## I N T R O D U C T I O N



## BRIEF NOTE ON DEVELOPMENT BLOCKS OF WEST KAMENG

A. West Kameng District is comprised of three development blocks, namely, Dirang, Kalaktang, and Nafra-Buragaon blocks. The salient features of the blocks are mentioned below.

### 1) DIRANG BLOCK

Dirang block was opened on 1st December, 1957 and it occupies the North-Western part of the district. The block covered the administrative jurisdiction of Dirang Circle and its headquarter is at Dirang.

The block is bounded by Tawang District of Arunachal Pradesh in the North, Bhutan in the West, Kalaktang and Nafra Circles of West Kameng are in the South and East respectively.

As per 1991 population census, the block is having 36 villages.

The topography of the block is mostly mountainous. The altitude of Dirang, the block headquarter, is 1197 mtr. The main river of the block is Dirangchu. The local inhabitants are mostly Monpas.

### 2) NAFRA-BURAGAON BLOCK

Nafra-Buragaon block comprise four administrative units i.e Nafra, Thrizino, Bondila and Bhalukpong Circles. The block was opened in the year 1962-63 and its headquarter is at Thrizino. The altitude of Thrizino is 1224 mtr.

The block is bounded by Tibet region of China in the North, Dirang and Kalaktang Circles of West Kameng on the West, Sonitpur District of Assam in the south and East Kameng District of Arunachal Pradesh in the East.

During 1991 population census, 84 Nos. of villages were recorded within the block area.

The main rivers are Kameng, Tenga and Bichom. The major tribes of the block are Mijis, Akas, Buguns and Monpas. Mijis are settled in Nafra Circle. Akas and Buguns are settled in Thrizino Circle. Monpas are inhabited mostly in Bondila circle and in Jerigao village of Nafra Circle. New Khellong and Foot-hills area of Bhalukpong circle are inhabited by Sherdukpens.

### KALAKTANG BLOCK

Kalaktang block occupied the South-Western part of West Kameng. The block is bounded by Dirang Circle of West Kameng in the North, Bhutan on the West, Thrizino and Bhalukpong Circles of the District are in the East and Sonitpur District of Assam in the South.

The block was opened in the year 1962-63 and it covers the administrative jurisdiction of Kalaktang Circle. As per 1991 population Census, the block is having 49 villages. The altitude of Kalaktang, the block headquarter, is 1113 meters.

The local inhabitants are mostly Monpas except in Shergaon, Rupa, Jigaon and Thongre. Villages were Sherdukpens are settled.

### MAIN ACTIVITIES IN THE BLOCK:

In order to stimulate local initiative in formulating developmental programme and also to get local efforts and resources in carrying out the schemes, Community Development(CD) and National Extension Service(NES) blocks were opened in Arunachal Pradesh. Under Community Development Programmes, the main emphasis is put to create and strengthen infrastructure facilities. The programme also covers such residual activities which do not fall within the purview of normal schemes of Development Departments.

The Integrated Rural Development Programmes (IRDP) was introduced first in Kalaktang block in the year 1978-79. The next block to be brought under IRDP was Mafra-Buragaon in 1980-81 and Dirang Block was covered in 1981-82. In addition to IRDP, some other Programmes, such as Integrated Child Development service(ICDS), Assistance to Small and Marginal Farmers (ASMF), Jawahar Rojgar Yojana(JRY), and Indra Awas Yojana(IAY) are under implementation in the blocks.
