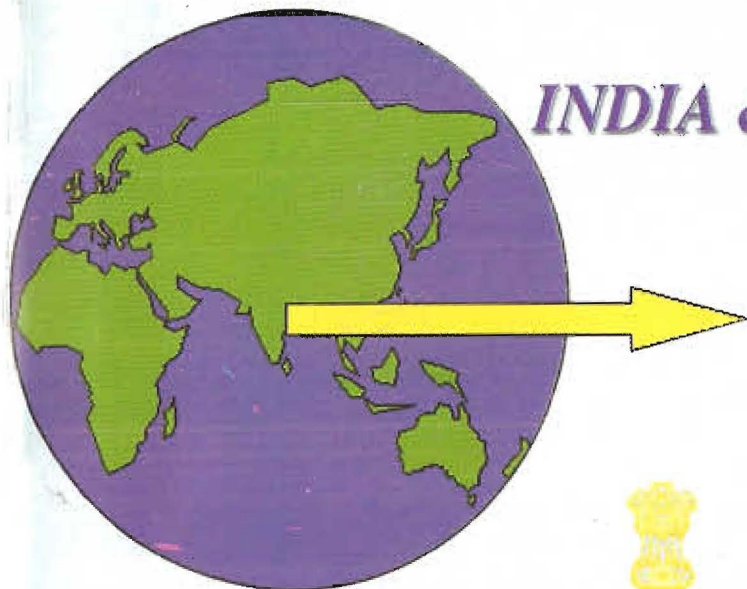

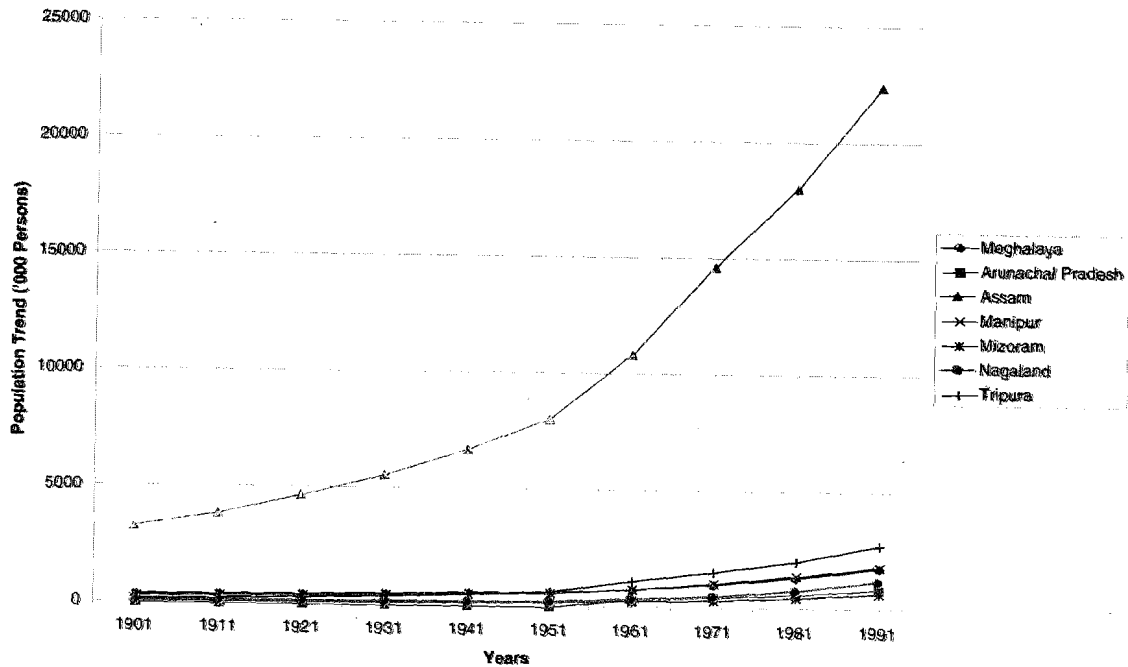

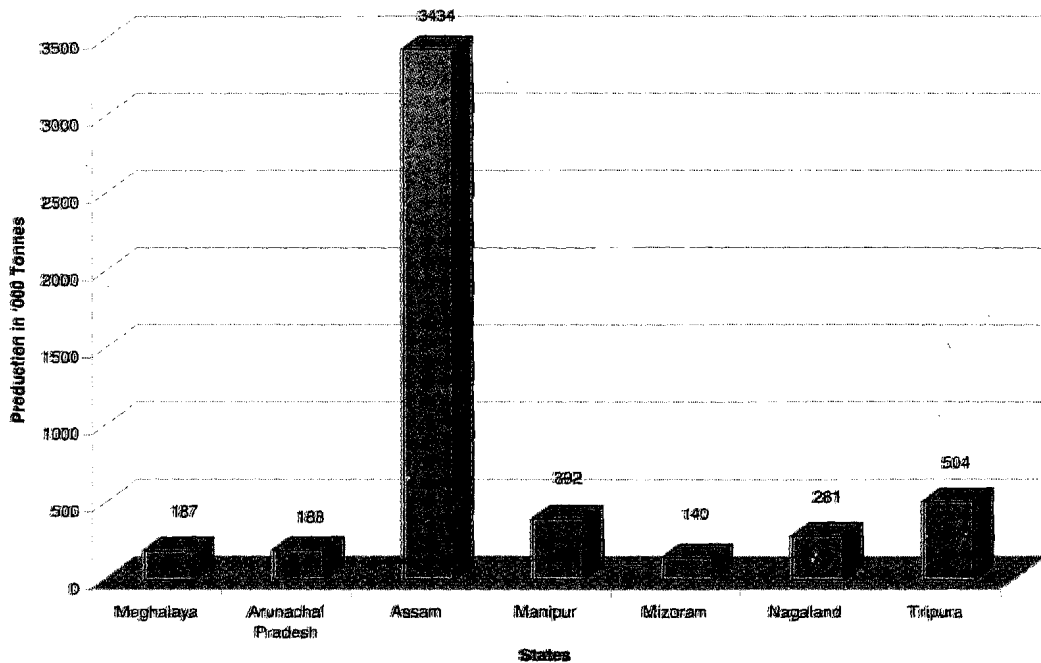

Literacy according to National Sample Survey, 1997

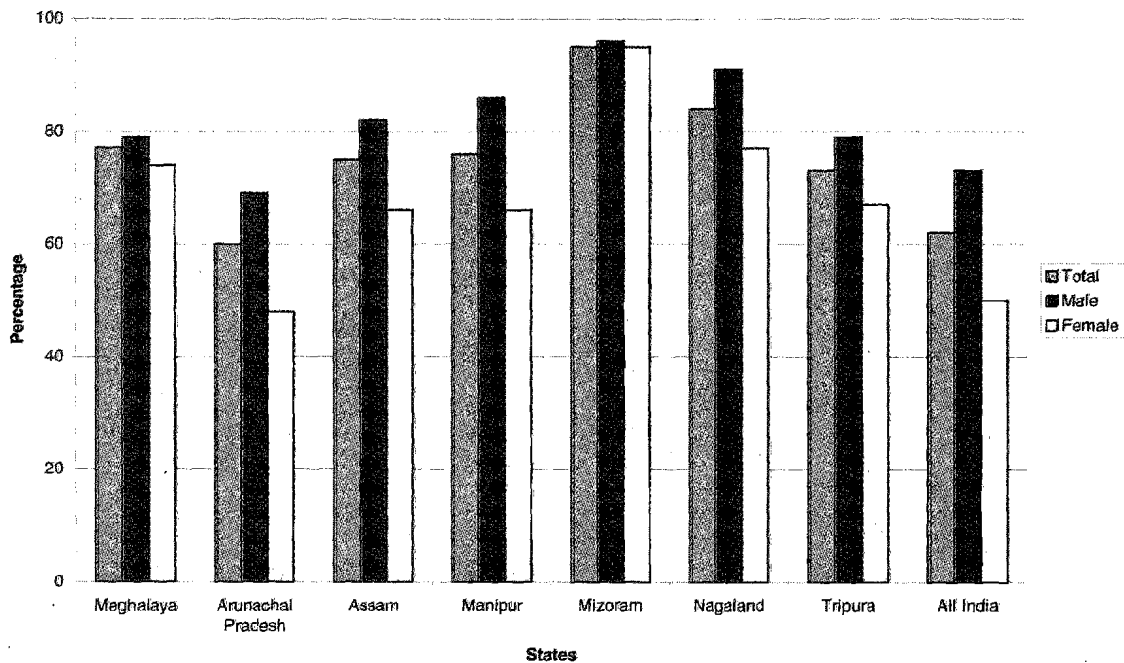

Plan Outlay of North Eastern States for 8th Plan(1992-1997)

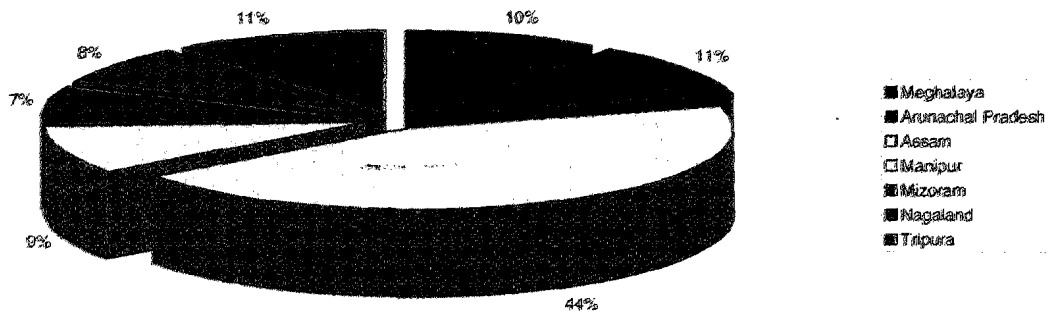
