

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GENERAL REVIEW OF FINANCES

REVENUE ACCOUNT

The receipts on Revenue Account during the year 1990-91 are estimated at Rs.372·30 crores and the expenditure is estimated at Rs. 334·01 crores. The estimates for 1990-91 reveals a surplus of Rs. 38·29 crores. Table 1 below indicates the budgetary position on revenue account.

Tax Revenue, 1990-91 (Budget Estimates)

The State's share of Central Taxes during 1990-91 is estimated at Rs.88·37 crores which is Rs.23·20 crores higher than the share in 1989-90 (Revised Estimates). Receipts from the State Taxes and Duties during 1990-91 show an increase of Rs.2·44 crores over the receipts in 1989-90 (Revised Estimates). Estimates of Share of Central Taxes and State Taxes and duties together with percentage to total tax revenue and percentage of tax revenue to total revenue are indicated in the Table below :—

The State's Share of Central Taxes, 1990-91 (Budget Estimates)

The State's share of Central Taxes during 1990-91 is estimated at Rs.88·37 crores out of which Rs.8·80 crores is the share of Income Tax, Rs.79·57 crores is the share of Union Excise Duties, and nothing in the share of Estate Duty. These together with percentage to total are shown in the Table given below :—

Expenditure met from Revenue, 1990-91 (Budget Estimates)

Estimate of expenditure under the revenue account for 1990-91 come to Rs.334·01 crores which is Rs.46·51 crores higher than the Revised Estimate of 1989-90 anticipated to be incurred under the revenue account.

Out of the total expenditure of Rs.334·01 crores in 1990-91, Rs.210·87 crores or Rs.72·11 percent is earmarked for developmental purposes which is Rs.39·44 crores higher than the expenditure expected to be incurred in 1989-90 (Revised Estimates). Non-Development expenditure is estimated at Rs.93·14 crores during 1990-91 which is Rs.7·06 crores higher than that of 1989-90 (Revised Estimates). These along with the percentage distribution are indicated in table 4 below:—
