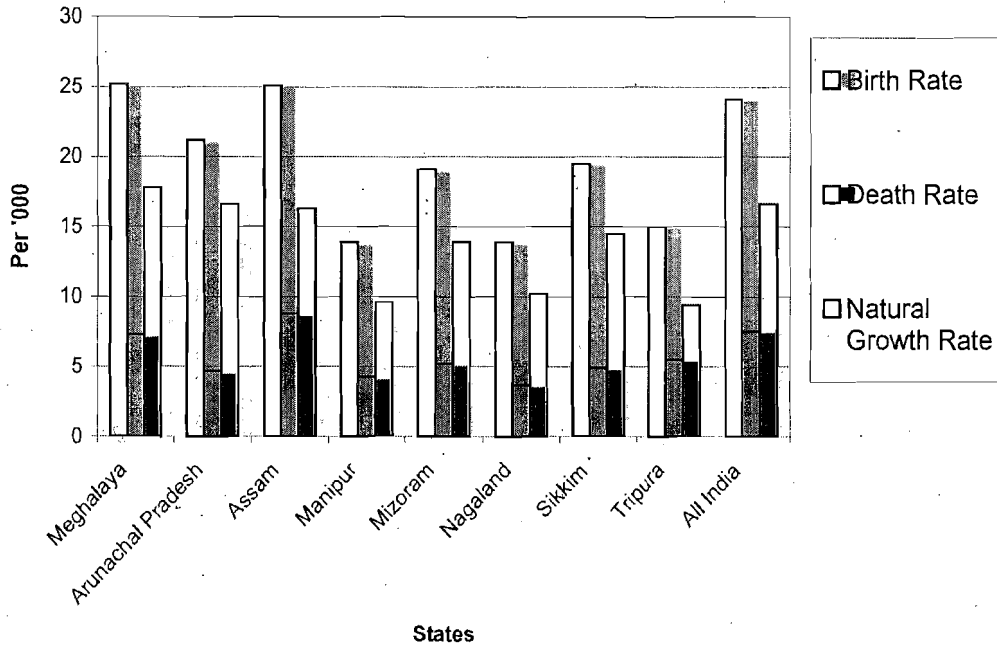

**Production of Foodgrains 2004-05**

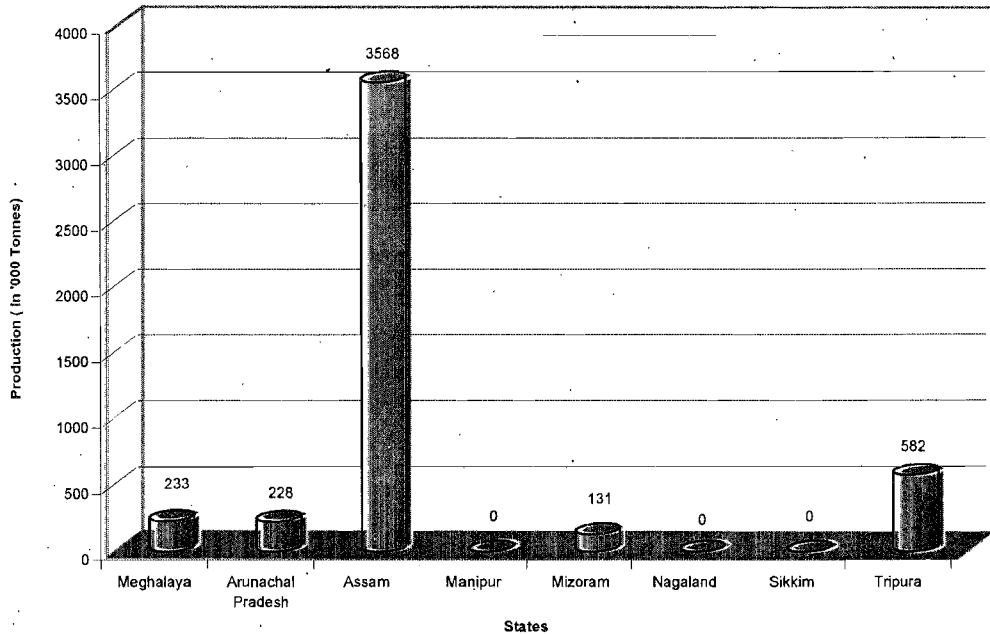

Literacy according to Census of India, 2001

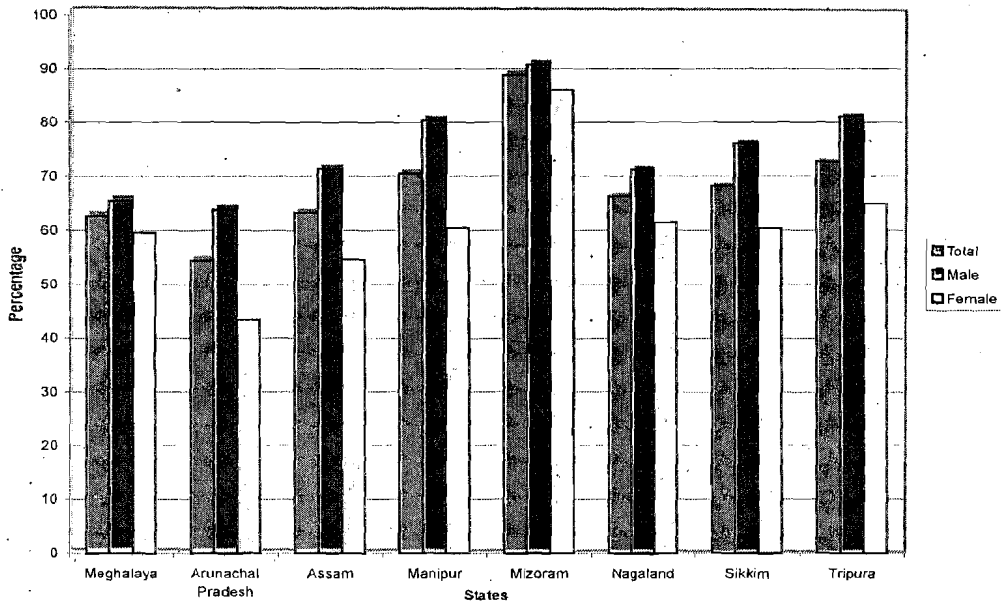

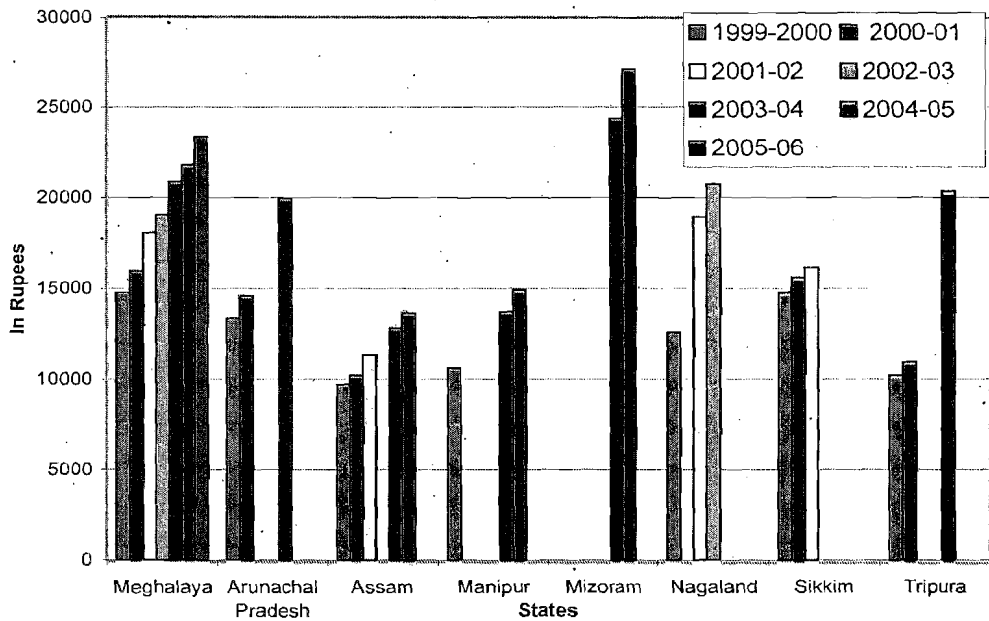
