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VIZIANAGARAM DISTRICT

CHAPTER I

1.1 General Information:

As per 1981 Census the population of Vizianagaram District is 18,04,196 out of which 8,99,548 are males and 9,04,648 are females. The population of the rural area of the district is 15,16,697 and that of urban area is 2,87,499. The male population of the rural area comes to 7,55,051 and female population is 7,61,646 where as the urban population of the district is 2,87,499 consisting of 1,54,497 males and 1,43,002 females.

COMPARATIVE STUDY

As compared to the State population, Vizianagaram district population is 3.36%. Out of which 3.31 relates to males and 0.42 relates to females as per 1981 census the district estimated population raises to 3.8% as on 30.9.86. As against the state rural population is 3.69% of the population relates to rural areas out of which 3.64% is for males and 3.74% is that of females. The estimated percentage of rural population as on 30.9.86 is 4.18%. As regards to urban population compared with the of state 2.3% are residing in urban areas among which 2.25% are males and 2.35 are females.

The density of population of the district is 276 persons per Sq.Km where as the state density is 195 persons which is an increase of 41.5% over state. As per 1981 census the literacy rate of percentage of the district is 21.74% where as that of state is 29.94% which comes to 8.20% less than that of State. The literacy rate of males in the district is 30.98 against 39.26% of the state whereas the of literacy rate of the females in the district is 12.55 as against 20.39% of the State. The literacy rate among males is 18.43% higher than the literacy rate of the females.

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Among the district population there are 1,84,792 persons belonging to SCs and this is 10.24% of total population of the district. Out of the total S.C. population of the district 78,012 are males and 76,233 are females residing in rural areas. ~~78,012~~ and 15,249 males and 15,298 females are residing in urban areas. As such 10.16% of SC population is in rural area and 0.24% in urban areas are residing.

The population of S.Ts in the district is 1,53,344 out of which 1,50,235 are residing in rural areas and 3109 are residing in urban areas. The rural population of S.Ts consists of 75,197 males and 75,038 are females and that of urban ST population (males and females) Urban ST population 1668 Males and 1451 females, in that is to say out of the entire population of the district the Scheduled tribe population is 3.5% among which 9.9 are residing in rural areas and 1.0% are residing in urban areas.

LEVEL OF INDUSTRIALISATION:

Industrial Development in the district has been generally Agro-based. Ex:- the establishment of Jute Mills at Nellimarla, Vantithadi, Salur and Bobbili, and Co-operative Sugar factories at Bheemasingi, Bobbili and Seethanagar. Besides the above there is Ferro Alloys Corporation at Shreeramnagar and Kothavalasa. These are mineral based industries. There are Khandasari Sugar Mills also at Pinapenki and Uttaravilli. The provision of infrastructure facilities like availability of Manganeses in Gajapathinagar and Cheepurupalli and Garividi Mandals and cultivation of sugarcane in Badangi, Therlam, Bobbili, Seethanagar, Salur, Makkuva mandals facilitated establishment of the major industries. Vizianagar Headquarters of the district, on account of its location, acts as a central marketing centre for the areas of Orissa and Madhya Pradesh States and has industrial establishments such as general engineering, Motor workshops Ground nut oil mills, rolling mills, spin pipes, saw mills, Aluminium Hencils Steel furniture manufacturers, Trunk Body making units and Oil cake mills and actions is being initiated in the district to start heavy industries also. Apart from these there are resource based industries like manufacture of Bricks and tiles around Kothavalasa, Beemali quarry work in Vizianagar and Nellimarla. There are also small scale units pertaining to forest, livestock, textile chemical paper based rubber and plastic based etc.

AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT:

Vizianagaram is predominantly an Agricultural district and about 86% of the population is residing in rural areas and depend on agriculture. Rainfed farming is the characteristic of agricultural as about 80% of its area is cultivated under purely rainfed condition. There are resources for irrigational purposes at Thotapalli, Ravada, Mamidipalli, Andra and Thatipudi. These reservoirs are connected by a number of canals and provides facilities for irrigation. The soils in the district are predominantly loami with medium fertility. They are mostly red loami soils in so far as dry lands are concerned and clay loami in case of wet lands. The normal annual rainfall of the district is 1119 m.m. Most of the rainfall i.e, 61% of the total rainfall is received during Southwest monsoon period during which the main Khareef crops are grown. In view of the unassured irrigation conditions in the district, majority of the crops grown are dry crops, paddy crop is cultivated mainly during Khareef season and the other crops are Mesta, Groundnut, Raagi, Bazra, Sugarcane and pulses. The percentage of net area irrigated to net area sown of the district is 39.5 which is higher than that of the coastal region (37.6) and also of the state(30.6). As regards irrigation by wells through the district has been making attempts it has not made any head way. The low level of irrigation facilities in the district are responsible in getting low yield in respect of paddy and other irrigated crops.

LEVEL OF DEVELOPMENT IN CULTURAL FIELDS:

Vizianagaram is the capital of the Raja's Vizianagaram who wielded power from the 17th century A.D.- the town in the centre of Historical importance and cultural importance and attained great prominence in the past, and it is also a centre of arts and culture. Under the patronage of the enlightening ruling family of Vizianagaram. Many of the existing educational and cultural institutions had their origin from the past rulers of Vizianagaram. There is a Music College and a Sanskrit college besides other institutions in the field of art and cultural development in the district. The district has produced people of National and International fame in the fields of literature arts, athletics, Social reformers pandits and in Music. There are culturally talented people throughout the district winning National and International fame. Late Sri Dwaram Venkataswami Waidu and Karikatha Pithamahudu Adibhatla Narayana Das etc.

FIFTH ALL INDIA EDUCATIONAL SURVEY:

In order to conduct V All India Educational Survey for the benefit of the District Survey officers at the Directorate a training course was organised from 18.6.87 to 26.6.87 at Hyderabad. The date of reference of the survey is 30.9.1986. In this training course village information forms (VIF) School Information form (SIF) and Urban Information forms (UIF) were explained. In that conference the District Survey Officer were requested to conduct district level and Mandal Level meets for the benefit of officials at grass root level in this regard.

Under the guidelines given by the State Level Officers at Hyderabad, we conducted a District Level conference from 6.7.87 to 8.7.1987 (3 days) and explained the importance of survey and gave guidelines to fill up the data in the SIF's VIF's, UIF's. For this conference all the Mandal Educational Officers, Project Officers of Non Formal Education and Headmaster of schools have attended. In this conference the M.E.Os were instructed to conduct the mandal level meeting for the Elementary school Headmasters and teachers to fill up the data in the SIF's, VIF's on 6.7.1987 we have supplied the SIF's VIF's in the conference.

The Mandal level conference was conducted by the M.E.Os to give guidelines to fill up the SIF's and VIF's. The Headmaster filled the VIF's with the help of village officials, prominent persons and some revenue officers of the concerned villages. The MEOs were instructed to handover the filled in forms and Mandal consolidated forms to the District Survey Officer before 15.12.1987. The district consolidation work was started from 16.12.1987.

The filled in SIF's VIF's by the Headmasters were consolidated by the Mandal Educational Officers at Mandal level and these SIF's, VIF's were verified by the District Survey Officer with Mandal consolidation tables. Then we included the mandal wise data in the district consolidation tables. During this consolidation work the observer from NCERT attended and gave some valuable instructions and special checks for proper verification of data.

While the district consolidation work was in full swing we were asked to stop the District consolidation and handover the SIF's, VIF's, UIF's at the computer firm directly for computerisation on 4.1.1988. The District Survey Officer and Statistician worked from 3.1.88 to 12.1.88 at Hyderabad. But later instr

otions were received to revise the manual consolidation. Hence entire data was manually completed and submitted to the Director of School Education for State Level consolidation.

A habitation in a district cluster of houses existing in a compact and contiguous manner with a local name. A village may have one or more than one habitation, except when it is a deserted bechirag one.

Village means the revenue village. In the present survey we have covered all types of schools i.e, Primary, Upper Primary Secondary and Higher Secondary under all managements, there are 214 habitations, 1,461 initiated villages and 10 towns (urban areas) in the district. The estimated rural population of the district is 17,19,514 as on 30.9.1986. There are 1710 Primary schools 135 Upper Primary Schools, 151 High Schools and 13 Higher Secondary Schools (Junior Colleges) in Vizianagaram district.

CHAPTER II :: PRIMARY EDUCATION

There are 1,600 habitations with a population of 16,51,600 covering 96.05% by the Primary stage Education facility within the habitation. There are 225 habitations with a population of 33,721 having primary stage facility within distance of one KM. There are 159 habitations with a population of 19,039 having primary stage facility within distance of 1.1 K.M. to 2 K.M. There are 130 habitations with a population of 15,107 covering 90.889 has Primary stage facility at the distance of more than 2 KM.

There are seven mandals in the district which have cent percent Primary Educational facility within the habitations. These mandals are 1.Jiyamavalasa 2.Dathirajeru 3.Pusapatirega 4.Denkada 5.Vizianagaram 6.Jami and 7.Badangi. 11 Mandals have got cent percent Primary Educational facilities within a distance of one KM. There are 16 Mandals having Primary stage facilities at distance of more than one KM.

There is one agency Mandal in the district G.L.Puram having 141 habitations out of which 35 habitations are having primary stage facility at a distance of more than 2 KM and this is because to the habitations are only tribal pockets with less than 100 population. Therefore this is the only mandal which is deprived of Primary Educational Facility for 35 habitations having no school within a distance of 2 K.M.

2.2 Out of 2114 habitations 1825 were served by the Primary schools covering the population of 16,85,368. 18 Primary Schools are proposed to be opened in 35 habitations with a population of 8,143 in the following 8 mandals.

There are still 254 habitations with a population of 26,003 having no Primary educational facilities even after providing new schools.

SCHEDULED CASTES PROPORTION AND EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES:

Out of 1,461 villages, 289 villages are having no SC population at all 891 villages the population is upto 25% villages have got Primary stage facility, 333 villages have Upper Primary stage F1, 109 villages have secondary stage and 7 villages have Higher Secondary stage facilities. In 258 villages there are 26 to 50% of SC population. For these 258 villages 55 villages have got primary stage facility, 07 villages have U.P.stage facility 03 villages have Secondary stage facility and one village having Higher Secondary facility. In 11 villages there are 51 to 75% of S.C.Population. Out of these 11 villages, 9 villages have got Primary stage facility, No U.P. stage facility, no Secondary Stage facility and there are no Higher Secondary stage facility for all the 23 villages. In 12 villages there are more than 75% of SC's population. Out of these 9 villages have got Primary facility. There are no Upper Primary and Secondary and Higher Secondary stage facility for all the 12 villages.

SCHEDULED TRIBES PROPORTION EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES:

Out of 1,461 villages, there is no ST population in 295 villages. There are 435 villages with ST population upto 25%, and out of 435 villages 416 villages having Primary facility and 186 villages are having Upper Primary School

facility are having U.P. School facility and 79 villages have got Secondary stage facility and 9 villages have Higher Secondary facility. There are 163 villages having ST population in the percentage ranging between 26 to 50%. Among such 163 villages 91 villages are having Primary stage facility, 11 villages are having Upper Primary stage facility and only one village is having Higher Secondary School facility. There are 245 villages with a % of population ranging between 51 to 75%. Out of 245 villages, 145 villages are having Primary Stage facility 3 villages are having Upper Primary School facility and one village is having Secondary facility. There is no facility for Higher Secondary stage. There are 323 villages with S.T. population of above 75%. Out of 323, 136 villages are having Primary Stage facilities and no other facilities are available.

2.4 PRIMARY SCHOOLS AND SCHOOLS HAVING PRIMARY CLASSES IN RURAL AND URBAN AREAS:

There are 1,710 Primary schools in the district under all managements. Out of which 55 are Government, 1,569 local bodies, 84 under Private aided management and 2 are under private un aided management.

There are 1,851 schools in total having primary classes. Out of which 67 schools are under Government, 1,692 under local bodies, 89 under Private aided management and 3 schools under Private Un aided managements.

In rural areas there are 54 Primary schools under Government, 1,482 under local bodies, 71 under Private Aided management and 1 school under Private un aided management. There are 65 schools in total having Primary classes under Government 1,591 under local bodies, 73 under Private aided management and 1 school under Private un aided management.

And so far as urban area is concerned there is one Primary School under Government, 87 schools are under local bodies, 13 schools under Private aided management and 1 school is under Private Un aided management. Regarding primary classes in urban areas there are 2 schools having Primary classes under Government, 101 schools in local bodies, 16 schools under Private aided management and 2 schools under Private Un aided management.

2.5 PRIMARY SCHOOLS ACCORDING TO THE TYPE OF BUILDING:

There are 1,710 Primary schools, out of which 939 are located in Pucca buildings in which 65 are in Urban areas and 874 in rural areas. Out of 102 schools located in partly Pucca buildings 18 are in Urban areas where as 84 are in rural areas. There are 151 schools located in Katcha buildings out of which 9 are in Urban areas and 142 are in rural areas. 225 schools located in tatched sheds among which 6 are in Urban and 219 are in rural areas. 31 Rural schools are located in tents. 262 schools are running in open space of which 4 schools are in Urban areas and 258 schools in rural areas.

2.6 PRIMARY SCHOOL ACCORDING TO NUMBER OF INSTRUCTIONAL ROOMS:

There are 258 schools without instructional room in the rural area and four in urban area. There are 1,075 schools in rural and 45 in urban areas with single room for instructional purpose. 146 schools in rural and 14 schools in urban with two rooms for instructional purpose. 56 schools in rural area and 13 schools in urban area with 3 rooms for instructional purpose. 27 schools in rural and 7 schools in urban with four rooms used for instructional purpose. 18 schools in rural and 6 schools in urban with 5 instructional rooms. 19 schools in rural and 6 in urban having 6-7 instructional rooms. 3 schools each in rural and urban having 8-9 rooms used for instructional purpose. 6 schools in rural and 4 in urban having 10 and above rooms for instructional purpose.

2.7 PRIMARY SCHOOLS ACCORDING TO ADDITIONAL ROOMS REQUIRED:

Out of 1,608 schools in rural area and 102 schools in urban area 152 schools in rural area and 19 schools in urban area have sufficient instructional rooms. In rural area 228 schools each require 1 additional room. Out of which 5 are Government schools, 220 local body schools and 3 private aided schools. In urban are 6 schools require one additional room out of which 5 are local body schools and one private aided school. In rural area 411 schools require 2 additional rooms each. Out of which 18 are Government schools, 384 local bodies schools and 9 Private aided. In urban areas 24 schools require 2 additional rooms each. Out of which one is Government School, 20 local body schools and 3 Private aided schools. In rural area 221 schools require 3 additional rooms, Out of which 4 are Government schools, 214 local body schools and 3 are Private aided schools. In urban area 16 schools require 3

additional rooms, out of which 14 schools are local body and 2 Private aided schools. In rural area 338 schools require 4 additional rooms each. Out of which 10 are Government Schools, 321 are local body schools and 7 are Private aided schools. In urban area 19 schools required 4 additional rooms each. Out of which 18 are local body schools and one is Private aided school. In rural area 258 schools require 5 and more additional rooms, Out of which 17 are Government Schools, 220 are local body and 21 Private Aided Schools. In Urban area 18 schools require 5 and above additional rooms out of which 14 are local body and four private aided schools.

2.8 AVAILABILITY OF BLACK BOARDS IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS:

In 1,710 Primary schools there are 8,748 sections in the district. Of which 2,997 sections have usable Black Boards; 390 sections have un-usable black boards while the remaining 5,451 sections do not have Black Boards at all in the district. In rural area among mandals, Vizianagaram mandal schools have the highest number of usable Black Boards that is 412 and the least number of usable Black Boards is 17 in the Mandal Makkuva. In Saluru Mandal out of 315 sections 257 sections do not have Black Board which is maximum deficit among mandals. In Gantiyada mandal only 32 sections do not having Black Boards which is least deficit in the district among the mandals. Comparatively the percentage of usable Black Boards is more in urban areas than in rural areas of the district.

2.9 AVAILABILITY OF OTHER FACILITIES

Out of 1,608 schools in rural area 228 schools have drinking water facility out of which 8 are Government schools 198 are local body schools and 22 are in Private aided; in Urban area out of 102 schools, 43 schools have drinking water facility of which one is Government, 30 local body and 12 Private Aided schools.

Out of 1,608 schools in rural area 41 schools have urinals (in which 3 schools have separate urinals for girls) 28 local body schools, 13 Private aided schools have the urinals. Out of 102 schools in urban area 33 schools have urinals. Out of which One is Government, 20 Local body and 12 Private Aided schools, there is no separate urinals for Girls in urban area.

Out of 1,608 schools in rural area 585 schools have medical checkup facility, out of which 9 Government schools, 525 local body schools and 51 Private aided schools. In urban area out of 102 schools 67 schools have medical checkup facility, out of which 1 Government school 53 local body schools and 13 Private aided schools.

Only one school in rural area and 25 schools in urban area have lavatory facilities in the district. Out of 1,710 schools in the district only 723 schools have vaccination inoculation facility of which 649 schools are in rural area and 74 are in Urban area.

2.10 There is no zero teacher school in the vizianagaram district. There are 663 single teachers schools in Vizianagaram district. Of which 7 mandals have below 10 each and the remaining 27 mandals have above 10 with a maximum number of 45 in G.L.Puram Mandal. There are only 2 single teacher schools in Cheepurupalli Mandal. There are 585 two teacher schools in Vizianagaram district. Out of which one is in urban area and the remaining schools are in rural area. Among 34 mandals, 30 two teacher schools in Salur Mandal which is highest figure among mandals and the least figure is 8 in Pachipenta and Vizianagaram. There are 100 three teacher schools in this district. Out of which 4 are in urban area and 176 are in rural area. Among mandals 16 three teacher schools are in Jiyammavalasa mandal which is highest number and one each 3 teacher schools are in Bhogapuram and Nellimarla which is least.

There are 102 four teacher schools in this district. Of which 6 are in urban area and 96 are in rural area, among which 6 schools are in Therlam mandal which is highest and 1 each four teacher school in Cheepurupalli, Merakamudidam, S.Kota and Vepada which are least number. There are 62 five teacher schools in the district. Out of which 22 are in urban area and 40 are in rural area among which each 3 schools are in Gajapathinagaram, Gantya and Vizianagaram. There are no 5 teacher schools in the mandals of Bhogapuram, Bobbili, Denkada, Garividi, Gurla, Komarada, Mentada, Pusapatirega, S.Kota and Vepada.

There are 118 more than 5 teacher schools in the district out of which 69 are in urban area 49 are in rural area among which 8, more than 5 teacher schools are in Seethanagaram Mandal which is highest among mandals.

There are no more than 5 teacher schools in the Mandals of Cheepurupalli, Dathirajeru, Gantayada, Garividi, G.L.Puram, Gurla, Jami, Kothavalasa, Mentada, Merakamudidam, Pusapatirega Ramabhadrapuram, S.Kota and Vepada.

87-88 TEACHERS AT PRIMARY STAGE IN RURAL AND URBAN AREAS:

360 teachers teach in the district at the Primary stage out of which 3,146 males and 456 female teachers are in the rural area and 402 male and 320 female teachers are working in the urban area of the district. In rural area 755 male teachers and 139 female teachers are below matriculates. 1,343 male teachers 175 female teachers are matriculates. 636 Male teachers 75 female teachers are having the qualification of Higher Secondary. There are 378 graduate male teachers 33 post graduate male teachers and 1 Language male teacher and 64 graduate female teachers are working in the rural area of the district. There are no post-graduate and language female teachers in the rural area of the district.

In urban areas 45 male teachers and 89 female teachers are below matriculates. 167 male teachers, 117 female teachers are matriculates. 126 male teachers and 56 female teachers are of Higher Secondary qualification (+2 stage), There are 55 graduate male teachers and 8 post graduate male teachers and one other skilled male teacher, 52 graduate female teachers and 6 post-graduate teachers are working in the urban area in the district. There are no untrained teachers both in the urban and rural areas of the Vizianagaram district.

101-108 ENROLMENT AT PRIMARY STAGE IN RURAL & URBAN AREAS:

There are 1,12,759 Boys and 92,961 girls on rolls in 1 to 5 classes in the district. There are 13,203 SC boys and 11,418 SC girls are studying in primary classes of the district. Out of which 11,148 Boys and 9,663 girls are in rural area of the district while 2,055 Boys, 1,755 girls are studying in urban areas.

9,372 S.T. Boys and 7,465 S.T. girls are studying in the district in the Primary classes out of which 9,023 ST Boys and 7,164 ST girls are in the rural areas while 349 ST Boys and 297 ST girls are in the urban areas of the district in the Primary Classes.

2.13 Indicators of Educational Development i.e., Gross Enrollment ratio: The Indicators are 1) Gross enrollment ratios 2) Age specific enrollment ratios. 3) Teacher pupil ratios 4) Percentage of girls. Gross enrollment ratios. The Gross enrolment ratio of boys ~~xxxxixixixixixixixixixix~~ is 97.82% and girls 81.81 in the district. The total gross enrollment is 89.87%. Out of the above the rural gross enrollment is 90.31%. Out of which the gross enrollment ratio of boys 99.33% and the gross enrollment of girls is 81.15% and in the urban areas the gross enrollment of the boys is 89.75% and the gross enrollment of the girls is 85.32%.

2) AGE SPECIFIC ENROLLMENT RATIOS:

The District total Primary classes age specific enrollment ratio is 68.09%. Out of which the rural age specific enrollment ratio is 67.73 and the urban age specific enrollment ratio is 70.01%. In rural areas Primary level, 6 to below 11 years, age specific enrollment ratio of Boys 74.20% and 61.17% for girls. In urban areas the age specific enrollment ratio of Boys is 75.32% and 66.64% for girls. In this the total age specific enrolment ratio of urban is 2.28% higher than rural enrollment ratio.

3) TEACHER PUPIL RATIO:

The teacher pupil ratio of urban is 43.6% and for rural is 48.3%. The rural teacher pupil ratio is 4.7% more than the urban pupil teacher ratio.

4) PERCENTAGE OF GIRLS:

The total percentage of girls at Primary stage in the district is 45.19%, out of which the urban percentage of girls is 48.3% and the rural percentage of girls 44.6% the disparity is 3.7% more than the rural girls percentage as compared with urban percentage of girls.

UPPER PRIMARY EDUCATION

In Vizianagaram district there are 2,114 habitations with a population of 17,19,514 out of which 258 habitations with 6,03,909 population covering 35.12% have an Upper Primary school facility within the habitation. Among the mandals 4 mandals covering about 50% of population have Upper Primary school facility within the habitations. They are Nellimarla, Gantyaada, Ranabhadrapuram and Bobbili.

There are 576 habitations with a population of 3,83,964 having an Upper Primary stage facility within a distance upto 1 KM among which 2 mandals Belijipeta, Mentada are covered cent percent by Upper Primary stage within one K.M. There are 316 habitations with a population of 2,19,944 having U.P.Stage facility ranging the distance between 1.1 to 2 K.M. upto this distance 4 mandals are having cent percent U.P.Stage facility. The mandals are Gagugubilli, Therlam, Gantada and S.Kota. There are 270 habitations with a population of 1,92,164 have an Upper Primary Stage facility within a distance ranging from 2.1 K.M. to 3 K.M. Out of the 2,114 habitations with a population of 17,19,514, 1,420 habitations with a population of 13,99,981 covering 81.42% have an Upper Primary stage upto a distance of 3 K.M. distance.

694 habitations are having the Upper Primary stage facility beyond 3 K.M. distance which covers 18.58% population of the district. There are 183 habitations with a population of 1,18,209 having Upper Primary Stage within the distance ranging from 3.1 to 4 K.M. There are 152 habitations with a population of 92,059 having Upper Primary Stage facility within a distance ranging from 4.1 K.M. to 5 K.M. 359 habitations with a population of 1,09,265 covering 6.35% depend upon the Upper Primary Stage facility available at a distance beyond 5 K.M.

 12.2 In Vizianagaram district out of 2,114 habitations 1420 habitations with a population of 13,99,981 covering 81.41 having a Upper Primary stage within the walkable distance.

There will be no Upper Primary stage facility for 630 habitations with a population of 2,23,619 covering 12.97% even after providing new schools on the basis of given criterion. So the above mentioned population they may be provided Ashram schools for Upper Primary stage facility.
