STATE LEVEL REPORTS

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COMPUTERISATION IN DEPT. OF EDUCATION.

The Department of Public Instruction in Karnataka :

The Department of Public Instruction (DPI) in Karnataka is headed by the Commissioner of Public Instruction (CPI). Each of the stages of education like primary, secondary, adult education etc. is looked after by a Director of Public Instruction. There are four divisions in the state and at each of the divisional headquarters there is a Joint Director of Public Instruction (JDPI). There are 21 districts and each of the districts has a Deputy Director of Public Instruction (DDPI) as the administrative head.

There are totally 43,486 authorised schools in the state, out of which 38,933 schools are primary schools and 5053 are high schools. There are 1,81,164 teachers working in these schools, out of which 1,35,742 teachers teach at primary level and 45,419 teachers teach at high school level.

DPI AND NIC :

The Department of Public Instruction is using computer facilities provided by National Informatics Centre (NIC) at district level and state level extensively. The department also has a PC AT at the Commissioner's office and the system is being used for small applications of the CPI's office. Two major systems implemented for the DPI are 'Education Census' and 'Institution Database of Disnic Education'. In addition, the applications computerised for the department by NIC include 'Monitoring of Inspection Programme of officers of the DPI', 'Student and teacher's welfare fund distribution programmes' and 'Personnel Information system of the officers of the DPI'.

Training programmes have been conducted for the staff of the department at state and district levels. The topics covered include Introduction to computers, Wordprocessing, Spreadsheet, data entry concepts etc.,

TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATIONS :

A task force on Education was set up in the state in the year 1987 to study the requirements and identify the contents and nature of data for preparation of databases for the sector to help in planning and policy formulation. The major recommendations of the task force include the collection of information in the following functional areas :

- INSTITUTIONS
- TEACHERS AND STUDENTS
- BUILDING AND OTHER FACILITIES
- SCHOOLING FACILITIES IN THE HABITAT
- INCENTIVE SCHEMES - IMPLEMENTATION AND COVERAGE
- SPECIAL SCHEMES - IMPLEMENTATION AND COVERAGE

The directorates involved in the system are - Directorate of Primary Education, Directorate of Secondary Education, Directorate of Pre-University Education, Directorate of Collegiate Education, Directorate of Adult Education, Directorate of Urdu and other Minority Institutions.

The broad areas under which information is to be collected are - Target group population, Admission information of the target group, School less habitations list, Institution data, Non-formal Education center information, Vidya Vikasa Scheme information and Range-wise expenditure information.

The input parameters for each of these functional areas have been listed and the outputs required at various levels of state, district, taluk and institution have been identified in the task force report, submitted in 1988.

The task force recommendations can be broadly classified as :

1. FAMILY LEVEL EDUCATIONAL DETAILS
2. INSTITUTION LEVEL EDUCATION DETAILS

The computerisation of Family level educational details was undertaken as 'Education Census' and the institution level information for schools is being implemented as 'Institution Database of Disnic Education'.

EDUCATION CENSUS :

The Government of Karnataka proposed to make primary education compulsory and thus introduced the Mysore Compulsory Education Act in the year 1961, under which it was binding on the educational authorities to conduct actual enumeration of all children in the specified age group. This enumeration is being taken up every year by the Department of Public Instruction in the state.

A conference of Education Secretaries and Directors of DPI was held under the aegis of Ministry of Human Resource development on 12-9-88 to present a new monitoring system in respect of universalisation of elementary education and non-formal education recommending 100% enumeration and computerisation of data. In addition, it was proposed to enumerate the target strength for adult education.

With this in view, computerisation of education census for the academic year 1988-89 was taken up in the state and enumeration of all individuals in the age group 0-35 was done. In addition to collection of educational details from the individuals, an opinionnaire on the 'Vidya Vikasa Scheme' was also conducted. Processing of the data collected was done using NIC's computer facilities at the districts.

ENUMERATION AND CONSOLIDATION :

In all 60 lakh households in the state were enumerated under Education Census. The input format for information collection was designed jointly by the DPI and NIC. The information collected included the category, financial status, educational status of the family and also the educational status of each individual in the family in the age group 0-35. Enumeration was done by school teachers drawn from various schools of the District between 8th and 13th of February 1989. Owing to the large volume of data involved, it was felt that consolidation of information at enumerator level should be done. Hence a procedure for consolidation was evolved, wherein each enumerator was asked to consolidate the schedules enumerated by him (on an average 50 schedules), into one consolidated sheet. To make the work of consolidation simpler, a worksheet was designed and was used by the enumerators and the consolidated information was fed into the computers.

USER TRAINING AND MONITORING :

For effective monitoring of the project, officers were identified at different levels and training conducted for them. A nodal officer (Education Officer) was identified for each district and was given the overall responsibility of data collection, scrutiny, data entry and validation. A training was conducted at Bangalore for the nodal officers on January 5th 1989. In addition an Assistant Education Officer (AEO) was appointed as nodal officer for a taluk. Training of the AEOs and the data entry staff was conducted jointly by the District Nodal officer and the District Informatics Officer at district level.

DATA ENTRY AND PROCESSING :

Data entry was done by school teachers at the NIC District Computer Centers at the respective districts. On an average 3 to 4 terminals were provided at each of the centers for the purpose. Some of the districts generated the reports at district level. However the data from all the districts was transferred to the state center and report generation for all the districts was done. The state level reports were also generated along with some analytical graphs.

OUTPUTS FROM THE SYSTEM :

The outputs from the system cover a broad spectrum of classification of the target group population. The classification is based on category, language, type of education, economic status of parents, educational status of parents, no. of years of schooling had, type of disability, repeaters in various standards etc.

The following reports were generated centrally at Bangalore for all the districts :

- (1) TARGET GROUP CATEGORY WISE
- (2) TARGET GROUP LANGUAGE WISE
- (3) PROPORTION OF CHILDREN ENROLLED IN SCHOOLS & NFEs AGAINST TARGET STRENGTH
- (4) NUMBER OF ILLITERATES ACCORDING TO TYPE OF ILLITERACY
- (5) PROPORTION OF ADULTS ENROLLED IN AECs AGAINST TARGET STRENGTH
- (6) NUMBER OF DROPOUTS (WITH REASONS) IN SCHOOLS STANDARD WISE
- (7) ATTENDANCE IN SCHOOLS ACCORDING TO ECONOMIC STATUS OF PARENTS
- (8) ATTENDANCE IN SCHOOLS ACCORDING TO EDUCATIONAL STATUS OF PARENTS
- (9) NUMBER OF CHILDREN IN DIFFERENT AGE GROUPS ACCORDING TO THE NUMBER OF YEARS OF SCHOOLING HAD.
- (10) NUMBER OF CHILDREN ACCORDING TO THE TYPE OF DISABILITY.
- (11) AGE WISE, REPEATOR WISE, SEX WISE DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOL GOING CHILDREN.
- (12) VIDYA VIKASA SCHEME REPORTS (TOTAL 7)

INSTITUTION DATABASE OF DISNIC - EDUCATION :

The INSTITUTION DATABASE of Disnic-Education is a database to be created for the education department in the state to help the district and state level authorities in planning, monitoring and decision making, by providing necessary information about the infrastructural and other facilities available in the institutions. The information to be collected pertains to the general facilities available in the institutions, student's information, teacher's information school-wise, teacher's bio-data database, building and maintenance information, examination results, Dropouts at various classes etc. The information is to be collected annually (at the end of the academic year) in case of annual information or as and when there is a modification to be made in the database in case of infrastructural information.

APPROACH :

To implement the Disnic-Education package action was initiated simultaneously at state level and Bellary district. At Bellary district the module on 'School Education' was successfully implemented with a few modifications in the existing parameters. Based on the pilot exercise at Bellary and discussions with state and district level officers of the Department of Public Instruction a revised set of formats have been designed. In addition to the infrastructural and other annual information of schools, Teacher's database has been added to the system which will be of immense use to the department in decisions related to teachers in the schools all over the state.

INPUT FORMATS :

There are in all eleven input forms to be filled in by each school and one input form to be filled in by each teacher in each school. A copy of the input forms is available in Appendix 1. A brief outline of the information collected in the input forms is as follows :

GENERAL INFORMATION - All static information of the school including location, stage, type, medium, category, management type and affiliation, recognition etc.

GENERAL FACILITY INFORMATION - Information on the facilities available in the school including building, class rooms, water & sanitary facilities, hostel, furniture, laboratory & other facilities, audio-visual aids available etc.

SPORTS INFORMATION - Information about the availability of playground and its utilisation, indoor games, special programs, etc.

LIBRARY FACILITY - Information about the number of books (total, reference, text, periodicals and others) available in the school, subject-wise and language-wise.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION - Information about the scholarships awarded to the students including the source of funds, category of students and amount of scholarship.

INCOME INFORMATION - Information about the recurring and non-recurring income of the schools from various sources including central and state government grants, sales proceeds, collection etc.

EXPENDITURE INFORMATION - Information about the recurring and non-recurring expenditure incurred by the school including information about expenditure towards salary of teaching & non-teaching staff, building maintenance, equipment etc.

EXAMINATION RESULT - Annual information of the examination results of schools category wise and subject wise giving the no. of students appeared, no. of students passed and no. of students failed etc.

MAINTENANCE INFORMATION - Information about the maintenance work being undertaken by schools including construction agency, area of land available, cost of construction, schedule of completion etc.

STUDENTS INFORMATION - Information about the strength of the school category wise.

TEACHERS & STAFF INFORMATION - Information about the number of teachers working and no. of vacancies subject wise and language wise.

TEACHER'S DATABASE - Information about individual teachers including the date of joining, mode of appointment, training undergone, qualification, languages known etc.

STATE LEVEL DATABASE CREATION :

A state level database will be created on the ND-550, after obtaining the data from all the districts. The database will be available for querying by state level officers. The software for loading the data on the ND-550 and a generalised query module is being developed for the purpose. Thus in addition to the periodical reports required by the department, ad-hoc reports can also be generated with the state level database.

OUTPUTS FROM THE SYSTEM :

The outputs from the system include periodical reports to be generated at taluk level, district level and state level. A list of the reports with their formats is enclosed as Appendix 2. In addition, ad-hoc reports could be generated as and when required.

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN :

The Government order for implementation of the Institution database in all the districts of the state was issued on 02-01-90.

Printing of the input formats has been done centrally for all the districts at Bangalore and will be distributed to all the districts. A detailed implementation plan has been drawn out for the project, as per which data collection, entry, verification and report generation will be completed by the end of October '90.

FORMATION OF COMMITTEE :

A committee has been formed at the state level headed by Director (UML) to monitor the progress of the project. A Committee is to be formed at the district level, headed by the DDPI to monitor all activities related to the system. In addition an Education officer will be nominated as nodal officer at district level, who will interact with the District Informatics Officer (DIO) and also supervise data collection and entry. At taluk level the AEO will be responsible for data collection from all the schools under his taluk.

TRAINING PROGRAMME :


An extensive training programme is planned for the implementation of the programme. Since the department staff is already using the NIC computer system extensively, training on fundamentals of computers, data entry etc., is not necessary. However the headmasters of schools are to be trained in filling up of the input forms.

A workshop is to be held at Bangalore for all the nodal officers at the state headquarters, wherein the system will be demonstrated and the benefits of the system explained.


At district level a training programme will be conducted for all AEOs of the district to explain the method for data collection. This training will be conducted by the DDPI and the DIO. The AEOs in turn will train the headmasters of schools in filling up of the forms.






SCHOOL GOING CHILDREN – CATEGORY WISE




SCHOOL GOING CHILDREN – CATEGORY WISE




AEC GOING STUDENTS – CATEGORY WISE




AEC GOING STUDENTS – CATEGORY WISE


NFE GOING STUDENTS – DISABILITY WISE













PARENTS' ECONOMIC STATUS VS. ABSENCE





AEC ENROLMENT IN THE AGE GROUP 15 - 29.





AEC ENROLMENT IN THE AGE GROUP 29 - 35.


